Ground alfalfa movement: Southwest/South Central Tonnage: 11,188/3,438 Last week: 10,636/2,735 Last year: 12,993/3,378 Hay trade slow. Demand moderate to strong for dairy alfalfa, moderate for alfalfa pellets, grinding alfalfa and grass hay. Unsettled weather has remained over the entire state interfering with the curing and baling of alfalfa and brome, wind and hail have damaged some crops. The first cutting of alfalfa is about finished and the second will begin as soon as the weather will allow. The market is basically dead, with most hay trading on an as needed basis. Dairies are looking for quality alfalfa, but will not pay the high asking prices. Meeting will tell dairy producers how to cut feed costs by letting cows graze

Dairy cows that eat more grass in the pasture will eat less processed feed in the milking parlor. That cuts feed costs and makes the milk check go further.

Speakers at the second Missouri Dairy Grazing Conference will explain theory and practice of pasture-based dairies, July 8-10 at Joplin, Mo.

"This is for dairy producers who want to graze in the U.S.," said Joe Horner, University of Missouri Extension dairy economist.

The program features MU Extension specialists in forage, economics, nutrient management and dairy. However, dairy producers will present a big part of the program, Horner said.

"The program features dairy producers from Missouri and New Zealand," he said. "Farmers like to hear the practical experience of other farmers."

Typically, grazing dairy operators divide their farms into pasture paddocks using electric fences. The milking herd is moved to a fresh paddock after each milking, morning and night.

Producers measure grass growth and enter the data into software that calculates a "grazing wedge," which producers use to decide which paddock is best for grazing next.

The first grazing conference, held at Monett, Mo., in 2006, attracted 200 people.

The program opens with an optional tour of the dairy grazing farm at the University of Missouri Southwest Center, Mt. Vernon, starting at 9 a.m., July 8. The formal program begins at 1 p.m. in Joplin.

Randy Mooney, a Missouri grazing-dairy producer and chair of the National Milk Producers Federation, will open the program with "Redesigning our Dairy Industry."

Later that afternoon, Charles Fletcher, a grazing-dairy producer, Purdy, Mo., will explain how he designed his grazing system. Since switching to grazing from conventional dairying, he has doubled and redoubled his milking herd.

Tony Rickard, MU Extension regional dairy specialist in Monett, said producers must shift their focus when going to a pasture-based dairy. "The main management decisions relate to grass. A philosophy we learned in New Zealand is, 'Take care of the grass and the cows will take care of themselves.'"

Two optional tours with two farms on each tour will be held after the conference. Maps will be distributed at the meeting.

The registration fee is \$150 in advance or \$175 at the door. Participants are encouraged to sign up before June 24 to assist tour planners. The Missouri Dairy Association will reimburse its members \$100.

The fee includes all talks, a dinner and reception on the first day, and

lunch on the second day. Buses will take attendees to two area farms during the conference.

A book of proceedings will be available later for \$25.

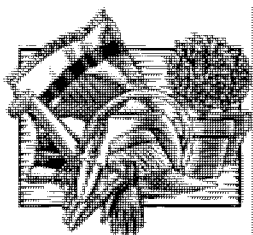

Yard & Garden Tips

Herbicides for Weed Control

The Riley County Extension Master Gardeners organized another wonderful "Garden Tour." Thanks to everyone that made it possible. It is an annual event that is enjoyed by many. I didn't see a weed anywhere. Weeds are one of the most common occurrences in any garden.

Little barley, crown vetch, cattails, crabgrass, foxtail, bindweed, bermudagrass, rough bluegrass and seeds of others unwanted plants appear in the landscape. Suffocation, cultiva-

tion and herbicides are tools to reduce weeds. Grassy weed herbicides include Sethoxydim and Fluzifop. These products work on existing weeds when they are young. They are commonly used on iris beds to manage crabgrass and bermudagrass. With all pesticides, you need to read and follow the label directions.

Many have called me about controlling crown vetch. That is the plant used to hold the soil in place at road cuts. Products contain-

ing 2,4, D or other active ingredients for broadleaf control should work if labeled. Bindweed and dandelions are also managed with these products. Be careful that it is not windy when applying these and all herbicides to avoid drift. High temperatures can cause drift as well so follow the product directions.

Glyphosate, the active ingredient in Roundup and many other products will stop the growth of most plants. The product, Rodeo is used on cattails. Ber-

mudagrass, bindweed, poison ivy and others are often treated with glyphosate.

Trifluralin is an active ingredient used to keep annual weeds from getting started. It is found in the product Preen and others. Read all product labels for safe use. The weed you want to control needs to be listed as well as on the plant you

are using it around. There are many more herbicides available for weed management. It takes several approaches to keep plants from trying to do what they want to do. Grow! Mulches that suffocate weeds, a sharp weeder and herbicides will quickly keep weeds down so you have more time to enjoy the garden.

Grasshopper crop has arrived, few options available

This year's grasshoppers have hatched. They don't have wings and look like tiny versions of their parents. But, they're still so small that most yard and garden owners have yet to notice.

"Depending on the weather, the nymphs usually have grown to about 3/16-inch long by early to mid June," said Bob Bauernfeind, entomologist with Kansas State University Research and Extension. "That's when you're likely to see them only if you notice small holes in garden plant leaves and then examine the damaged plants more closely, looking for nymphs."

Scouting for an invasion can be a good idea. The

smaller and younger grasshoppers are, the easier they are to control, Bauernfeind said, adding: "When they mature, grasshoppers have a tough exoskeleton (hard shell) that serves as a barrier against the penetration of insecticides. That really reduces the effectiveness of control efforts." Active insecticide ingredients that are proven grasshopper controls include carbaryl,

cyfluthrin, esfenvalerate, lambda-cyhalothrin and permethrin.

These options translate into a wide array of effective products now available.

"With food crops, you'll need to make note of and observe your selected product's instructions about post-treatment harvest in-

tervals," he said. "For your garden as a whole, you'll need to remember that you may have to spray more than once if grasshoppers continue moving into your garden."

Marketed in Kansas under the tradenames Nolo BaitTM and SemasporeTM, today's "organically accept-

able" grasshopper controls contain the spores of the protozoan Nosema locustae. This natural pesticide ingredient has proven to be slow-acting but effective, if used under the right conditions.

"The problem is: These organic products were de-

signed for use in treating rangeland — large acreages — as a long-term control strategy. They're basically for use in and around grasshopper hatching sites. Homeowners may not be able to achieve comparable results," Bauernfeind said.

Weekly report shows most crop progress on par

In the weekly crop update provided by the Kansas Agriculture Statistics Service, fifty-five percent of the wheat is turning color, compared to 38 percent last year and 68 percent for the 5-year average. Two percent is considered ripe for harvest, compared to 5 percent last year and 15 percent for the 5-year average.

The wheat condition is rated as 5 percent very poor, 12 percent poor, 35 percent fair, 41 percent good, and 7 percent excellent. Insect infestation of the wheat crop is rated as 73 percent none, 23 percent light, 3 percent moderate, and 1 percent severe.

Disease infestation is rated as 50 percent none, 34 percent light, 14 percent moderate, and 2 percent severe. Ninety-five percent of the corn has emerged, compared to 94 percent last year and 97 percent for the 5-year average. Corn condition is rated as 1 percent very poor, 6 percent poor, 30 percent fair, 50 percent good, and 13 percent excellent.

Sixty-one percent of the sorghum has been planted, compared to 38 percent the previous year and 57 percent for the 5-year average. Twenty-six percent has emerged, compared to 18 percent for the previous year and 34 percent for the 5-year average. Sorghum condition is rated as 2 percent poor, 19 percent fair, 74 percent good, and 5 percent excellent.

Seventy-three percent of soybeans have been planted, compared to 60 percent last year and 74 percent for the 5-year average. Fifty percent have emerged, compared to 46 percent the previous year and 56 percent for the 5-year average. Soybean condition is rated as 2 percent poor, 27 percent fair, 64 percent good, and 7 percent excellent. Thirty percent of the sunflowers have been planted, the same as the previous year but 10 points behind the 5-year average of 40 percent. Twelve

percent have emerged, compared to 7 percent the previous year and 19 percent for the 5-year average.

Seventy-seven percent of the cotton is planted, compared to 86 percent the previous year and 68 percent

for the 5-year average.

Eighty-eight percent of the first cutting of alfalfa has been completed, compared to 80 percent the previous year and 87 percent for the 5-year average. Feed Supplies Report: Range and

pasture condition is rated as 2 percent very poor, 5 percent poor, 25 percent fair, 59 percent good, and 9 percent excellent. Feed grain supplies were rated as 7 percent short, 92 percent adequate, and 1 percent surplus.

Stock water supplies were estimated as 6 percent

short, 87 percent adequate, and 7 percent surplus. Precipitation this past week was moderate and widespread.

Producers averaged 5.4 days suitable for fieldwork. Topsoil moisture is rated as

2 percent very short, 22 percent short, 73 percent adequate, and 3 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture is rated as 2 percent very short, 16 percent short, 78 percent adequate, and 4 percent surplus.

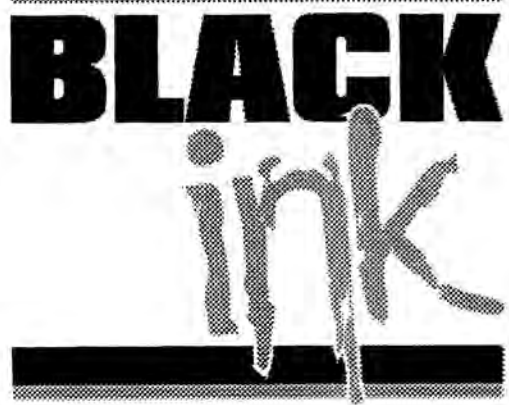

## Why "trade down?"

Demand for beef is down. Can you blame the recession? Not entirely, but it's a darned inconvenient coincidence.

It's hard to argue that beef quality was too low, because production of every class of premium beef has been trending up for some time.

The supply of Choice beef in particular has increased for six years, and at an increasing rate, especially in the last two years. In concert with that, supplies of Select beef declined in quantity and total value.

Beef industry observers don't understand why beef quality turned sharply higher in 2008, and because the greater supply was unexpected, our multi-billion-dollar industry could not ad-

just quickly enough in the short run.

With a huge share of business locked up in contracts that reflect expectations, it takes many months for the rudder to deploy, let alone turn the ship. Those reactions were slowed by economic panic, especially in the foodservice sector.

They were also muffled by deployment of other rudders.

For more than a decade, the beef industry has worked to add value to the previously underutilized chuck, the front portion of every carcass. First came the teres major and flat iron steaks; as their popularity grew, the industry followed with another round of discoveries such as the Denver steak, ranch steak and country-style ribs.

More packing plants and processors began to break down the chuck to supply this demand.

As restaurateurs saw options beyond the middle meats, those strips, rib-eyes and filet mignons, chefs who never bought anything from the chuck started buying a lot of the new "value cuts," especially in premium Choice and Prime, with their inherent safety net of superior marbling.

This strategy has been a key to the upper tiers of beef quality maintaining stronger demand. A rancher might check the Choice-Select spread to monitor demand for quality, but that number — lately quite small — does not reflect the stronger demand for higher quality most of which has been sorted off to premium brand markets.

Gradually, the beef industry's campaign to build demand for the new chuck cuts have helped train meat buyers and consumers to "trade down," especially during times of financial pressure. There's evidence that shoppers may trade down to a

value cut, or even ground beef, within their premium quality brand, rather than switch to a lower grade overall. Of course, others trade all the way down to chicken or pork, but the beef value cuts have helped hold the line.

The recession is still the dominant factor, and it can't last in the long run. In better times, the middle meats will regain their value and the whole beef animal will be worth a lot more.

The market just needs time to regain equilibrium.

It makes little sense to argue that we have too much high-quality beef, if we are serious about regaining that demand. Consumers' taste buds have not changed.

A new wave of retailers is moving up to allow their customers to buy beef of Choice or higher quality. Foodservice operators recovering from the recession will see no future in the inconsistency of Select beef as they welcome back old customers and try to win new ones.

Producers must look beyond the less-relevant

Choice-Select spread today, and realize there is no market signal to back away from quality. The cost/price squeeze is calling for greater efficiency, and you can move ahead there in tandem with quality goals. If your cattle are too small, you can easily change that, but keep in mind that selection for efficiency tends to result in smaller cows.

Every sector of this economy features competing messages and analyses, but if you cut to the bottom line, it's always about value. Look at any selection or

management changes that can add long-term value with uniformity and predictability. Choose replacements from your most efficient cows and restrict their breeding season to a few weeks that best fit least-cost production.

Cull for disposition to save labor and equipment costs, and develop a herd that's easy to lead where you want to go. If you are already on track to produce high-quality beef that's still supported by the bedrock of consumer demand, why would you trade down?

# Schwieterman Market Outlook

A marketing commentary by Bret Crotts

The June supply and demand report wasn't too shocking, but it did have some important information. There weren't many changes from last month, so the change in the corn yield estimate was by far the most important change that USDA made. The cut from 155.4 to 153.4 put the current yield estimate below last year's final number of 153.9. I was glad to see that they didn't make too drastic of a cut since they really over did it last year in the June report. The second most important feature of the report was the fact that there were no changes to either corn or soybean acreage.

That wasn't a surprise, but what it means is that traders will be anticipating changes in the June Acreage report, which comes out on the 30th. With the problems that we had with planting it is hard to imagine that there won't be some adjustments, and most likely that means few corn and more soybean acres. If that is the case we could see some very tight corn ending stocks figures in the July supply and demand report.

The other interesting "no change" was the old crop corn export estimate. Export sales have been strong enough that another increase was possible in the June report, but it didn't happen. I think that increases the likelihood that we will see the estimate bumped up in the July report. If that happens, it will only make the new crop ending stocks tighter. It is very easy to put together an extremely bullish supply and demand scenario for the corn without making any drastic changes. Just a couple small adjustments make our supplies very tight.

The wheat numbers were the most bearish since most traders were looking

for new crop ending stocks to shrink, but instead they grew by 10 million to 647 million. There was a 10 million bushel cut in production, but there was also a 20 million bushel cut in feed usage. I am beginning to think we will see further cuts in production, but I need to see some yield results in Kansas to be sure. The problem is that production is not the problem with our supply and demand situation.

Demand is still not good enough to create any kind of excitement in the marketplace. If the current estimates prove to be accurate, we are only going to see a very small decrease in ending stocks even with lower acreage and a lower yield than last year. That indicates the wheat market can give up even more acres next year and tight supplies still won't be a concern if we have a "normal" yield.

Last week's market movement in the corn was pretty typical of what we see when a report comes out just like expected. The report was bullish, but the fact that it was anticipated and the corn failed to quickly make a new high for the move led to profit taking and a selloff. Friday's sharply lower close was probably little more than frustrated bulls bailing out of long positions.

It is likely that we see more weakness this week, but if you take a long term view of the market, this is probably just a bull market correction. Generally in the price discovery process, the market will trend higher until we get a firm handle on what crop size will be. Right now crop size and ending stocks estimates are trending lower, which means price will likely continue trending higher until that changes.

Look for more corrective

activity this week. The \$4.40 level may prove to be very good support in the December contract, but a move down to the \$4.25 level is likely. The July KW nearly completed a 62% retracement of the last leg up. That indicates to me that the wheat has the best chance of moving higher this week.

The fundamentals aren't that great, but we have seen a deep correction and if there are poor yield reports out of Kansas this week, traders may take a shot at buying wheat. I would use this break as an opportunity to by a September call against any forward priced wheat. I want to make more cash sales on a move over the \$7.00 level.

It still looks like the July soybeans have a good shot at reaching the \$13.25 level. The market is very overbought and we have had two weeks in a row of net cancellations of old crop export sales, but the July soybeans were still higher for the week and the bull spreads still worked. Sales are being rolled forward to the new crop because of the wide price spread and also perhaps because of lack of availability, so it isn't like the business is disappearing, it is just being moved forward. The old crop ending stocks estimates keep shrinking because USDA raised both the export and crush estimate in this week's report, but that could come to an end if we don't see positive export sales again.

I am still very concerned about the new crop soybeans. If we see a higher acreage estimate this month it would make the new crop ending stocks burdensome. The \$10.00 November puts traded actively at 70 cents and less, so you should have 20% of your production covered with those. The idea

now is to leg into a \$10.00 - \$8.00 bear put spread by selling an \$8.00 put for 30 cents. That could easily happen on a break in the next few weeks.

Cash cattle traded in Kansas at \$82, which is up from last week's \$81. Live

cattle futures were slightly higher and feeder cattle were higher for the week, thanks to Friday's gains. I really want to be bullish, but there hasn't been much reason to be. I like owning August feeder cattle calls, but I am not bullish enough

for futures yet. I doubt the market is headed straight up right now, so I would be looking to sell the August live cattle at \$83 or better. There hasn't been any indication of a change in trend in the futures, so we still have to look to sell strength.
