



# Schwieterman Market Outlook

*A marketing commentary by Bret Crotts*

We started the week with the August supply and demand report, which gave us some bullish surprises in terms of lower ending stocks in the corn, wheat, and soybeans and lower than expected production in the corn and soybeans. We also had data released by the FSA that suggested, perhaps, that the "Prevented Planting" acres might be larger than expected, which helped boost the market. In addition there are concerns about the development of the corn and soybean crops, which were exacerbated by extended forecasts calling for an early freeze in late September. Combining these bullish elements with

markets that were oversold created an atmosphere that was primed for a short covering or corrective rally, and that is what we got, at least in the soybean market.

The market activity for the corn and wheat wasn't quite as bullish as one would have hoped for given the circumstances and the December corn was only up about 10 cents for the week while the wheat finished the week slightly lower. In the case of the corn it feels like we are dealing with a lot of conflicting information with some areas expecting record production while others are still dealing with the effects of a wet spring and cool summer. While USDA did cut the yield estimate to 154.4 bu/ac the production estimate of 13.763 billion is still record large, and will still be record large even if we cut acreage, so that is some-

thing that weighs on traders' minds. There is a good chance that even with stronger exports and reduced acreage, ending stocks will be double last year and higher than the past 3 years. Average farm price in the 2010/2011 crop year was \$5.18 with 1.128 billion bushels of ending stocks. Our current ending stocks estimate is 1.837 billion, so it will probably take at least a 500 million bushel cut in ending stocks for futures to trade consistently over \$5.00 during the next crop year. That leads me to believe that rallies are still for selling and that we are a very long way from turning the trend back up.

As for the wheat, that market seems to be going nowhere. With ending stocks cut to 551 million and solid export sales, one would think the wheat would perform better, but the corn market has acted as an anchor and when the corn is strong it seems that the wheat is used as the short leg of spreads. There is still potential for the wheat to show independent strength, but we will have to continue to see solid export sales. Meanwhile the July 14 Kansas City wheat made a new contract low this week and with the planting conditions improving it will difficult for that contract to show any signs of strength.

The November soybeans were the best performers of the week, gaining 76 cents. Yield was cut to 42.6 bu/ac, planted acres were cut to 77.2 million, production was

cut by 165 million and ending stocks were cut by 75 million to 220 million. 220 million is still a big jump from the 125 million for the old crop, but this level it only take one big week of export sales to have traders wonder how tight supplies will be next summer. Throw in the threat of yet another lower acreage estimate in the fall and we have the makings of a bull market. The lower acreage will have

to be confirmed in order to see the market above \$13.00, but keep in the back of your mind that there is some upside potential in the soybeans. In the short run the market is overbought and has stalled out at trend line resistance, so I am looking for some pressure. If the crop condition ratings don't crop significantly the USDA yield cut will be called into question and the bulls will be forced to hope for an early freeze to keep yields in check.

August feeder cattle reached the highest level since March thanks to rising prices at the sales barns. Judging by the daily numbers of the feeder index, the August contract should make it over \$155. The deferred contracts still have

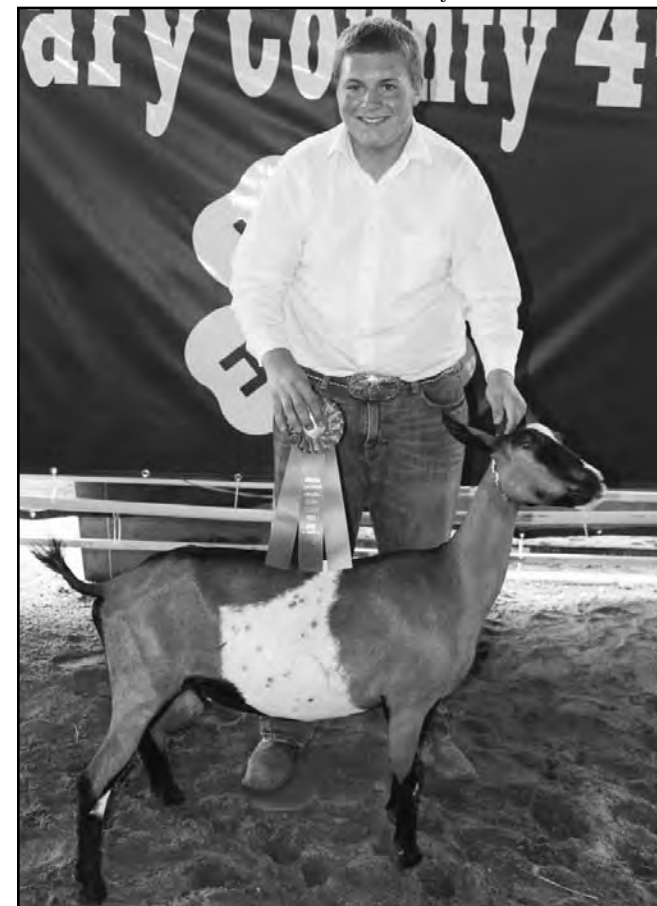
some work to do to make new highs and that will be impacted by the corn and the deferred live cattle. Merck is going to stop selling Zilmax in N. America, which should be supportive to cattle prices since it should result in lower carcass weights and lower beef production. The December live cattle did reach the highest level since late March, but Friday's close was not impressive. I like the fundamentals, but I'm not in love with the charts.

The most recent U.S. Cattle inventory report indicates that the U.S. beef herd is the smallest it has been since 1952. If and when beef herd expansion occurs those cattlemen who can provide high quality replacement females have the potential to access another revenue stream.

A new program developed by K-State Research and Extension in conjunction with the Kansas Department of Agriculture should help Kansas producers be at the forefront of the beef herd repopulation effort.

The Sunflower Supreme heifer development program is focused on implementing selection criteria and management practices that increase the long-term value of heifers selected as replacement females. The program is modeled after the Missouri "Show Me Select Program" and will provide the option for those heifers which successfully meet all of the program guidelines to be marketed through a special sale.

The intent of the Sunflower Supreme program is to provide knowledge, guidance and tools to assist beef producers in improving reproductive performance of replacement heifers and in

turn increase cow longevity within a herd. These goals will be reached by the adoption of effective health protocols, successfully utilizing available technologies and using available genetic predictors. The main areas of emphasis of the program will be on decreasing dystocia issues, improving herd health, and using techniques and selection criteria that improve conception rates.

Expected Progeny Differences (EPDs) are the most reliable tool to minimize calving difficulty. All breed associations report EPD's for birth weight (BW) and several report EPD's for calving ease direct (CED) as well. If available the calving ease direct EPD is a better predictor of dystocia problems in first calf heifers because in addition to sire differences in birth weight this EPD is calculated accounting for differences in calving score as well. The CED EPD is reported as a percentage of unassisted births and therefore producers should select sires with a higher CED value.

The Sunflower Supreme program is designed to encourage producers to work with their veterinarian in developing a whole herd health management plan, with emphasis on respiratory and reproductive health.

The vaccination guidelines involved in the program can be adapted to any operation with guidance from their veterinarian about type and booster requirements of each vaccine.

Additionally, this program will require all producers to receive Beef Quality Assurance (BQA) training at/or around enrollment time. This training will help producers understand and implement correct management techniques. This will help to guide producers into initiating correct welfare programs and can open up additional marketing opportunities.

Heifers in the Sunflower Supreme program can be bred by either artificial insemination or natural service. This program encourages a 60-day breeding season, which helps in selecting those heifers that reach puberty earlier and should have a more productive lifetime. In addition to choosing a breeding strategy, and synchronization protocol, this program hopes to help producers improve reproductive success by evaluating heifers prior to breeding with a breeding soundness exam completed 30 to 45 days prior to breeding. At the pre-breeding exam, heifers should be weighed, body condition scored (BCS), evaluated for repro-

ductive tract status, and correct size and shape of the pelvis.

This will be a great educational tool for producers and all the guidelines can be adopted in any operation raising replacement females. With expanded collaboration between producers, Extension, and local veterinarians, this program will add value and additional revenue to southeast Kansas cow herds and provide quality replacement heifers to increase the demand for Kansas cattle.

## Eastern Kansas Grazing School September 11-12

Rotational grazing is one way in which cattle producers can use rangeland and forages as efficiently as possible. That's one of the topics that will be discussed at the third annual Eastern Kansas Grazing School planned for Sept. 11-12 in Ottawa.

The event, hosted by K-State Research and Extension, will be at the Franklin County Fairgrounds, 1737 S. Elm St. and area pastures. It will feature presentations by K-State Research and Extension, the U.S. Department of Agriculture's Natural Resource Conservation Service and private industry, including:

Mark Green, NRCS-based in Missouri, and Wesley Tucker, agricultural economist with University of Missouri Extension, will share their experiences;

Dale Strickler with Star Seed, Inc., will present information on complementary forages and share his experiences with rotational grazing; Doug Shoup, K-State Research and Extension southeast area Extension agronomist, will address the basics of grass growth; Jaymelynn Farney, SE area Extension animal scientist, will discuss animal behavior and interaction as they graze; David Kraft, NRCS state rangeland management specialist will present "The Art and Science of Grazing" and along with Doug Spencer, NRCS rangeland conservationist, will conduct a hands-on pasture allocation exercise; and

A fencing demonstration will highlight advances in electrified fences.

## Low cost trees available

The Kansas Forest Service is taking orders for low-cost tree seedlings offered through their conservation tree planting program. Orders will be taken September 3 through October 11. Landowners are encouraged to place their orders early to ensure they get the plants they want. The price is \$50 per bundle for 25 of a single variety.

The program offers one- to two-year-old species which are selected for hardiness in the central high plains. The seedlings are mostly 12- to 18-inch tall container-grown stock, depending on the species.

Fall planting is ideal due to moderate temperatures and ample rainfall. Trees can be planted as long as soil temperatures are above 40 degrees, which is normally up until Thanksgiving in the Kansas City area. Trees should be monitored and watered throughout the winter to insure survival. Protective tubes are available for purchase to protect new plantings from rabbits.

Approved uses for the plants include: habitat creation for game birds, song birds and wildlife; barriers to reduce noise pollution; home and/or livestock windbreaks; liv-

ing snow fences; Christmas tree plantations; firewood lots; ugly view screens; and property line marking.

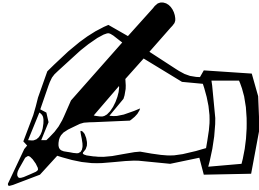

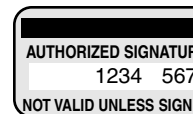

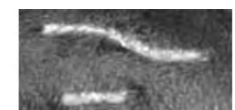

  - 21st Century Tools for Western Kansas Wheat Breeding;
  - Adding Value: Food Grade Grain Sorghum;
  - Plant-to-Plant and Field-to-Field: Insect Movement and Consequences for Pest Management; and
  - The Importance of Fallow and Fallow Alternatives: Cover Crops and Annual Forages.
- A complimentary lunch will be served.

## K-State agronomy researcher Sweeney to be honored

Kansas State University agronomy professor Dan Sweeney has been named a Crop Science Society of America Fellow for 2013. He will be honored at the annual Crop Science Society of America meeting in Tampa, Fla.. in November.

The Fellow designation is the highest recognition bestowed by the CSSA. The society's members nominate colleagues based on their professional achievements and meritorious service. Achievements in teaching, extension and industrial education and in investigative competency, as well as leadership are among those considered. In any given year, a maximum of 0.3 percent of the CSSA membership can be designated a fellow of the society.

Sweeney, who is based at the K-State Southeast Agricultural Research Center in Parsons, has focused his research on fertilizer application, tillage, and irrigation to improve row crop and forage production on claypan soils – the types of soil prevalent in southeast Kansas. He also has studied environmental issues such as land application of municipal solid waste compost and animal manures for row crop production, plant-based remediation of con-

taminated soil, and nutrient losses in surface runoff after turkey litter applications.

He has published numerous scientific articles, authored publications and been a presenter at many K-State Research and Extension events designed to convey research findings to agricultural producers.

Sweeney, who earned a master's degree from Purdue University and a Ph.D. from the University of Florida, currently serves as editor of the on-line scientific journal *Crop Management*, and was a technical editor for row crops with Agronomy Journal.

He is one of the very few scientists who have the distinction of being named Fellow of the three professional societies – the American Society of Agronomy, the Soil Science Society of America and the Crop Science Society of America.

“It is rather rare, indeed,” said Sara Uttech, member communications manager with the CSSA, who counted a total of just 43 individuals (living and deceased) who have received the distinction of Fellow of all three societies, during the more than half a century that all three have been in existence.

# New wheat varieties discussed at seed conference

New, prospective wheat varieties were discussed at the Kansas Seed Industry Conference recently as farmers prepare to begin planting. The annual meeting allowed industry leaders to determine the availability of certified seed and discuss the varieties producers anticipate using in the future.

During the conference, the Plant Genetic Materials Release Committee for K-State Research and Extension held their annual meeting. The committee determined they would move forward with two wheat varieties developed by wheat breeder, Allan Fritz, and his team of colleagues.

These two potential wheat varieties were approved for increase with the goal that they may be released to certified seed producers in the fall of 2014.

Daryl Strouts, president of the Kansas Wheat Alliance said, "It is very important for farmers to be aware of the upcoming varieties because it gives them an idea of what to buy and plant in the next couple years."

KS061406-LN-37 is adapted for the central and eastern parts of Kansas. It is a short-statured, early maturing, hard red winter wheat with white chaff and upright growth habit. The pedigree of this variety includes Aspen, Everest and the experimental line KS980554-12-9. In more than three years of testing, this variety has averaged 10 percent greater yields compared to Everest. This line has shown exemplary resistance to Fusarium head blight (also known as head scab) although the tolerance is not as strong the Everest variety.

Early results indicate baking quality is expected to have improved dough strength and loaf volume, but further testing is needed to verify. Baking quality performance above that of Everest will be required for it to move forward as a variety. Uniquely, should this be released, it will be added to a very short list of varieties that have resistance to both leaf and stripe rust.

KS030887K-6 is a short-

statured, medium maturing, hard red winter wheat that has performed well statewide but has proven to be better in western Kansas. This variety is expected to be exceptional under irrigation. However, it is very susceptible to Fusarium head blight (head scab) making it unsuitable for eastern Kansas. It has shown good end use quality and has proved excellent test weights compared to major cultivars of hard red winter wheat in western Kansas.

This variety especially is noteworthy because it contains six genes for non-race specific adult resistance to leaf and stripe rust. As a carrier of three genes to protect against both leaf and stripe rust as opposed to just one, it is expected to have stronger resistance designed to last for several generations.

Work began on these varieties over eight years ago. From a single cross in a greenhouse, a significant amount of testing and effort have been put into developing these experimental

wheat varieties.

It takes an average of five years after the greenhouse stage to select for positive physiological traits and segregate negative offspring. At least three years of yield trials, testing, and data collection are required before a potential variety can begin to gain approval to initiate founda-

tion seed. These two experimental varieties will begin the foundation seed stage this fall.

After years of work Fritz is confident that these experimental varieties will pass the Wheat Quality Council evaluations this winter and then be recommended by the Plant Genetic Materials Release Com-

mittee to the dean of the College of Agriculture at Kansas State University to be approved for release in fall of 2014.

The Kansas Wheat Commission supports the K-State wheat breeding program through the wheat check-off. Farmers can begin to look for these new varieties in the near future.

# August 30 webinar to focus on ethanol use in legacy engines

Old tractors are often prized possessions, whether an antique tractor used in shows and parades or that tractor still occasionally putting in an honest day's work in the field. Tractors and other old vehicles with "legacy" engines in them were designed to run on the fuels of their time, but what about running modern fuels, like ethanol, in these older machines?

A webinar, titled "Ethanol Use in Legacy Engines," will take place on Friday, Aug. 30, at 10 a.m. CST to discuss just that. Edwin Brokesh, an instructor of biological and agricultural engineering at Kansas State University, will present the webinar, which will cover the inter-

action of ethanol with different materials found in older engines and how the combustion process may affect the operation of older engines. Participants should come away with a better understanding of the care and maintenance of an older engine using ethanol-containing fuels.

Brokesh says much of his work with K-State Research and Extension involves providing people with a basic understanding of biofuels—what they are, how they work in engines, and their differences and similarities. While writing an Extension publication about small non-road engines and ethanol, he had the idea to present this webinar as a learning tool.

"I started to think about all these old tractors that you see at farm shows, parades and fairs, and the countless others that Dad or Grandpa bought new and are still being used," Brokesh said. "These machines also may see fuels containing ethanol. Because it is fair season, the thought was to produce a webinar now and then to write a publication off of the material presented in it later."

# Upland bird workshop to focus on quail and prairie chicken habitat

Upland bird populations in northeast Kansas remain lower than historical long-term trends. Many landowners have seen traditional game bird populations like the bobwhite quail and greater prairie chicken decline substantially over the years. Even other non-game grassland birds such as the eastern meadowlark and loggerhead shrike have experienced similar population declines. While many factors contribute to these declines, biologists and many landowners understand that quality habitat is the driving force for improving upland bird populations.

The Kansas Department of Wildlife, Parks & Tourism (KDWP) is hosting an Upland Bird Management Workshop to discuss what landowners and tenants can do for these birds and other wildlife on their property. Since approximately 97% of Kansas is privately owned land, the fate

of all upland bird populations lies in the hands of private landowners. If you are concerned about declining upland bird numbers then you will want to mark the evening of October 22, 2013 on your calendar.

Brad Rueschhoff, KDWP wildlife biologist, will discuss basic habitat requirements and life needs of the bobwhite quail and greater prairie chicken from egg through adult stage, effective habitat management practices landowners can implement on their land, and KDWP Private Landowner Assistance Programs which can provide technical and cost-share assistance. In addition, Sara Fredrickson, NRCS district conservationist will give overviews of USDA Farm Bill Programs such as EQIP, General CRP, and Continuous CRP practices which are beneficial to wildlife while also conserving soil and water resources. Time will be allowed at the end of

the evening for a question-and-answer session.

Admission is free. Participants will receive a packet containing information on habitat requirements, management practices, and cost-share assistance programs available. Landowners and the general public are encouraged to attend.

The workshop will take

place on Tuesday, October 22, 2013, beginning at 6:00 p.m. Location will be the Kansas Department of Wildlife, Parks, and Tourism Region 2 Office located at 300 SW Wanamaker in Topeka. Retaining an interest

I never thought I would feed cattle, until I got to know more than a few cattle feeders.

Some were all about buying low, selling high and happiest when they beat both their supplier and buyer. But in the mid 1990s, more feeders made new commitments to customer service, reaching out into the country. They wanted “relationships” with producers.

That was the beginning of the end for the island mentality, and the start of win-win alliances between ranchers, feeders and packers. Trust usually grew where it was given a chance.

The old idea of partnering was reborn in the common cause of improving cow herds so that future generations of cattle would have more potential to gain efficiently and earn higher quality grades without giving up yield.

I had to overcome the barrier of weaning at home or with local family and friends before taking the

further leap to go 50/50 with a new friend in the feeding business in 1999. But I had only half a load and it was a good enough year for other farm income to defer some into 2000.

We had a few health problems for the first several years, but less and less with experience and as the cattle got better.

Now, you can find custom feeders that will coordinate health programs and timing to care for calves weaned on their inbound trucks. Even early-weaned calves less than four months old get kindergarten-like care and go on to hit the profit and quality targets for everyone from gate to plate.

Still, most cow-calf producers don’t show much interest in their calves after weaning.

If you care what happens to them, that’s good for the beef supply chain because it suggests you’re getting them ready with vaccinations and proper nutrition.

You could take the next step and find out how to ad-

just selection and management to make your cattle worth more to you and others.

State breed associations and universities often host carcass value discovery projects that accept enrollments of as few as three head and provide feedlot and carcass data.

They can give you an idea of herd performance over time, and perhaps confidence to take another step into finishing some at home or partnering on more of your calves at a custom feedlot.

Regardless of whether you feed a few or many in partnership, there are sometimes other options for carcass value discovery. Researching service-oriented feedlots and vigorous communication before an auction or direct sale can land your calves in a pen where you’ll meet a new friend in the feeding business.

Don’t be afraid to follow up when you know where the calves went, and offer to pay the modest per-head fees that will return individual carcass data.

Maybe your early discovery work shows you have much more selection and coordinated management to get right before taking a further step in feeding, but a 50/50 partnership makes sense for many producers.

I like that arrangement so much, I used to wonder

why anyone would retain full ownership in the feedlot. Then I rode around with more than a few ranchers who have selection and management figured out to a higher level of confidence.

They’ve seen the reports that retained ownership has been profitable more than 85% of the time over the past two decades, but some of them figure it’s been profitable every year. That’s because their cattle are far above average.

Average cattle are 35% to 45% Select at harvest, and that portion of the pen does not usually make money for anyone. But cattlemen who have used data feedback not only to pick better bulls but to cull below-average cows rarely market any Select calves.

“I’m trying to make a living out here with this herd, and now that I have it producing the way I want it, I can’t afford to split the profits with anyone else,” an Oklahoma rancher explained this summer.

It made me realize I had to take a few more steps to hit that level. For now, I will keep retaining at least some interest in all steers and using the records to climb the profit ladder.

Recent rainfall in Kansas sets records

(AP) – The recent rainfall in Kansas has shattered records across the state and helped ease drought conditions in some sections of the state, according to weather experts.

Mary Knapp, state climatologist, said that in the first nine days of August, 144 daily precipitation records were broken across the state. Four of those records were in Hutchinson, including a six-inch rainfall on Aug. 4 that broke the record for the amount of daily rainfall for any day in August, The Hutchinson News reported. The previous record was set last year when 3.3 inches of rain fell on Aug. 25, 2012.

About 75 percent of a year’s precipitation happens between May and September, with June typically the wettest month. This year June recorded 1.92 inches of rain in Hutchinson. So far, August has had about ten inches.

Knapp also said, however, that although the rain has helped with the drought, a wetter-than-average month doesn’t make up for weeks of no rain. When the ground is dry, it can’t quickly soak up the water, which increases flooding.

“You won’t get the same benefit from it as you would have if it would have been spread out,” she said.

According to the U.S. Drought Monitor, much of Reno County in south-central Kansas is now out of the drought, at least for the time being. However, extreme western Reno County remains abnormally dry. Western Kansas was in an exceptional drought, but the monitor didn’t have recordings from last week’s heavy rainfall.

“The fact that it’s wet now and end of July was wetter than average, it didn’t make up for four-six weeks of no rain,” Knapp said. “That’s why you’ve still got drought issues when you have surplus and flooding.”

If the precipitation keeps up, portions of western Kansas will also have the wettest August on record, said Tim Burke, meteorologist at the National Weather Service in Dodge City. Records date back to 1874.

“After being in a drought for a long time, we’re hoping for a wet pattern,” Burke said.
