CoBank, a cooperative bank serving agribusinesses, rural infrastructure providers and Farm Credit associations throughout the United States, has announced it is launching a \$150,000 charitable fund to support wildfire relief efforts throughout the states of Kansas, Oklahoma and

Recent fires have impacted farming and ranching communities in all three states, burning hundreds of thousands of acres, destroying property and killing livestock. In Kansas, an estimated 700,000 acres have burned throughout more than 20 counties in the state's southwest and central regions. In Oklahoma,

the Forestry Service has estimated that approximately 400,000 acres have burned and a state of emergency has been declared in 22 counties. An estimated 325.000 acres have burned throughout the Texas panhandle.

"These wildfires have had a devastating impact," said Tom Halverson, Co-Bank's president and chief executive officer. "CoBank is committed to working hand-in-hand with our customers, other Farm Credit organizations and local relief agencies to support farmers, ranchers and other victims of these fires in impacted communities."

All five Farm Credit associations in the state of Kansas have already committed to using the fund to support relief efforts in that state. American AgCredit, Farm Credit of Ness City, Farm Credit of Western Kansas, Frontier Farm Credit, and High Plains Farm Credit have pledged \$80,000, which will be entirely matched by

The remaining \$70,000 in the fund is available to all active CoBank borrowers as well as Farm Credit banks and associations. Contributions to relief efforts will be matched on a dollar-for-dollar basis and coordinated through the bank's Corporate Communications Division. New Conservation Reserve Program SAFE Practice offers market-based financial incentive for restoring playas

Kansas landowners and ag producers who have playas on their property may be eligible for a new USDA Continuous Conservation Reserve Program (CRP) practice that provides a market-based financial incentive for restoring playas and planting a native grass buffer around them. The newly established Migratory Bird, Butterfly, and Pollinator Habitat State Acres for Wildlife Enhancement (Migratory Bird SAFE) practice uses a reverse auction whereby landowners submit an offer to enroll their playa for the amount they are willing to accept as an annual payment — up to a maximum amount of \$300 per acre — for a period of ten to fifteen years. This practice is entirely focused on conserving playas, a critical source of water for the wildlife and people in western Kansas. The name of the program gives a hint at how important these temporary wetlands are to the region's wildlife, but playas also provide important benefits for the people who live in this region. Research shows that properly functioning playas are a primary source of recharge for the Ogallala Aquifer — contributing up to 95 percent of inflow to the aquifer and improving the quality of that water. USDA will evaluate submitted offers for the Migratory Bird SAFE in a competitive process. As a continuous CRP signup conservation practice, landowners can submit bids at any time, but offers will be ranked at intervals. Offers that don't make the first cut-off date, or aren't accepted during the first batch, will be carried over for consideration during the next round. To be considered in the first ranking, offers must be received by March 31, 2017.

Total precipitation from Sept. 1, 2016, to Feb. 28, 2017. varied widely with some areas receiving far more than normal precipitation while the entire southwest quarter of Kansas received below-normal precipitation, Weather Data Library. "As a consequence of

the precipitation shortage last fall in southwest Kansas, many fields there have erratic stands or are just now germinating or emerging," said Lollato, a wheat specialist with K-State Research and Extension. That leaves growers facing several agronomic and economic considerations as they decide whether to maintain the crop or plant the field to a different spring-planted crop.

In fields where the wheat seed sowing depth was relatively deep (two inches), the first leaf may have started below ground, he said. Some of those plants may never push through the soil surface, so those fields may have scattered wheat stands. In other fields that were dry last fall and now have moisture, shoots may push through and producers could end up with a decent stand. In these cases, sowing depth, seed treatment, seed vigor, and occurrence of pests and diseases will affect the final stand.

have a more normal warm an early greening of wheat fields, with some already past the jointing stage of development in south-central areas.

> "The early spring greenup will require producers to make certain management practices, such as nitrogen fertilization, earlier than normal," the agronomist said. "Winter wheat turns from vegetative to reproductive development after its vernalization requirements are met - normally in early spring, so the number of spikelets per head is determined at greenup. Having nitrogen in the root zone by then is critical to ensure good head formation and to maximize the number of spikelets per head."

Insect management is another important consideration in warmer-than-usual

conditions. Another major consequence of the early start to this growing season is the heightened risk of freeze injury to the developing crop, Lollato said. He noted the average last date for freezing temperatures in Kansas ranges from early April in southeast Kansas to early May in northwest Kansas.

Where the crop is developing early, it is more likely to be in more-sensitive phases of development if and when a freeze occurs this spring, he said. A recent cold snap, during which minimum air temperatures reached as low as 9 degrees Fahrenheit from March 8-14, is a good example of that. While most Kansas wheat should have

dodged the detrimental effects of that freeze event, especially fields where the growing point was still below ground, it highlights how the crop may be vulnerable to a freeze in the near future. As of March 22, many fields around the state are reaching the jointing stage of growth, and a similar cold snap could be much more detrimental.

If the crop escapes freeze injury, either by a mismatch between freeze occurrence and highly sensitive growth stages or due to the absence of a freeze, an early spring

green-up might signify an early grain fill period.

"During the 2015-2016 growing season, the Kansas crop avoided three major freeze events due to a mismatch between freeze occurrence and sensitive stages of development, and yields were generally very good since the crop experienced good grain-filling conditions," Lollato said. "It will all depend on the weather moving forward."

He said many fields are showing yellowing of older leaves, typically from a combination of drought and nitrogen deficiency stresses. "In many cases, producers were timely applying the nitrogen to the wheat crop. but the lack of moisture did not distribute the nitrogen to the root zone, where it needs to be in order for uptake. If this week's precipitation forecast materializes, it will be beneficial to the crop to reduce some of the drought stress and ensure nitrogen is in the root zone for plant uptake."

Schwieterman Market Outlook

A marketing commentary by Bret Crotts

March 31st we will get the Quarterly Stocks Report and the Prospective Plantings Report from USDA. It has been a long time since we had the long string of seemingly random stocks numbers from USDA, so that report isn't much of a concern. However, the Prospective Plantings Report will be very important and set the tone of the corn and soybean markets for the next couple of months. Market direction will be determined by how close the corn and soybean acreage figures are to 90 million. 90 million

acres of corn would be supportive, but much more than that would be construed as negative. 90 million acres of soybeans would be outright bearish, but the number would have to be less than 86 million to be considered even a little friendly. Obviously the assumption is that we are going to see fewer corn acres and more soybean acres, the unknown is just how big of a change will be get. Be prepared for a lot of volatility on Friday because numbers that are very far away from expectations will create big moves in the

On the charts, it was a pretty rough week for the corn, wheat and beans. We ended up seeing multimonth lows in all three and not much sign of support. Demand wasn't really the problem since we saw good numbers across the board, but ideas that the S. American crops are great, soybean acreage is going to expand in the US, and that rain will salvage the U.S. HRW crop, all worked together to keep the markets under pressure. The July KW seems to have found support at the \$4.40 level for now, but it looks like the July corn will have to test the \$3.60 area and the July beans may be headed for \$9.50, especially if we get a large acreage figure Friday.

The cattle market was basically the opposite of the grains. We saw new multimonth highs or new contract highs in virtually every contract. The Fed Cattle Exchange had a high of \$136 and an average of \$133.50, so the momentum of that market is clearly up, and the feeder cattle auctions were at least \$3 higher than the prior week, all week long.

Demand for beef is very good right now and the prob-

lems in Brazil with their inspection system will either help with the demand for U.S. beef, or cut the available supply that we can import. Depending on how long it takes to resolve their problems, we could see a significant increase in U.S. beef prices.

Looking ahead, the cash cattle market is still well above the futures, but that probably won't change until after the April live cattle options expire. If the cash market is still strong at that point, the delivery period for the April live cattle contract will be pretty exciting. In the feeder cattle market, the March futures are above the cash index. but since the index is rising, that doesn't concern me too much. Chances are that the cash market will be up with where the futures are in time for expiration.

Despite fewer hives, **Kansas** honey production increases

Honey production in 2016 from Kansas producers with five or more colonies totaled 336 thousand pounds, up 17 percent from 2015, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Ser-

There were 7,000 honey producing colonies in Kansas during 2016, down 13 percent from 2015.

Average yield was 48 pounds per colony, up 12 pounds from 2015. Producer stocks were 54 thousand pounds on December 15, 2016 down 50 percent from a year earlier.

Prices for the 2016 crop averaged 297 cents per pound, down from 350 cents in 2015. Prices were based on retail sales by producers and sales to private processors and cooperatives. Total value of honey produced in 2015 was 998 thousand dollars, down 1 percent from 2015.



Sales tax exemption and refund programs available for fencing materials used to rebuild after Kansas wildfires

To help provide farmers and ranchers rebuilding after the 2016 and 2017 Kansas wildfires, the Kansas Department of Revenue has created www.ksrevenue. org/wildfires with information on applying for refund and exemption certificates.

In March, the Legislature passed and Governor Sam Brownback signed into law a bill exempting the sales tax on fencing material used to reconstruct agricultural fences destroyed by wildfires in calendar years 2016 and 2017.

The page includes information on both the refund and exemption certificate application processes, the required forms for both programs and answers to frequently asked questions.

We realize that Kansas farmers and ranchers are rebuilding their lives and hope that this information will help them access assistance easily," said Revenue Secretary Sam Williams.

In addition to the sales tax exemptions, the department is also waiving some fines and fees for those in fire-affected-areas including:

• Those who lost a driv- they can bring in insurance er's license or ID card in the wildfires can get a free replacement by visiting a state driver licensing office or a county treasurer's office that offers driver's license renewals.

- Those who need to replace vehicle titles lost in the wildfires can get a free replacement by visiting their local county treasurer's office.
- People who need replacement copies of their tax returns can call 785-296-3081, and the department will provide a copy for free.
- For those who lost vehicles in the wildfires,

claims to their local county treasurer's office and apply for a refund for the vehicle's tags.

- Homeowners may be eligible for a property tax abatement on destroyed or substantially destroyed dwellings due to fire. Contact your county appraiser's office for details.
- For businesses affected by the wildfires, which are busy trying to reopen, the department will waive any late filing fees they incur if they file those taxes late. The owner should call 785-368-8222 to coordinate with the department.

griculture nominee to distance himself from businesses

(AP) - Agriculture secretary nominee Sonny Perdue says he will step down from several positions at companies bearing his name, restructure family trusts and create blind trusts to avoid a conflict of interest if he is confirmed.

In a written agreement with a government ethics agency, the former Georgia governor said he will also step down from positions

at the National Grain and Feed Association and the Georgia Agribusiness Coun-

"I will not participate personally and substantially in any particular matter in which I know that I have a financial interest directly and predictably affected by the matter," Perdue said in the agreement.

The agreement is routine for any member of the Cabinet. Senators have been waiting for more than seven weeks for Perdue's letter, which is dated March 7 but was posted on the Office of Government Ethics website just recently.

Donald Trump chose Perdue for the job on Jan. 18, two days before the inauguration, but the formal nomination was only sent to the Senate last week.

A financial disclosure form released by the ethics office shows that Perdue holds substantial assets from agricultural companies, including a grain merchandising company called AGrowStar that is worth between \$5 million and \$25 million.

The ethics agreement is required by the Ethics in Government Act of 1978. passed after the Watergate

In the weeks since he was chosen, Perdue has held several meetings with senators on Capitol Hill. Farmstate senators have mostly praised his nomination, including Democrat Heidi Heitkamp of North Dakota,

who said she would support him.

Perdue, 70, is a farmer's son who would be the first Southerner in the post in more than two decades. He built businesses in grain trading and trucking before becoming the first Republican governor of Georgia since Reconstruction.

Like Trump, Perdue declined while serving as governor to put his assets in a Mike Young is in charge.

blind trust, as his immediate predecessors had done. He said then that he did not want to abandon businesses that were still operating. That set the stage for critics to question various land deals and tax breaks and prompted charges of conflict of interest.

While Perdue's nomination is pending, acting Agriculture Deputy Secretary



As the farming and ranching community watched the horrors of the southwest Kansas wildfires unfold, the gut-wrenching images became a call to action for many individuals, businesses and organizations. Many area sale barns have conducted roll-over auctions with cattle donated by individuals, and several producers conducting spring sales donated partial or complete proceeds from designated animals to the effort. According to Kansas Livestock Association, Farmers and Ranchers Livestock in Salina sold a Charolais bull donated by Fink Beef Genetics

that brought \$12,200 and a both of Blue Rapids. comheifer pair donated by Norman Fuller sold for \$3,600. With other donations, they raised close to \$20,000. A steer donated by Neal and Marya Haverkamp sold at Marysville Livestock Auction for 16,038 and they plan to keep a donation jar available for a week or so. Pratt Livestock also held a benefit auction. Holton Livestock sold a steer donated by Kim and Kelly Kirkham of Valley Falls in a roll-over auction for a total of \$27,381 and a steer donated by Steve Arndt sold multiple times at Emporia Livestock for total donations of \$38,376.

Wedel Red Angus accepted fencing supplies and cash donations at their annual sale in Leoti.

Springhill Herefords and Alcove Cattle Company, mitted 5% of all bull sales from their On Target Bull Sale and gave customers the opportunity to match or exceed the 5%. \$6,900 was raised. The Wide Awake 4-H Club that meets in Blue Rapids also had a table set up at the On Target Bull Sale, which raised \$320 for the orphan calf project they partnered on with Grass & Grain, and raised \$320.

Kratzger Show Goats donated the proceeds from a purebred boar doe and Hinkson Angus Ranch contributed the proceeds from a 3-year-old commercial cowcalf pair from their production sale. The pair brought \$2,200 and other donations brought the total to \$2,900. Twenty-five percent of the proceeds of two bulls from the McCabe Genetics bull

and commercial email sale were designated for wildfire relief, as was money from the sale of an open Angus heifer from Black Velvet Cattle's production sale at Mankato Livestock.

Farms Woodbury pledged the proceeds from a registered heifer from their annual bull and female sale, which was held at Overbook Livestock Commission Company, and brought more than \$8,000. Flat Iron Angus donated the proceeds from an open registered heifer from their production sale.

Sandhill Farms of Havilland donated a registered Hereford bull to be sold during their annual bull and female sale on March 31.

The Kansas Angus Association pledged \$1,000 to the Kansas Livestock Foundation and the Kansas Junior Angus Association is raising funds for a special project.

Many individuals and companies have donated hay for the ranchers affected by the fires, and sometimes that required teamwork and sharing of resources. When Randy Fisher from Garden City wanted to donate hay, he was faced with the challenge of hauling it and called Shawn Tiffany to see if he knew of anyone who had a truck that could be used. When Shawn couldn't locate one, he let them use his. Jason and Justin Brown of JC Cattle Company in Dwight donated the use of their drop deck trailer and Matt Forge provided a driver. When local ranchers got wind of it, more hay was donated until six loads had been delivered. Also donating hay


were Todd Britt, Kent and state, but an effort has been Rose Bacon, Tiffany Cattle Company, Cattle Company and Korby Effland.
