



# Schwieterman Market Outlook

*A marketing commentary by Bret Crotts*

Friday the U.S. Dollar Index reached 79.28, which is the lowest level since February. The Dollar has been trending lower since June and now looks to be headed down to the 2009 low near 74.25. All indications are that Federal Reserve will begin another round of "Quantitative Easing," which essentially means printing more money. That is long term negative to the US Dollar and will eventually be inflationary especially if the economy improves. The recession is officially over, but with unemployment still near 10%, not everyone feels that it is really over. That is why the Fed feels it is necessary to continue to increase the money supply and try to stimulate the economy, and since they can't lower interest rates any further, tweaking the money supply is their only tool.

The weakness in the Dollar helped to push the gold to new all time highs again last week. The December contract moved over \$1300 for a while on Friday and

other than the technical indicators showing the market is overbought, there is no indication of a top. Thursday is the September Quarterly Stocks Report and the Small Grains Summary. The September stocks report has been full of surprises lately, which makes me a little bit nervous. Corn harvest is ahead of average this year, which means that some new crop bushels could show up as old crop stocks and skew some of the numbers. We have seen that happen before and it takes months to resolve the problem. The June stocks report showed a surprisingly low level of corn stocks and some traders fear that the grain may reappear in this report. It may be prudent to own cheap put options ahead of Thursday's report, just in case the government does something goofy. The corn started the week by making new highs for the move and coming very close to the \$5.25 objective in the December contract. The corn failed to hold gains on Monday, which led to a poor

close on Monday and three more days of weakness. Friday, however, the market was very strong and the corn tested Monday's high and ended up being 8 1/2 cents higher for the week.

The fundamental outlook for the corn is still very bullish. Yield reports have not improved, which has more and more traders thinking that our yield could end up as low as 155 bu./ac. 155 would still be the 3rd highest ever, and above the 5 year average, but it just isn't good enough this year. Export sales weren't good last week at only 561,800 MT, but all indications are that they will be better this week. If we have a 155 yield, price will have to ration demand, but I don't think we have reached that point yet. On the charts, this week's correction has relieved the overbought condition of the market and Friday's action suggests we have already started another leg higher. The \$5.25 area is still acting as resistance, but we should be looking for a move up to \$5.67 in the December con-

tract and then \$6.10.

The December KW had a rough week, losing 10 3/4 cents despite gaining over 20 cents on Friday. The losses in the wheat resulted in an outside week down on the charts, which suggests further weakness is ahead. The wheat seems to be transitioning from trading in a sideways/higher pattern to a sideways/lower pattern. The July contract, on the other hand, gained 8 cents for the week and made its highest close of the contract.

Bear spreading was active last week despite some good demand news. Old crop export sales came in at 950,300 MT and after cancellations by Egypt last week, we saw them back in the market. The weaker Dollar should help keep us competitive in the world market and after a week of corrective pressure, Friday's action suggests that the French milling wheat is ready to move higher again, which is also helpful to our markets.

Last Friday the November soybeans closed above the \$10.50 - \$10.60 resistance and this Friday the November soybeans moved through the \$11.00 resistance. For the week the November beans gained 57 cents and reached the highest level in 2 years.

The charts look good. Technical indicators are be-

coming overbought again, but they can stay that way for a long time. The next major upside objective for the November contract is the \$11.80 area, followed by \$12.70. The fundamentals are getting more bullish. Demand is still excellent. Export sales came in at 1.08 MMT and soybean oil sales were huge again as well. That is all great, but the big news was Infoma's estimate that acreage would be down 1.4 million acres in the October supply and demand report. That would be very supportive to both the old crop and the new crop because of the lower production and tighter stocks, and it would make next spring's acreage battle much more interesting. Also, the weather in Brazil has been dry, which has traders nervous about world stocks levels not being as high as expected. It is still too early to worry much about the dry weather in Brazil, but if it lasts, it will become a major bullish factor in the market.

The December live cattle followed last Friday's new contract highs by free falling this week. The December LC lost \$3.825 this week and fell below the 50-day moving average, which I really don't like. So, the charts look suspect to further selling, and we should know early in the week if the down trend is going to

continue. A move below \$97.80 Monday would be very negative and suggest we are in for a move down to \$95.30. Cash cattle still traded at \$98 last week, which was good considering the pressure in the futures. If cash doesn't break this week, we will see a strong bounce in the futures.

## Patch burning: a new concept in rangeland management

A six-year research project is under way in Woodson County, where Kansas State University (K-State) scientists are working to determine how viable patch-burn grazing is for raising livestock.

Patch-burn grazing is a fairly new concept in rangeland management, but has been occurring naturally for hundreds of years, said Walt Fick, K-State Research and Extension range management specialist.

Historically, Native Americans purposely started prairie fires, and lighting did the same thing naturally. Bison and other native herbivores were attracted to the new growth that comes up after the land burned; consequently, these animals moved from grazing area to grazing area — searching out the most attractive areas of new growth, Fick said.

Some ranchers are mimicking that grazing pattern by sectioning a large pasture into three or more burn areas.

"Every year, one of those sections is prescribed burned, concentrating the grazing pressure in specific areas of the pasture," he said. "The cattle are free-roaming over the entire pasture, but tend to gravitate toward the one-third area of the pasture that has been burned, because that is where the most attractive new growth has occurred."

"When burning, producers may create burn boundaries (fire guards), but

using natural breaks would be more efficient because of labor expenses," he added.

The main purpose of patch-burn grazing is ecology-driven; it has a high potential to increase biodiversity and wildlife habitat.

"Through our research, we would like to determine how it affects livestock performance, if it will compromise the health of the prairie, and if it can control the highly invasive plant, *Sericea lespedeza*," Fick said.

This year will be K-State's third year with the project, completing one full cycle. So far, there has been no noticeable difference in cattle performance in the patch-burn pastures, according to the range specialist.

"Forage growth has shifted toward annual grasses and forbs, and there has been a decrease in basal cover. *Sericea lespedeza* plants have decreased in height because of the grazing pressure," Fick said. "Most importantly for producers, though, is maintaining the long-term health of the pasture; with increased grazing pressures, the pasture may not be able to recover. We have three more years to determine this."

Cade Rensink, K-State Research and Extension agent in Coffey County and a graduate student in agronomy, has been working with Fick on the research.

# Kansas Corn, Grain Sorghum associations heard at Senate Ag hearing on EPA and agriculture

EPA's handling of atrazine regulation was one of the topics at a Senate Agriculture Committee hearing last Thursday. At an oversight hearing on EPA and agriculture, the Senate Agriculture Committee heard from Jere White, executive director of the Kansas Corn Growers Association and Kansas Grain Sorghum Producers Association. Also speaking at the hearing was EPA Administrator Lisa Jackson, Rich Hillman, Arkansas Farm Bureau; and Jay Vroom, CropLife America.

White expressed his concern over the process used by EPA in its latest round of Science Advisory Panels.

"I explained how EPA has gone through an extensive scientific evalua-

tion of atrazine that began in 1995, and the fact that they had just reregistered the product in 2006 with more than 6,000 studies being involved in that process. Yet, after all of that scientific research, discussion and decision making, EPA suddenly announced last fall a new re-review of atrazine after a coordinated media blitz surrounding a Natural Resources Defense Council study late last summer. So we have EPA using a great amount of resources in a politically motivated round of SAPs, which clearly was a response to activist media hype," White said.

White also told the committee about a rash of subpoenas issued out of the Holiday Shores case, an Illinois state court

case in which trial attorneys are representing some community water systems seeking large payouts from the makers of atrazine.

"Several grower groups who have participated in the stakeholder process at EPA on atrazine have been targeted to receive subpoenas for massive amounts of records and information," White said. "About three-fourths of the ag groups who participated in last week's Science Advisory Panel at EPA had been served subpoenas before the SAP."

At that time, the Kansas Corn Growers and Grain Sorghum associations had not yet received subpoenas.

"In my presentation at the SAP, I brought it to the attention of the panel

that people were being harassed for their participation in the process. When I returned home from Washington DC, I was rewarded with three subpoenas."

White told the Senate Agriculture Committee that the timing of the subpoenas seemed to be more than a coincidence.

"They are sending a clear message that if you are going to be an advocate for atrazine, the trial attorneys are going to make you pay a price," he said. "When I explained this at the Senate Ag Committee, senators on both sides of the aisles were clearly concerned."

## Yard & Garden Tips

By Gregg Eyestone

### A Sweet Harvest

At the end of May, I wrote about planting sweet potatoes. All the vegetables at that time were looking like it would be a decent gardening year. The weather changed and many of our vegetables just didn't turn out as well as hoped.

Tomatoes and peppers weren't harvested in any record numbers.

The onions were hit with a hot spell which reduced their ultimate size.

I recall digging the Irish potatoes out of the mud to prevent rotting.

Sweet corn and popcorn struggled to fill the ears.

One vegetable I can depend upon year after year is the sweet potato. The sweet potato can take whatever nature deals out and come through. It is good to have something

that always ends on a high note.

Sweet potatoes are dug now through the first frost. They are damaged by freezing temperatures. The vines can be cut away to make digging easier. Gently lift the roots out of the soil. The sweet potato skin is tender and easily damaged.

After digging, break the roots apart. Allow them to air dry in the garden for a few hours before picking them up. Gently place them in a container to transport to the house.

Curing the sweet potato will improve the flavor, seal over bruises and increase the length of time they will keep. Sweet potatoes are "cured" in a warm humid location for 1-2 weeks. Place them in an 80-90 degrees F environment with high humidity

for 7-10 days. Then lower the temperature to around 55 degrees F for long-term storage. Never allow temperatures to drop below 50o F as poor keeping quality, flavors, and dark colors will result. If sweet potatoes are washed before storing, make sure they are handled carefully and dried before curing. It is common for them to keep for four months or longer.

If you didn't get around to growing your own sweet

potatoes, they should be readily available for purchase. Sweet potato roots are nutritious. One average sized root provides one-half the recommended daily allowance of vitamin C, twice the vitamin A, as well as significant amounts of calcium, iron, niacin and riboflavin. They also provide protein. Enjoy the last part of the vegetable season with sweet potatoes.

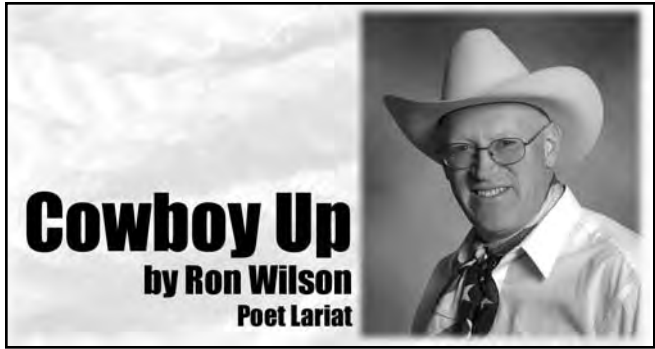

Uncle Fred

He was an outstanding farmer-stockman, an award-winning livestock judge, a leader in farm organizations, an innovative livestock producer, and a husband, father, and grandfather.

To us, he was simply "Uncle Fred."

Fred Germann passed away on September 17, 2010 at the age of 89. He had a long career as a successful farmer and stockman. Fred and his sisters, including my mother, grew up on a farm in the Blue River Valley north of Manhattan. As an animal husbandry student at K-State, he became an outstanding livestock judge under the tutelage of Dr. Don Good.

Upon coming back to the farm, he found that the Germann family home was located in an area of huge controversy: The Battle of the Blue, aka Big Dam Foolishness. The federal government had a plan to build a huge dam on the Big Blue River for flood control and recreation. Unfortunately, the huge reservoir that resulted would cover acres of productive farmland and displace communities and family farms – including the Germanns.

The neighbors rallied to fight the government land grab, but ultimately the feds won. (This outcome seems ironic, in the light of today where entire government projects are brought to a sudden halt to protect the habitat of some obscure minnow, for example.)

But that old saying "If life gives you lemons, then make lemonade" certainly applied to Fred's philosophy of life. He had a positive attitude and would find a way to make something good out of whatever happened. In this case, the

Germann's farmland was inundated but the pasture on the nearby hillsides became lakeview property for new homes. The Germann farm was moved to near Dwight where he started a new type of pork production called Specific Pathogen-Free hogs and became a leading pork and beef producer. He became K-State's Stockman of the Year among many other honors. Fred was the only Kansan ever to be president of both the Kansas Livestock Association and the Kansas Pork Producers Council.

During high school, I worked for Fred as a hired hand in the summertime. He was a great boss: Hard-working, smart, kind, fair, and good-humored. A major fringe benefit was joining in a hearty noon meal prepared by Aunt Helen. When I told Fred with tongue in cheek that I wanted a top-level administrative job, he conferred upon me the title of Executive Vice President in Charge of Cleaning Out the Farrowing House. It didn't change the pay or the view, but it looked good on a resume.

He and Helen had a long, happy life together. On September 10, 2010, he was inducted into the Kansas Cowboy Hall of Fame in Dodge City in the Rancher/Cattleman category. Unfortunately, he took sick that week and was unable to attend the ceremony, but was proud of the honor. Six days later, he was gone.

Today, we stood in a wind-swept cemetery, with a riderless horse atop the hill nearby, and laid him to rest.

Thanks for everything, Uncle Fred.

# Rural Life

## Farmers Facing The Challenges Of Widowhood

A newly widowed farmer faces a life of breaking new ground without his life companion and soulmate. His wife's death causes changes that are deep and profound. It is impossible to anticipate and prepare for them.

However, there are some attitudes and behaviors that will help make this catastrophic loss more bearable.

**1. Learn the basics of survival.** Most older farmers grew up in an era of sharp sex role distinctions. Despite being good at fixing most everything under the sun, they have usually neglected the basics of cooking, laundry, health care and other domestic skills.

**2. Give yourself permission to grieve.** A man used to fixing things and rigging up solutions is confronted with a problem that cannot be fixed. There is no control, no solution, no cleverness that is going to

change a thing. The only way to get through it is to go through it.

The loss is the injury. Grieving is the healing. This is not a test of whether a man can endure his pain silently. Part of accepting what has happened is to feel the pain and misery of the loss and to express it.

Grief is not a disease to get over. It is not something to ignore and pretend it is not there. It is a misguided notion that tears are weak and wrong. Part of oneself is missing. The void and emptiness are real. Share your sadness and emotions.

**3. Avoid alcohol.** Men who use alcohol as a coping tool will lean on it even more heavily to mask their emotions and their loneliness. Abusing alcohol does not help and it will cause its own set of problems.

**4. Use caution in operating farm equipment.** This

is a dangerous time for farm accidents. A grieving man is preoccupied with his thoughts. More than ordinary precautions need to be taken when operating power equipment.

**5. Stay socially active.** A farmer's past social activity and past support system will determine how comfortable he is in turning to others after his wife's death. He needs to continue his habits and mingle with children, friends and relatives. Research shows that widowers without a good social support system are at greater risk for health problems and an earlier death.

**6. Rethink your personal goals.** A man needs to continue to work toward meaningful goals despite the loss of his lifelong companion. Part of successful coping is to find

purpose and enjoyment in life. Be active and regain a focus for your new life alone.

**7. Accept your children's help.** Adult children, their spouses and your grandchildren can help fill the void left by the loss of a companion. They give their father/grandfather extra attention through invitations and phone calls. They come to visit or invite him for holidays and special occasions.

This is an awkward time for a father who isn't used to intruding into his children's lives. As much as he may wish to resist their invitations and desire to be close, he needs to accept their love and presence in his life. They, more than anyone, share his pain and loss.

**8. A quick remarriage is not the answer.** The most intense time of grief is during the first three to five years. Widowers do not live as long living alone as women who lose their mates. Men, in their haste to deal with their loneliness, act too quickly. Widowers who remarry wait an average of 1.7 years while widows wait

an average of 3.8 years.

By remarrying too soon, a widower may carry active grieving and expectations into this new relationship. He will quickly realize that the woman he married is a distinct personality in her own right with her own habits, expectations, goals and values. Tensions, arguments and stalemates can develop in marriages made in haste.

A man's flexibility and ability to communicate will lessen the possibility of too much conflict in the remarriage. Life cannot be the way it used to be. A wife cannot be "replaced." A remarriage should be on a sound foundation of mutual interests and values.

Marrying someone from the local community increases the chances that a new spouse's view of life and expectations about farming will match the widower's own values. She will already have her own place and identity in the community. She will have fewer adjustments to make.

Also, any farming arrangements with adult children and the reality of the interdependent nature

of those relationships need to be understood and accepted - just as acceptance of her family is crucial.

**9. Be patient and open with children about your remarriage plans.** It is easy to forget that the children are also grieving the loss of their mother. Their cool reaction or hostility to a new marriage may be a reflection of their own grieving.

If the remarriage isn't done in haste, children will generally accept and be glad for dad's need for a companion. Love has come into his life. A prenuptial agreement will eliminate fears of a rightful inheritance being channeled to their father's new wife or her side of the family at his death. Openness and communications will prevent resentment and problems from developing down the road.
