

## Chinese officials complimentary, optimistic about future with U.S. soy

When a group of U.S. soybean farmers stepped off a plane in China last month, they anticipated a celebration of 30 years of partnership. What they got, however, was a whole lot more. The work of the soy checkoff through the United Soybean Board (USB) and its international marketing arm, the U.S. Soybean Export Council (USSEC), has paid dividends in China and the officials wanted to make sure these farmers knew it.

"We're more than just a supplier of soybeans, but that is part of it," says Vanessa Kummer, a soybean farmer from Colfax, N.D., and chair of USB. "We've helped them improve their food safety and, during this visit, we heard how much they appreciate it."

The Chinese aquaculture industry is a big part of this partnership. The soy check-off funds projects that help increase the food safety and growth rates for fish farmers, and the group of U.S. soy farmers heard about the positive success of these programs.

"Fish are a big part of the Chinese diet, so the aquaculture industry is a major player in their economy," adds Kummer. "The checkoff has helped these

fish farmers achieve the right rations and populations, which lessens negative effects."

Through checkoff-funded demonstrations, USSEC helps show the Chinese aquaculture industry how to lessen disease and pollution in their production systems. Soy-based diets play a role in these improved practices. As the Chinese increase their protein consumption, soy meal use in animal feed continues to increase. Kummer notes the checkoff also works in other

animal sectors, including China's fast-growing poultry sector.

"The people we met with in China recognize the investment U.S. soybean farmers have made in their food security," says Kummer. "They appreciate our partnerships and look forward to the future of our business relationships together."

The relationship continues to grow demand for U.S. soy, as well. In 2011, the United States exported a record 895 million bushels of soybeans to China.

## Kansas corn production forecast revised down again

(AP) — A new government report is forecasting a Kansas corn and soybean crop that could be the smallest harvest in the state since 2006.

Kansas Agricultural Statistics Service reported last Wednesday that corn for grain production in Kansas

is now expected to be 382.2 million bushels. That is down 2 percent from August and is 15 percent below last year.

The estimate is based on an average yield of 91 bushels per acre from 4.2 million harvested acres.

The new forecast pegs

the soybean crop at 70.4 million bushels. That is down 5 percent from last month and down 31 percent from last year.

Grain sorghum remained unchanged over last month with 88 million bushels, down 20 percent from last year.

# Ag Heritage Park plans corn picking, shelling & grinding for Old Settler’s Day September 22

Ag Heritage Park, in Alta Vista, plans for a full day of activities to celebrate Alta Vista's Old Settler's Day, Saturday, September 22, while celebrating the town's 125th anniversary. Ag Heritage Park will be open all day from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Demonstrations of old-time corn picking with a tractor-powered one-row corn picker and tractor-powered shellers are planned Saturday afternoon at 1:30 p.m., in a corn field just south of the Park, at Main Street and Highway 4. Also part of the demonstration will be a horse-powered ear corn grinder. Visitors will park in the field where they can get a bird's-eye view of the picking and shelling.

A quilt show is also on the Park schedule this Saturday, open to anyone and any type of quilt, vintage or new, individuals or guilds. The quilts will be on display at the main museum building from 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., with registration beginning at 8:00 a.m. Included in the quilt display will be a quilt by the 2012 Dwight and Alta Vista art students, kindergarten through eighth

grade. The pattern, "The Prairie," is a painted blocks quilt. The quilt was assembled by Bessie Lighthall and Jane Kirke-minde and machine quilted.

There will be a drawing for a tractor quilt throw, made and donated by Connie Larson, at 4:00 in the afternoon, with the donations benefiting Ag Heritage Park. Tickets for the tractor quilt throw will be available all day, and the winner does not have to be present at 4:00 to win.

On Old Settler's Day, Ag Heritage Park will be introducing a new attraction to the area, new barn quilt blocks displayed on the main museum building. This program is scheduled for 10:00 a.m. The pair of barn quilt blocks sport the pattern "Home Treasure" and are painted by quilt artist Susan Kesl, and contributed by Chase Kesl. Susan chose the red, white and blue color theme to be truly Americana, depicting real rural heritage. Barn quilt blocks are an art painting replica of a quilt block pattern. In some rural areas of the United States the barn quilt blocks are likened to

a clothesline – quilts on barns that will stretch a trail across the nation. # Schwieterman Market Outlook

A marketing commentary by Bret Crotts

The September supply and demand report was disappointing to the corn bulls. Production was cut less than expected because there was no change to the harvested acres figure, but the big surprise was the 150 million bushel drop in old crop feed/residual usage, which resulted in much higher than expected beginning stocks. Old crop ending stocks now stand at 1.181 billion, which would imply that all those end users who had trouble sourcing corn and were paying high basis levels were wrong; the corn was there all the time. Also, with the new crop ending stocks estimate at 733 million bushels the talk about changing the ethanol mandate should go away because there is plenty of corn. Actually, what USDA said was that the feed/residual usage was cut due to record maturity and harvest progress as of September 1st. That makes interpreting the supply and demand report very tricky, because that says to me that production was actually increased in this report, not decreased.

Looking ahead to future supply and demand reports, there will be plenty of questions about production, ranging from how much was harvested, to when was it harvested? Many analysts still believe that harvested acreage should be cut and there are also those that suggest FSA data points to

higher planted acreage. We also have the September stocks report out at the end of the month that will add to the confusion because that report is the "final" word on old crop ending stocks. How will that handle the early harvest? What if there aren't as many old crop bushels as the supply and demand report suggests? These Quarterly Stocks Reports have become notorious for causing confusion and volatility and the next one will not be an exception.

As for the corn charts, things aren't looking so good. The December corn has made four consecutive closes below the 50-day moving average and twice this week the 50-day has acted, and held, as resistance. That doesn't look friendly at all. Harvest is upon us, which is replenishing supplies, and it is totally normal to have "harvest pressure" and that could last several more weeks. The pressure will end when either harvest winds down or demand picks up. We haven't attracted a lot of fresh export demand on this break, which doesn't give the bulls much confidence and gives end users a reason to be patient. The slipping market, the poor technical outlook, and the seasonal tendency for pressure at this time of year leads me to believe that this is a perfect time to sell cash grain to eliminate downside risk and use prices breaks as oppor-

tunities to replace your grain with call options. There is still plenty to be bullish about in the corn market, but it is best to take a practical risk management approach.

There were no changes to the wheat supply and demand numbers, which wasn't really surprising, but I still think that at some point feed usage will have to be increased. On the charts, the wheat is the opposite of the corn. Instead of trying to fall out of the bottom of the trading range the wheat is trying to move out the top of the range. Although USDA didn't change the U.S. supply and demand numbers and barely changed the world numbers, the wheat market fundamentals are becoming more bullish. The Russians are running out of wheat, it is dry in Australia and in a big part of the HRW Belt, and we still aren't sure what US corn production will end

up at. Either the December or March Kansas City wheat contract will make it to \$11.50.

The soybean supply and demand numbers will be a little friendlier than expected with production falling to 2.634 billion bushels. The most interesting part of the report was the decision to leave new crop ending stocks at 115 million bushels despite the lower carry in and lower production. That means demand was cut across the board and it implies that if you want part of that last 115 million bushels, you are going to have to pay up for it. So far the market is doing a poor job of slowing demand and that means the market will have to go even higher later on to keep us from running out of soy-

beans. Buy breaks.

Cash cattle traded at \$127 for the most part and there were some even higher than that. The October futures reached \$128.775, but didn't hold gains. I think that after a little more corrective activity the October contract will end up reaching \$129 and possibly \$131.50. As for the October feeder cattle, there is a double top on the chart that suggests we will see a test of support at the \$144 level at some point next week.

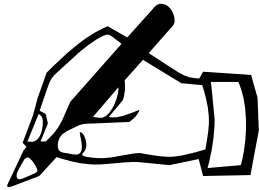

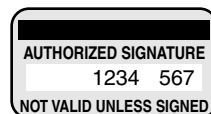



# New resource available from Kansas State for producers of raw commodities

A new resource published by Kansas State University will provide producers of raw commodities and other durable food products with the information needed to protect stored products from insects, molds and vertebrate pests.

"Many changes in government regulations that influenced stored product protection and advances in pest management tech-

niques have occurred," said Thomas Phillips, K-State Research and Extension entomologist and one of the editors of the publication.

Stored Product Protection, \$156, is an update and companion book to Stored Product Management, E912, published by Oklahoma State University in 1995. The expanded information in the new book from K-State Research and Extension in-

cludes information on pest management in grain and other raw commodities, and in food processing facilities and other food product storage situations.

The training manual gives readers an understanding of pest biology, behavior and ecology in the marketing system, pest management methods, including fumigation and other chemical controls as well as non-chemical methods and pertinent economic and regulatory considerations for vari-

ous products, Phillips said.

The book is written for those involved with commodity storage and management, food processing and pest management, including members of the academic, government and private sector research and regulatory communities.

# Entries for Kansas Junior Livestock Show hit record number

Youth from 91 counties have entered 1,764 animals in the 80th Kansas Junior Livestock Show (KJLS). This is the largest number of livestock entered in 25 years.

A total of 750 exhibitors plan to bring 147 market steers, 329 breeding heifers, 305 market hogs, 101 breeding gilts, 300 market lambs, 70 purebred ewes, 191 commercial ewes, 231 meat goats and 90 commercial doe kids to the show. The statewide event will take place September 21-24 at the Kansas Pavilions near Wichita.

Pottawatomie County leads the state with the most exhibitors, 31, and the largest number of breeding heifers, 23. Johnson County has entered the most total livestock, 81, and tops the steer, market lamb and commercial ewe categories, with 10, 21 and

11 head, respectively. Coffey County exhibitors entered the most market hogs, 18.

Franklin County youth are bringing nine breeding gilts, which represents the largest number for this category. The purebred ewe division is led by Lyon County, with ten entries. Labette County competitors have entered the most meat goats, 15, and commercial doe kids, 11.

The grand and reserve steers, hogs, lambs and goats will be sold during the KJLS Auction of Champions, September 24 at 7:00 p.m. The public is welcome and encouraged to support the event by bidding on livestock in the live auction. In many cases, exhibitors of the winning animals use the money earned from the auction to help fund their college educations and

buy next year's livestock projects.

Prior to the premium sale, KJLS will present a number of scholarships ranging from \$750 to \$2,500 to exhibitors who have excelled academically, in community service and in 4-H/FFA. A total of \$305,100 in scholarships has been presented to 243 KJLS exhibitors since the program's inception in 1993. Last year, a total of \$21,500 was awarded to 11 exhibitors. The scholarship program is funded primarily through private contributions and income generated by the Beef-eaters Barbecue held in the Sam Fulco Pavilion prior to the auction. Tickets to the barbecue, which will begin at 5:30 p.m., are \$60 and can be purchased at the door that evening or in advance by calling Cheryl Smith at (316) 390-0285.

"The responsibility of preparing for and showing at this event provides a great learning experience for Kansas youth," said KJLS president Ed Frey of Wichita. "We invite individuals and businesses to help reward these young people for their hard work by attending the Beef-eaters Barbecue, participating in the sale or contributing to the scholarship fund."

Separate from the selection of species championships, a showmanship contest will be held. The top showman in both the junior and senior divisions of each species will receive a silver belt buckle. Prizes also will be awarded for second through fifth place in each division.

The Kansas Livestock Foundation (KLF) will sponsor a club calf show and sale during KJLS. Steer and heifer prospects

from some of the top club calf producers in the Midwest will be consigned. The event will take place September 22. Sale proceeds will go toward KLF Youth in Agriculture scholarships. Major sponsors for KJLS are the Kansas Livestock Association, Kansas State University and the Agri-Business Council of Wichita. In addition to these groups, hundreds of volunteers from across the state help organize and put on the show.

"This really helps fill a gap," said Karen Kollars, agritourism development

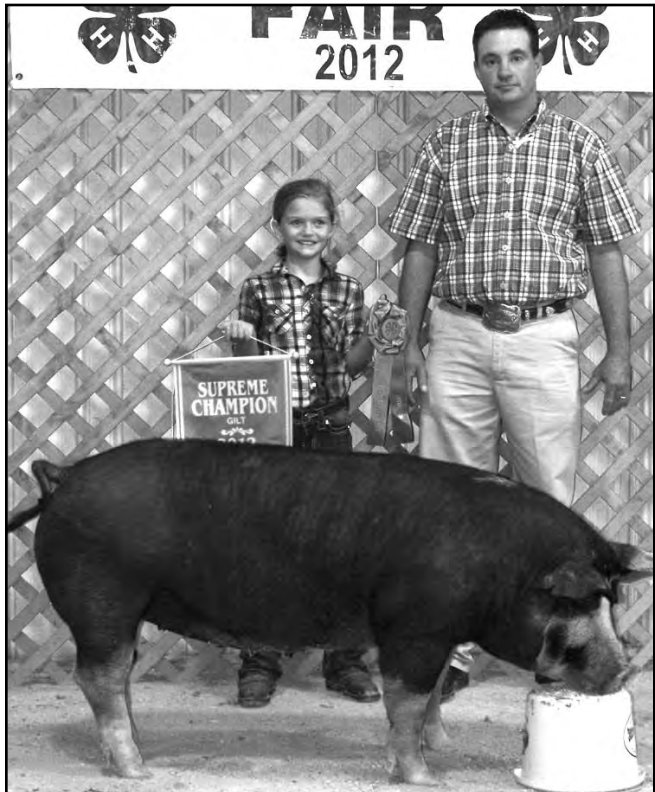

- Checklists that opera-

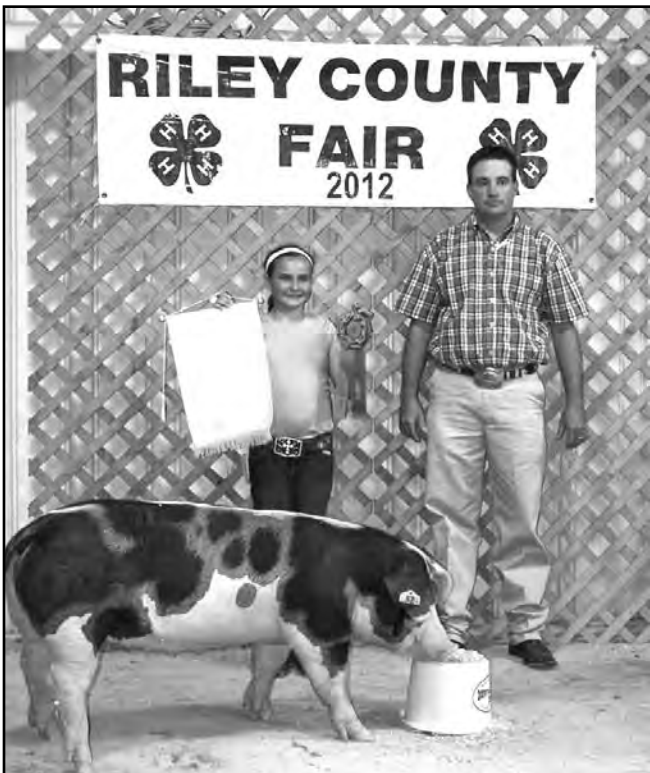
tors can print and use to conduct customized walk-throughs to identify safety issues and hazards in their operations.

Chip Ramsay, general manager of Rex Ranch in western Nebraska, advised producers to inventory their resources and consider the end goals of their operation before making management decisions.

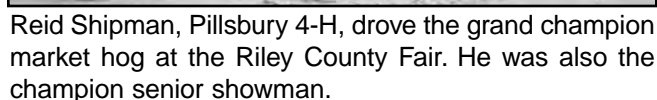
create something from nothing," Ramsay said at the conference. "Most of us inherit something and we have to take inventory to determine what we have, because that makes a difference in where we want to head," he said.

Ramsay also advised producers to do research on their options and seek advice from experts as they plan and explore management options.

"It's tough to write things down, especially in our industry, because our biggest strength is our flexibility,"

While it is difficult at times for producers to identify and nail down a direction they want to go, it is essential to moving forward. Just because a goal or direction is written down does not mean it cannot be changed, Ramsay said. It will be crucial to re-evaluate and adapt along the way.
