

# USMEF event showcases return of U.S. beef, pork to South Africa

Working to build a solid base in a developing market, the U.S. Meat Export Federation (USMEF) matched red meat exporters with buyers during the first USMEF South Africa Seminar and Buyers Reception. Funding support for the networking and educational event, held Aug. 18 in Johannesburg, was provided by the USDA Market Access Program, the Beef Checkoff Program and the Pork Checkoff.

Along with one-on-one business meetings and updates on current market conditions, USMEF staff provided technical advice and assistance to traders

with an interest in putting more U.S. beef and pork in South Africa's processing, retail and foodservice sectors. Focus was also put on food safety and the quality and consistency of U.S. red meat products, as well as the availability of U.S. beef livers, kidneys and other beef variety meats.

"This was an opportunity to not only build and establish relationships, the event also provided valuable information for buyers in South Africa and helped reacquaint them with high-quality U.S. beef and pork," said Dan Halstrom, USMEF senior vice president of marketing, who noted that

those in attendance were from the South African trade, along with one buyer from Nigeria.

"South Africa's retail market is a combination of modern supermarkets and the more traditional wholesale markets," said Halstrom. "The degree of modern retail development in South Africa far exceeds the rest of Africa, and the pace of growth continues to be strong. The potential in retail, along with foodservice and further processing, provide promising future opportunities for U.S. beef and pork."

Also prior to the seminar, USMEF Technical Services Manager Cheyenne McEndaffer and Monty Brown, USMEF representative in the region, traveled to Durban to meet with South African port officials. Durban was chosen because it is the highest volume port for meat imports entering the country. The goal was to better familiarize USMEF staff on the import clearance protocols. In discussions with the port officials, McEndaffer and Brown had an opportunity to learn about common documentation and labeling errors, in addition to clarification on the physical inspection and residue and microbiological sampling protocol for imported red meat products. USMEF plans to use this information to educate U.S. exporters on South Africa's import process in

order to minimize shipment delays or rejections in this new market.

"As is generally true when a market opens or reopens, exporting to South Africa is going to include a learning process for everyone involved, but continual information gathering will help clarify the process for our exporters," McEndaffer said.

In February, South Africa reopened to U.S. pork, allowing U.S. exporters to send certain cuts of raw, frozen pork to the country for further processing at approved establishments and a narrower range of items for unrestricted sale (including retail). South Africa reopened to U.S. beef in January, with no restrictions. The South African market had previously been closed to U.S. beef since the December 2003 BSE case. It had been officially closed to U.S. pork since 2013, but prior to that time trade was very limited due to regulatory restrictions.

Having both products eligible in South Africa is adding momentum to USMEF's market development efforts in Africa. Last September, USMEF held its first Meat Buyers Showcase and Seminar in Sub-Saharan Africa. The event, held in Ghana, attracted several U.S. export companies and more than two dozen buyers from Ghana, Benin and Nigeria.

## Bacon alternative made from beef

Schmacon, a recently developed bacon alternative, is made from the underbelly of cattle. The product was developed at Schmaltz Deli by Howard Bender, who says Schmacon has half the calories and fat of pork bacon. The meat is also cured without using nitrites, which helps to lower the sodium content.

"It is a new way for us to utilize more of the total carcass," says Mark Gwin, Certified Angus Beef product integration manager. "What we're trying to do is value-add those lower priced parts of the carcass."

# Wheat Olympics - A test of endurance

With the 2016 summer Olympics wrapping up, it only makes sense for wheat to get in on the action. Who knew wheat could be so competitive?

Finding a wheat variety that performs well in terms of both quality and protein becomes survival of the fittest to see which varieties outlast the others under hot and dry conditions. If wheat is the athlete, then Kansas

State University associate professor in agronomy Krishna Jagadish is the coach. Jagadish and his team impose heat and drought stress on post-flowering plants to determine which ones will cave under pressure and which ones will overcome the odds.

To test these plants, promising heat-tolerant wheats, including seven Kansas varieties, are grown in growth chambers and

then exposed to drought and heat. But growth chambers have some limitations, so field trials are done as well using heat tents that can be moved to different plots in the field.

"We want to be as close to the realistic field conditions as possible," said Jagadish. "We try to impose heat and drought stress at different stages, particularly during the flowering stage or the post-flowering stage, be-

cause that's when the most of the wheat grown in Kansas is exposed to those conditions."

Heat spells that happen when wheat is flowering inhibit fertilization, producing no seed at all. When a heat spell happens after flowering toward harvesting time, the grain is smaller and the quality is corrupted. Most of the lines being tested in this project already exhibit heat-tolerance but if a better source of tolerance can be found, it can be in-

corporated into a breeding program. This means that the quality and yield of varieties like Everest can be used longer, rather than breaking down much more quickly.

"This is the whole idea; when you like a product there are many things inside that product you could change. If you want the product to last, you might as well supplement it, and add one thing to keep it around longer," said Jagadish. "If you already have something nice, and you can find a good donor source, you can keep the quality and yield for longer."

All the seeds collected from the trials are sent to Jeff Wilson, USDA grain

quality specialist, who analyzes the grain starch quality and protein to see what is happening during drought and heat stress. With results from this year's trial expected to be in soon, Jagadish and his team are currently starting chamber work to see which of seven Kansas varieties, including Joe and Everest, can handle the heat.

"The idea is to try to see where the level of tolerance is with these popular cultivars we are currently growing," said Jagadish. "Can they really take it or are they that bad? Is one better than the other? And we try to prepare them as much as possible through breeding processes."

## Indicator cows

When you have just enough cows to name them all, it's easy to characterize them by appearance, temperament and some might even say personality. Kids like to find names to fit. Twister was one of ours 20 years ago, an outlier for poor docility that left no daughters in the herd.

Now with 100 or more cows to start each year, we are less likely to name them and none would sound like rodeo bulls if we did, but the occasional high-headed one still stands out. When she shows her wild side, we take note, check records and see if it relates to genetics.

Then there are the calm but adventurous types that test fences. They serve a purpose, alerting us that we

waited a bit too long to rotate pastures in summer or suggesting the need to replace a fence that's no longer dependable.

Our favorites are the quiet majority supported by records, pedigree and progeny performance.

I've been on places with 1,000 or more cows known for excellence throughout. Even among the most uniform there are standouts for eye appeal, though I don't often see behavior that says "Here is an indicator cow."

As to the quiet core, managers sometimes use teleprompter ear tags to point out a few of their best. Once in Montana we found the top indexing cow on a computer screen, and then went out and saw her grazing on a slope. You would not have guessed.

Progeny records and the more recent genomic testing can open an unseen world for cow herd managers. Sure, an experienced eye can keep up a good set of cows and pick heifers that appear to represent the leading edge, but anyone can miss unseen opportunities.

We look for the indicator cows that appear much like their sisters but backed by a superior genomic score. We look for those with records showing they raised heavier calves that never got sick, that gained in the top 25% after weaning and qualified for a premium beef bonus.

Those are the foundation females that will build demand for beef and pay their way for the wider cattle community.

Consumers learn about outlier beef after just one experience. Very likely you know what I mean because you enjoy a great steak, burger or roast, too.

Beef has to be the preferred protein to maintain economic viability at its price point far above the competition. In that sense the old promotional line still holds: beef is king.

It can't afford to be a royal disappointment. The couple out to celebrate may always remember the perfect dinner date and plan on many happy returns, or they may look for other bright sides and try to forget the beef.

The restaurant manager can't afford many customers walking away to tell others to avoid their tables. Retailers can't afford developing a reputation for the least dependable beef in town. That's why the wait staff and meat case managers frequently interact with customers and ask about their eating experience.

They're on the lookout for indicators that support their beef supply program or suggest a need for change.

# Council on Dairy Cattle Breeding to host 2016 Industry Meeting

The Council on Dairy Cattle Breeding will be hosting its 2016 Industry Meeting on October 4, 2016 at the Alliant Energy Center. Finally, different perspectives about where the dairy industry is heading to

will be presented as an effort to identify the challenges and opportunities that the dairy industry will be facing in this era of change.

## Yard & Garden Tips

### Seedling Lawn Grasses

Tall fescue is a favorite grass for use in our area. Another option is using bluegrass by itself or mixed with tall fescue. Both of these cool-season grasses are seeded in the fall for quick establishment. September is the ideal month for seeding.

One of the most important steps in being successful is selecting the variety or varieties of grasses. A blend of tall fescue varieties is generally used. K-State Research and Extension trails many and selects ones that have done the best in Kansas. This list is available from the office and online at [www.riley.ksu.edu](http://www.riley.ksu.edu) under "hot topics."

When you open a bag of grass seed, there are other things in there. A surprise is

not wanted. The seed label lists what is to be in the bag. A low percentage of weed seed and noxious weed is desirable. Another desirable low percentage is the other crop seed line. Below 0.5% is recommended.

Planting the seed is the next step after selecting the best seed available. The seed needs to get good contact with the soil. Soil can be loosened with a tiller, seeder, aerator and even a rake. They all will work. It depends on the situation which method to use.

Fall planting is preferred because the soil is warm for quick seed germination. With the seed in the ground and covered lightly with soil, moisture is required. Our summer rains have aided in great soil mois-

ture. Light and frequent wetting of the seeded area is needed to start and to keep the seed alive while it develops roots. Deeper and less frequent watering is used as the grass grows.

A "starter fertilizer" is often used at seeding. It has readily available phosphorus for the young grass root to get. Some nitrogen is also beneficial for the young grass plant. Fertilizer is optional at planting but normally worth the expense.

You can learn more about seeding and weed management on Saturday, August 27 beginning at 9 a.m. Join me at Pottorf Hall in CiCo Park for a demonstration on seeding and lawn care. It is free, and bring a friend or two.

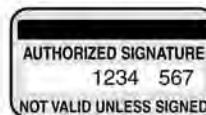

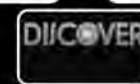

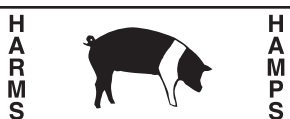

# Corah honored by Feeding Quality Forum

Seven years ago when Larry Corah suggested adding a people element to the Feeding Quality Forum (FQF) he helped launch in 2006, he certainly didn't expect to be a recipient of the Industry Achievement Award one day.

Now "mostly retired," Corah was an easy choice for the FQF committee, which moved to honor one who served the beef commu-

nity - from ranch to consumer - for more than 50 years.

He grew up in North Dakota in the 1950s, when technology was reshaping agriculture. His parents attended school to eighth grade, but they never stopped learning on a farm that included a small feedlot. The family cooperated in many Extension research trials to see how electricity,

silage unloaders and hybrid seeds could make life better.

Corah loved to learn by doing, whether in animal science at North Dakota State University, as a local county Extension agent in 1964 or digging into the feedlot side for his master's in ruminant nutrition at Michigan State University. There, he met an Australian guest lecturer who made an

irresistible offer a couple of years later.

Soon Corah, with wife Mary and two children, was living on the southeastern edge of the Outback for two years while he served as technical advisor for an Australian program to develop a cattle feeding industry.

Coming back in 1970, Corah worked in Extension in Minnesota before the family moved to Laramie, Wyo., while the young scientist earned a PhD in bovine reproductive physiology. In 1974, they moved to Manhattan to stay.

He joined Kansas State University as a feedlot specialist, with a first mission of traveling the state to meet people and see the booming industry.

"I had seen 1,000-head feedlots, but not the 20- and 30,000-head operations," Corah recalls. "The first time I saw a pit full of high-moisture corn, I said 'What the heck is that?'"

He established relationships quickly, helping each new contact think about what they'd like to know with K-State's assistance. He felt a kinship with each cooperator as they sought to adapt new technologies to their feedyards.

Corah also developed a little-used summer intern-

ship program into a network of a dozen committed young people placed at leading yards across the feeding belt.

"Not only did we get a lot of science done, but it was a good training ground for students," he says.

The feedlot specialist became beef section leader at K-State in 1979 and head of cow-calf research in 1985, becoming the first Wildcat to earn the Extension Achievement Award from the American Society for Animal Science in 1987.

For all the cooperative research Corah was getting done, across 20 years he also mentored a wave of 30 graduate students who went on to take leading positions in the beef industry, academia and allied industry.

His easy-going personality helped him build a thick Rolodex of industry contacts over the years, and those helped launch his own "retirement" careers. Corah left Extension after 25 years to head up producer education at the newly unified National Cattlemen's Beef Association in 1997.

There he established strategies and programs as a foundation of NCBA efforts to this day, including an expanded Cattlemen's College.

In 1998, when former grad students with the Certi-

fied Angus Beef® (CAB®) brand suggested their mentor to lead the company's outreach to ranchers and cattle feeders, Corah signed on as vice president of supply development, based in Manhattan.

The next year, he and new staff members that included current CAB president John Stika launched the CAB Feedlot Partners program, and later teamed up with allied industry sponsors to hold the first FQF seminars in Nebraska and Texas.

Always looking ahead more than back, Corah predicts the growing trend of individual cattle management will lead to more of a "supply chain focus, where feedyards will really target a lot of their production" toward specific value-adding programs and brands.

"The fact that we put cattle on feed for 100 to 150 days of a high-concentrate diet creates a really intense flavor profile that has established our beef as not only something that the U.S. consumer wants, but globally it positions us," Corah says.

These are exciting times for a career teacher and student of the industry.

"It amazes me how dramatically we've changed cattle," Corah says. From breed makeup to performance gains, their evolution didn't leave carcass quality behind.

"Today nearly 70% of the cattle grade Choice or Prime and CAB acceptance rates - years ago we set a target at 30% and thought that's just unachievable," he notes. "Now we're seeing weeks and months where we're doing that."

The many who reach out to congratulate Corah will likely hear the disclaimer, "I've always been surrounded by talented people."

Those would invariably reply they owe much of their own industry achievements simply to being on the same team.

Corah will accept the award just prior to the noon CAB brand lunch in Grand Island, Neb., Aug. 23 and two days later in Amarillo, Texas.

The meetings are sponsored by Zoetis, Roto-mix, Feedlot magazine, Micronutrients and CAB.

## Iola FFA member wins State Proficiency Award

A member of the Iola FFA chapter was recognized for having one of the best career development programs in the state at the 88th Kansas FFA State Convention, June 1-3, 2016, on the Kansas State University campus.

Caitlin Dreher received a State FFA Proficiency Award in Goat Production during the convention for outstanding accomplishments she has made in de-

veloping programs that will prepare her for a career in agriculture. This award is sponsored by Animal Health International.

The proficiency award program recognizes students for exceptional accomplishments and excellence in a Supervised Agricultural Experience (SAE) program. This program allows students to set goals and gain real-world experience in a chosen area of the

agriculture industry.

Dreher started her SAE by showing meat goats and has since grown her herd to five Boer does. One of her greatest challenges during her project was managing urinary calculi, a common metabolic disease in male goats. It closely resembles human kidney stones and can be fatal if not recognized and treated. While treating two of her wethers for the disease, she learned

to diagnose and manage it. Dreher has also attended the International Boer Goat Association nationals and was named a premier exhibitor in 2012. She plans on attending Hutchinson Community College to obtain a degree in animal science and marketing.

Caitlin's parents are Jerry and Cathy Dreher. Her advisor is Charles Kerr.

## KCA hosts regional meeting in Fredonia

Members of the Kansas Cattlemen's Association (KCA) and the public came together in Fredonia at the Fredonia Livestock Auction for a presentation on Beef Checkoff and Veterinary Feed Directive. The free event was co-sponsored by Ruma-Lic Liquid Feed, who sponsored the USA BEEF meal served by The Stockyards Restaurant.

"The goal of the meeting was to bring independent cattlemen together to learn about industry information and discuss changes to regulations that directly affect their operations. With some attendees traveling in from over 200 miles away, we had a good mix of producers from across the state, and even some from other states," commented Tyler Dupy, KCA executive director.

Dr. Seth Fox of Wilco Veterinary Clinic gave a presentation on regulation regarding the Veterinary Feed Directive. With a goal to help ensure safe food and sustainable use of antibiotics for animals and humans, the FDA published the revised VFD to promote the responsible use of antibiotics for food-producing animals. This regulation will require a VFD for all medically important antibiotics (those important in

human health) administered in feed, and a veterinary prescription for all medically important antibiotics used in water. The new rule is set to be effective January 1, 2017.

David Pfrang and Jim Dobbins, KCA members from Nemaha County, provided a presentation on the Beef Checkoff. The presentation reveals a lack of transparency and proper controls between the Kansas Beef Council and the Kansas Livestock Asso-

ciation. Pfrang and Dobbins argue in their presentation that without a proper firewall in place, the checkoff funds can be used to lobby against producer interests. The United States Department of Agriculture recently set forth a proposal to officially recognize the option of producers to redirect the current fifty cents the Kansas Beef Council withholds up to the Cattlemen's Beef Board. Pfrang and Dobbins recommended independent ranchers elect

for the redirection, and showed attendees a simple process for accomplishing the redirection of the funds.

## Kansas cattle on feed up 9 percent

Kansas feedlots with capacities of 1,000 or more head contained 2.11 million cattle on feed on August 1, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. This inventory was up 9 percent from last year.

Placements during July totaled 445,000 head, up 13 percent from 2015. Fed cattle marketings for the month of July totaled 375,000 head, down 5 percent from last year.

Other disappearance during July totaled 10,000 head, unchanged from last year.

# Kansas Hay Market Report

Hay trade activity saw another slight uptick, especially for grinding alfalfa.

Demand light to moderate for grinding alfalfa and light for all other classes of hay, with prices generally steady. According to the U.S. Drought Monitor the abnormally dry category decreased to 13.03 pct. Abnormally dry conditions persist primarily along the northern tier of counties and

nine counties in the northeastern region. The NASS Kansas Crop Progress and Condition report for the week ending August 15, 2016 has alfalfa hay conditions at 1 pct Very Poor, 4 pct poor, 32 pct fair, 58 pct good, and 5 pct excellent. Alfalfa hay condition rated 1 pct very poor, 4 pct poor, 33 pct fair, 57 pct good, and 5 pct excellent.

Alfalfa hay third cutting was 84 pct complete near 82 last year, and ahead of 70 pct average. Fourth cutting was 6 pct complete, behind 14 last year and near 7 average. # Eastern Kansas Grazing School coming in September

Few livestock operations would say they have an abundance of available forage – or that they couldn't use more. Since they aren't making any more land, however, that means we have to fine-tune our management to get the most out of what we have available to us. That's the purpose of the Eastern Kansas Grazing School to be held at Perry on September 20-21.

Whether you are a beginning or experienced grazer, in-

formation on how to get the most out of your forages is a key to profitability in your operation. This year's school will again include presentations from K-State Research & Extension and Natural Resource Conservation Service (NRCS) specialists on the art and science of grazing and grazing arithmetic as well as a pasture allocation exercise and grazing operation tour.

Missouri NRCS district conservationist Mark Green will be back to share information on watering systems, fencing, and layout and design of management intensive grazing sys-

tems. University of Missouri Extension ag economist Dr. Wesley Tucker will discuss the economics of these systems.

Limited space is available for the school on a first registered basis. Registration is \$50 for the first person from a farm (includes lunches, snacks, and handouts). ## Final venue set for WOTUS challenges

The 11th Circuit Court of Appeals has denied states' latest bid to have their challenges to the Waters of the U.S. (WOTUS) rule heard by district courts, where they think they'd find more receptive audiences, according to reports on Politico.

This means that the 6th Circuit Court of Appeals, based in Cincinnati, will hear the cases challenging the EPA's Clean Water Rule, generally known as WOTUS. States had urged the 11th Circuit to take the appeal, arguing that the issue does not qualify under a provision of the Clean Water Act that allows certain challenges to leapfrog district courts and head straight to appellate court. The 6th Circuit, where appellate court challenges have been consolidated, has ruled that the issue belongs with it.

"It would be a colossal waste of judicial resources for both this Court and the Sixth Circuit to undertake to decide the same issues about the same rule presented by the same parties," the panel wrote.

Last fall, the 6th Circuit Court of Appeals placed a preliminary injunction on implementation and enforcement of the WOTUS Rule in all 50 states so it has not taken effect. Oral arguments in the case before the 6th Circuit have been set for spring of 2017.

- 23 Black 3 and 4 year old cows bred to Hinkson Angus bulls. They will start calving on Sept. 1st for 75 days.
- 130 Mostly black and black white faced 3 - 5 year old cows bred to Angus bulls. Cows will start calving first week of September for 60 days. Big cows that will weigh 1200-1300 lbs.
- 30 Mixed colored 3-5 year old cows bred to Angus bulls. Cows start calving first week of September for 60 days. Cows will weigh 1100-1250 lbs.
- 52 Mixed colored 4-5 year old cows bred to Red and Black Angus bulls. Cows will calve in September and October.
- 30 Black running age cows bred to registered Angus or Horned Hereford bulls. Cows will start calving the second week of September.
- 80 Mixed colored running age cows bred to Angus bulls. Cows will calve in September and October.
- 23 Black and red 3-5 year old cows bred to Angus bulls. Start calving on October 15th for 90 days.

**Pairs:**

- 110 Black first calf heifer pairs. Cows weigh 1050-1100 while calves weigh 250-400. Cows have been exposed back to Angus bulls.
- 20 Mixed colored 3-5 year old pairs. Cows weigh 1100-1200 while calves weigh 200-300. Cows will sell open.
- 40 mixed colored running age pairs.
- 15 Black running age pairs with calves weighing 200-350 lbs. Cows have been running back with Angus bull.

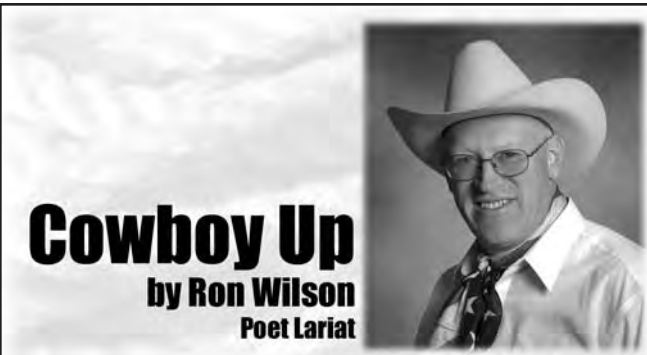

## Power

POWER is also a catchy acronym for a conference which recently happened in the Kansas Flint Hills. In

this case, POWER stands for Peers Organizing Winning Effective Results (Gotta love a good acronym). POWER is a bi-annual conference for youth leaders of the beef cattle industry, specifically from the Gelbvieh and Limousin breeds. Two years ago, the first POWER Conference was held in Denver. This year, they hosted the conference in Manhattan, Kansas with the theme Forging Friendships in the Flint Hills. The conference took place in early August. Participants traveled into Kansas City, spent a day there including some livestock judging, and then traveled to Manhattan.

Nearly 30 participants

came to the conference from across the nation. They heard various speakers and participated in workshops. Tours included various K-State animal science units, the feed mill, and the Kansas Artificial Breeding Service Unit. There was also a virtual tour of the National Bio and Agro-defense Facility. Participants went to K-State Leadership Studies building where they experienced leadership training using Coach Bill Snyder's 16 Goals for Success. After the second day, they came out to our ranch for some food and fun.

At KABSU, they even got to palpate some cows. I would call that a "hands-on" experience - or maybe a "hands-in" experience...

By bringing these young leaders together, they learned a lot and built long-lasting friendships that will transcend the individual lines of their breed associations. Many of the participants are officers of their

junior breed associations. All the participants were college age and younger.

I was impressed with these young men and women. It was impressive that they would take time out of their summer to travel to a four-day conference like this. The two staff representatives from the breed associations were wonder-

ful also.

It was also impressive that two different breed associations would get together and collaborate in this way. This demonstrates that there can be POWER in collaboration.

If the Gelbvieh and Limousin breeds can collaborate, maybe the Big 12 can do the same.
