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Schwieterman Market Outlook

A marketing commentary by Bret Crofts

The ag commodities seemed to do a better job of separating from the stock market last week. The Dow Jones started off the week stronger, but spent most of the rest of the week trading sideways or lower and ended up being just about unchanged for the week. The grain markets, on the other hand, posted significant gains and the corn got back nearly two weeks of losses. The outside markets may have had less impact on the day to day trading in the grains, but the action in the outside markets was still very important to the commodities and the outlook for the economy as a whole.

The Dow Jones only managed one day of follow through strength after last Friday's reversal higher. That has been the typical response to bullish chart formations in the stock market lately so that was not a big disappointment. It was disappointing that the stock market couldn't hold Monday's gains and that the Dow Jones was essentially unchanged for the week, but I think it is more important to look at Friday's market activity and I am pretty impressed by that. Friday the stock market started off lower in response to the failed automotive bailout plan, but managed to come back and close positive. We had negative unemployment numbers out Friday and the general outlook ahead of the

open was very, very bleak, but the market shrugged off the negative news. When a bear market fails to respond to bearish news, that is one of the first signs that you are no longer in a bear market.

The Dollar Index was sharply lower last week, which should be supportive to commodities in general. The government has been doing just about everything possible to weaken the Dollar and stop deflation and last week's action in the Dollar indicates that may be starting to work. Significant technical damage was done to the Dollar Index chart and I look for follow through weakness over the next week or so.

Bond futures made new all time highs on Friday then reversed lower, which looked like a sign of a long term top. However, by the time the session was over bond futures were higher again and ended up making the highest close ever. Mortgage rates are coming down, which is good for borrowers and should help increase the activity in the housing market. The rising bond market is a little disturbing though, because right now it indicates there is still fear of deflation and fear of putting money anywhere but in the hands of the government. I suspect that if the stock market avoids a sharp selloff next week that the bonds will start to come under pressure. Gains in the

stock market next week would start to convince traders to put their money to work instead of hiding it in government bonds.

Thursday was the December supply and demand report. It was not friendly at all, but we ended up seeing a friendly reaction to the numbers. Once again bear markets failed to respond to bearish news and that is one of the best signs we have seen that the grain markets are at least done going down.

Corn ending stocks were raised by 350 million bushels. Exports and ethanol usage were cut and feed usage was raised. As expected there was no change in production, but that is still a possibility for the January report. The 1.474 billion bushels of ending stocks is not friendly, but it was not entirely unexpected. We are still going to use more corn than we produce and traders basically said "so what" to the increase in stocks. On Friday Informa released their estimate of planted acreage for next year and came out with 82.3 million, which is sharply lower than this year. That was a bullish surprise to the market since it would imply a sharp reduction in ending stocks next year. It also is a sort of warning to the market that the current economic set up is not conducive to increasing corn acreage. Prices need

to increase or inputs need to decrease. Both would be preferable.

The March corn has started to work through important technical resistance levels and could see some follow through next week. The \$3.85 - \$3.95 area is the next technical hurdle the corn market has to clear. A close above \$3.95 would be very significant and mark the end of the bear market.

The wheat numbers weren't too meaningful this time around. Ending stocks were higher due to an increase in imports and a decrease in food usage. Export sales are still good enough that at some point we could see an increase in the export estimate, but it didn't happen this time around. The wheat is pretty much void of news and is relegated to being a follower. Unless we see a dramatic improvement in the export market there really isn't much to talk about right now so the wheat will be

stuck being a follower for the foreseeable future.

Soybean ending stocks were left unchanged. There was a cut in crush and an equal increase in exports. The export market is still very strong so I would not be surprised to see another increase in the estimate at some point in the future.

The soybean charts are definitely looking friendlier. The beans have worked through all the down trend lines and the last step in calling the bear market over is a close above the 50-day moving average, which is at the \$8.95 area in the January contract. Strength in the crude oil and avoiding a meltdown in the stock market would allow for a test of the 50-day moving average next week. A close above that and we will have to be aggressive buyers.

Dates set for Walk Kansas 2009

For many in Kansas, participating in Walk Kansas — a Kansas State University Research and Extension health challenge — signals spring, said Walk Kansas coordinator Sharolyn Jackson. The 2009 program will begin March 8 and continue to May 2.

Over the eight-year history of the program, it has grown to more than 20,000 participants, said Jackson, who is Extension's northeast area specialist in family and consumer sciences. Each year, the participants form teams of six to log 423 miles, the equivalent of walking across Kansas.

This year, she said, some adjustments and additions to the program are expected to keep it fresh and in line with changes in recommendations for health.

The goal in the past has been 30 minutes of aerobic activity each day. But, updated recommendations now call for a total of 2-1/2 hours (150 minutes) of heart-healthy aerobic exercise per week.

Participants also are encouraged to tally health-promoting fruits, vegetables and whole grains on their menu each week.

"The focus of this eight-week program continues to be fitness and health. Incorporating healthy habits can be helpful in managing weight, hypertension and diabetes, as well as in preventing some cancers and reducing stress," Jackson said.

The cost to enroll is \$7 to cover registration and program materials, which include a weekly newsletter with nutrition and health tips and recipes.

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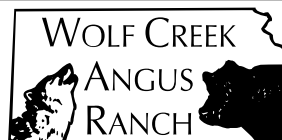
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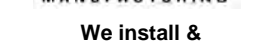
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Entomologists work toward halting the spread of Lyme disease

In research that could mitigate the spread of Lyme disease, Kansas State University entomologists are looking for answers in tick saliva.

Yoonseong Park, associate professor of entomology at K-State, is working with Ladislav Simo, a research associate, to understand what controls the salivary gland system in black-legged ticks.

“My research program has focused on how the tick’s neurological system is connected to the salivary system,” Park said. “We have identified neuropeptides involved in controlling salivary gland activity.”

Working in collaboration with K-State’s Functional Genomics Consortium, Park and Simo have used the group’s MALDI-TOF machine. Park said it is one of the most modern protein analysis machines available, and with it they have identified a number of neuropeptides for the first time. Understanding these neuropeptides could help mitigate the spread of Lyme disease, Park said.

Also called deer ticks, black-legged ticks spread Lyme disease. Park said it affects between 250,000 and 350,000 people in the United States each year and also is a big problem in Europe. The bacteria that cause Lyme disease are transmitted through the tick’s saliva when it is feeding on a host.

A tick’s meal lasts about a week, Park said. During that time, neuropeptides control the salivary gland to keep the feeding process going. That means secreting anticoagulants to make the host’s blood drinkable and secreting anti-immunoglobulins that inhibit the host’s ability to resist the tick.

Park said that the tick’s salivary system is continually adjusting these secretions as needed.

The salivary system also plays a role in helping the tick survive when a host isn’t available. Park said the tick uses its salivary gland to control the suction of water out of the atmosphere.

“Eventually, our study can be a tool for disrupting the disease transmission,” Park said. “We might be able to inhibit the tick’s salivary secretion mechanism.”

He said that his research with Simo also will help scientists who are trying to understand such mechanisms in other tick species, like the species that spreads Rocky Mountain Spotted Fever.

Park said that his lab at K-State is one of few labs in the country studying the neuropeptides’ role in the salivary system. Their research will be published in an upcoming issue of Cell and Tissue Research.

Park and Simo also are collaborating with Purdue University researchers who are sequencing the black-legged tick’s genome. Park said that they have identified the genes responsible for encoding the neuropeptides.

Their research is being done with support from K-State’s Center of Biomedical Research Excellence. Funded by the National Institutes of Health, the center provides resources to junior basic researchers and clinician-scientists at K-State and across Kansas.

Park’s previous research through the center involved investigating the excretion processes in Anopheles gambiae, the mosquito that spreads malaria.

Farmers advised to buy fuel, fertilizer now

LITTLE ROCK, Ark. (AP) — Prices for diesel fuel and fertilizer are about as low as they are going to go, and an agricultural consultant is advising farmers to buy their supplies now for the coming year.

Richard Brock, president of Milwaukee-based Brock Associates, told rice farmers at the 2008 Rice Outlook Conference on Monday that price volatility is likely to continue and that growers should lock in low prices when they can.

Brock attributed swings in commodity prices earlier this year to cash from index funds. He said futures purchases by one particular fund, the Goldman Sachs Commodity Index, have been largely responsible for driving agricultural-commodity prices up, and then down. Brock said those price swings mirrored the price of crude oil.

Brock says one result is that many farmers and commodity merchants have stopped using futures and options. He said the markets will lose their usefulness for price discovery and hedging if rules for index funds are not changed. Arkansas is the nation’s top rice grower, producing about half of the U.S. crop. The 2007 harvest was worth more than \$1 billion.

Jim Wiesemeyer, a vice president in the Washington bureau of Memphis, Tenn.-based Informa Economics Inc., said he thinks President-elect Barack Obama will lift the U.S. trade embargo against Cuba, which would open an important market to Arkansas growers.

“That’s probably one thing that could

give you a good, sustained bump in your cash price,” Wiesemeyer told the rice growers.

Rice prices have been dropping since May, after setting a record season-average high of about \$15 per 100 pounds, said Nathan Childs, senior rice-market analyst with the U.S. Department of Agriculture’s Economic Research Service.

When rice prices went up last year, the spike was brought by artificial shortages created by export bans imposed by such countries as Egypt and India, Childs said.

“We see a continued decline in U.S. and global prices” well through the 2009-10 rice marketing year, which begins in August and ends in July, Childs said.

He said people cutting their household budgets during the economic crisis may wind up eating more rice, which would improve prices for farmers.

Brock said that the recent Chapter 11 bankruptcy filings by Pilgrim’s Pride, a chicken producer based in Pittsburg, Texas, and VeraSun Energy, an ethanol producer based in Sioux Falls, S.D., came about because of poor hedging positions. Pilgrim’s Pride has 2,900 Arkansas workers, plus hundreds of contract farmers in the state.

More than 750 attended this year’s rice conference, including growers, millers, merchants and those in related businesses. The event rotates annually among the six U.S. rice-producing states: Arkansas, California, Louisiana, Mississippi, Missouri and Texas.

Speaker at Classic tells group cash is king

Agriculture has been one of the lone bright spots in an otherwise bleak U.S. economy.

Tim Ohlde, president of the Elk State Bank of Clyde, says high commodity prices available to grain producers in 2007-08 gave many farmers a chance to achieve unprecedented profitability. What farmers choose to do with that profitability is critical to their future success, particularly as the U.S. economy continues to slump, pulling commodity prices down, too.

Ohlde, who spoke at the Kansas Commodity Classic in Salina on Dec. 9, said farmers should gear up for hard times on the farm by developing a solid portfolio of financial reports, including cash flow, income and expense and balance sheet statements. Preserving cash, Ohlde adds, is paramount.

"Cash is definitely king," Ohlde said. "Holding on to

cash and having working capital available is so important. We don't know if this economic storm will continue to deepen and be more challenging to the agriculture industry, or if it is more of a v-shape that went down and will come right back up again."

A cushion of cash, Ohlde explained, is like a shock absorber in that it allows farmers to withstand the economic potholes that crop up from time to time. If the cash reserve gets thin, these potholes can cause damage from which some farmers may never recover. But farmers who maintain a healthy cash reserve may be able to take advantage of future opportunities that arise, such as land purchases or equipment upgrades, without burning through equity.

"You can't go wrong by having working capital. Not only does it allow you to get through a downturn, but it

is your front line of defense," Ohlde said.

With high farm income, of course, comes a higher tax bill. Therefore, some farmers may wish to find additional expenses — seed, fertilizer and chemicals prepaid for the 2009 crop year, for example — or even new equipment, which can reduce the tax burden. Such expenses can be wise investments, if made within reason.

"In my mind, you want to pay taxes. However, you want to minimize your taxes by maximizing the lowest possible tax bracket rate," Ohlde explained. Paying

zero tax often is an objective, but that can be short-sighted.

"Over time, if you pay zero taxes you potentially are faced with a year in which you'll pay in the upper tax bracket," he said. "Do pay taxes, but be smart about your tax strategy. Defer income to the next year, or prepay as many expenses as possible.

"But don't forget about retirement. Take these years to sock away money for retirement, because there may be years when it is harder to come up with retirement investments," Ohlde said.

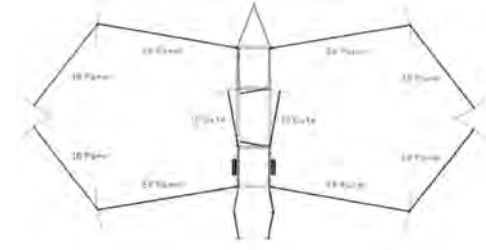

Livestock producers set policy focused on business issues

Members of the Kansas Livestock Association (KLA) have approved policy calling for improvements in the state's highway system, producer compliance with approved animal care practices and the preservation of private property rights. Policy action on these and other key livestock business issues was taken during the group's annual meeting in Wichita.

"The resolutions are a result of extensive member input, starting with the fall roundtable discussions and continuing through committee and council meetings at the convention," said KLA President Todd Allen, a Wichita cattleman. "KLA officers and staff will use this policy to help protect members' business interests during 2009." Transportation and energy were the subjects of several resolutions. Members support adequate state funding for a new transportation plan that improves highways, local roads and bridges. The resolution is based on the need of grain and livestock producers to have viable infrastructure for moving products to market.

Members acknowledged vehicle regulations must be reasonable so as not to impede the transportation of ag products. For example, producers support an interpretation of federal law clarifying that transporting ag products to and from market within the state does not constitute interstate commerce. Members also favor changes in the maximum gross vehicle weight limits for trucks operating in Kansas to a level more compatible with those imposed by neighboring states.

KLA members approved a resolution supporting a transition to a market-based approach for renewable fuels derived from commodities used as livestock feed. Support also was expressed for the research and development of additional renewable fuel technologies that will reduce America's dependence on foreign energy.

New policy endorsed by the membership recommends producers implement industry-approved best management practices for cattle care and handling. The reso-

lution also emphasizes the importance of livestock producers taking the initiative to share with consumers their round-the-clock commitment to providing quality animal care. The elimination of humane harvest for unwanted horses is a point of concern among members. Based on the increase in abandoned and neglected horses caused by various state bans on horse processing for human consumption, KLA opposes legislation or regulations that hinder the ethical and humane processing or movement of horses.

After considerable study and producer discussion, KLA adopted language strongly discouraging the

movement through marketing channels of animals persistently infected (PI) with bovine viral diarrhea (BVD). The resolution encourages beef and dairy producers to consider cost-effective prevention and testing programs for BVD PI.

Protecting property rights was the underlying motivation for several resolutions. One calls for initiatives that strengthen penalties for anyone vandalizing or gaining unauthorized entry into a livestock operation. Another supports legislation to protect the property rights of landowners when an oil or gas company damages surface interests.

Potential regulation of greenhouse gas emissions

gained attention during KLA policy meetings. Members support uniformity and consistency among federal and state laws and regulations dealing with climate change. They also favor maximum flexibility for livestock and other ag operations to meet regulatory obligations.

Long-held policy supporting free enterprise was reaffirmed. Language in the resolution opposes any regulatory or legal attempt to narrow the business options or individual freedom of livestock producers to manage and market their products.
