

# Kansas Hay Market Report

Ground alfalfa movement: Southwest/South Central Tonnage: 10,222/2,910 Last week: 10,491/3,210 Last year: 12,029/4,245 Hay trade slow. Demand moderate for alfalfa pellets, dairy and grinding alfalfa and grass hay. A significant number of producers in the southern half of the state are in the process of harvesting the first cutting of hay, hoping to miss the weekend forecast for rain. In the southwest region of the state producers are aggressively chopping the first cutting of alfalfa. Buyers and sellers are continuing the standoff for new crop contracts. Alfalfa, Horse, small squares, 210.00-250.00; Dairy, recent trade 80-90 cents/point RFV, some new crop contracted 150.00 (some no test, some 150-200 RFV), some contracts have been made 95.00-105.00 (dried to 15%-0% moisture) on alfalfa standing to be chopped for haylage. Utility-Fair grinding alfalfa shipped in 100.00, at the edge of the field, 100.00-105.00, some new crop contracted 100.00-110.00. Ground and delivered locally to feedlots and dairies Spot 130.00-150.00, some new crop contracted 120.00-135.00, some ground-on-the-truck 128.00-130.00. The week of 5/11-15, 10,222T grinding alfalfa and 648T of dairy alfalfa were delivered. Straw, good large bales 55.00-60.00.

# Schwieterman Market Outlook

A marketing commentary by Bret Crotts

The US Dollar Index fell to new multi-month lows last week and it looks like we will eventually see a test of the December low. Weakness in the US Dollar makes our products more attractive in the export market, which is something that the wheat market really needs. A little extra foreign demand would also be beneficial to the cattle and hog markets.

The biggest negative factor to having a weak dollar is that it helps drive up the price of crude oil and imported gasoline, so if the trend in the Dollar stays

down, it makes it more likely that the trend in the crude oil will stay up.

Traders are still very concerned about the weather in the eastern Corn Belt. The corn started last week sharply lower based on ideas that farmers would have nearly two weeks of open weather ahead of them to get the planting caught. The way that looks now, the open weather has been cut to five days, which means the areas that got rain last weekend may have only one or two days that they could actually plant.

In Monday's report Illinois had only 20% of the corn planted compared with 92% on average. There will be some progress made, but most likely Tuesday's progress report will show that less than half of the Illinois corn crop is planted at a time when they are normally done. This means there will be more and more talk of yield loss and acreage shifts.

The futures are still up against the same resistance levels that we have seen the past couple of weeks. There is still a lot of selling interest at the \$4.30 - \$4.35 level in the July contract and the \$4.50 - \$4.55 level in the December. Last week the corn

made its best closes since early January, so the market is in the upper end of the trading range, which means if the wet weather materializes early this week, the corn should finally be able to move through the resistance and move up to the January highs.

Two weeks ago I had almost given up on ideas that the July KW would make it to the \$6.90 - \$7.00 area. Monday morning the market looked like it was in very bad shape, but it bounced back and the July KW ended up gaining 30 cents for the week and making its best close since the 9th of January.

The wheat performed a lot better than I expected last week, but I still don't think that the wheat can rally independently. We still need to see strength in the corn and soybeans for the wheat to rally. There are some bullish fundamental factors such as the planting delays in North

Dakota and the rainfall causing quality problems in the SRW crop. However, that still probably isn't enough to support consistent gains unless we start to see demand improve enough to draw down stocks. Maybe the weakness

in the Dollar will help us out with that.

There was some spread unwinding last week that held the July soybeans back a little bit, but the July contract still gained 35 ½ cents.

Demand is still too

strong. We hear talk about potential Chinese cancellations, but we have seen no evidence of it yet. Last week's export sales report showed old crop at 700,600 MT and new crop at 667,000 MT. We have nearly reached the USDA's sales estimate and we still have 15 weeks left in the crop year. Unless we do see cancellations soon, USDA will have to raise the export estimate again. It is looking more and more like we will see ending stocks fall to the 100 million bushel level.

The way things look right now, any set back in the bull spreads is a buying opportunity. Demand is strong and there is a growing possibility that there will be more soybean acres than USDA expects. Some analysts are talking about the possibility of the July - November spread moving over \$3. I won't argue with that.

I don't feel comfortable being optimistic about the cattle market right now, but the way the October LC chart looks, and the deferred live cattle in general, I think some optimism is warranted. The markets could be on the verge of a break out. Low cattle on feed numbers and falling meat production numbers may be getting the attention of traders. The rising stock

market and cheaper Dollar can't hurt either.

Last week we had \$85 cash trade in Kansas and \$86 in Nebraska, which was essentially steady with the prior week, but there were some fears of lower trade, so I will look at steady as a moral victory. Beef was a little lower and June futures were a little higher, so the front end of the market was pretty flat. The October contract gained about \$1.50 though and made its best close since mid February.

Cattle on Feed numbers were friendly again with only 97% on feed and placements at 104%. That is 104% of a very small number last year, so placements were really no better than average. Marketings were at 93%, which sounds small, but it is compared to a large number last year. Marketings were really bigger than 3 of the past 4 years.

# Work continues to yield new cuts of beef, add value to carcass

Just about any way you slice it, beef continues to yield new cuts of meat that are expanding choices for consumers and boosting profits for the industry.

Earlier this decade muscle-profiling research by scientists from the University of Nebraska-Lincoln and the University of Florida led to development of new beef products including the

flat iron steak, now widely available in grocery stores and restaurants. Further work resulted in other new cuts from the shoulder clod, including the ranch steak and petite tender. Because those three cuts are found on the outside of the chuck, they were relatively easy to get at, said UNL meat scientist Chris Calkins, who's led UNL's research in this area.

Those new products have been hugely profitable. The National Cattlemen's Beef Association estimates that more than 174 million pounds of the flat iron and other value cuts developed from the shoulder clod are served annually. Those new products add \$50 to \$70 per head to the value of U.S. beef, or about \$1.2 billion per year.

Phase two of the research has been to focus on the chuck roll, which is most of what's left of the chuck after the shoulder clod. As traditionally cut, the chuck roll, which is found under the shoulder blade, produces two or three steaks, with most of the rest of the meat sold as boneless chuck roast.

That "hunk and chunk" approach "doesn't capture very much value from those cuts," Calkins said.

The Institute of Agriculture and Natural Resources scientist has worked with NCBA New Products Initiative to "identify a better way to disassemble that chuck roast that provides more value-added opportunities." Now that effort, funded by the Beef Checkoff, is paying off with several new products:

The Delmonico steak, also called the chuck eye, is tender, juicy and well-suited for grilling, broiling or pan frying. Country-style chuck ribs are boneless and tender.

America's Beef Roast can

be dry-roasted in the oven and tastes great when thinly sliced for sandwiches.

The Denver cut, which comes from one of the most tender muscles, has lots of marbling and a rich flavor.

The Sierra cut is very similar to flank steak.

Ellen Gibson, executive director of the NCBA's New Products Initiative, said some of these new products already are catching on in the market. "We expect these flavorful cuts to offer versatility and value, work well with high volume cooking and present increased profit opportunities for producers, packers, processors, retailers and foodservice operators," she said. "The chuck roll also lends itself well to home-style and ethnic dishes."

Meantime, scientists and the beef industry will continue efforts to carve more value out of a carcass. "The next logical question is where do you go after this," Calkins said. "And the answer is the round."

The round's large size allows for many cuts to be gen-

erated. It's relatively lean, which might appeal to health-conscious consumers but which also creates challenges in producing tender products.

The chuck and round comprise about half the weight of a beef carcass, but historically only about 25 percent of its value.

Calkins isn't heavily involved with the development of new products from the round. So far, NCBA has identified eight new value cuts from the round, with a goal of rolling out some products early next year. NCBA estimates that products from the round could add another \$20 to \$30 value to each carcass, raising the overall value of the newer muscle cuts to about \$2 billion per year.

Key to the continued success of this effort, Calkins said, is the collaboration among meat and food scientists, chefs, marketers, operations experts and culinary professionals in the meat packing, processing, packaged goods, foodservice and retail industries.

## Kansas Wheat receives bioscience innovation grant

The Kansas Bioscience Authority announced this week that they will fund the Kansas Innovation Center for Advanced Plant Design in the amount of \$4 million for fiscal year 2010.

The Innovation Center is a public and private collaboration between Kansas Wheat, Kansas State University, the University of Kansas and many private investors.

The Center will use a unique, state-of-the-art technology platform to conduct wheat, sorghum and native plants research targeted to specific market needs in the areas of human health and nutrition, animal nutrition and health and biofuels/biomaterials. Once discoveries are made, the Center will focus on commercializing these discoveries, bringing them to market to create additional value and wealth for Kansas.

The Kansas Wheat Commission was the lead applicant for the KBA grant. The Kansas Association of Wheat Growers incorporated the business entity for the Innovation Center called Heartland Plant Innovations. Wheat producers, through KAWG, own 51% of the shares of Heartland Plant Innovations.

An interim director for the center has been hired, and the first meeting of the board of directors will be in early June. The Board of Directors will perform a national search for a permanent director. The director will coordinate the research of highly skilled scientists at the Center, Kansas State University and the University of Kansas.

Some expected outcomes from the Center include: commercialization of sustainable, drought-tolerant, high-yielding varieties; foods with reduced allergenicity; new food products that are rich in antioxidants and cancer-fighting components; plant-derived compounds that are natural sources for dietary supplements; high biomass plants optimized for cellulosic biofuel production; high starch-content grains for animal feeds and ethanol that will ultimately result in animal wastes with less environmental impact and environmentally-friendly plants that require less fertilizer and pesticides.

Predicted Center outcomes have the potential to return at least an additional \$1 billion to the Kansas economy through the agriculture sector.

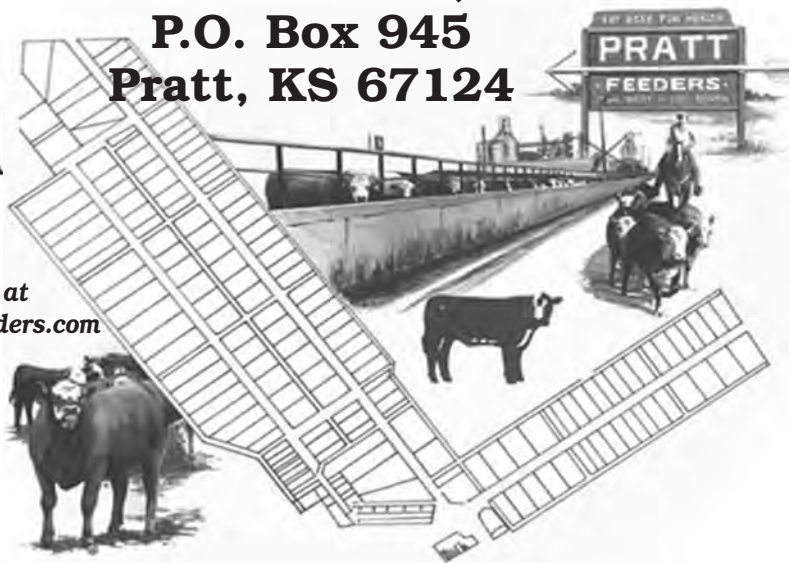

Website gives ranchers ideas to deal with high costs

From better storing grain byproducts to reducing mineral costs, Profit Tips on the University of Nebraska-Lincoln Extension's Beef website <http://beef.unl.edu> can help cattle producers save money.

Ranchers are facing economic challenges due to high input costs. Input costs, such as fuel, land, fertilizer and especially feed all have influenced the profitability of the beef industry. Feed costs represent a major part of beef cattle production expenses, said Judson Vasconcelos, feedlot nutrition specialist at UNL's Panhandle Research and Extension Center at Scottsbluff.

The UNL Extension initiative, "Surviving High Input Costs," targets feedlot and cow-calf producers.

UNL Extension specialists from the departments of agricultural economics and animal science and the Great Plains Veterinary Educational Center all have written some very helpful material about basic management principles that could help producers survive bad economic times, Vasconcelos said.

Meeting to address application of DNA technology in beef cattle

The use of DNA technology in beef cattle will be addressed at a June 22 conference at the U.S. Meat Animal Research Center in Clay Center.

Producers, extension personnel and others who attend the free meeting will learn about the history of DNA technology in beef production, its current status and where it is headed, said Matt Spangler, University of Nebraska-Lincoln Extension beef genetics specialist.

For example, DNA technology currently is used to test whether animals carry genetic defects, Spangler said. DNA also can be used to get a glimpse of an animal's genetic potential for growth — a technology that is still developing, he said.

Speakers at the meeting include Spangler; Darrah Bullock, extension beef genetics specialist at the University of Kentucky; Alison Van Eenennaam, animal genomics and biotechnology extension specialist at the University of California-Davis; John Pollak, National Beef Cattle Evaluation Consortium director at Cornell University; and Mark Thallman, research scientist at the Meat Animal Research Center.

Multistate collaborative research on the use of DNA

technology in beef cattle will be discussed at the meeting, Spangler said.

The meeting will begin at noon with a lunch and end at 5 p.m. Attendees are asked to contact Spangler at

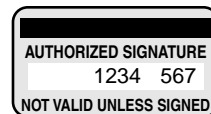

# Yard & Garden Tips

By Gregg Eyestone

## Poison Ivy Weed Control

Our plants have leafed out now and identification becomes easier. Hopefully, all your desirable plants made it through the dormant season. Perhaps a few undesirables have started to take off as well.

Early treatment is suggested. Poison ivy is an undesirable that most don't want in their landscape. On the plus side, the three leaflet leaves turn red in the fall. As long as you don't come in contact with any open poison ivy plant wounds, you shouldn't have a reaction. Several methods can be used to remove poison ivy and other weeds. All plants can be killed by continually removing the leaves and starving the plant. This will require persistence. Prune as low on the plant as possible and keep removing any new growth.

Protective clothing is particularly necessary for poison ivy since cutting it will expose the oily sap that causes the skin rash. Use lots and lots of cold water and soap to clean any exposed skin, clothing and tools.

Putting black plastic or a bucket over the plant is another way to get rid of it. This method will take a while but once in place won't need additional attention like the pruning method. It may take all summer to kill it.

The use of an herbicide is the quickest method of control. It can either be foliar applied or on some labels stump applied. Two commonly selected herbicides are triclopyr and glyphosate. Always read and carefully follow all di-

rections on the container label. You will then be using the product in its most safest and effective manner. If you have left-over pesticides, you may take them to the local household hazardous waste facility.

The Riley County site is at 6245 Tuttle Creek Boulevard. People may bring plant samples in to the Ex-

tension office for identification.

Some samples like poison ivy, a picture brought in or sent by email would be preferred by me. When a sample or picture doesn't work, the Extension agent can drop by and take a look.

# Initiative makes over \$1.5 million available in Kansas as part of EQIP; signup ends May 29

Speaking on May 5 to the USDA National Organic Standards Board (NOSB), Agriculture Deputy Secretary Kathleen Merrigan announced \$50 million for a new initiative to meet the Obama Administration's promise to encourage more organic agriculture production. Funding for the initiative is being made available as part of the Environmental Quality Incentives Program (EQIP).

According to Eric B. Banks, Kansas Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS) State Conservationist, Kansas received over \$1.5 million for the initiative. Applications received from organic producers or producers in transition to organic farming will be accepted under this initiative from May 11 through May 29.

Producers may still sign up for the Organic Initiative after May 29. However, applications received through May 29 will be ranked at that time and considered for funding.

Under the Organic Initiative required minimum core conservation practices will be determined by specific resource concerns. The practices are: Conservation Crop Rotation; Cover Crop; Nutrient Management; Pest Management; Prescribed Grazing; and Forage Harvest Management. States must consider using any appropriate practice that meets the resource concern on a particular operation. Ranking criteria has been established based on resource concerns that link to the NOP objectives and the core conservation practices.
