

Kansas Hay Market Report

Hay trade slow. Demand moderate to strong for dairy alfalfa, moderate for alfalfa pellets, grinding alfalfa and grass hay. Unsettled weather has remained over the entire state interfering with the curing and baling of alfalfa and brome. The first cutting of alfalfa is about finished and some second will begin next week, most second is a week away.

Alfalfa producers continue to resist the lower prices offered. Dairies are trying to reduce losses and reach a breakeven point by lowering their feed costs. Higher grain prices have increased the price of protein supplements making alfalfa a bargain.

Southwest Kansas: Dairy and grinding alfalfa steady. Movement slow. Alfalfa, Horse, small squares, 230.00-250.00; Dairy, 75-80 cents/point RFV, Premium to Supreme 130.00-140.00, or 140.00-155.00 delivered; Premium 120.00-130.00, alfalfa standing for haylage 95.00-105.00 (dried to

15%-0% moisture). Utility-Fair grinding at the edge of the field, 100.00-110.00, mostly 100.00-105.00, an instance 95.00 for immediate pickup. Ground and delivered locally to feedlots and dairies 120.00-130.00, ground-on-the-truck 118.00-123.00. The week of 5/25-30, 10,636T grinding alfalfa and 1,516T of dairy alfalfa were delivered. Wheat hay, good large rounds 60.00-65.00. Oat hay, good small squares 125.00. The average paid by feedlots on June 1 for alfalfa ground and delivered was 153.62, down 9.54 from last month, usage was 1,099T/day, down 1% total usage was 34,071T.

Alfalfa, Dairy, 65-80 cents/point RFV, Premium to Supreme, 130.00-140.00, an instance 160.00; Premium 115.00-130.00; Good 90.00. Utility-Fair grinding alfalfa at the edge of the field 80.00-90.00. Ground and delivered locally to feedlots 100.00-116.00. The week of 5/25-30, 2,735T of grinding alfalfa and 1,956T of dairy alfalfa were delivered. Alfalfa pellets: Sun Cured 15% protein 160.00-175.00; Sun Cured 17% 170.00-183.00; Dehydrated 15% 210.00 and 17% 220.00. The average paid by feedlots on June 1 for alfalfa ground and delivered was 127.22, down 10 cents from last

month, usage was 270T/day, down 12%, total usage was 8,373T.

Schwieterman Market Outlook

A marketing commentary by Bret Crotts

We had a wild week. Most of the time it felt like the direction of the Dollar Index was controlling the direction of the grain markets. Lots of times there is an inverse relationship between the Dollar and the grains, but it seemed to be especially true last week. Last week the cash Dollar Index fell to just above the December low where it should have found support, and did. The Dollar Index then bounced off the support and is in the process of making a correction. There is little indication at this time that we are going to see a change in the long term trend of the US Dollar, which is down, but we are due for a correction and it looks like we are getting one.

Wednesday is the June supply and demand report. It is hard to guess what

changes we may see in the June report since we have the June acreage report at the end of the month. Acreage changes in the June supply and demand report are uncommon, but they do happen. This year it is possible that we will see a cut in corn acreage and an increase in soybean acreage due to the planting problems we have seen this year. Last year USDA cut the corn yield estimate by 5 bu/ac from the May to the June report dropping it to 148.9. This year we are starting out at 155.4, and although this was adjusted down due to slow planting progress, we may see a cut in the yield estimate in this week's report.

On the demand side we could see an increase in the export estimate for old crop corn and soybeans. It will be particularly interesting to

see what they do with the soybean export estimate and how tight the ending stocks estimate is. I think it is too early to see any new crop demand changes unless we see a major change in the new crop production estimates.

A cut in the wheat production estimate is possible since we have seen a decline in the HRW and SRW condition ratings and the planting problems in the HRS region. There probably won't be any wheat demand changes this time around.

Organization says bill moving could threaten industry

Senate bill 787, the Clean Water Restoration Act (CWRA), which was recently introduced in the U.S. Senate, is a threat to cattle producers and ranchers across the country.

The Kansas Cattlemen's Association (KCA) is opposing this bill to help protect farmers and ranchers and their private property rights. The purpose of the CWRA is to change the wording "navigable waters of the U.S." to "waters of the U.S."

The word "waters" is widely defined by the bill but includes any natural pond, stream, interstate and intrastate river and reservoir. This bill would then allow the government to regulate any body of water and the activities affecting these waters.

KCA is concerned with this bill because it would allow the government to control private property rights by placing

regulations on private land owner ponds and streams. If governmental departments, who do not understand agriculture, believe that if producers are not meeting their standards, the government can regulate producers right out of business.

"Kansas Cattlemen's Association contacted both Senator Roberts and Senator Brownback regarding cattlemen's concerns of this bill. As it's more about allowing the EPA to invade producers' property private rights than restoring clean water, KCA expressed the importance of opposing this bill. We were very pleased with the conversation with our legislative offices and hope that our Senators will vote no on S.787. Kansas cattlemen expect our elected officials to support the Kansas producers who grow our nations safe and wholesome food supply," remarked KCA Executive Director, Brandy Carter.



Kansas hosting National Festival of Breads

Kansas has long been known as “The Wheat State,” and when the National Festival of Breads gets underway June 15-17, we’ll be known as “The Bread State,” too.

The inaugural event, co-sponsored by Kansas Wheat and the King Arthur Flour Company, features outstanding amateur bread recipes from eight finalists from across the nation.

The eight will compete in four categories — Ethnic Breads, Rolls, Time Saving and Easy Breads and Whole Grain Breads — for a Grand Prize featuring \$2,000 in cash and an expense-paid trip to the King Arthur Flour Baking Education Center in Norwich, Vermont.

The eight finalists and their breads are:

Whole Grain Category: Marjorie Johnson, Robbinsdale, Minnesota; “ABC Wheat Bread,” Jan Galloway, Columbia, Missouri; “Mom’s Best Hearty Wheat Bread.”

Ethnic Category: Dianna Wara, Washington, Illinois; “Tomato, Basil, Garlic Filled Pane Bianco,” Nikki Norman, Milton, Tennessee; “Spiced Cranberry Lemon Danish.”

Time Saving and Easy: Jessie Grearson, Falmouth, Maine; “Sweet Life Sweet Potato Focaccia,” Tanna Richard, Cedar Rapids, Iowa; “Healthy Homemade Bread.”

Rolls: Judy Reynolds, Bloomington, Indiana; “Cranberry and Lemonade Cream Rolls,” Gloria Piantek, West Lafayette, Indiana; “Bacon Onion Baby Brioche.”

Finalists were determined by reviewing more than 500 recipes submitted to Kansas Wheat and King Arthur Flour, through the Internet. A panel of judges narrowed these submissions to just more than 100 recipes, which were test-baked. These were then taste-sampled by a panel of judges.

“We were pleased at the number of home bakers who entered from across the United States. We had bakers from nearly every state,” says Kansas Wheat Commission Nutrition Educator Cindy Falk, contest coordinator.

On June 17, the Festival is open to the public, with several free events, including:

Baking Sessions. Featuring Paula Gray, King Arthur Flour and Sharon Davis, Home Baking Association, these sessions begin at 9 a.m. and 10:30 a.m. and are repeated at 1 p.m. and 2:30 p.m. Each session is 60 minutes long. Gray’s topic is “Bread 101.”

Davis will focus on “A Baker’s Dozen Breads from One.” “Expand your yeast bread skills to include the art and science of substitutions and additions to a basic yeast dough. We’ll demonstrate how bakers include multiple whole grain flours, milk, cheeses, vegetables, and more for delicious variety breads,” says Davis, Home Baking Association staff member and Family and Consumer Sciences teacher.

Multiple organizations and business will have displays at the Festival of Breads “Mini Trade Show.”

Also, several artists will have displays, too, including the Kansas Association of Straw Artists and potters Steve and Jayne Frye and Carl Brothers. Finally, the Oklahoma Wheat Commission will prepare and bake fresh bread on-site, sharing samples with attendees.

Urban Wheat Field. Attendees at the National Festival of Breads will have the opportunity to walk through a miniature “Urban Wheat Field,” which will have wheat plants in various stages of growth with educational displays to explain how wheat gets from the field to your plate.

The National Festival of Breads finalists will prepare their bread recipes in

miniature test kitchens inside the Wichita Airport Hilton Ballroom, during the Festival. Attendees will have the chance to interact with contestants at this time. All Festival activities are free and open to the public; however, attendees are asked to bring a non-perishable, canned food item for donation to the Kansas Foodbank Warehouse in Wichita.

The doors open to the public at 7:30 a.m. and the Festival is finished at 4 p.m.

At that time, a panel of judges will begin bread evaluation. An awards banquet, recognizing the winners, begins at 7 p.m.

Ants soon to be marching, marching

Solitary scout ants have already started this spring's search for food and water.

Lines of ants will soon follow. They'll be marching along a chemical trail laid by a scout from their colony, marking the way to a good find. Their target may very well be a home or restaurant kitchen.

"Some homeowners make a real effort to notice any scout ants that appear inside their house. Their aim is to smash each one before it has a chance to get back to the home nest. Apparently, that sometimes works," said Ward Upham horticulturist with Kansas State University Research and Extension.

Once a line of ants appears, control can still be direct if someone is able to trace that line back to a nest. Spraying the nest with a properly labeled insecticide quickly takes care of the problem, Upham said.

"Unfortunately, ant nests typically are outside, not in some human structure. And, those nests can be extremely difficult to find," he said. Trying to keep ants from coming indoors isn't very practical, either. "Ants are so small that you're highly unlikely to be able to find and caulk all of their potential entry points," Upham said. "Treating their trails can sometimes provide tem-

porary relief. Normally, though, it won't work long term because the ants will simply find another way in."

Other than calling an exterminator, this leaves just two control options — sanitation and baits.

"Ants use the most easily accessible food sources," Upham said. "That's why eliminating their access to crumbs, grease, scraps and other foods helps to discourage invasions. It's also why baits can work — especially since the ants will take some of the toxic food home for their queen and colony members."

Most ant baits now come pre-packaged in a child-

and pet-resistant "station." They're slow-acting enough to allow worker ants time to return to the nest — extra bait in jaws or claws — before finally dying, he said. But, not all ants are attracted to the same bait. So, people may have to try more than one product.

Yard & Garden Tips

Multi-Tasking Nut Trees

A native tree that does well in most of Kansas is the black walnut. Dad introduced them to the property some thirty years ago. Since they produce nuts now, they come up like weeds in many places. They have their pros and cons like all plants.

Walnut trees have several uses. Their nuts can be used for food, just ask a squirrel. Generally, a selected variety is grafted on to a rootstock to produce the best nuts. The wood is used for many purposes such as furniture and cabinets. Our walnut trees have been used for firewood and shade.

leopathic chemical called juglone that is toxic to certain plants. Injury is greatest when there is direct contact between the walnut roots and the roots of susceptible plants.

Symptoms of toxicity include the wilting of terminal shoots, poor flower development, the wilting of the entire plant and death. Research shows that xylem cells are damaged in the susceptible plants reducing the flow of water in the plant. Butternut, shagbark hickory and other walnut related trees can affect susceptible plants.

Tree roots extend many times out from the trunk. This has made for some challenges in plant selection for the rest of the landscape.

Highly susceptible ornamental plants like lilacs, peonies, cotoneaster and conifers need to be well away from the walnut tree. Apple and pear trees, tomatoes, peppers, potatoes, cabbage and most berries are affected. Black raspberries are tolerant.
