Schwieterman Market Outlook

A marketing commentary by Bret Crotts

The grain markets finished 2008 lower for the year, but we have seen a strong finish and got back a couple months worth of losses. The markets are now over bought and due for a correction and as we get the first full trading week of 2009 underway the time for that correction has probably come. Right now with the technical considerations of the markets being pretty bullish, I would say we have to look at buying breaks in the grains. Export demand for soybeans is still outstanding. Export de-

mand for wheat is more than adequate and has the potential to improve. The corn still has demand problems, but we do have the potential to see a lower production figure in next week's supply and demand report. Stability in the world financial and credit markets in recent weeks has allowed the grain markets to act independently from the stock markets, which has been a big help. The overall fundamental outlook of the grain markets is not bearish as long as traders are not focus on

global financial disaster and deflation. A return to the 2008 highs is not likely in 2009, but that doesn't mean we won't have some very good selling opportunities this year. The cattle market also looks like it has turned the corner in the past couple weeks. Feeder cattle charts in particular are beginning to look very friendly. Cattle feeders should be putting on long positions to protect against rising feeder cattle costs this spring. Secrets to sorghum survival in acidic soils

A gene that protects sorghum from aluminum in acidic soils has been identified by an Agricultural Research Service (ARS) scientist and cooperators.

Acidic soils, which are found around the world, often have aluminum levels that are toxic to food plants such as sorghum. This finding could help plant breeders develop sorghum varieties that can be grown by subsistence farmers who depend on this grain crop for survival.

Plant physiologist Leon Kochian leads the ARS Robert W. Holley Center for Agriculture and Health in Ithaca, N.Y. For this research, he collaborated with Jurandir V. Magalhaes, a scientist with Embrapa Maize and Sorghum, a branch of the Brazilian Agricultural Research Corporation (EMBRAPA), Brazil's federal agricultural research agency.

Aluminum tolerance in wheat is regulated by the aluminum-tolerance gene ALTM1. When ALTM1 is activated, it triggers the release of malic acid, which bonds with the aluminum and neutralizes its toxic effect. The research team found a gene in sorghum that protects the plant from soil aluminum via mechanisms that closely parallel ALTM1's activity in wheat. In sorghum, the aluminum tolerance gene prompts the release of citric acid, which also binds to soil aluminum. But this sorghum transporter — dubbed SbMATE — is not related to the ALMT1 transporter protein.

The team found that activity of SbMATE is activated in the roots of aluminum-tolerant sorghum only when aluminum is present in the soil. Under these conditions, SbMATE is most highly expressed in the first centimeter of the tip of the root. This optimizes the ability of the transporter to neutralize the aluminum and protect the sensitive root tip.

ARS and EMBRAPA researchers are now engaged in collaborative projects with plant breeders in Africa to develop aluminum-tolerant sorghum varieties for cultivation in African soils.

The Robots Are Coming

Have you ever become really frustrated over the way robots are taking over the country? I don't mean elected robots, spewing politically correct dogma to the media. Granted, they're bad enough.

But I'm talking about real robots, machines that interfere with the normal flow of our lives. I happen to be thinking about this because I had some phoning to do one morning. There were about six or seven calls on my list, all with essentially the same message, but one I needed to deliver in person. On four of these calls, I was invited to talk to a machine, and was unable to complete the call. "We'll call back as soon as we can."

Okay, what does that mean? Ten minutes? Tomorrow? A week from Friday? There's no way to tell. Maybe some people can sit by a phone, endlessly waiting in case somebody calls back. I can't do that, because I have other things to do. I can't explain to cattle that they're not getting fed because I have to wait to

see if somebody might return my call. In my experience, calls are returned only about half the time (Possibly they tried, while I was out feeding the cows).

But some of these were long distance calls. I hate to pay to talk to a machine, and then have it amount to nothing anyway. Of course, if the other party does call back, it's at his expense. But then, look at the financial waste. It has cost twice what it should to complete the call, not even counting the loss of professional time at both ends.

I'm not totally opposed to progress. I had one of the very first answering machines in our town, in 1959. That was a case of need. I was a bachelor, and there was no one to answer the phone when I was absent. But that's a far cry from the way they're used now.

Take, for instance, just one of the calls the morning I mentioned. It was to an out-of-town establishment I'd been trying to call all week. They have a central switchboard and many phone extensions. I had

asked for the appropriate extension on Monday, and listened to a very mechanical "voice-mail" inviting me to leave my number and "Sally" would call me back. Sally didn't. I tried again on Tuesday, with the same result. Wednesday, same thing.

This time, I called back and explained to the switchboard that I really need to talk to Sally, or at least some live person. The operator said she'd ring somebody else. After a few rings, the same voice-mail robot answered, same message, with a different name mechanically substituted ... "Betty" would return my call.

I didn't think so. I don't even know Betty. I know Sally pretty well, and she's not calling me. Another call to the switchboard ... I explained, as calmly as I could, that I thought this sort of operation was inconsiderate, inefficient, frustrating, and degrading to anybody trying to contact this outfit. I know the building is full of live people, and I see no excuse for such in-

sulting treatment.

This time I was finally permitted to talk to a live person. Sally, it seems, was sick at home, and wouldn't be back all week, probably. Okay, but is that any excuse? I could have been told that last Monday. Then I'd call her next week, instead of wasting time and money on a whole series of useless attempts to reach her. And what if I'd been stupid enough to wait by the phone for a return call?

I see a potential problem here, not limited to this outfit. It's everywhere. I've personally tangled with this in several firms and operations. In one case, I learned that the guy whose voice-mail message promised to call me "right back" had been on vacation for a week. Why not tell me that? In another, an employee on the road in a company car had some car trouble. She called in from a phone booth and couldn't get past her own company's cute little voice-mail message! I think the robots have already taken over.

Life moves on after popular rancher vanishes

PASSAIC, Mo. (AP) — The auctioneer sat above the cattle ring and told the crowd what a great herd they were getting ready to bid on. Well-tended, top-notch cows and performance-tested bulls.

"They certainly would not be for sale if not for the circumstances," auctioneer Jim Hertzog said into the microphone.

His voice broke with those words and he held up a hand: "Give me a second."

The arena crowd sat stone quiet. Hertzog, wearing a big cowboy hat, took a sip of water.

Then, with game face restored, he started the sale: "All right, boys, let's take a look at 'em."

The roundup was bitterly cold, on hands and heart.

With blowing snow, a north wind and temperatures in the teens, workers, including friends and family, herded nearly a thousand head of David Cook's cattle off the Sterling Ranch in Bates County last week and took them to the Mokane Livestock Market in nearby Passaic, about 50 miles south of Kansas City. Cook kept the cattle on the 10,000-acre ranch, which he managed.

The ad for last week-end's "Complete Dispersal Sale" described Cook as a knowledgeable and successful rancher for 35 years who always had a top-producing herd.

It doesn't say the cattle were being sold because Cook, 55, hasn't been seen since he disappeared from the ranch one day in mid-November.

His billfold was found inside the house. No disarray; no forced entry. His pickup still sat in the driveway.

"Nobody knows what happened. ... He's just gone," said Elsie Cash from

behind the counter at McBee's General Store, about a mile east of the ranch. "He used to stop in here all the time, for food and whatnot. Nice fellow."

"People round here sure are wondering what happened."

The Sterling Ranch is between the Kansas City Power & Light generating plant at La Cygne, Kan., and Amsterdam, Mo. It's rough land — a lot of pasture but with brushy hills and strip pits from old mining operations.

The rugged terrain hampered searches by law enforcement and a hundred volunteers.

"Brush is so thick in some places we couldn't ride a horse through it," said Judy Transue, Cook's sister.

After more than a month of diminishing hope, she

and others now believe someone took him out of the house and killed him. Over the years, Cook was involved in several volatile situations, including one in which he received death threats for testifying in a federal fraud case, family members and others said.

His daughter asked that her name not be used for this article for fear that she also could be in danger.

She is in her final year of medical school. During the preparation for the auction, she also was taking finals.

"It's like something out of a movie," she said this week. "It's just overwhelming. I'm an only child, so I don't have siblings to help me with all this. ..."

"We're trying to do what's right. But if my dad should come back, it would be so sad to him that we've sold all his cattle."

The Missouri State Highway Patrol's drug and crime control division recently took over the investigation from a local task force. Sgt. Dan Green would say only that investigators are following leads.

"We can't comment further than that at this time," Green said.

A reward is up to \$80,000. Transue sat in her Lenexa dining room recently and said the case is difficult because Cook knew so many people from the ranch, cattle business and the power plant, where he also worked. A hunting lodge on the property brought strangers to the ranch.

Her head began to shake as soon as she saw a question coming that maybe her brother just took off ... needed time alone ... had to get away ... went to Europe ... ran off with a woman.

"No way," she said. Then with a sad smile she added, "If nothing else, David would never leave his cows."

David Cook grew up the oldest of seven children in a farm family near Ballard,

Mo. He always loved the outdoors and wildlife.

He tried college for a while, but eventually quit and went to work. Ranching was what he wanted. He got married and had a daughter. A while back, he and his wife divorced. She remains on good terms with his family.

Those who knew him say he didn't do drugs, gamble, chase married women or have money problems. He was honest, hard-working and well-liked.

Hertzog, the auctioneer and one of the owners of the Mogan Livestock Market, met Cook 16 years ago.

"He was a good friend," Hertzog said. "He and his family are good people. He was very knowledgeable about cattle. The guy worked all the time. Running that ranch and then working at the power plant — he was always going on about three hours of sleep.

I don't know how he did it.

"And here's the thing, he was always in a good mood, friendly as could be. Take a dull moment and make it bright. That's what I'll remember about David."

Transue tells this story about her brother:

A few years back, she told him she wanted a colt to raise for riding and asked him to help find one. He did that and then offered to keep the animal at the ranch. Over time, he helped her break the animal.

One day when he finally got a saddle on the horse, he put his boot in the stirrup and was ready to swing himself up when he stopped and glanced at his sister.

He smiled, pulled his boot free and motioned to her — "Get up there."

"He knew I wanted to be first," Transue said.

Remembering the moment, she cried.

Mike Cook, a brother, was sitting in an office at

Mogan Livestock Market before the start of the auction when the door opened and an employee stuck his head in.

"Mike, we're getting ready to start," the man said. "Jim wants to know if you want to say something first."

Cook shook his head. "I can't."

The man nodded and closed the door.

"I don't even know if I want to go out there because I'll probably lose it when Jim talks about David," Cook said.

The past month has been hard on this family. First there was the disappearance and intense search. Then

came the realization that David Cook probably was not coming back and that something had to be done with his cattle.

The time of year makes it even harder. For years, 25 to 30 members of the Cook family gathered to celebrate Christmas at the hunting lodge on Sterling Ranch. They would ride horses, and David would show the children the buffalo and elk that lived there. He often sent each child home with a cow's tooth or set of horns.

"Things are a lot different for all of us this Christmas," Mike Cook said.

Especially for their father, Millard Cook, 83, who lives in a nursing home in

Butler, Mo. Not long after he told Transue: "Find David."

She took his hand. "We're trying, Dad. We're trying."

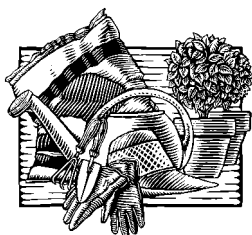
