

Schwieterman Market Outlook

A marketing commentary by Bret Crotts

It was a brutal week for the grain markets. The corn, wheat, and soybeans were all under heavy pressure last week. After making new contract highs of \$7.993/4 last Friday the July corn posted a low of \$6.914 last Friday. The market did bounce back by the close on Friday and so far hasn't closed below \$7.00, but the massive break last week has the chart pattern looking a little ominous. Trend line support in the July contract comes in at \$6.87 on Monday, so one certainly can't rule out more weakness from a technical standpoint. The fundamentals are still very bullish, but the market was really lacking any fresh bullish information. All the talk this week was about improving crop condition ratings, greater yield potential, USDA under estimating acreage, the latest Greek crisis, declining ethanol production, declining crude oil prices, feed demand shifting to wheat, and weakening basis in the eastern Corn Belt. Nobody was too concerned that cattle on feed numbers are still above year ago levels, that the basis is generally still improving, flooding is still wiping out acres, or that supplies are going to be exceptionally tight in just a matter of days.

Attitudes may change quickly, but right now the corn market is in need of a bullish spark like a large old crop export sale or a rebound in the crude oil market. The job of the market is still to ration demand because old crop supplies are still very tight and new crop supplies, even if production potential does improve, won't grow very much. This week's break obviously didn't slow any demand. It improved both ethanol production margins and livestock feeding margins as well as generated rumors of Chinese corn buying. The price of corn in China is rising relentlessly and it seems that it is only a matter of time until they get into the market more aggressively. China was listed as a buyer of old crop corn in this week's export sales report. It was a small quantity, but if we see them again it would be the spark the corn needs.

The wheat had been trending lower even before this week's break so the size of the total move is beginning to be rather large. It is about \$1.70 from the most recent high to Friday's low in the July KW. It is a tremendous break in the face of a very poor HRW

harvest and planning problems in the HRS regions of both the U.S. and Canada. There is widespread talk of feeding wheat, which one would think of as supportive, but it hasn't helped the market yet. I still think the fundamental outlook will improve at some point in the crop year, but right now it is hard to overcome the fact that USDA told us not to worry and that supplies are going to be more than adequate for another year. That is what USDA said, that is what the trade believes, and that is why the market is struggling. It felt to me like the wheat was losing downside momentum on Friday. There was plenty of opportunity to fall apart again, but it didn't do it, which is somewhat encouraging. The market is very oversold and due for a corrective bounce, but I fear that we will see a move down to \$7.75 in the July KW before the market finally turns. A new low for the move on Monday would

be very bearish. The July soybeans fell through the 50-day moving average and down to the \$13.30 support. There is a good chance that it holds since export sales are more than adequate and there is still uncertainty about new crop acreage, but like the


other markets, the soybeans are lacking fresh bullish news and lacking something to inspire the speculators to buy. The supply and demand report told us that supplies are fine, so until we see a surprisingly large export sale, see a cut in acreage, or see dry weather develop in the Corn Belt, it will be very difficult to sustain rallies and the July contract will be in jeopardy of moving down to the \$13.00

The cattle on feed report was friendly to the October and December live cattle contracts. On feed was at 104%, placements at 89%, and marketings at 107%. The cattle futures had a great

week and confirmed a bottom. The August live cattle gained \$6.85 and the August feeders picked up \$10.68. Technical indicators are giving buy signals and the last hurdle that the August live cattle need to clear is closing above \$110.50. After such a fast and large move higher it won't be surprising to see a setback to start the week, but a pull back to \$108.50 is probably a great

buying opportunity.





Cattlemen stand up to support "Made in USA"

Recently, the World Trade Organization (WTO) issued a preliminary ruling against the United States' Country of Origin Labeling law (COOL). This ruling stems from a suit filed by Canada and Mexico claiming that the USA has violated trade agreements with its COOL law. The WTO claims that COOL does not meet the United States' objective that the labeling law informs and helps U.S. consumers make purchasing decisions regarding the origin of meat, produce and other products and that the USA has violated trade barri-

"According to the Center for Food Integrity, whose members include an array of agricultural groups, consumers have become interested in how their food is grown, processed and brought to the market. With more consumer consciousness, it is reasonable to deduce that consumers also want to know the origin of their food. Why would anyone deny consumers the right to information? Labeling provides just that... information. It is up to the consumers to choose what they want to purchase," explained Kansas Cattlemen's Association Executive Director, Brandy Carter.

Linn county cattleman and KCA president Paul

Acton weighed in on the issue, "I am a huge fan of exploring new export markets via fair trade agreements. However, I don't think the United States beef producers should be subject to rules that are from an entity outside of our own judicial system such as the WTO, and we have a right as Americans to market. label, and produce our products as we see fit to accommodate a free market system.

"Due to a lack of choice, most of the products that we purchase are made in a foreign country, and all are labeled as such. If a tire can be labeled 'Made in China' and sent here for

sale then why is it that my product that I have produced for sale cannot say 'Product of USA.' in the American market place," asked Acton.

Kniebel receives Roy A. Wallace **Memorial Scholarship**

Cassandra "Cassie" Kniebel of White City received the prestigious Roy A. Wallace Memorial Scholarship during the Beef Improvement Federation (BIF) research seminar and annual meeting in Bozeman, Mont., June 1-5.

Kniebel is first vice president of the Red Angus Junior Association of America and is majoring in Animal Science at Kansas State University.

The Roy A. Wallace BIF Memorial Fund was established to honor the life and career of Roy A. Wallace. Wallace worked for Select Sires for 40 years, serving as vice president of beef programs.

He devoted his life to beef cattle improvement and became involved with BIF in its infancy. He was the only person to attend each of the first 40 BIF conventions. He loved what BIF stood for - an organization that brings together purebred and commercial cattle breeders, academia and breed associations, all committed to improving beef cattle.

Wallace was honored with both the BIF Pioneer Award and BIF Continuing Service Award. He also co-authored the BIF 25-year history, Ideas into Action.

BIF established the scholarship named in Wallace's honor to encourage young men and women to pursue beef cattle improvement with the dedication and passion that Wallace exhibited.

BIF awards the Roy A. Wallace Memorial Scholarships to graduate and undergraduate students currently enrolled as fulltime students pursuing a degree related to the beef cattle industry.

The selection committee considers applicants who demonstrate a commitment and service to the beef cattle industry. They give preference to students who have demonstrated a passion for beef breeding, genetics and reproduction. They also judge academic performance, personal character and service to the beef cattle indus-

This year, BIF awarded two \$1,250 scholarships. Kniebel received the scholarship designated for undergraduates, and Jessica Bussard of the University of Kentucky received the graduate scholarship.

the Flint Hills, I see an explosiion of Sericea Lespedeza and cedar trees. Far too many, be it the owner, tenants, or public officals are not taking this threat serious.

Yes, the Flint Hills will

New research facility will help safeguard the supply of global wheat crops

Agriculture (USDA) and the United States Agency for International Development (USAID) have broken ground on a state-of-the-art greenhouse that will play a key role in helping scientists combat a growing global disease threat to the world's wheat and barley supplies. The 2,880-squarefoot greenhouse will be operated by scientists from the Agricultural Research Service (ARS), USDA's principal intramural scientific research agency.

"Historically, stem rust has been the most destructive disease of wheat and barley, but in recent decades, scientists have been able to breed resistance to this disease into new varieties of wheat," said ARS administrator Edward B. Knipling. "Since 1999, the world has faced a new and unprecedented threat from a stem rust called Ug99. More than 80 percent of our global wheat crop is vulnerable to Ug99. This new greenhouse puts another U.S. research facility on the front lines to battle Ug99 and help secure global food security.'

The greenhouse will increase controlled growing space at ARS' Cereal Disease Laboratory (CDL) on the University of Minnesota campus in St. Paul, and boost the laboratory's analytic capacity fivefold. The construction of the greenhouse is being funded through a \$4.5 million cooperative agreement between USAID and USDA through Feed the Future, the U.S. government's global hunger and food security initiative. Feed the Future is a Presidential Initiative to improve agricultural productivity, promote market development, facilitate trade expansion, invest in innovation and res promote equitable

dress child malnutrition in 20 food-insecure countries.

"By expanding our commitment to research that targets crop diseases like Ug99, we can strengthen food security and reduce hunger and poverty in countries like Afghanistan, Bangladesh, Ethiopia and Pakistan," said Robert Bertram, head of USAID's Office of Agriculture, Research and Technology. "This research concurrently helps U.S. scientists pro-America's wheat crops."

The scientists at the ARS Cereal Disease Laboratory are known worldwide for their expertise in tracking the emergence and spread of new virulent rust strains. The ARS scientists identify and characterize rust samples from all over the world and collaborate with national agricultural research systems in developing countries to identify new rust strains.

The St. Paul laboratory also plays a leading role in ARS' research program to discover new genetic resistance to stem rust and other rusts and incorporate those genes into new wheat breeding material. The new greenhouse will help speed the hunt for these vital resistance genes.

ARS is coordinating the evaluation of wheat lines from U.S. wheat breeders -

both public and private for resistance to Ug99 in Africa. Since 2005, more than 14 000 lines from 28 universities, 11 companies and eight ARS laboratories have been tested in Kenya. These efforts link closely with USAID's support of international wheat research programs that develop resistant varieties of wheat adapted to the needs of farmers in at-risk regions such as East Africa and South Asia.

ARS also is distributing wheat breeding lines, which have already proven their ability to stand up to Ug99 in cooperative test nurseries in Kenya and Ethiopia, to wheat breeders

and geneticists in 34 countries around the world.

The groundbreaking was part of a four-day research conference that drew 400 of the world's top wheat and barley experts to the University of Minnesota's St. Paul campus. The conference is sponsored by the Borlaug Global Rust Initiative, which was created with the support of the late Nobel Peace Prize laureate and University of Minnesota alumnus Norman Borlaug. The Borlaug Global Rust Initiative has led to international cooperation between ARS researchers and more than 40 other institutions and countries since





Nothing better than looking at really nice cattle. Unless it's looking at them while referencing some really deep individual data. Every cow is good at something, but in a few cases, the only thing they're good at is looking good. That's why we need records, unless money is of no importance.

Records should confirm those mature-weight guesses and, factoring in average weaning weights, point out the most and least efficient cows. Ear tag numbers should convey age at a glance, and the oldest cows have made us the most money. That's unless, again, we manage as if money is not important and let them stay regardless of whether they wean a calf each year.

Deeper data just goes into more detail on econom-

ically relevant traits. It's amazing what lies beneath the appearance and basics of weight and functionality. Uniformity can make a big difference, often \$300 or more between calves at today's prices, and we can learn a lot by comparing weights per day of age. The less uniform a calf crop, the more we give up lot-size premiums at auction. If we sell direct, every buyer knows the value differences only widen after weaning and he must bid conservatively on

That puts a premium on cows with a record of steady to higher adjusted-weaning weight. It incentivizes tight breeding and calving seasons, too.

uneven calves.

Maintaining excellent health is mostly management, but genetics may play a role as well. Those with

records often debit a cow's total points when her calves repeatedly turn up sick or dead after weaning.

Of course, sire influence

is a huge part of herd genetics. Sorting cows by sire and calves by sire group can point out which combinations work best and which pull the average down. Ten years ago, studies showed at least a \$1,500 value spread between yearling bulls that looked about the same and weighed the same, just based on progeny differences at weaning. That could be double today and taken another step, through finishing and into the packing house cooler, it could double again. But wait, as they say on infomercialsthere's more: if we keep replacement heifers, those differences could double again.

The optimum bull, chosen by his on-target estimated progeny differences (EPDs), registry and appearance, is a foundation decision. The unknown alternative bull can miss most progeny criteria, creating a downtrend in cow herd performance and quality.



Celebrate the dairy industry in June

Each June the dairy industry celebrates Dairy Month and promotes the importance of milk production, the nutritional value of dairy products, and the economic impact of the \$110 billion dairy industry to the United States.

"Dairy managers will be challenged in 2011-2012 to remain economically viable as feed and fuel prices increase," said Mike Hutjens, University of Illinois professor of animal sciences emeritus. "They will need to find ways to produce milk at an economical price for consumers while maintaining the highest quality milk possible."

Hutjens said dairy managers are continuing to play catch-up after an economically disastrous 2009 and 2010 business year with milk prices down 40 percent. Dairy managers need \$17.00 per 100 pounds or \$1.45 per gallon of milk sold to cover feed, variable, fix, and labor

costs with a return on as-

Although current milk prices have been favorable, Hutjens said three factors will impact the price of milk and dairy farm profit margins this

"First, milk prices depend on supply and demand with more than 13 percent of current U.S. milk solids being exported," he said. "World demand may be impacted by the financial status in Europe and unrest in the Mideast areas.'

In addition, corn prices will lower profit margins this year. He said the late planting of corn in the Midwest, flooding along major rivers, and drought in the Southwest will impact corn and feed prices.

He also expects that energy costs (price of oil) will impact fertilizer, fuel, and energy costs.

Hutjens said the most recent numbers are out for the "average" U.S. consumption of dairy prod-

ucts, and these numbers indicate a trend toward lower calorie diets. Dairy products that increased in consumption in 2009 compared to 2008 included yogurt (up 5.9 percent), cottage cheese (up 1.3 percent), reduced and low-fat milk (up 0.8 percent), and cheese (up 0.6 percent).

Flavored milk dropped 3.5 percent, whole milk dropped 2.8 percent, and ice cream dropped 2.4 percent.

The average expenditure for food in 2009 for a household was \$6,443 with dairy products accounting for \$430 of the total. Total fluid milk consumption was 20.7 gallons per per-

In this report, Hutjens said 52 ice cream flavors were listed with vanilla as the No. 1 ice cream flavor, followed by chocolate. Other unique ice cream flavors included coffee, moose track, peanut butter and chocolate, maple, orange, and egg nog.

U.S. had the highest milk yield per cow at 20,589 pounds per cow annually, followed closely by Japan at 20,564 pounds per cow. Other countries ranged from 18,484 pounds per cow in Canada, European Union at 12,156 pounds, China at 8,814 pounds, Russia at 7,518 pounds, and Mexico at 3,758 pounds per cow in 2009. Hutjens said consumption patterns throughout the world indicate wide variation and tremendous potential for future sales. For example, in the United States, fluid milk consumption was at 198 pounds per capita while China consumed pounds per capita.

"The international demand for high-quality protein and nutrients found in dairy products can become a huge market for U.S. dairy managers," Hutjens said.
