

RMA issues Fusarium Head Blight reminder

Spring 2009 weather has not been as conducive to the development of fusarium head blight, or head scab in the winter wheat crop as it was in 2008. Many wheat farmers, however, are not likely to forget last year's instances of head scab, which caused great difficulty for farmers trying to deliver wheat to the grain elevator during harvest.

Rebecca Davis, director of the Topeka regional office of USDA's Risk Management Agency, says that producers who carry multi-

peril crop insurance policies subsidized and reinsured by the Federal Crop Insurance Corporation may be eligible for quality loss adjustments if the reason for the loss in value is due to a covered event, such as this spring's excess precipitation.

"To protect your rights, it is imperative that you always report any damage in the required timeframes and seek advice from your insurance company before proceeding with harvest or destruction of the damaged

crop," Davis says. "Crop insurance policies require that farmers notify their company within 72 hours of noticing a loss. It is important that farmers be proactive in checking their fields to determine if there is any damage to the crop before harvest."

Quality adjustments are available for loss in value for conditions such as low test weight, damaged kernels, and shrunken or broken kernels. Discounts made for crop loss purposes may not be the same as

those seen at the elevator.

Any production of extremely poor quality wheat that has a value not located on the discount factor charts in the Special Provisions of Insurance ("off the discount

tables") is adjusted by taking the actual sale price based upon the Reduction In Value divided by the local market price to equal the discount factor for the production. "In the event

that the production has Zero-Market Value, RMA loss procedures require insurance providers to make every effort to find a market for the production before declaring a zero value.

Kansas Hay Market Report

Ground alfalfa movement: Southwest/South Central Tonnage: 10,995/3,854 Last week: 10,222/2,910 Last year: 12,451/4,340 Hay trade slow. Demand moderate to strong for dairy alfalfa, moderate for alfalfa pellets, grinding alfalfa and grass hay. Dry, warmer weather has returned to the entire state allowing swathing and baling to resume. Some dairy alfalfa was ruined by the rain early in the week. Most alfalfa is too far along to make dairy quality in the Southern half of the State. Producers continue to resist the lower prices offered. Dairies are trying to reduce losses and reach a breakeven point by lowering their feed costs. Reports of more Cheat grass than usual in Central Kansas will lower the demand from alfalfa grinders and pellet mills. Huge losses greet national dairy month

June Dairy Month marks the midpoint of 2009, a year that clearly will not be “kind” to dairy producers, said a University of Illinois Extension dairy specialist.

“Dairy managers are recording huge financial losses,” said Mike Hutjens. “Milk prices dropped nearly 40 percent starting last January, reaching less than \$12 per hundred pounds. The price was \$18 per hundredweight in December 2008.

“To cover all the costs of production—feed, non-feed, and labor—Illinois dairy farmers need \$16 to \$18 per

hundred pounds of milk produced, depending on herd size, debt load, labor efficiency, and feed costs.”

This year, from February to June, the average dairy farm with 105 cows is losing over \$10,000 each month, he noted.

“The reasons for these huge losses include a decline in foreign exports—11 percent of U.S. dairy products were exported in 2008, a stronger U.S. dollar which reduces exports while raising costs, a decline in the U.S. and world economies, and less dairy products being consumed as a result of reduced incomes and lost jobs,” he explained.

“To survive in the future, dairy producers need to aggressively pursue some basic goals, he said. “Minimize equity losses, review feeding programs using economical feed ingredients, produce high-quality milk leading to quality premiums, and maintain high milk yields,” said Hutjens. “Do not make ‘wrong’ decisions this summer such as postponing cow pregnancies or slowing heifer growth. These could result in long-term negative impacts in 2010.”

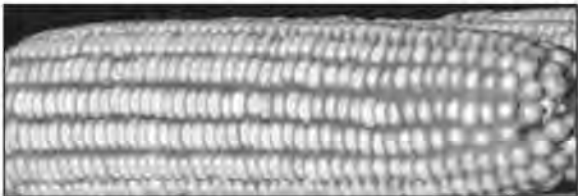

Schwieterman Market Outlook

A marketing commentary by Bret Crotts

The U.S. Dollar Index spent the first three trading days of last week trying to make a corrective bounce, but on Friday all of those gains were erased and the Dollar Index made new multi-month lows. The Dollar Index currently stands at 79.34 and a move down to the December low of 77.68 looks inevitable. If you look at the weekly chart, one gets the impression we will eventually revisit the 2008 low of 70.69 sometime in the next 6 to 9 months. Most of the first half of last year the Dollar Index was trading both sides of the 72.00 level, and that is also the same time many commodities were peaking out. A return to the 2008 lows in the Dollar Index would make a return to the 2008 highs in commodity markets more likely.

The corn finally moved through the resistance levels it had been fighting with for the past couple of weeks. The July corn made its highest close since the 7th of January and gained seven cents for the week. The December contract gained 7 1/4 cents.

I have been looking for a move up to the January highs, \$4.49 1/4 in July and \$4.71 3/4 in December, for quite some time and we are almost there. The \$4.70 area is going to be a good place to make a few sales of new crop corn and milo, but you don't want to get beyond 35-40% sold at this time because it could be a very explosive summer.

There is more talk of acres being switched from corn to soybeans, which, if it happens, is very friendly to prices and downright bullish if we have any kind of drought scare in the Corn Belt. There is also the fact that export sales are still doing well and that there is a chance that USDA may have to raise the old crop export estimate again at some point. It will not be hard to get ending stocks estimates to fall below 1 billion bushels and if that is the case we aren't going to see much weakness in the corn this summer.

I continue to be surprised by the fact that wheat is leading the way higher right now. Both world and US stocks levels are plentiful and export sales are still poor, which makes the leadership role of the wheat a little hard to understand. However, it is important to realize that the trend is up and funds are buying more and there is no point in standing in the way of the market.

The July KW reached my objective of \$6.90 - \$7.00, traded at the highest level since early October, and gained 26 1/2 cents for the week. What's next? The market is overbought and due for a correction, but it can stay that way for a long time. With the bullish fundamental set up in the corn and the increased talk of crop problems in S. Central Kansas, corrections will likely be shallow and short lived until we get a better

handle on crop size. From a technical perspective a close above \$7.00 would point to a move up to the \$7.60 area.

The July soybeans gained 18 cents last week, which isn't bad, but the November gained 31 1/2 cents. It feels like the soybeans are running out of steam a little bit, but with the export pace still strong and with the likelihood of another cut in ending stocks in the June crop report, it is hard to be negative. Export sales were only 237,400 MT in the old crop, but that was enough to put us over the yearly estimate.

The July contract basically stalled out at the \$12.00 level. That is just a little short of the \$12.25 objective, but it makes sense to have that round number resistance. I think we will still see the \$12.25 eventually and you have more traders talking about the possibility of \$13.25 as well. As for the November contract we have moved through the resistance at \$10.40 and are closing in on the next objective of \$10.80. A close above \$10.80 will make \$11.70 the next objective.

The bull spreads obviously didn't work last week, which is a little disturbing, and the spread chart looks like we could have a deeper correction. One theory about the spreads was that funds were rolling positions from July to November and that was the reason for the weakness. So, with exports

still strong and the threat of corn acres shifting to soybeans, once the fund rolling comes to an end the bull spreads should get back on track.

Cattle and hogs didn't perform very well last week. We had lower cash cattle trade at \$84, choice beef lost \$1.62, and the August LC lost \$1.95. The August LC dropped back to long term support, so I suppose we won't see much more weakness from here. In fact I would guess we will start next week on a firm basis.

August feeders were weaker as well, but only lost a few cents. The trend in the feeder cattle is still up, but the market is overbought, so a correction is due.

On feed numbers are down, which makes slaugh-

ter fall below year ago levels, which means beef production is below a year ago, which means we should have good support and good potential for strength in the cattle market, but we just aren't seeing it. I am cautiously optimistic in the sense that I don't recommend hedges at these levels, but at the same time upside potential feels like it is still limited. The cattle market lacks enthusiasm and I am not sure what it needs to get that back.

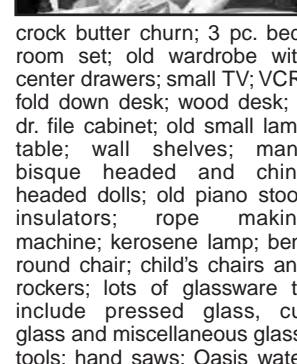

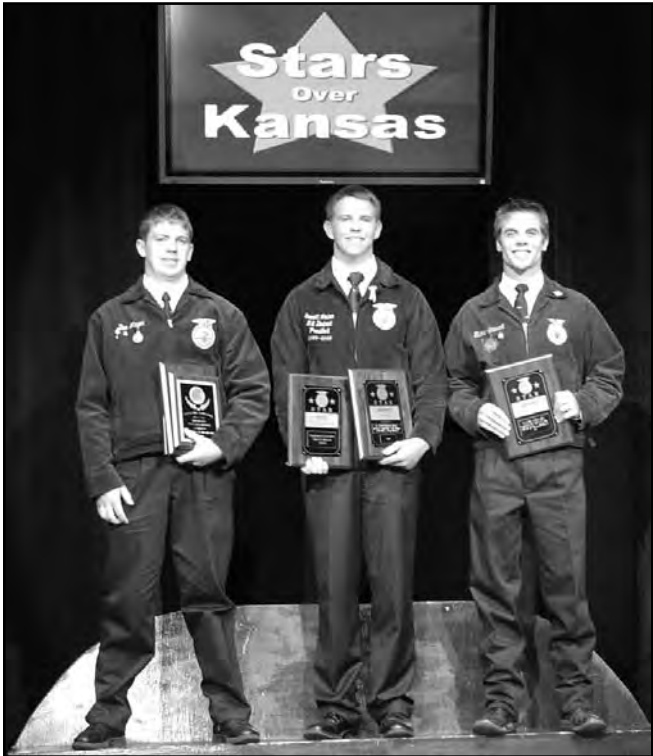
