



Schwieterman Market Outlook

A marketing commentary

At mid-week the head and shoulders top formation in the soybeans had been completed and it looked like the market was ready to begin a long term down trend. The bull camp, however, won out at the end of the week thanks to strong export sales among other things. The front months of the soybeans finished the week about 20 cents higher and even traded through trend line resistance. The Chinese demand for our soybeans seems relentless and all the talk about

negative crush margins in China and an overabundance of soybeans don't seem to matter. If there was follow-through buying Monday it will negate the top formation and this market will be headed for \$11.00.

The corn behaved in a similar manner. The market hasn't gone anywhere in over a month and at mid-week it looked like the market was ready to take a dive and give up most of the fall rally. The last half of the week the market made a strong recovery

and is now back to the top of the range. The market is still range bound and the big test will be early next week. If we don't see a new high quickly the market will follow the same pattern it has been stuck in and move back to the bottom of the range.

Corn demand has been very good with both ethanol production and export sales running at high levels. If the strong demand continues we will see the USDA increase the export estimate and cut ending stocks. Cutting ending stocks in the old crop will make maintaining acreage more important, which means it will be difficult for the new crop corn to move lower from here until spring, after the insurance planting price has been set. Corn supplies are more than adequate, but the fact that corn is much cheaper than it has been the past couple of years and the idea that supplies could be tight again in

18 months, seem to be holding the market up very well.

The wheat ran up to new highs for the move early in the week and then made a sharp correction. The market quickly found support at the 38% retracement of the move up and could be set for another leg higher. If we see some buying early this week there will be lots of talk about the March and July KW contracts moving above \$7.00. Right now we aren't seeing good enough export sales to justify further gains, but the Paris milling wheat is still in an uptrend, so there is the idea that we could become competitive on the world market. The U.S. Dollar keeps making new highs, which is usually negative for the wheat, but right now it doesn't seem to matter. A move below \$6.25 in the March KW will suggest a move to \$6.06.

We normally see the live cat-

tle make a break as we head into option expiration and first notice day for the December contract and this year turned out to be normal. The February cattle started the week with a strong bounce, but ended up losing about \$4.50 for the week. Feeder cattle fared much better because the Index is record high and rising. It is a long time until the January feeders expire, so the futures and cash don't have to come together right away, but the futures are at a \$10 discount right now, so that should at least be supportive.

Once we get first notice day out of the way for the December Live Cattle, the market will probably start to work higher again. The fundamentals of the market are still quite strong and it is quite likely that we see new contract highs in the near future.

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Farm bill education meeting planned for December 17

The Kansas Farm Management Association will host a farm bill education meeting on Wednesday, December 17, 2014 at Pottorf Hall on the Riley County Fairgrounds in Manhattan. The meeting, which will run from 9:00 a.m. to noon, is open to the public.

Under the new farm bill, farmers may choose one of three program options; Agriculture Risk Coverage at the County Level (ARC-CO), Agriculture Risk Coverage at the Individual Level (ARC-IC), or Price Loss Coverage (PLC). Pro-

ducers who fail to select a program option prior to the March 31, 2015 deadline will automatically be assigned to PLC, but will forfeit 2014 payments. However, to receive payments for 2015 and beyond, producers would still need to sign up for the farm program each year. Assignment to PLC is automatic for those who fail to make a choice, but farm program participation is not automatic. Annual sign-up is still required.

Producers wishing to participate in the farm program must make their pro-

gram election by March 31, 2015. Producers also have the option to update yields and re-allocate base acres, based on yields from 2008-2012 and the ratio of acres planted to each crop from 2009 to 2012. The decision to update yields and re-allocate base acres must be made by February 27, 2015, a month before the program election deadline.

Base acre reallocation and updating yields are the landowner's decision, unless the tenant has FSA power of attorney to act on the landowner's behalf. Pro-

ducers the OSU-KSU Farm Program Decision Tool, an Excel-based computer spreadsheet that will help evaluate the potential payout under each farm program option.

Given the high value of cows and calves, losing one or both to calving difficulty has a significant cost. A meeting which will discuss and illustrate best management practices for calving will be held Wednesday, December 17 at the Labette County High School cafeteria in Altamont. The meeting will begin at 6:00 p.m. with a meal. The meeting is sponsored by K-State Research & Extension's Wildcat Extension District as well as local beef-related businesses.

Keith Martin, Wildcat Extension District livestock agent, will begin the meeting with a presentation on ways to ensure that newborn calves get adequate

colostrum intake. The featured speaker will be Dr. Dave Rethorst, veterinarian with the Beef Cattle Institute of Kansas State University. Utilizing the BCI's recently acquired life-size "cow & calf" demonstration model, Dr. Rethorst will discuss various calving dystocia situations and demonstrate proper correction and calving assistance pro-

cedures.

Producers in attendance will also be given the opportunity for a "hands-on" experience of identifying various calving problems and practice the correction and delivery of the "calf" themselves, an excellent hands-on educational opportunity.

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Kansas ranchers warned of possible rustling surge

(AP) – A Kansas livestock expert is urging farmers and ranchers to take precautions against rustlers as historically high cattle prices make the animals a prime target for thieves.

Steers were selling between \$1,300 and \$2,000 per head in late November, according to a Farmers & Ranchers Livestock Commission's market report.

"Right now we are looking at record prices," said Anthony Ruiz, livestock production agent for the Central Kansas Extension District. "That's a lot of money."

Earlier this month someone stole a dozen or more Black Angus bulls and heifers – worth an estimated \$20,000 – from a northwest Kansas ranch, *The Salina Journal* reported.

The cattle were reported missing Nov. 19 from a Cheyenne County ranch south of Wheeler.

"It was a quick grab-and-go," Cheyenne County sheriff Cody Beeson said.

In September, someone dumped a load of cowhides in McPherson County. The sheriff's office said it received several leads but none panned out.

Ruiz said the hides could indicate that the cattle had been stolen.

"But that isn't your run-of-the-mill rustler," he said. "That's a pretty sizable chunk of meat. Where are you going to put that? That's taking it to a whole new level."

Ruiz advises ranchers to register a brand and brand their cattle, making it harder to sell stolen cattle by simply removing an ear identification tag. He also encourages ranchers to change their routines and not feed at the same time so potential thieves can't take advantage of a schedule.

"Another thing is to install some deer cameras," he said. "Take a look at who's coming onto your property. Any way you can be vigilant to know what's going on at your operation when you're not there will help."

The U.S. cattle herd is as low as it has been since the 1960s, causing prices to surge, Ruiz said.

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USDA extends deadline for dairy margin protection program

U.S. Department of Agriculture Secretary Tom Vilsack has announced that the application deadline for the dairy Margin Protection Program (MPP) will be extended until Dec. 19, 2014. The program, established by the 2014 Farm Bill, protects participating dairy producers when the margin – the difference between the price of milk and feed costs – falls below levels of protection selected by the applicant.

“The 2014 Farm Bill created these safety net programs to provide safeguards against the uncertainty of weather and markets, but this safety net is not automatic. Producers must visit their local Farm Service Agency office to enroll before December 19,” said Vilsack. “Despite the best forecasts, weather and markets can change, so a modest investment today can protect against unexpected losses tomorrow.”

“For just \$100, a farmer can cover 90 percent of production at \$4 margin swings, and with affordable incremental premiums, dairy farmers can cover up to \$8 margin swings,” said Vilsack. “Those who apply this year will receive a slight increase in production protection that will not be available in the future. Farmers who do not sign up for the Margin Protection Program for 2015 will forfeit the 1 percent base production increase. For a 400-cow operation, this would equate to an additional 80,000 pounds of milk that are eligible for coverage. It’s a small step to take to ensure your business is covered.”

Vilsack encourages producers to use the online Web resource at www.fsa.usda.gov/mpptool to calculate the best levels of coverage for their dairy operation. They can type in specific operation data and explore price projections and market scenarios to determine what level of coverage is best for them. They can also compare the data to see how the program would have helped in previous years, such as 2008, when margins dropped from \$8 to \$3 in just three months. The online resource is on a secure website that can be accessed from computers, mobile phones or tablets, 24 hours a day, seven days a week.

Farmers also have a chance to share comments and help shape the Margin Protection Program for the future. Last month, the U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) announced the extension of the opportunity for public comments on both the Margin Protection Program and the Dairy Product Donation Program until Dec. 15, 2014. 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Coalition formed to oppose lesser prairie chicken listing

A new coalition is fighting to defend the rural way of life and economic prosperity in five states.

The coalition, comprised of the Kansas Farm Bureau, Kansas Corn Growers Association, Texas Farm Bureau, The American Farm Bureau Federation, New Mexico

Farm and Livestock Bureau and Colorado Farm Bureau, opposes The Center for Biological Diversity, Defenders of Wildlife and WildEarth Guardians' request that the lesser prairie chicken (LPC) be listed as an "endangered" species. The bird is currently listed as "threat-

ened." The LPC range is roughly 20 million acres, affecting 85 counties in Kansas, Oklahoma, Texas, New Mexico and Colorado.

"We are already seeing impacts from the 'threatened' listing," said Jim Sipes, who farms near the primary habitat area. "We have seen wind generator projects leave the area. We have seen oil and gas companies pull out of the region. We have seen seismograph crews stopping seismograph work, and we are seeing effects on farms and ranches through the amount of grazing we are able to do."

The threat from an "endangered" designation reaches far beyond the farm gate to rural Main Street and local government.

"In our small communities, businesses on Main

Street depend on farmers and ranchers," said Marieta Hauser, an economic development administrator and rural Chamber of Commerce official. "If we don't stop excessive regulations on farmers and ranchers, more and more often what you are going to see on Main Street in rural America is a 'Going Out of Business' sign. If farmers and ranchers don't have money to spend, our main street businesses will not be able to survive. It's that important."

County commissioner Mick MacNair, who lives in the habitat area, is concerned that with a more restrictive designation of the LPC comes lower property values. With less oil, gas, and renewable energy development, the tax base reduction would be disastrous.

"How we are going to fund our county roads and keep them maintained? How are we going to fund our local police departments? How are we going to fund our EMS and fire departments?" MacNair asks. "These are essential government entities. With the loss of revenue this will cost us, we have some very grave concerns."

The coalition has created a website to provide de-

tailed information on the issue and the progress of a lawsuit opposing the listing. Users are also urged to donate to the legal fund to defer the cost of litigation. The site is www.stopfowlplay.com. ASA hails barge increase

As part of H.R. 647, the Achieving a Better Life Experience (ABLE) Act, the House of Representatives passed, by a vote of 404-17, a provision to increase the barge fuel fee to fund needed waterways infrastructure projects. American Soybean Association (ASA) president and Iowa farmer Ray Gaesser expressed ASA's appreciation for the fee, which is supported by those in the waterways industry.

"The nine-cent increase in the per-gallon barge fuel fee is something that is supported not only by the nation's soybean farmers, but also by the commercial barge and towing operators who pay it. We all support this as a way to dedicate funds to new waterways infrastructure construction and major rehabilitation of the inland waterways system through the Inland Waterways Trust Fund. We are pleased that the House passed this provision, and we call on the Senate to quickly do the same," he said.
