

Climatologist explains wind chill index

In the summer, forecasters and weather watchers refer to the heat index. But there is the other side to that in the wintertime. It's what is known as the wind chill, according to Mary Knapp.

Knapp, who is the state climatologist for Kansas, said that people can get into trouble if their internal body temperature drops below about 95 degrees F.

"We have a layer of air

around our body that is basically body-temperature, about 98 degrees F," said Knapp, who oversees the Kansas Weather Data Library, which keeps weather records for the state. "The wind affects how quickly we lose that layer and cool the internal body temperature. That's why the National Weather Service developed the wind chill index to chart the effect at various temperatures and wind speeds."

Knapp said the index does not factor in other things that can have an effect: the cloudiness, a person's clothes or their sensitivity to cold.

"Generally, though, the faster the wind, the faster we lose our self-generated heat. And, if the wind chill is at or below minus 18 degrees, we'd better watch out," she said. "Frostbite can occur within minutes."

Online road information helpful for planning travel

How are road conditions east of Topeka on I-70? Is there a traffic accident slowing my evening commute? Where are work zones on Kansas highways? These are some of the questions that drivers can find answers to, thanks to KanDrive (www.KanDrive.org).

KanDrive, operated by the Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT), connects travelers to helpful, relevant information to plan safe journeys.

An interactive map of Kansas roads, work zones, traffic incidents and surface-related weather conditions. (http://511.ksdot.org)

Snapshots from more than 30 closed-circuit cameras along I-70 between Topeka and Colorado and along other highways in the state, as well as camera views from the KC Scout system.

Important messages displayed on roadside dynamic message signs that advise travelers of key weather-related driving issues, traffic accidents, work zones, and AMBER Alerts.

Links to related helpful transportation resources,

including KC Scout; the future Wichita Traffic Management Center (TMC); state, county and city travel maps; links to neighboring states' travel information, Kansas Turnpike information and resources on preparing for winter travel, rest area locations, Scenic Byways and more.

"KDOT created KanDrive to increase awareness among travelers, commuters and truck drivers of our intelligent transportation services, especially the roadside cameras, message signs and 511 system," said Barb Blue, KDOT spokeswoman. "KanDrive reflects KDOT's commitment to using technology to benefit the safety, convenience and awareness of motorists in the state of Kansas."

KanDrive is a portal that displays information from KDOT's traveler information technology, including highway cameras, dynamic message signs, traffic management centers and 511 phone, online and mobile (http://511mm.ksdot.org). It will also include Wi-Fi connections and kiosks planned for some rest areas and state parks.

Schwieterman Market Outlook

A marketing commentary by Bret Crofts

The Dollar Index was sharply higher again last week, but it didn't hurt nearly as bad as it did the week before. The Index gained another 2.20 points for the week and on Friday's high it was at the highest level it had been since September 9th. The gold market and the stock market saw the most damage because of the strong Dollar. The Dow Jones lost about 180 points and the February gold fell below the 50-day moving average for the first time since August.

The grain markets didn't do too badly considering the Dollar strength. The March corn lost 7 cents, the March KW lost 4, and the March soybeans fell 23

cents. When the Dollar was strong on Thursday and Friday it did seem that traders were selling the grains for only one reason, but the rest of the week the Dollar didn't really matter. Many traders seem to be convinced that the Dollar has made a long term low so it is likely that we will be dealing with the threat of a stronger Dollar for quite a while. The solution to this problem is to either own US Dollar Index call options, or to own Euro or Yen put options. Any of those trades will protect you from strength in the Dollar. Another idea is to own S&P put options. The Dollar and the Stock market have had an inverse relationship for

about a year and a half and if that continues we could see quite a bit of pressure in the stocks. So far the weakness in the stock market hasn't been proportional to the strength in the Dollar, but that could change quickly.

Looking at the charts, the corn is still stuck in a side-

ways range. The March corn made it up to \$4.13 ¾ last week, which was short of the top of the range and disappointing to technical traders. Friday the \$3.91 area held as support and the market had a good close, due at least in part to the fact that the Dollar gave up most of the day's gains. From a technical perspective the market is in no man's land and could go either way, which means that traders will pay very close attention to the outside markets on Monday. Fundamentally, export sales were better than expected and a marketing

year high at 1.23 MMT.

Weak basis at the Gulf and the threat of a rising Dollar must have spurred some buying interest. If this sales pace can be maintained for a month or so, then USDA would have to consider increasing the export estimate and there would be something positive to talk about in the corn market, which is something we haven't had in a while. I hate to always talk about the Dollar, but if the Dollar has really bottomed, then the grain markets will have to rely on bullish funda-

mentals to make them move higher. Right now that is lacking in the corn and wheat and we need to see demand improve to use up our stocks.

Speaking of the wheat market, the March KW broke out of the bottom of the recent trading range when the Dollar was strong on Thursday, but managed to make a strong bounce back on Friday. The wheat has the poorest fundamental outlook by far, but you can never tell which market will benefit from the spread trade. Friday it looked like

traders were buying wheat against short soybean positions. Technical indicators are oversold and we can hope that \$5.10 will hold as support, but right now all you are doing is hoping for spread traders to buy wheat and for Index funds to buy soon. Export sales were poor again at 345,000 MT. There is just nothing happening in the export business. Acreage will be down, but at the current demand level, stocks will rise again anyway. The outlook is not good for the wheat. Rallies are sales opportunities.

Soybean demand is still excellent. This week bean sales were 934,700 MT. Meal and oil sales were great as well. Demand will slow at some point, but it hasn't yet. With all that demand, why were the beans the downside leader this week? Some of it is because our ending stocks are still ade-

quate and supplies are far from tight. Technical traders were discouraged by the failure to make new highs. World stocks are going to be very large next year because of better crops in S. America. Part of it was the strong Dollar and part of it was the fact that Informa thinks we have another 100 million bushels of soybeans. If that is true our stocks will be burdensome and it will be difficult to maintain the current price level.

The charts look weak now that the market has fallen out of the bottom of the trading range. A move back to \$10.00 looks likely in the March beans. Demand is going to be supportive, but because of Informa, traders will be nervous about the January Supply and Demand report. There is good news to report in the cattle market. Cattle on Feed

numbers came in at 99%, Placements at 92% and marketings at 104%. If traders paid attention to these numbers the market would be sharply higher Monday. Cattle on Feed numbers don't really matter, however there is still reason to be optimistic. There was cash cattle trade as high as \$82.50 this week and the beef market has higher. Live cattle and feeder cattle futures posted strong gains and the technical outlook is improving. The last major

hurdle is for the February LC to close above the 50-day moving average. If that happens next week, then the low is in for quite some time.

Yard & Garden Tips

Mulching Strawberries

Applying mulch over strawberries serves several useful purposes. It will keep them dormant come spring to reduce the changes of an early bloom which could be killed by a frost. Straw or other mulching material will filter down between the plant and the soil which will keep the fruit cleaner come harvest. Mulch will hold moisture, could reduce weeds and protect the plants from critters.

Strawberries produce best when the soil reaches an average of 40 degrees measured 4 inches deep in the soil. That will vary from location to location. I look at the information from the weather station in Manhattan. Historical weather information is available from the K-State Research and Extension weather data library. Go to [http://wdl.](http://wdl.agron.ksu.edu/)

[agron.ksu.edu/](http://wdl.agron.ksu.edu/) and select the location you want information on.

In hindsight, the weekend of December 5th would have been the best time to have applied mulch around Manhattan. The next best time is when one can get to it. Snow is a good substitute mulch for the time being.

Straw and prairie hay makes good mulch. Either should be applied to a depth of 2 to 3 inches when settled. When you don't have either, one may need to be more creative. This year, I'm going to use my dead grass tops from our ornamental grasses. It is similar material to the straw and hay.

I'm hoping that once covered that they will be less tempting to the neighborhood deer. There were seven in the yard prior to the snow. Luckily, only four were

feeding on the strawberries when I shooed them away. If the mulch doesn't work, then the bird netting will need to
