Schwieterman Market Outlook

A marketing commentary by Bret Crotts

We had a wild week. Most of the time it felt like the direction of the Dollar Index was controlling the direction of the grain markets. Lots of times there is an inverse relationship between the Dollar and the grains, but it seemed to be especially true last week. Last week the cash Dollar Index fell to just above the December low where it should have found support, and did. The Dollar Index then bounced off the support and is in the process of making a correction. There is little indication at this time that we are going to see a change in the long term trend of the US Dollar, which is down, but we are due for a correction and it looks like we are getting one.

Wednesday is the June supply and demand report. It is hard to guess what

changes we may see in the June report since we have the June acreage report at the end of the month. Acreage changes in the June supply and demand report are uncommon, but they do happen. This year it is possible that we will see a cut in corn acreage and an increase in soybean acreage due to the planting problems we have seen this year. Last year USDA cut the corn yield estimate by 5 bu/ac from the May to the June report dropping it to 148.9. This year we are starting out at 155.4, and although this was adjusted down due to slow planting progress, we may see a cut in the yield estimate in this week's report.

On the demand side we could see an increase in the export estimate for old crop corn and soybeans. It will be particularly interesting to

see what they do with the soybean export estimate and how tight the ending stocks estimate is. I think it is too early to see any new crop demand changes unless we see a major change in the new crop production estimates.

A cut in the wheat production estimate is possible since we have seen a decline in the HRW and SRW condition ratings and the planting problems in the HRS region. There probably won't be any wheat demand changes this time around.

Organization says bill moving could threaten industry

Senate bill 787, the Clean Water Restoration Act (CWRA), which was recently introduced in the U.S. Senate, is a threat to cattle producers and ranchers across the country.

The Kansas Cattlemen's Association (KCA) is opposing this bill to help protect farmers and ranchers and their private property rights. The purpose of the CWRA is to change the wording "navigable waters of the U.S." to "waters of the U.S."

The word "waters" is widely defined by the bill but includes any natural pond, stream, interstate and intrastate river and reservoir. This bill would then allow the government to regulate any body of water and the activities affecting these waters.

KCA is concerned with this bill because it would allow the government to control private property rights by placing regulations on private land owner ponds and streams. If governmental departments, who do not understand agriculture, believe that if producers are not meeting their standards, the government can regulate producers right out of business.

"Kansas Cattlemen's Association contacted both Senator Roberts and Senator Brownback regarding cattlemen's concerns of this bill. As it's more about allowing the EPA to invade producers' property private rights than restoring clean water, KCA expressed the importance of opposing this bill. We were very pleased with the conversation with our legislative offices and hope that our Senators will vote no on S.787. Kansas cattlemen expect our elected officials to support the Kansas producers who grow our nations safe and wholesome food supply," remarked KCA Executive Director, Brandy Carter.



When there are children, she wants their ideas of gift-giving to be respected and in line with family priorities. Grandparents need to check out their ideas with the younger couple before giving a major gift. Grandparents need to be aware of their expectations regarding visits with the grandchildren.

She wants to feel supported in her efforts to

Accept your son's marriage as permanent and support their marriage. Relate to them as a couple. Give up your special bond with your son.

Be patient. They may need time to work on their own autonomy and identity. share holidays and special Be clear in your expectations on what you want in the way of family events and visits. Negotiate and be accepting of their decisions. Be friendly, hospitable and let them set the tone for how much closeness they would like. Avoid guilt trips.

Stand back and let the new family come to you with problems or advice. Be slow to comment on their affairs unless they encourage discussion. Even then, be a good listener. Don't be quick to give advice that they might resent. Keep your doubts and criticisms private.

Define your own boundaries when you feel they are taking you for granted. Make sure the business partnership is working well and talk over work conflicts in a business-like manner. A regular family business meeting is the best vehicle for working out normal business conflicts and keeping them separate from family dis-

Ants soon to be marching, march

Solitary scout ants have already started this spring's search for food and water.

Lines of ants will soon follow. They'll be marching along a chemical trail laid by a scout from their colony, marking the way to a good find. Their target may very well be a home or restaurant

"Some homeowners make a real effort to notice any scout ants that appear inside their house. Their aim is to smash each one before it has a chance to get back to the home nest. Apparently, that sometimes works," said Ward Upham horticulturist with Kansas State University Research and Extension.

Once a line of ants appears, control can still be direct if someone is able to trace that line back to a nest. Spraying the nest with a properly labeled insecticide quickly takes care of the problem, Upham said.

"Unfortunately, ant nests typically are outside, not in some human structure. And, those nests can be extremely difficult to find," he said. Trying to keep ants from coming indoors isn't very practical, either. "Ants are so small that you're highly unlikely to be able to find and caulk all of their potential entry points," Upham said. "Treating their trails can sometimes provide temporary relief. Normally, though, it won't work long term because the ants will simply find another way in."

Other than calling an exterminator, this leaves just two control options - sanitation and baits.

"Ants use the most easily accessible food sources," Upham said. "That's why eliminating their access to crumbs, grease, scraps and other foods helps to discourage invasions. It's also why baits can work — especially since the ants will take some of the toxic food home for their queen and colony members."

Most ant baits now come pre-packaged in a childand pet-resistant "station." They're slow-acting enough to allow worker ants time to return to the nest — extra bait in jaws or claws — before finally dying, he said. But, not all ants are attracted to the same bait. So, people may have to try more than one product.



Yard & Garden Tips By Gregg Eyestone

Multi-Tasking Nut Trees

A native tree that does well in most of Kansas is the black walnut. Dad introduced them to the property some thirty years ago. Since they produce nuts now, they come up like weeds in many

places. They have their pros and cons like all plants.

Walnut trees have several uses. Their nuts can be used for food, just ask a squirrel. Generally, a selected variety is grafted on

to a rootstock to produce the best nuts. The wood is used for many purposes such as furniture and cabinets. Our walnut trees have been used for firewood and

If you have an interest in walnut trees consider participating in the Walnut Council Field Day on Thursday, June 11. Registration begins at 9 AM. Dress for being out in the walnut grove located south of Tuttle Creek Dam near Manhattan. Cost is \$12 which includes lunch. Pre-register by calling (785) 484-2509.

Black walnut trees can inhibit growth of other plants. Tomatoes don't cohabitate well with black walnuts. The roots of the black walnut produce an allelopathic chemical called juglone that is toxic to certain plants. Injury is greatest when there is direct contact between the walnut roots and the roots of susceptible plants.

Symptoms of toxicity include the wilting of terminal shoots, poor flower development, the wilting of the entire plant and death. Research shows that xylem cells are damaged in the susceptible plants reducing the flow of water in the plant. Butternut, shagbark hickory and other walnut related trees can affect susceptible plants.

Tree roots extend many times out from the trunk. This has made for some challenges in plant selection for the rest of the land-

Highly susceptible ornamental plants like lilacs, peonies, cotoneaster and conifers need to be well away from the walnut tree. Apple and pear trees, tomatoes, peppers, potatoes, cabbage and most berries are affected. Black raspberries are tolerant.
