

Kansas farm groups endorse KARL program

Kansas farm groups have donated more than \$24,000 to the Kansas Agriculture and Rural Leadership (KARL) program, an educational non-profit organization, in the past year. KARL provides a two-year program offering intensive study, training and travel for future leaders in agriculture and rural communities. Commodity groups, the Kansas Farm Bureau, and agricultural banking groups, including the Kansas Bankers Association Ag Bankers Division and Farm Credit of Western Kansas support the programs offered by KARL. Commodity groups that have invested in

KARL include the Kansas Wheat Commission, Kansas Association of Wheat Growers, Kansas Corn Commission, Kansas Grain Sorghum Commission, Kansas Soybean Commission, Kansas Livestock Association, Kansas Cooperative Council and the Kansas Grain & Feed Association.

"Sponsoring the KARL program is not a difficult decision for Kansas Wheat. The successes and leadership roles achieved by the graduates of the program demonstrate its effectiveness. Many of our wheat leaders are KARL graduates," said Justin Gilpin, chief executive officer of

the Kansas Wheat Commission. "As the number of individuals involved in agriculture in the state decreases, the need for their individual voices to be heard increases. The Kansas Wheat Commission supports KARL, because KARL is good for Kansas agriculture."

Farm groups in Kansas have had a long and strong history of supporting KARL. "The Kansas commodity organizations and commissions endorse the KARL program through partnership investments because of its ability to supplement their leadership pool with graduates that have

been trained to deal with issues from rural development through international trade," said KARL president Jack Lindquist. "In fact, virtually all of the organizations have had KARL graduates on their boards and in top leadership roles. Over the past 18 years KARL has provided executive-level leadership training for farm organizations, making it the preferred leadership training program for many of the commodity leadership pools."

All funds for the program come from private and corporate support, donations and private grants.

KARL offices are housed on the Kansas State University campus under an agreement with the Kansas Cooperative Extension Service of KSU. More information

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Schwieterman Market Outlook

A marketing commentary by Bret Crofts

The corn and wheat markets had a rough week. Export sales were poor again with the corn at only 208,900 MT due to cancellations by "unknown destinations" and the wheat at 317,100 MT. The lack of exports seems to be weighing heavily on the corn and wheat since we aren't doing much to disprove USDA's ideas that exports are going to be low this year. In the case of the corn it would only take about 6 consecutive weeks of sales over 600,000 MT to start to convince USDA they are wrong, but we aren't getting it done. The poor sales number on Thursday seemed to be the cue traders were waiting for to put pressure on the corn and when the \$6.30 support failed in the December contract stops were hit and

traders started talking about the large option open interest at the \$6.00 level. \$6.00 puts that were worthless early in the week were suddenly picking up value and panic ensued.

Chart damage has been done to the corn and wheat. At this point we will probably have to get past Friday's option expiration before the markets can move anywhere. There will be lots of talk about the \$6.00 area in the December corn and it very likely that we will see the market gravitate there at some point in the week. After that the markets will be free to move higher, but we are going to have to see some consistent bullish news. It is sort of funny that we are dealing with the tightest corn ending stocks in years and yet we are

struggling to find bullish news, but as they say, a bull has to be fed.

On the positive side of the grain markets, ethanol production is very strong, and although there is still a long way to go in the crop year, it looks like it won't be a problem to reach USDA's usage estimate. Also, the drought monitor still shows that the bulk of the HRW Belt is in dire shape. There is going to have to be better moisture in the near futures

to have a wheat crop, but traders aren't too concerned about that right now since the current supply and demand situation suggests we can handle another crop disaster.

The outlook for the soybeans is actually improving for a change. We have had two good export sales weeks in a row and next week will be good as well due to large Chinese purchases. If the Chinese were to return to a purchasing pace similar to the past two years it would have a dramatic impact on the supply and demand tables. China is expected to import more soybeans than last year, but Argentina is expected to provide the extra supply and take some of our market share. If there is any hiccup in that plan it would have a major

impact on our prices, which is why S. American weather and shipping strike news will be important again this year.

On the charts, the January soybeans have basically held at the October low. The market pushed below the October low both Thursday and Friday, but closed above it both times. Friday's chart action was pretty

friendly by the end of the day with a nice reversal higher. We have an oversold market, divergence in the indicators, and improving fundamentals, all of which point to a bottom in the market. A close above \$12.00 in the January contract will confirm that the market has made a low.

The cattle on feed report was relatively friendly. The

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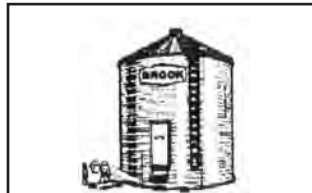
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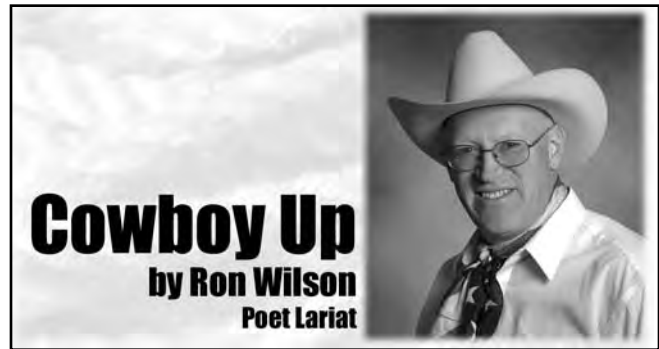
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The Budget Doesn't Budge

Cowboys have their priorities. We understand a limited budget and having to make choices — we're just not any dadgum good at it.

Unfortunately this philosophical statement may apply to me. I was reminded of this character flaw during the recent Flint Hills Cowboy Poetry Gathering in Alma.

The gathering itself was a success, which was remarkable considering the level of cowboy planning which went into it. By that I mean, a bunch of cowboys got together and thought a gathering sounded like fun, so we had one. Fortunately the Wabaunsee County Economic Development office got it all organized and it turned out very well.

Consultants have meetings. Lawyers have conferences. Professors have seminars, but cowboy poets have gatherings. Maybe we're just too independent and disorganized to do otherwise. Or maybe it's like gathering calves in spring or fall.

The credit for this gathering goes to Paul Schmitt and Trey Allen. Paul, from the St. Marys area, is a veteran cowboy poet, performer, and participant in cowboy poetry gatherings. He wanted to build on the momentum of last summer's cowboy poetry contest at the Symphony in the Flint Hills, and the idea of a local gathering met with enthusiastic support from poet Trey Allen and others. Trey did a lot of work in lining up entertainment and bringing in sponsors.

So on the first weekend of November, we had a gathering in Alma. Poets, gear-makers, artists and western fans came together. It was fun.

In the afternoon at the gathering were breakout sessions on different themes on which the cowboy poets were to expound. I was in a session titled "History and Philosophy."

Of course, restricting a cowboy poet to a given theme is like trying to contain the Kansas wind with a barbed wire fence. We did tend to wander a bit. But when I thought about a cowboy's philosophy, one of the elements which came to mind was frugality.

Cowboys can be quite thrifty. It just depends on the situation. For example, cowboys are good at conserving money when it comes to frills and optional expenditures such as, say, homes and children. But we're definitely willing to spend money when it comes to more important things such as hats and horses. You just have to have your priorities.

At least that's my philosophy.

K-State researchers study using CRP land for biomass feedstock production

Talk about a "green" idea — using land taken out of agricultural production for conservation purposes and later using plant materials from it to produce bio-fuels, while retaining conservation benefits for the land.

To that end, Kansas State University researchers are studying the feasibility of using land that had been enrolled in the U.S. Department of Agriculture's Conservation Reserve Program to grow plants for the bio-mass market.

"CRP is a program that began in 1985, that takes land out of crop production and puts it into perennial grassland in order to conserve soil and reduce surface water runoff," said K-State range scientist Keith Harmony. "When this project started in 2008, Kansas had about 3 million acres in CRP land, but by the end of 2011, about 50 percent of those CRP contracts will expire."

Harmony, who is based at K-State's Agricultural Research Center in Hays, is studying different ways to manage former CRP land that could produce biomass while retaining water quality, wildlife habitat and soil conservation benefits.

"We're looking to see if there are other ways that producers can utilize the CRP lands without putting them back into row crops," he said of the five-year study that began in 2008 and is scheduled to end with the harvest in 2012.

Kansas is one of six states involved in the study, and the 18-acre CRP site near Hays is the only site in Kansas. Other states in the study are Montana, North

Dakota, Oklahoma, Missouri and Georgia.

The research, sponsored by the U.S. Department of Energy and Sun Grant Initiative, examines different management strategies, including using no nitrogen fertilizer, applying 50 pounds of N per acre and applying 100 pounds of N per acre.

The dominant grasses on the acreage are sideoats grama, indiagrass, little bluestem, switchgrass and big bluestem. A significant amount of yellow sweet-clover is also present.

"The harvest management we're studying is close to peak standing crop, shortly after the midpoint of summer, after July 15, and the other is at the end of the season after the first frost," Harmony said. The July 15 date is important because it marks the end of the Kansas grassland bird-nesting season, so harvesting after that date, in late July or early August, avoids disturbing any nesting birds.

"This research project is a little bit different than your typical plot research experiments," the range scientist said. "It's much larger scale. Each of the plots is one acre in size, which means we've been able to use typical field scale equipment to harvest the plots — just like the swathers and balers that producers would use."

The stand was cut to a height of 6 inches, leaving a 6-inch stubble to maintain soil and water erosion.

The research so far shows that while fertilizing with 50 or 100 pounds of nitrogen per acre statistically increased yield over the non-fertilized treatment,

the overall increase was not as efficient as expected, Harmony said.

"Nitrogen fertilization has increased productivity," he said. "We've been able to increase production by about 600 pounds per acre from having 50 pounds of nitrogen fertilizer, and just a little over 1,000 pounds an acre from utilizing 100 pounds of nitrogen per acre," but noted that with current rates of production and returns, harvesting biomass from CRP land without adding N fertilizer is more profitable.

As part of the study, the researchers are tracking plant populations and plant composition to see how they've changed over time due to harvest management and nitrogen treatments.

"We've also collected soil samples so we'll be able to track how soil nutrient status has changed over time, as well as some of the other soil properties," Harmony said.

After the 10 year contract expires on CRP program acres, producers have often had the option to re-enroll in CRP or to plant back to row crops, he said. Since the study began, thousands of Kansas CRP acres have been planted back to grain crops, but thousands of CRP acres have also been re-enrolled with new contracts.

"This project is important because Kansas currently has about 2.5 million acres of CRP lands, much of which will soon be coming out of the program, so any research that involves CRP has the potential to have a big impact and affect a large acreage of Kansas lands," the researcher said.
