Ashley Mueller has joined the staff of the Kansas Foundation for Agriculture in the Classroom (KFAC) as a program assistant.

Mueller, a Geneva, Neb. native, received her master of science degree from Purdue University in youth development and agricultural education in May and her bachelor of science degree in Food Science and Technology from the University of Nebraska-Lincoln in 2007.

At Purdue University, she served as a graduate research assistant for the Cooperative Extension Service, where she assisted in planning and coordinating Extension events. During her undergraduate career, she worked as a biological lab assistant for the United States Department of Agriculture's Agricultural Research Service in the Grain, Forage and Bio-energy Research Unit.

As part of the KFAC staff, Mueller will be involved in the day-to-day functioning of the KFAC office and will assist with the organization's on-going projects, which provide agriculture-based curriculum materials and programming to school children and their teachers. Mueller is passionate about educating both children and their teachers about agriculture.

Growing up in rural south-central Nebraska, she experienced the positive effects of agriculture firsthand in her community. She understands that many children and adults have not experienced the same opportunities and agriculture exposure she had.

"Agriculture is science, and I believe science is relatable, no matter a person's background or life experiences. From the clothes we wear, the food we eat, to advancements in medicine, agriculture affects us all.

It's important that children and adults are educated in agriculture," Mueller said. "Bringing agriculture into the classroom is essential in cultivating Kansas residents to be literate in agriculture. Imagine children sharing the information

they learn from KFAC programs and assemblies with their parents, grandparents and community members. I'm looking forward to assisting the foundation in its efforts to have agriculture in every classroom, every day."

Schwieterman Market Outlook

A marketing commentary by Bret Crofts

Last Tuesday's supply and demand report held a lot of information that will affect the grain markets for months to come. The most important piece of information was USDA's estimate of new crop corn ending stocks, which came in at 1.145 billion bushels. That is the tightest stocks level since the '03/04 crop year and the tightest stocks to use level since the '95/96 crop year. 1.145 billion is a 455 million bushel drop from the old crop, which implies that we will have to have more production or less demand next year. It is usually very bullish when you have to have more acres and the tight stocks level means we can't afford a

production problem this year either.

Wheat numbers were better than expected, but far from bullish. Even with lower acres and the production problems that we are having this year, ending stocks are only expected to drop 32 million to 637 million bushels. World wheat ending stocks are expected to climb to 181.90 MMT, which is up 50% in two years. We need to see better demand, but with the growing world supply of wheat, it is hard to see that happening. The best thing that could happen to the wheat is a production problem in the corn, which would increase feed usage and draw acres away.

Last week's soybean

numbers were more or less as expected. Old crop stocks were cut to 130 million bushels, mostly due to an increase in the export estimate, and new crop stocks came in at 230 million. I few months back traders were worried that new crop ending stocks might end up closer to 500 million bushels. I suppose they still could if we end up with more than expected acres and if demand slacks off, but for the moment the soybean supply and demand situation is far from bear-

ish. The corn is going to need more acres next year and the soybeans won't have that many to give.

Ag credit tightened according to Federal Reserve report

WICHITA (AP) — Agricultural credit conditions tightened in the Midwest during the first quarter of this year, The Federal Reserve Bank of Kansas City said Friday.

The Federal Reserve reported that its quarterly survey found that the percentage of lenders raising collateral requirements reached another record high in the Tenth Federal Reserve District. The rate of loan repayments also fell for the second straight quarter.

Turbulent agricultural conditions contributed to the tightened farm credit, the agency said.

“The thing to take away from all of this is ... farmers are positioning themselves to get through turbulent times,” said Federal Reserve economist Brian Briggeman.

The district includes Colorado, Kansas, Nebraska, Oklahoma, Wyoming as well as parts of New Mexico and Missouri.

Lower farm incomes curbed the demand for farm loans across most of the district, making more money available for lending. Oklahoma was the only state in the region that did not experience a sharp drop in loan demand.

Bankers in Oklahoma reported the largest increase in the percentage of loans refused due to a shortage of funds, the report said.

“Based on our respondents, we did not have anybody report significant shortage of funds other than Oklahoma,” Briggeman said.

The increase in bank referrals to government farm lending programs across the region was also driven by Oklahoma, where bankers were concerned

about drought stress on the winter wheat crop.

Those early fears over the crop appeared well founded. The National Agricultural Statistics Service this week issued a winter wheat forecast saying Oklahoma’s wheat crop was expected to come be 52 percent smaller than last year’s crop because of drought and spring freeze damage.

“Things are definitely tough in Oklahoma right now on two fronts,” Briggeman said.

Not only have the livestock operators been under pressure for the last two years, but now wheat farmers are also having problems from the drought and spring freeze.

Survey respondents reported farm income had slipped from the record highs of last year, especially in Oklahoma and Kansas where winter wheat conditions deteriorated during the first quarter. Livestock producers also were struggling with low cattle and hog prices amid waning global demand for meat, the

Federal Reserve said.

New equipment sales slowed dramatically in the district. The Association of Equipment manufacturers reported a 20 percent decline in tractor sales during the quarter when compared to last year’s record high, according to the report.

Farmland values appeared to stabilize after

modest declines in 2008, and most bankers expected those values to hold steady, the agency reported.

Non-irrigated farmland values rose 1.4 percent across the district compared to the previous quarter, with no change in the value of irrigated acreage. Ranchland values declined by less than 1 percent, re-

flecting the struggling livestock sector.

Nebraska had the most dramatic fluctuations in land values with the highest gains in 2008, but also the

sharpest declines in the past two quarters.

The Federal Reserve’s quarterly report was compiled from 255 lenders surveyed.

Alumni honored by College of Agriculture

Kansas State University's College of Agriculture recently recognized two distinguished alumni who have been actively involved in the cause of agriculture in Washington, D.C.

U.S. Sen. Sam Brownback of Kansas, a 1979 K-State graduate, received the college's Distinguished Alumnus Award, and Michael Torrey, a 1986 K-State graduate, was named Outstanding Young Alumnus. The awards were presented May 9 at the Ag Alumni Awards Reception.

"These alumni have shown great leadership and service in the agricultural industry," said Fred Cholic, dean of K-State's College of Agriculture. "We are proud that they represent the college and university."

Brownback, Topeka, was elected to the U.S. House of Representatives in 1994, then was elected to the U.S. Senate in 1996. Over the years, he has been actively engaged in re-opening U.S. beef trade in Asia and increasing markets for Kansas agriculture products, while also encouraging measures to protect American farmers and food supplies. He promotes new energy sources and biotechnologies, and has worked to revitalize the rural heartland with tax incentives and job creation. Brownback was a White House Fellow in the first Bush administration and was the youngest secretary of agriculture in Kansas history. While at K-State, he was student body president. He earned a bachelor's degree in agricultural economics from K-State and his law degree from the University of Kansas.

Torrey is a former member of the second Bush administration, serving as deputy assistant secretary for congressional relations at the U.S. Department of

Agriculture, and later as the department's deputy chief of staff. In addition, he has been special assistant to the commissioner of the Commodity Futures Trading Commission, vice president of legislative affairs for the International Dairy Foods Association and has served as adviser to former presidential candidate and Senate Majority Leader Bob Dole and U.S. Sens. Nancy Landon Kassebaum and Sheila Frahm of Kansas. He currently is chief executive officer of Michael Torrey Associates LLC, a government relations and consulting firm. While a student at K-State, he was elected president of the college's Ag Student Council and earned a bachelor's degree in agricultural education. Torrey also was a graduate of Wamego High School.

Brownback and Torrey also were recognized at the New Graduate and Alumni Dinner that followed the reception. The awards are given by the Ag Alumni Association to recognize exceptional members.

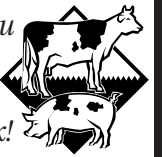

Some are laying hay down ahead of choppers for haylage. In North Central Kansas where they have been missing the rain, dryland hay is beginning to dry up, so they are cutting it. The current, stormy weather pattern and high humidity is not conducive to curing alfalfa.

Utility-Fair grinding alfalfa shipped in 100.00, at the edge of the field, 100.00-105.00, some new crop contracted 100.00-110.00.

South Central Kansas: Dairy and grinding alfalfa and alfalfa pellets steady. Movement slow.
