

Schwieterman Market Outlook

A marketing commentary by Bret Crotts

The wheat market had another monster week as it chased the French milling wheat higher. The September KW gained 59½ cents for the week and reached the highest level since mid-June of last year. The whole idea behind the run up in US prices is that the problems in Europe and the Black Sea region will translate into better exports for the US. The past couple of weeks the export sales have not been impressive, but this week's total of 919,900 MT was the second best of this crop year and about double what we have to have each week to meet the USDA projection. If we see consistent export sales at this level it will make this rally seem a lot more logical. Otherwise, there is just nothing behind it and the wheat will quickly drop back to the recent lows. Ending stocks levels will still be very high unless we see our exports stay strong.

The wheat charts still look friendly with the exception of the technical indicators being very overbought. The September KW moved through the \$6.60 objective and the market now appears to be headed to \$7.10. It is interesting to note that both trading funds and Index funds have a larger net long position now than they did when wheat was making the all time highs in 2008. Investment money keeps coming into commodity markets and is helping to fuel the rally.

I still like using HTA's to protect new crop wheat, but limit that to 20-30% of production for right now. You definitely want to avoid locking in the terrible new

crop basis, but some price protection is a practical move. Cover another 10% of your production on a move to \$7.35. Corn futures were higher last week as well, but the corn is definitely lagging the wheat. December corn gained 221/4 cents after starting the week under pressure. The market held support at the 50% retracement of the last leg up and bounced from there. The weekly reversal looks impressive on the charts and suggests further strength ahead. The next major hurdle is for the September corn to move through the \$4.00 level, which is trend line resistance on the weekly chart. On the daily chart a move through \$4.10 in the December contract would indicate the market is moving up to the \$4.50 level and a move to \$4.80 is not out of the question from a technical standpoint.

The weather is still nonthreatening and there is still talk of record yields, so the news is not completely bullish. We have excellent demand and USDA is likely too low on both the old crop and new crop export estimates. This week's export sales came in at 432,300 MT for the old crop and 528,100 MT for the new crop. Anything above zero is great for the old crop since we are already surpassed USDA's sales estimate. We can absorb a record yield without much problem, but all the talk of good yields is the one thing holding the market back. Index funds are adding to their record net long position, trading funds are building their net long position, but farmer selling is offsetting much of that

buying. Maintaining some protection with put options is a good idea, but you don't want to limit your upside potential at this point. The corn could be just as explosive as the wheat at some point, or even more so, since the corn fundamentals are much more bullish than that of the wheat. Right now you don't want to lock in any more corn until the December reaches \$4.50 and if you haven't covered any previous sales with call options, you should do so.

The November soybeans

reached the highest level since early January on Friday. The charts look very friendly right now. The recent set back has relieved the overbought condition of the market and we are now set for another leg higher. The charts suggest the November beans will head to \$10.20 and probably \$10.60. Money flow and demand are the name of the game here. Both trading funds and Index funds are adding to their net long positions and demand from China is still tremendous. I think that USDA is low balling the new crop export estimate, which means they are too high with the ending stocks estimate, which means that bean supplies next summer will be tighter than most are

thinking right now. Last week's export sales numbers were great with 339,000 MT of old crop and 1.14 MMT of new crop sales. Like the corn, any positive number is more than enough for the old crop beans since we have already exceeded the sales expectations. USDA may have to increase old crop exports to 1.5 billion bushels.

Cash cattle trade was lower this week, but the futures held on pretty well. The October LC only lost about 20 cents thanks to Friday's strong bounce. This week's correction wasn't quite as deep as I expected, but it still looks like it was the correction that this market needs before making another move higher. Buy the October LC and look for the market to make a run to \$97. If the live cattle are moving higher, the feeder cattle should be as well. Cattle feeders should own calls and hedgers should not do anything to limit upside potential.

I don't often mention the hogs, but the hog market is catching on fire. Time is running out for the August contract, but recent action suggests we will see new contract highs in the August lean hog contract.

Irrigation scheduling can conserve water and money, but many producers do not feel comfortable making scheduling decisions based on data from soil water monitoring equipment. When Steve Melvin, extension educator in Frontier County, found this out, he decided to develop a webinar series that would walk producers through the step-by-step process of making irrigation scheduling decisions based on soil water moniwill just go through and show my decision-making process based on the data and a chart system I am using, something we've developed over the past few years. The videos show how to use (the charts), but more importantly how to look at data and make soil monitoring-based irrigation decisions based on it," Melvin said. Melvin posted his first video the first week of July and will continue to post weekly videos until irrigation season ends around early Sep-

In the videos, he discusses irrigation scheduling based on the week's soil moisture readings for two corn fields on

Each week, Melvin walks viewers through a series of charts that help determine how much water should be added to the soil based on the soil water monitoring data. The irrigation capacity for the test fields allow for application of about 2 inches of water per week or about 5.5 gpm/acre, and Curtis is in a 20 inches per year rainfall zone. However, Melvin provides information for a variety of crops, soil capacities and other variables. Super Cow-Calf Show entries due Aug. 16

All Kansas commercial cow-calf producers are eligible to exhibit cattle in a special show September 13 at the Kansas State Fair in Hutchinson. The Super Cow-Calf Show will feature pairs in pasture condition, with no fitting allowed. An entry consists of one cow and her natural calf. No bull calves are allowed. The age of the cow and birth date of the calf must be known and provided by the exhibitor. Cows will be judged on type, structure, muscling, natural fleshing and soundness of udder, eyes, feet and legs. The calf at side will be evaluated on the same criteria. Cow weight and the calf's projected 205-day adjusted weight will be given to the judges. A two-judge system will be used. Judges will independently score each cow and calf. The total score of both judges will be used to rank pairs in the respective divisions.

The grand champion pair will win \$600, while the reserve grand champion will earn \$400, third place \$250, fourth place \$150 and fifth place \$100.

All cows and calves must be unloaded and processed by 11:00 a.m. September 13. The show begins at 2:00 p.m. All entries must arrive and leave September 13.



Webworms Changing Trees' Appearance

Webworms seem to attack trees overnight. Several of our trees have webworms now. In reality, they have been slowly consuming leaf tissue since June. As they progress in size their need for food increases. Missing leaves and a mass of webbing attracts attention. Fortunately, the feeding poses no threat to the health of established trees. While foliage may be consumed, the buds are not damaged that will make new leaves. Trees will leaf out again this year or next when the tree needs them.

One course of action that was once suggested was to remove the plant part that had the webworms. This may disfigure the infested plant unnecessarily. If I did this to our crabapples, it would leave some big holes. Now for those that might have seen me pruning our walnut tree, it was because the branch was broken and just happened to have some webworms.

We have a pear tree that it would be to our benefit to remove the webworms. If they were left to remove more leaves then the pears will remain small. A sharp stick or broom can be used to gather in the webbing. Webworms will fall out of the web as well as be wrapped up in it. In the old days, the webs would be set on fire. Fire is not required.

There are many possible insecticides to be used on webworms once the web is removed. I prefer a strong spray of water or a good limb-shaking to dislodge the remaining webworms. Only beware of falling pears in this case. If a pesticide is selected, read and follow the label directions for best use.

Many kinds of trees can be hosts for webworms. There are also several types of webworms. Mimosa webworms prefer honeylocust trees. I have never had them on our mimosa tree. Selecting a more resistant tree is a suggestion. Species of honevlocust reported to be susceptible less 'Moraine', 'Shademaster' and 'Imperial'. The variety 'Sunburst' appears to be favored by webworms.

We have two races of fall webworms in Kansas. These webworms have a broader range of trees. Redbud, mulberry and elm are commonly infested. Our walnut, Osage orange, flowering crabapple and pear have them this vear.

Sunflower assessment to increase for 2010 crop

The voluntary assessment paid by producers for sunflowers sold in Kansas will increase starting September 1, 2010. In April of this year, the eight-member Kansas Sunflower Commission voted to increase the check-off from 3 to 5 cents per hundred weight of sunflowers. The assessment rate has been 3 cents per hundred since inception of the Commission in 2002. Kansas law gives the Commission authority to assess up to 6 cents per hundred weight. The law also provides that producers who wish to receive a refund of the assessment may simply provide evidence of the assessment charges within one year of

Voluntary check-off dollars are used for promotion of the commodity and its products as well as research on variety of issue related to sunflower production.

"We really need to help our Kansas producers find some solutions to the barriers on sunflower production, particularly weed control," says Karl Esping, Kansas Sunflower Commission Chair. "We have a great opportunity here in Kansas to increase both full-season and doublecrop sunflowers but producers have to have the tools and markets to make that a profitable venture," says Esping. "Producer's check-off dollars will be

Teff, a grain native to Ethiopia, has been grown in Graham County since 2005. In 2007 the Solomon Valley RC&D was awarded a three-year U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) Conservation Innovation Grant (CIG) to grow and market teff. There are currently more than 150 acres of teff being grown in Osborne, Rooks, Graham, and Phillips Counties. Teff is glutenfree and known to be both flood and drought tolerant. The grant is administered by the Natural Re-Conservation sources Service, an agency of USDA.

For lambs, a pasture a week keeps blood suckers away

Deworming lambs can be minimized with rotational grazing and checking the animals' eye color, according to an Agricultural Research Service (ARS) study.

Animal scientist Joan Burke at the ARS Dale Bumpers Small Farms Research Center in Booneville, Ark., and colleagues made this finding as part of a continuing collaboration with scientists, veterinarians, and extension agents from the Southern Consortium for Small Ruminant Parasite Control.

The consortium was formed in response to the threats posed by worms resistant to parasiticides. Unnecessary de-worming speeds development of resistant worms. Reducing the use of conventional parasiticides fits well into organic and grass-fed management systems and meets consumer preferences of minimizing chemical residues in meat.

The blood-sucking worm. Haemonchus contortus, can cause severe anemia in animals. It is called the barber pole worm for the spiraling of its white, egg-filled ovaries around blood-filled intestines. Worldwide, they cost farmers and ranchers millions of dollars in losses. Animals shed worm eggs with their manure, and the larvae that hatch can be eaten by other livestock.

Burke and colleagues found that gel capsules filled with copper oxide wire particles eliminated the need for conventional dewormers in all but one case. And lambs that also rotated pastures needed fewer dewormings with the copper oxide pills.

They tested 71 lambs naturally infected with the barber pole worm. This is the first study of rotational grazing that used worm-infested lambs. They did the copper oxide deworming only to animals whose inner eyelid color was medium pale, Stage 3, on an eye color chart used as part of a clinical, onfarm system for detecting anemia and eliminating unnecessary dewormings for barber pole infesta-

The stages range from the red eyelids of healthy livestock (Stage 1) to the almost white eyelids of severely anemic goats and sheep (Stage 5).

Some of the lambs grazed on bermudagrass in the same pasture all season, and some were rotated every 3.5 to 7 days.

This work was published in the journal Veterinary Parasitology.







Workaholism Leads to Family Farm Unhappiness

Workaholism is more than hard work and a sense of responsibility essential for farming success. It is valuing work to the point of neglecting basic needs of health, spirituality, social involvement, leisure and family commitments.

Many farm women are frustrated by their husbands' priorities. They feel their husbands spend too little time cultivating their marriage, children, or other ingredients of a balanced lifestyle.

What is the attraction of farmers to work? Why do so many develop a workaholic response to farming?

Feeling responsible. Farm work involves interaction with living systems. Success depends on timely interventions to nourish the growth of animals and crops. A farmer knows his management is responsible for their well-being. Farmers grow to love what they serve, similar to the way that a young mother bonds with her baby. The work is compelling because of this dependency and attachment bond.

Achievement is visible. There is an art and craftsmanship connected with the upkeep of machinery and the use of innovative farming techniques. Good feelings come with the work being done and done well. Farm management involves lots of opportunities for decision-making and control of events. Owning and operating a farm involves plenty of creative challenge and problems to overcome. The farm's development is visible and rewarding.

High standards. If the pleasure from work is cou-

pled with a need to be perfect, then a farmer justifies even longer hours to get things "just right." His standards for farm work are not compromised at the expense of other things he could be doing with his time. His standards also prevent him from delegating work that could easily be done by others.

Work is so close at hand. Other professions have the advantage of a physical demarcation between home and work. Farm work is never finished. It is so legitimate. It is so close! The temptation to work late or to go back outside to work is powerful.

Work is revered as a cultural value. It is part of the American dream that a person can get ahead by determination and hard work. Hard work plays a major role in the success of farming. It is a major dimension by which farmers pass judgment on one another.

Farming is an occupation where work demands far exceed the 40 hour work week. There are no standards for knowing when to stop. Men tend to judge their worth by success in work. This view of masculinity is based in early socialization practices and cultural reinforcement.

Traditional sex roles are reinforced by other farmers and family members who have similar views of life. Hard work can be a defensive tactic to preserve a sense of worth and identity.

Fathers show the way. Children, as they grow up, observe their fathers' approach to work, relationships, and other interests. A child sees graphically what a father does. In addition, a

father may consciously teach a workaholic orientation as a philosophy of suc-

If the father disparages leisure, has limited outside interests and puts the farm ahead of his wife's needs, then the child grows up thinking this is normal and natural

Workaholism attempts to overcome shame. Many workaholics come from a farm childhood where they experienced workaholism, alcoholism, abuse, or neglect. Feelings of low self-esteem come from these distorted family experiences. Children deaden their feelings to cope with the inner pain. To feel OK about themselves, they may adopt a lifestyle of achievement to attempt to earn the admiration and respect of others. Work is their answer for the lack of love and approval they feel.

Inner fears, shame, and feelings of inadequacy from childhood can keep an adult from disclosing feelings and

getting done.

The relative isolation of the farm and the ability to farm alone allows a farmer to make a good living and not interact with a lot of people. This isolation and workaholic behavior may mask the insecurity and the threat felt in relating to others.

Farming is highly competitive work. Farmers grow up in a highly competitive world where they compare themselves to others in judging their self-worth. Limited experiences outside of farming and the farming community work against the formation of an independent judgment of worth.

Peer competition in school and sports continues into farming in adult life. Farm management techniques and decisions are commonly known and talked about. The compulsion toward work may also serve as a way of bolstering esteem and respect in the community as a whole. The improvements and ideas implemented are highly visible to fellow farmers. The pride factor fuels expansion of farm work.

Easy to justify. Is it any wonder then that a workaholic farmer uses his knowledge of farming to discount demands or requests from

Banana derbies new at **Central Kansas Free Fair**



Nothing beats the good old-fashioned entertainment of a county fair. And the Central Kansas Free Fair in Abilene delivers seven solid days of fun things to do. From music to demo derbies to chainsaw artists to farm activities, there's entertainment for all at the fair in Abilene August 4-10. Grandstand entertainment is featured each night. The Wild Bill Hickok Rodeo runs August 4-7. The auto demo derby is Sunday, August 8, and on August 9 is a combine demo derby and compact figure 8 race. On August 10, the last night of the fair, a second auto demo derby is held with a new team derby.

Other activities include a Country Showdown Runoff and Finals on August 5, magic shows August 6-9, and farm fun activity booths sponsored by Dickinson County FFA Chapters. At the booths kids (and adults) can learn about agriculture by milking wooden cows, checking corn, riding a pedal tractor, and watching hens sit on eggs. Throughout the day, the stilt walker

will stroll through the grounds and the chain saw artist will carve trees into art. The wooden artworks will be auctioned off on August 8 at 2 pm, with proceeds going towards fair activities. Jacque Karl, fair secretary, said the proceeds are helpful. "It gives us extra money to add to the (fair's) entertainment without having to go out and hit up sponsors." A free watermelon feed is held during the auction.

The fair features something new this year: a banana derby. Similar to pig races, a banana derby is monkeys trained to ride dogs. These monkey jockeys love fan participation! The banana derbies will be held three to four times a day. A new carnival company, Pride Amusements, will also be on hand. Karl said fair-goers requested a change. "The public wanted more state fair type rides and more games. We'll still have plenty for the small kids, but more big, big rides." Carnival tickets are available at a discount with a nightly wristband for sale in advance for \$15. During the fair, the wristband will cost \$25. The carnival "dollar day" will take place from noon to 4 pm on Sat., August 7, where all ages and all rides are \$1.

Tickets for the grandstand entertainment are available through the fair office or online. Rodeo packages are \$28 and admit the bearer to all four nights of rodeo August 4-7. Demo derby packages are \$21 and admit the bearer to all three nights of derbies August 8-10. Individual tickets for grandstand entertainment are \$8 per night in advance and \$10

Fall can be a good time to plant alfalfa

fall are often the best times to plant alfalfa in Kansas if we've had enough rainfall, according to Jim Shroyer, Extension agronomy state leader. This year, many areas of Kansas have good moisture for alfalfa planting, although it's getting dry now in places. A fall-seeded crop is more productive during the first growing season than a spring-seeded crop. After the first season, however, yield potential is about the same.

Growers in northwest Kansas can plant as early as Aug. 10-15. Those in southeast Kansas can plant in mid to late September. In other parts of Kansas, planting time is late August or early September.

Producers just need to plant early enough to have three to five trifoliate leaves before the first frost. Alfalfa is a three- to fiveyear or longer investment. Some producers shy away from alfalfa because of its high establishment cost and risk of stand failure. In the long run, however, it's relatively inexpensive, if amortized over the life of the

If managed properly and if we have a good year in terms of weather, dryland alfalfa can produce four to six tons of forage per acre per year. Irrigated fields can produce eight to 12 tons per acre per year.

When planting alfalfa, producers should keep the

following in mind: * Test the soil. Alfalfa grows best in well-drained soils with a pH of 6.5 to 7.5. If the land needs lime, add it before planting. Apply the needed phosphorus and potassium, too. Since each cutting removes 10 pounds of phosphorus per acre for each ton of forage harvested, it's an annual input.

 Plant certified, inoculated seed. Inoculation helps alfalfa seedlings fix available soil nitrogen for optimum production.

* Plant in firm, moist soil. If possible, prepare the seedbed and plant after a rain. Tilling after a rain will reduce soil moisture. A firm seedbed ensures good seedsoil contact; therefore, use a press wheel with the drill to firm the soil over the planted seed. Or, consider no-till planting in small-grains stubble - which is a successful alternative and in some areas is the primary mode of planting.

* Don't plant too deeply. Plant one-fourth to one-halfinch deep on medium- and fine-textured soils and three-fourths-inch deep on sandy soils. Don't plant deeper than 10 times the seed diameter.

Use the right seeding rate. Plant 8 to 12 pounds of seed per acre of dryland in western Kansas, 12 to 15 pounds per acre in irrigated medium- to fine-textured soils, 15 to 20 pounds per acre on irrigated sandy soils, and 12 to 15 pounds per acre of dryland in central and eastern Kansas.

Check for herbicide carryover that could damage the new alfalfa crop especially when planting alfalfa no-till into corn or grain sorghum stubble. In areas where row crops were drought-stressed and removed for silage, that set up a great seedbed for alfalfa, but may still bring a risk of herbicide damage.

* Choose pest-resistant varieties. Resistance to phytophthora root rot, bacterial wilt, fusarium wilt, verticillium wilt, anthracnose, the pea aphid, and the spotted alfalfa aphid is essential. Some varieties are resistant to even more diseases and insects.
