

Cattleman has attended 66 Western Stock Shows

DENVER (AP) — Walter Douthit marveled at the weekend’s shirt-sleeve weather in the National Western Stock Show & Rodeo stockyards, with the sun warm on his shoulders and the scent of green hay on the breeze.

“I’ve seen it 30-below out here,” the 70-year-old cattleman from St. Francis, Kan., said Saturday. He hasn’t missed a stock show in Denver in 66 years.

Things have changed a lot, and he’s not talking about just the weather.

He remembers rolling into Denver in the early morning hours. The city lights were amazing to a young boy in the 1940s: Used-car lots lined Colfax Avenue in Aurora, selling acres and acres of Chryslers, Hudsons and Packards.

Today his daughter, Megan, and her husband, Chuck Downey, help sell the Hereford bulls that have made the Douthit family famous in the cattle business and the stockyards.

Just across the walkway, Walter’s brother Steve sells cattle from a different business on the same family homestead that has been producing bulls for more than four generations.

Walter remembers sending cattle to Denver by train when the stockyards sold cattle year-round.

Now he is the last of the cattlemen who bring a herd and sell a herd at the stock show. Nearly all the rest have switched to “show” cows, meaning prize animals that attract buyers to the herd back home.

What you see is what

you get when you deal with the Douthits.

“A lot of things have changed, but we still sell bulls the way we always have,” Walter said, as his 29-year-old daughter talked to a potential customer.

His traditional approach reminds stockyard veterans of what the West, and the stock show, used to be like.

“Walter is a classic,” said stock-show volunteer Keith Chamberlain. “He’s the kind of guy you used to find down in the stockyards, but there aren’t many left like him.”

His other daughter, Teresa Slough, is a professor of equine sciences at Kansas State University. His son, Chad, is a production manager for the pork foods maker John Morrell & Co.

Downey said her father was a good example to follow into the cattle business, teaching her to always “be honest and always treat a customer the way you would want to be treated.”

Walter remembers decades ago when he sold bulls for as little as \$400. The current average price is about \$7,500. But it’s a far cry from the asking price for another of his bulls — \$27,000 for the 6-foot-by-6-foot acrylic painting.

Rural America artist Don Coen snapped a photo of a Douthit Hereford at a stock show a few years ago and turned the image into a painting, which is on display in the Coors Western Art Exhibit and Sale on the top floor of the Hall of Education.

“Man, I’d love to sell a bull for that,” lamented the chipper salesman.

First guaranteed loan for commercial-scale cellulosic ethanol plant approved


Agriculture Secretary Ed Schafer announced Jan. 16 that USDA Rural Development has approved the first-ever loan guarantee to a commercial-scale cellulosic ethanol plant. The \$80 million loan to Range Fuels Inc., Soperton, Ga., comes from the Section 9003 Biorefinery Assistance Program authorized by the 2008 Farm Bill.

“The investment in this facility, which will make cellulosic ethanol from wood chips, has the potential to significantly advance the timetable for second-generation ethanol production in this country,” Schafer said.

The Biorefinery Assistance Program promotes the development of new and emerging technologies for the production of advanced biofuels, defined as fuels that are not produced from food sources. The project is expected to produce an estimated 63 jobs. When fully operational in 2010, the plant is expected to produce approximately 20 million gal. of cellulosic ethanol per year.

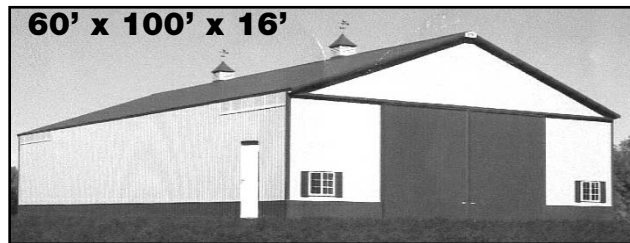

The Kansas Rural Center announces the statewide Farmer's Market Conference which is scheduled from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. on Monday, February 23 at the Topeka and Shawnee County Public Library at 1515 SW 10th Avenue, Topeka, Kansas.

Mercedes Taylor-Puckett, KRC's Farmer's Market Project Coordinator, said the "bigger and better" 2009 conference is titled "Growing Together" and is open to all involved with farmers' markets whether as a producer, market manager, board member or interested citizen.

Charuth and Kevin Loth, of ShadowBrook Farm in Lincoln, Nebraska, are the conference's featured speakers. The Loths operate a family-owned diversified vegetable farm incorporating cattle, dairy goats and flowers into the 34-acre, organic farm's rotation plan. The couple participates in three farmers' markets and the Nebraska Food Cooperative, as well as operating a CSA (Community Supported Agriculture) and on-farm market and dairy.

"Shadowbrook is an inspiring example a new generation of sustainable farms," Taylor-Puckett said. "Charuth and Kevin have explored many direct marketing opportunities over the past thirteen years and aren't shy about sharing what has and hasn't worked and why."



USDA announces funding for cattle fever tick prevention

The U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) announced mid-January that it will make an additional \$4.9 million in emergency funding available to support the Cattle Fever Tick Eradication Program (CFTEP). These funds will help address the emergency cattle fever tick situation in Texas.

The eradication program was initiated in 1906 and was initially funded by Congress in 1907 as a cooperative federal/state/industry disease and pest eradication effort. Due to these efforts, cattle fever ticks were eradicated from all 14 states that comprised the fever tick's his-

torical range and were pushed across the Rio Grande River by 1943. A permanent quarantine area was established along the Texas side of the Rio Grande River in 1938 to prevent re-establishment of fever ticks from Mexico in Texas.

Despite the success of the program, since 2005 the level of tick infestations has been trending upward. Tick incursions from Mexico are increasing, resulting in a historically high number of infested premises as well as temporary expansions of the permanent quarantine buffer area in Texas.

APHIS proposes rule on NAIS

USDA's Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service (APHIS) has proposed a rule to amend the domestic livestock regulations with respect to the National Animal Identification System (NAIS). The proposed rule — published in the Federal Register Jan. 13 — would require that when animal identification numbers (AIN) are used, only those numbers beginning with the 840 prefix will be recognized as official for use on all AIN tags applied to animals one year or more after the date on which this proposed rule is finalized. In addition, the rule would require all new premises identification numbers (PIN) issued on or after the effective date of this rule to use the seven-character alphanumeric code format.

Official eartags using a premises-based numbering system issued after a one-year phase-in period would be required to use the seven-character alphanumeric code format as well. The rule further proposes several changes pertaining to the use of the U.S. shield on official eartags, numbering systems that use such eartags, and the correlation of those numbering systems with the PIN.

According to APHIS, the

proposed changes are intended to achieve greater standardization and uniformity of official numbering systems and eartags used in animal disease programs and to enhance animal traceability.

FDA Issues Final Guidance on Regulating Genetically Engineered Animals

Jan. 15 USDA issued a final guidance for industry on the regulation of genetically engineered (GE) animals under the new animal drug provisions of the Federal Food, Drug and Cosmetic Act (FFDCA). The guidance, titled "The Regulation of Genetically Engineered Animals Containing Heritable rDNA Constructs," clarifies the FDA's statutory and regulatory authority, and provides recommendations to producers of GE animals to help them meet their obligations and responsibilities under the law.

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The FFDCA defines "articles (other than food) intended to affect the structure or any function of the body of man or other animals" as drugs. An rDNA construct that is in a GE animal and is intended to affect the animal's structure or function meets the definition of an animal drug, whether the animal is intended for food, or used

to produce another substance. Developers of these animals must demonstrate that the construct and any new products expressed from the inserted construct are safe for the health of the GE animal and, if they are food animals, for food consumption.

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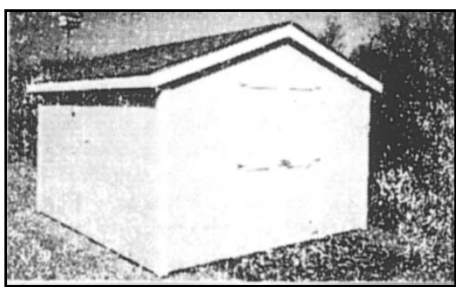

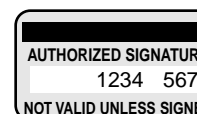

Schwieterman Market Outlook

A marketing commentary by Bret Crotts

Gulf corn basis has improved by about 15 cents since the first of the year, which can be an indication of more export demand. This week we finally saw some better numbers. This week's export sales total was a marketing year high at 1.09 MMT. Our sales are still terrible compared to last year, but if we can see another week of good number the USDA won't cut the export estimate again. If we can see a month of sales over 1 MMT we could actually see the export estimate revised higher.

We had a great deal of volatility but it didn't accomplish anything because the corn ended up being unchanged for the week. We had large trading ranges every day, but because gains couldn't hold and buyers were found on any weakness the market didn't go anywhere. The 40 and 50-day moving averages were tested every day as support and the support held every day this week. I still have concerns about the large ending stocks figures, but the technical outlook for the market is friendly, and if we are going to see better demand in the future, then we have to look for the corn market to move higher.

Right now the March corn has strong overhead resistance at about the \$4.00 area. If that resistance is broken next week, it will be a very good buy signal and a very good indication that the March corn is headed up the \$4.35 and possibly \$5.00 level.

Like the corn, the wheat ended up going nowhere this week as well. The March KW had a 45 cent trading range, but only gained 1 1/2 cents. It only gained 1 1/2 cents, but it was a better close than the previous 8 sessions, so I guess we shouldn't complain.

The charts don't look too bad. We had the hard down day last week after the crop report, but since then it has basically been consolidation trade. The market certainly gave us a scare on Tuesday and sure looked like it was headed lower.

However, the rejection of Tuesday's weakness and the positive close for the week has technical indicators giving buy signals. Another leg higher is not out of the question and a move to \$7.50 looks possible.

Another leg higher would actually be likely if our exports stay at this week's pace. We sold 410,300 MT, which may not sound like much, but it is quite a bit more than we need each week. There are indications that there isn't much wheat available out of eastern Europe and buyers may have to turn to the US in the near future.

The other fundamental factor we are watching is the growing drought in the HRW area. The most severe area of dryness is in Texas, but there are also problems in Oklahoma and many areas in Kansas could use some moisture. Another 5 weeks without significant moisture and drought will be getting a lot of press.

The March soybeans ended up losing about 11 cents this week, which I found surprising considering the weather problems in S. America, the lower acreage estimate out of Argentina and our extremely strong export sales pace. The beans showed signs of strength of at times, but could never put together back to back positive closes.

Exports were outstanding at 1.32 MMT. We have nearly sold as many bushels of soybeans as we have of corn, which is pretty amazing for this late in the crop year. We have shipped more soybeans this crop year than corn, which I doubt has ever happened before at this point in the year. Part of this is because corn sales have been terrible, but we are also on a record soybean sales pace. I think there is a very good chance USDA will have to raise the export estimate to a record level. We only need to sell 234 million more bushels to meet the USDA estimate and we sold 48 million last week. The current ending stocks estimate is 225 million, which means at the current sales

pace we could sell all the beans we need to in order to meet the USDA estimate and sell all of our ending stocks in less than 10 weeks.

The bull spreads worked very well again this week because of the good demand and the threat of more acres this spring. The main thing holding the market back right now seems to be that threat of more acres. If the corn exports could stay strong for a while it would take some of that threat away and the beans could be much stronger.

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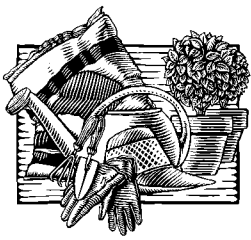
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Yard & Garden Tips

Easy Picking Fruit Crop

January is the month of dreaming and planning your garden. Vegetable and fruit plants have gained in popularity with the reported ailing economy. In the past, people took the time to grow their own food. The cycle may be back to home food production.

Kansas has a challenging gardening environment. Not all plants are suited to it. I suggest paying attention to varieties that have historically prospered. Experienced gardeners will and should try some new ones for fun.

K-State Research and Extension has publications on tried and true plants. They are available from the office and on the Riley County Extension website at www.riley.ksu.edu. Go to the lawn and garden icon and then click on good plants to grow.

Homegrown produce tastes better to me so I grow it in good or hard times. Brambles are the easiest fruit crop to grow for me. Black raspberries are my favorite. Every Fathers Day's weekend, I enjoy walking out our front door and gathering my supply for my breakfast. This works as long as the kids didn't graze the night before. Allen, Jewell and Bristol are proven varieties. You could also try Blackhawk.

There are other colors and flavors of

raspberries. Reds like Titan, Latham and Reveille produce in the summer. Heritage and Amity produce mostly in the fall. Brandywine and Royalty are purple varieties. If you want some yellow in your fruit salad consider Kiwi Gold, Fall Gold or Goldie. The yellow varieties have the habit of the fall red raspberries.

Blackberries (not the electronic device) are easy to work with. Thornless varieties are nice. Ouachita, Apache and Triple Crown along with Chester and Black Satin should be considered. We have had Chester for a long time. I'm adding Triple Crown to our landscape.

Brambles need a little pruning and watering but that is about it. If you want to supplement your food budget, try growing some brambles. The publication "Raspberries and Blackberries" is available from the office or on the web at www.oznet.ksu.edu.

Roller coaster prices leave many farmers uneasy

DES MOINES, Iowa (AP) — It wasn't so long ago that farmers were frequently asked what they would do with their wind-fall profits.

That was last summer, in the heady days of \$8 a bushel corn and \$16 a bushel soybeans, when it seemed farmers could count on an inexhaustible demand from ethanol manufacturers and food companies.

Today, corn prices have dropped below \$4 a bushel following a surprisingly strong 2008 harvest and plunging demand. Soybeans were trading at close to \$10 a bushel.

Faced with such a huge price swing, combined with the high costs of seed, fertilizer and machinery, farmers could be forgiven for being a bit bewildered. Some are considering switching crops and many are bracing for more questions when they seek annual loans to cover their upfront costs.

"What we've seen these last two years, you almost got to throw out any previous history because we're in uncharted territory," said Ryan Weeks, a 36-year-old fifth-generation farmer of corn and soybeans from Juniata, Neb.

"We've been through a downturn before," Weeks said. "But we've also never had the risk out there that we have now. If we see a huge retreat on grain prices, it's going to be very, very tough."

Swine Profitability Conference to feature special guest speaker

Many factors have contributed to the roller coaster ride, especially for Iowa's hallmark crop of corn. Among them:

The dramatic drop in oil prices has forced a corresponding decline in the price of corn-based ethanol. Many ethanol plants have been idled until their profitability improves, reducing demand for corn.

Last summer widespread flooding in Iowa increased corn prices because of fears it would reduce the harvest, but farmers managed to recover and produce the second-largest crop in U.S. history.

Another big crop came as an economic slowdown swept over the United States and much of the world, likely lessening demand and causing a drop in purchases by food companies and livestock producers.

The various factors and possibilities have farmers unsure what to expect.

"It's harder to know what is a good price because it might be \$1 higher or lower in a couple of months," said William Edwards, an agricultural economics professor at Iowa State University.

There's some indication that farmers who had planned to plant corn are instead opting for soybeans, which have lower input costs, said Bob Callanan, a spokesman for the American Soybean Association.

Others are simply expecting longer talks with their bankers when discussing annual loans. Because banks could be leery of making loans based off uncertain cash-flow projections, more farmers may turn to the U.S. Agriculture Department's Farm Service Agency.

Brian Gossling, the farm loan program director for the agency in Iowa, said the organization offers direct loans as well as a program that guarantees 90 percent of a bank's loan to a farmer as additional collateral.

"That's the intent of our loan program," Gossling said. "To provide some stability and incentive to banks to continue to make loans during riskier times."

Gossling said the program should have enough money to meet an increased demand.

For farmers, it's all resulted in an uneasy waiting game.

"Everybody has a kind of wait-and-see attitude," said wheat farmer Erik Younggren of Hallock, Minn. "You're up the creek without a paddle, really."
