### MELVIN SHIPLEY

#### Longtime Kansas Hampshire Breeder Dies

Melvin Shipley, 83, of Esbon, Kansas, passed away at his farm which he lived at his entire life on April 28, 2012.

Melvin began raising purebred Hampshire breeding stock with the purchase of 10 Hampshire gilts and 1 Hampshire boar in 1951. He was instrumental in many areas of the swine industry until 1996, when he sold all of his sows. He was a charter member of the Jewell County Pork Producers, the NCK Pork Producers, the Waconda Area Swine Producers, the Kansas Pork Producers Association, and the Kansas Hampshire Breeders Association. Melvin was an early supporter of the Purebred Boar testing stations at Manhattan and Valley Center, Kansas and SENEK boar testing at Wymore, Nebraska. He participated in many area, state, and national swine shows placing near or at the top each time. He was well respected world-wide for his purebred Hampshire breeding stock.

Melvin liked to help youth. He spent many hours helping 4-H'ers and FFA'ers with their livestock projects. He especially liked to help with livestock judging, hosting many contests and workouts. He also raised a reputation commercial Angus herd with buyers wanting his steers and heifers.

Melvin never retired from the farm that was his life. In his later years he loved to raise watermelons, cantaloupe, pumpkins, and decorative gourds, not for sale, but to give to anyone that would take them. He loved to work with his hands. His hobby was to make barbwire windmills, horseshoe cowboys, barnwood picture frames, hedge root decorative, and several other wood projects, all to give away to neighbors, friends, relatives, and people he met along his life's journey.

His bride of 57 years, lone, still lives on the family farm. His son Gary and wife Teresa, live and work on the farm near Esbon. His son, Lyle and wife Pennie, pastor in the United Methodist Church at Coalgate, Okla., and his daughter, Melva and husband John Harvey, manage a landscaping business near Raymore, Mo. He has eight grandchildren and one great grandchild due in August.

## Youth Beef Quality Assurance training modules now available online

Beef industry youth have the opportunity to become certified in Beef Quality Assurance (BQA) online at no cost. The Beef Cattle Institute at Kansas State University has launched a Youth Animal Care Training program.

The BQA program teaches participants about implementing best management practices to help enhance herd profitability and improve consumer confidence in high quality beef products. With increased public attention on animal welfare, BQA enables youth and producers to demonstrate their commitment to food safety and quality.

The program features free online educational training modules for youth through high school age. By participating in the training, youth can improve their knowledge of animal handling, animal welfare, antimicrobial residue avoidance and food safety. After a training package is completed, a certificate is available for printing.

Through the support of Beef Cattle Institute sponsors, the training packages, certification and electronic record of training are offered to youth at no cost.

"Animal handling, welfare, and disease prevention and control are very important management concepts to anyone who raises beef cattle," said Dan Thomson, DVM, assistant dean of outreach for K-State's College of Veterinary Medicine. "As we move forward, it's essential to teach our industry youth these practices early on so they become more routine and instinctive."

Youth can work through the multimedia training modules at any time. Once all the modules within a package are completed and the quizzes are passed with 80 percent accuracy or higher, a certificate is available. There is no time limit or deadline to complete the modules and quizzes.

The program is designed to provide valuable online training in various areas of

animal care. Each package is different in the length of time it takes to complete all of the modules. However, each module ranges from five to 20 minutes long.

The current training packages are:

- Youth Beef Quality Assurance (28 modules)

- Youth Dairy Animal Care and Quality Assurance (31 modules)

Youth need to re-certify every three years to keep their certificate for Beef Quality Assurance up-to-date. The system will send an email a month before the certification is up as a reminder to re-certify.

"As an educational program, BQA helps producers, including young cattle producers, identify management practices that can be improved," said Ryan Ruppert, senior director of Beef Quality Assurance at the National Cattlemen's Beef Association. "The program raises consumer confidence through offering proper management techniques and a commitment

to quality within every segment of the beef industry. BQA is all about continuous improvement, and these modules get the future farmers and ranchers off on the right foot for a life time of improvement in beef production."

The efforts of Beef Quality Assurance have been instrumental in recent successes that continue to rebuild and sustain beef demand. Through BQA programs, new and experienced producers recognize the economic value of committing to quality beef production at every level, not just at the feedlot or packing plant, but within every segment of the cattle industry.

"Youth are not tomorrow's leaders; they're today's leaders. We must provide them with the tools to help them learn and move the industry forward," Thomson said.



## Tractor Safety Course — June 4 & 5

A Hazardous Occupations Training course (tractor safety) will be conducted on Monday, June 4 and Tuesday, June 5 at KanEquip in Wamego. The class will run from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. the first day, and from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. on day two.

The course is taught by KSU Extension agents from Pottawatomie, Riley, Shaw-nee and Wabaunsee counties and is recommended for youths age 12 and older. Any youth 14 or 15 years old who will operate a tractor for someone other than their parent is required to pass the course to be legally employed. Youths age 12 and 13 are welcome to participate in the class, but can't be certified until age 14.

Two hours of practical tractor experience is also required for certification. A parent or employer will supervise the two hours of practical experience at a later date. Actual tractor driving will not be included in the safety course.

## Checkoff invites farmers to help tell sustainability story

An investment of just a few minutes of time and a few clicks of the mouse can help farmers demonstrate the high sustainability performance of U.S. soy. The payoff could include helping to retain and increase all U.S. soybean farmers' markets.

Some major customers of U.S. soy want to source sustainable ingredients for food, feed, fiber and biofuel.

The United Soybean Board (USB) and soy check-off remain committed to helping U.S. soy farmers demonstrate their excellent sustainability performance. One new example of the effort is a checkoff partnership with the National Institute for Sustainable Agriculture (NISA) on an Internet-based questionnaire to help gather data to show U.S. soybean farmers already use sustainable management practices.

"We don't want a list of standards U.S. farmers have to meet that are created by people who know nothing

about today's agriculture," explains Wisconsin farmer Chuck Prellwitz, a former soy checkoff farmer-director and current NISA board member. "Instead, we want a way of measuring what farmers have already done to grow their products sustainably."

Farmers can visit [www.CoolBean.info](http://www.CoolBean.info) to complete the confidential and anonymous Soybean Assessment Tool or Whole-Farm Assessment Tool questionnaires. Prellwitz encourages all U.S. farmers to participate.

The results will be segmented by region because best management practices are dependent on factors that vary regionally, such as soil, water, and weather. As

one way of demonstrating soy's sustainability performance, the checkoff and NISA could use the data to show U.S. soy customers the share of U.S. farmers who have adopted sustainable best management practices appropriate for their region.

"This is another example of a farmer-driven effort to show our customers that we're sustainable before some non-agriculture group tells us what to do and how to do it," says soy checkoff farmer-director Mary Lou Smith, who farms in southeastern Michigan and serves on USB's Sustainability Initiative Leadership Team. "The goal is to compile more information to show that our agricultur-

al practices are sustainable."

The soy checkoff has already conducted an independent, third-party life-cycle assessment that demonstrates the sustainability performance of U.S. soy production and processing. The checkoff also continues to support the Field-print Calculator, another sustainability tool that U.S. farmers may use for free. This tool can show farmers the effects of various farm-management decisions on the sustainability performance of their farm, including the financial impacts of those decisions.







# Schwieterman Market Outlook

*A marketing commentary by Bret Crotts*

May 10th is the May supply and demand report. It is the first look at the new crop estimates and can be full of surprises. The Prospective Plantings Report said we should expect 95.9 million acres of corn, 55.9 million acres of wheat, and 73.9 million acres of soybeans, but that isn't necessarily what USDA will print in the report. The strong early planting pace could lead USDA to increase the corn acreage estimate, the late March surge in Minneapolis wheat may have attracted spring wheat acres, and the spread between soybeans and corn may result in some switching, along with more double crop acres. There are obviously a number of variables at work, so it is hard to guess which ones USDA will pay attention to, so my guess is they will make very few acreage changes until the June Planted Acreage report. As for the yield, there is plenty of fear out there that USDA will add to their already inflated trend line estimate of 164 bu/ac due to the fast planting pace. There really isn't a correlation between early planting pace and final yield, but USDA has a tendency to make these adjustments anyway. It really wouldn't be a surprise to see them use 166. For wheat they will use 44.6 bu/ac and for the soybeans they will use 44.

End users in Illinois are now paying as much as 60 over the July contract for corn. When interior basis levels reach that level it is either because there is little corn to be found or the futures mar-

ket is much, much, too low. With the basis strong, the May contract has been forced to a record wide spread level versus the July contract in order to avoid forced deliveries. At Friday's settlement the May was 42 cents over the July and traded wider than that during the day. With all this spread activity and basis strength it is very disappointing that the July futures haven't performed better. The market had a strong rebound from Friday's lows and only lost 5 cents for the week, but with the cash market so strong, I expect to see more strength. The old crop charts do look promising after Friday's reversal higher and I still expect to see the July market move to \$6.50 soon. The December contract, however, is a different story. The December fell to new multi-month lows this week and traders are very worried about what USDA may come up with for a production estimate. Some guesses are as high as 14.9 billion bushels, which would roughly equate to 97 million acres and a 168 yield. Until the report has passed, it will be difficult for the December contract to move higher.

The wheat was the downside leader this week. The July KW lost 32 cents for the week and is now less than 7 cents above the July corn. I won't be surprised to see that spread at zero or less in the very near future.

It should be no surprise that the charts look very bearish. There really isn't any support under this market until the \$6.00 area and the only real

hope for strength in the wheat is strength in the corn. The wheat is a feed grain at this point and newly harvested wheat should quickly replace corn in the feed mix, at least temporarily.

The wheat tour suggested that the Kansas yield could be record high at 49.1 bu/ac, but I seriously doubt that will happen. There will be plenty of wheat in Kansas, but there is a large area in the western part of the state that will be a drag on the yield. The tours guess was a 400 million crop, but I think 370 is more realistic.

The soybeans posted

reversals lower Wednesday after posting new highs. The subsequent pressure led to 15 cent losses for the week. Reversals lower are often sign of a top in the market, and in this case it was most likely just the beginning of a bull market correction, which may have already ended. The May supply and demand report will most likely be very friendly to the soybeans. USDA is clearly underestimating old crop exports and their biggest challenge will be to print believable new crop demand estimates while keeping the ending stocks estimate from being uncomfortably low. The soybean fundamentals are bullish, but the question is how bullish will USDA's numbers be?

The feeder cattle bottomed in early April, but it took until Thursday for me to be convinced that the June live cattle found

a low. Thursday's limit higher move was impressive and should result in follow through buying next week.

Boxed beef prices are holding the recent gains, which is encouraging and cash cattle are at a premium to the June, which is supportive to the futures.

# Guest Editorial

The U.S. Senate Agriculture Committee recently approved its version of the 2012 Farm Bill. In today's partisan climate where everything seems to turn into a political issue, Sen. Pat Roberts, R-Kansas, and the other members of the committee deserve high accolades for their swift, bipartisan passage of a commonsense plan that protects American agriculture while at the same time reducing our nation's debt by an es-

timated \$23 billion. And while the bill's commodity title gets most of the attention in the news, I would argue that the conservation section of the bill, Title II, is just as important, if not more so, to the future of America. After all, if we don't protect and preserve our nation's natural resources, we won't have any land on which to farm in the future. Whether you're involved in agriculture or not, the benefits of strong conservation efforts affect everyone. We all eat, and we all need clean and air

and water. With the world's population on the rise, the sustainability of our food supply has never been more critical. The conservation title in the Senate bill streamlines and consolidates programs for increased efficiency and ease-of-use for producers while maintaining critical funding for valuable technical assistance that helps ensure conservation best practices. While the bill would cut \$6 billion in conservation program funding, I

fully understand that all of us, in every sector of the economy, must be prepared to make sacrifices in the current economic climate. However, additional cuts beyond this amount could put the viability of these programs at risk. Producers in Kansas and all across the country are already faced with the challenge of doing more with less, and conservation is a tool that is available to every producer. Not only do farm bill conservation programs play a key role in supporting clean air, clean water, and productive soils, they also help producers implement conservation practices through

voluntary, incentive-based methods rather than through a top-down, regulatory approach. In addition, conservation programs support our nation's long-term economic and food security. I think everyone would agree it's better to make a long-term investment in our natural resources today than be forced to pay escalated costs for repair in the future. It's time for Congress to take action and pass a farm bill before it's too late. Contact your congressional representatives and let them know that you support funding for conservation programs.
