

Rural artist turns yard trash into treasure

SCRANTON(AP) — When Terry Miles looks at a rusty disk or shovel for sale at an auction, he doesn't see useless farm tools or equipment. He sees tail feathers for a turkey, the curved body

of a frog or petals for a flower.

Miles deconstructs metal equipment and objects and then uses the scrap iron to build yard art.

"You got to have a little

imagination and the right piece of metal," the 56-year-old Union Pacific track foreman said.

Miles said he began creating his artwork about 10 years ago. His first piece was a Jayhawk made from a shovel, pick, bicycle fork and shoe forms from a cobbler.

From there, he went wherever his imagination took him. Typically, he gets an idea, sketches it on paper and then can't wait to start making it.

The yard of Miles' home southeast of Scranton is a showcase for his work. Scrap-metal flamingos standing 4 feet high languish at a nearby pond. Large spiders formed from disk blades or milk cans crawl up the side of a tree. Cornstalks made of rebar and scrap metal with real ears of dried

corn serve as squirrel feeders.

His smaller creations are lined on shelves outside of the garage where he grinds and welds the metal pieces together. Horseshoes become cowboys. Circular faucet handles become flowers for a wall hanging that has a floor heater register or a basketball goal as a

frame. An iron skillet serves as the body for a mouse while nails and ball bearings help form its whiskers and nose. Railroad spikes become the body of a sprinting roadrunner.

"You can't make two things the same way," he said, looking over his work.

While Miles does all the grinding and welding, his wife, Debbie, often helps paint his creations.

Miles doesn't participate

in arts and crafts shows, and he doesn't sell his yard art on the Internet. His customers find out about him simply by word of mouth.

"I do a lot of trading with people," he said. "I just like making people happy."

Miles said he has a list of scrap metal projects he like to do in the future. At the top of that list are an elephant, a Kansas State University wildcat and a totem pole.

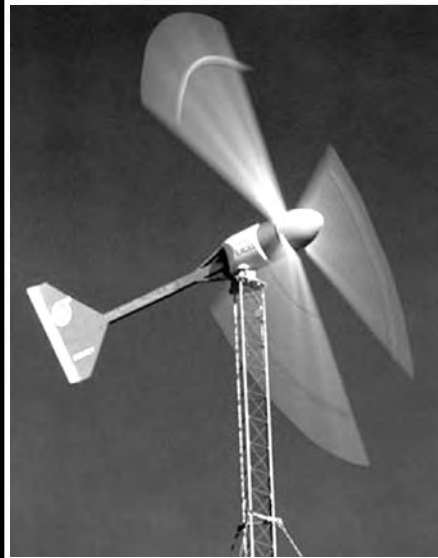

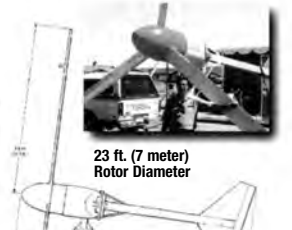

ML Ranch to host ranch management field day

Maximizing the use of grazing resources to reduce feed costs will highlight the topics to be addressed August 19 during a field day at ML Ranch near Peru. The operation, owned by Mike and Libby Long, revolves around a backgrounding and stocker business, with some beef cows as well. This will be the first of three ranch management field days presented by the Kansas Livestock Association (KLA) and Kansas State University.

The cost of feeding and carrying a beef cow for one year is the most significant expense item for cow-calf producers. Dry-lotting cows or hauling feed while native grass is dormant is considerably more costly than previous years. K-State animal nutritionist KC Olson will provide several suggestions on how producers might be able to reduce input costs, including stretching out the grazing season and matching calving dates with available grazing resources. Natural Resources Conservation Service technician David Criger and K-State watershed specialist Warren Bell will give a presentation on state and federal cost-share programs available to assist producers in designing and developing stockwatering systems. Alternatives to be discussed include piping to stock tanks, spring development, pit ponds and use of pond water for supplying alternative sites.

Another educational session will focus on the

“Locate in 48” program. Premises registration for the National Animal Identification System is a voluntary program, but producers all across the U.S. are helping the industry prepare for an emergency disease outbreak. The program is designed to encourage producers to register their premises, which would allow animal health officials to conduct more efficient, timely and cost-effective disease traceback. KLA Director of Feedlot Services Clayton Huseman and KLA Stockgrowers Council Chair Beth Patterson, Yates Center, will discuss why and how producers should register their premises. Attendees also will hear from K-State veterinarian Larry Hollis about the effects of water quality and animal health products on cattle health and beef quality. Hollis will provide an overview of commonly found water quality problems in Kansas and tips on how to avoid these is-

issues, which can cause producers considerable problems. He also will discuss why the proper handling and use of pharmaceutical products is vital for good beef quality and consumer satisfaction.

The Peru field day will begin with registration at 3:30 p.m. and conclude with a free beef dinner at 6:45 p.m. All livestock producers and others involved in the business are invited to attend.

ML Ranch is located in Chautauqua County. From the Highway 99 and Highway 166 junction, go south on 99 four miles to Chautauqua. On the east side of Highway 99, going through Chautauqua, go one block past Steve's 99 convenience store to Chautauqua Street. Go east on Chautauqua Street (Cowboy Road) for two miles. At the intersection of Road 22 and Cowboy Road, go north π mile to the bulk tanks. From Highway 166, one mile east of the Highway 99 and Highway 166

junction, go south on Road 21 2.4 miles to Dalton Road. From the Road 21 and Dalton Road intersection, go one mile east to Road 22. From the Road 22 and Dalton Road intersection, go south 1.4 miles. Enter at the bulk tanks. Directional signs will be posted. KLA and K-State also will host ranch management field days August 21 at Fletchall Ranch near Beloit and September 26 at Gant-Larson Ranch near Medicine Lodge. Unique aspects of each operation will be incorporated into the educational sessions.

Learn rangeland plants at weekend event

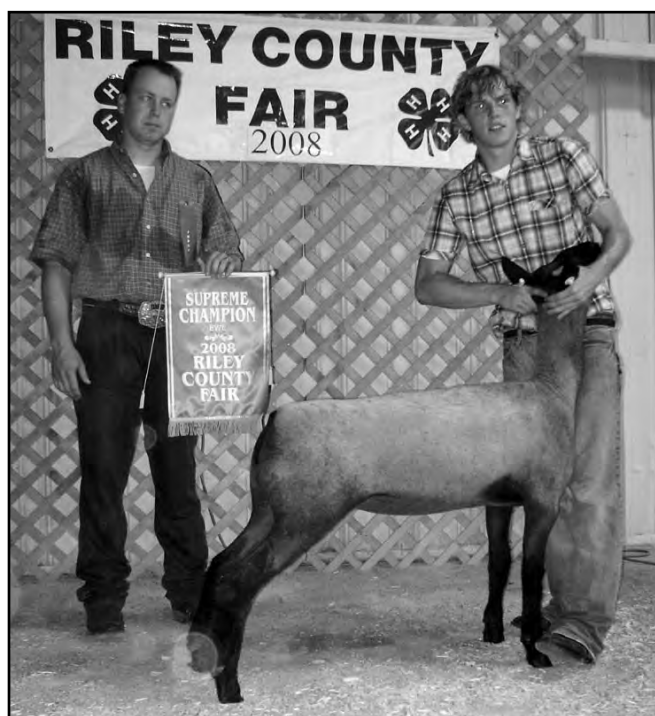
A native prairie rangeland in eastern Kansas could easily have 500 species of plants. A few important grasses can be quickly recognized. Weeds also get their due share of publicity. But what benefits do remaining mix of 450 grasses and broadleaf plants impart to the overall production and forage value of the prairie?

Get to know the rangeland plants by name and learn about information resources on September 13 and 14, at Tallgrass Prairie National Preserve in Chase County. On this special weekend, Kansas Native Plant Society (www.kansasnativeplantsociety.org) members will be at Tallgrass Preserve to lead plant walks and share information related to plants in Kansas.

The Tallgrass Prairie National Preserve, located two miles north of Strong City on Hwy. 177, is nearly 11,000 acres of rolling prairie, springs, creeks, and woodlands. The National Park Service will have guided bus tours out onto the prairie as well as tours of the historic

stone house and barn.

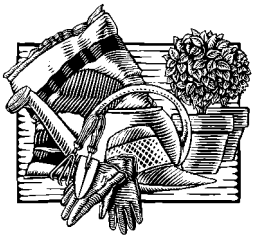

Yard & Garden Tips

By Gregg Eyestone

Browning of our trees

Trees have taken a beating the past nine months. It started with the December ice storm. Wind and tornadoes haven't helped them out. Now we are faced with insects and a disease that typically appear at this time.

All of these conditions may lead one to want to remove all their trees. Tree benefits like providing shade on a hot day and providing something for the kids to climb on are good enough reasons to have trees. If you need more convincing go to www.treesaregood.com.

Fall webworm is becoming noticeable on many trees such as red-bud, walnut, crabapple, mulberry and others. These caterpillars feed on leaves that are within their web. This is smart for the caterpillars since they are mostly protected from predators and insecticidal sprays. But even smarter are the trees. The feeding of the fall webworm doesn't harm the tree. Although several insecticides like carbaryl and spinosad will kill webworm, it isn't necessary for tree health.

Many honeylocust trees

in the area have mimosa webworm. These trees have brown leaves wrapped in webbing on the terminal ends. Many of the same insecticides for fall webworm will manage mimosa webworm. For any insecticide to be effective, it must get to the pests and through the webbing. Just as the fall webworm doesn't injure its host, mimosa webworm doesn't harm honeylocust. Or for that matter, it doesn't even try to feed on my mimosa tree.

Pines that appear to brown up overnight from top to bottom, most likely have a disease call pinewilt. The disease actually got started in May but takes the heat and drought stress of summer to finish off the tree. The only practical solution is to cut the dead trees down and hope it doesn't spread to other pines.

There are many available resources for information on these and other gardening topics. Stop by the Extension office for a publication on any of these topics.

Fall is a great time to plant trees and preferably pest-free kinds. I hope you can attend a "Back to Gardening" event on Wednesday, August 27 from 6 p.m. to 9 p.m. in Pottorf Hall. Sessions on a variety of fall gardening activities will be held including trees.

AngusSource reveals performance information

Good data, good people and good cattle. In combination, they add up to top honors in the 2008 spring quarter AngusSource Carcass Challenge (ASCC).

Beller Feedlot, Lindsay, Neb., fed 62 calves that took home first place in the second quarter of the calendar-year contest. The Certified Angus Beef LLC (CAB) licensed feedlot will vie for the overall \$500 cash award when the competition ends in December.

The genetic-, source- and age-verified calves came from three different ranches and were 80.7% CAB and CAB Prime. That's 12.5 points above the next closest entry in the April to June time frame.

Terry Beller, feedyard owner-manager, has purchased cattle from Montana ranchers Mike Green, Den-

nis Green, and Scott and Traci Glasscock for more than five years.

"We have a very good relationship going. They plan on me to come up there and I plan on them for numbers," he says. At Beller's suggestion, his suppliers began tagging their calves for AngusSource, a USDA Process Verified Program (PVP) since 2005.

Beller also looks for an ideal situation: calves that gain and grade.

"That's why I go back to those producers every year. After so many years of data you can just about pin the costs on them, what it's going to cost to gain, what their conversions are going to be," he says. "That's why CAB has been a big help because we get that data and we can get it back to them so they can make changes

if they need to."

Traci Glasscock, of Rock Springs, Mont., says it has given them another tool in selecting breeding stock.

Mark McCully, CAB director of supply development, says the company's feedlot program was set up to facilitate these relationships.

The steers were the second harvest group from a pen that was sorted using the Centralized Ultrasound Processing (CUP) Lab, Ames, Iowa.

"We scanned for high marbling and took the top 62. These were kind of the heart of them, but even the other cattle did extremely well," Beller says. "It speaks for the quality that we feed here. It's just nice to work with those producers that are in the same mindset we are: focused toward quality."

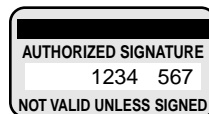

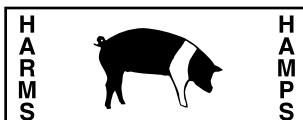

"I told her dad she might feel bad if it got a low ribbon," Sharon said, after finding out that the quilt had won its division. "So, she should be happy."

A younger granddaughter, Lacey, caught her grandmother's quilting bug when she was 6 years old and has since been showcasing her skills at the fair, as well. This year, at age 14, Lacey took home a purple ribbon and the grand champion quilt quest award with the quilt she had quilted on a long-arm machine.

Sharon is geared up for her latest project, and an ambitious one at that. "The newest idea is, I want to make one for our 50th wedding anniversary," she said.

Ivan and Sharon will celebrate 50 years of marriage Aug. 23 and, as of July 23, she hadn't yet begun the project.

"It's going to happen," she said, smiling. "I'm going to make it happen."

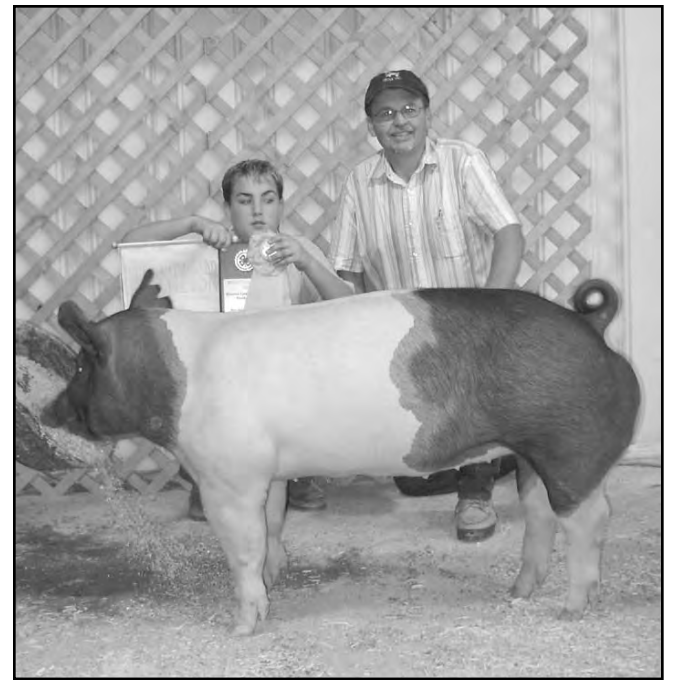

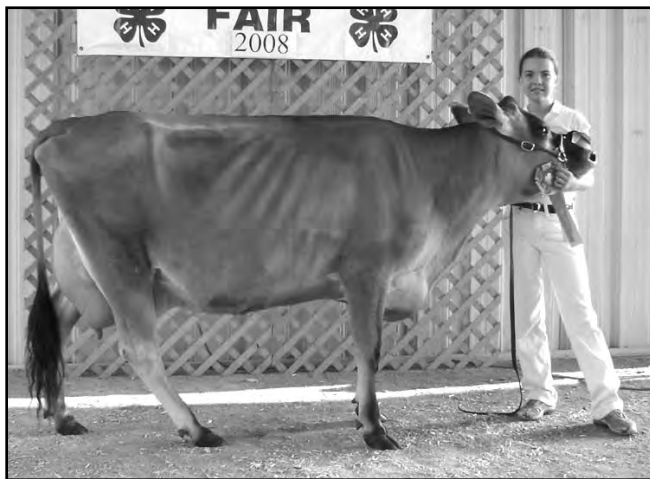

Kansas and Missouri building a foodie following for special swine

KANSAS CITY, Mo. (AP) — Nate Appleman stands in the abattoir at Paradise Locker Meats in Trimble, Mo., just inches away from the hanging carcass of a 300-pound Berkshire hog.

Abattoir is an elegant French word for slaughterhouse. But the rising star chef does not so much as flinch, even though moments earlier he had witnessed the hog's last breath. Even though the day before he had watched spotted piglets romping through pastures at Newman Farm in the Ozarks.

Most days the 29-year-old chef is at his popular San

Francisco restaurants A 16 and SPQR or working on his third restaurant, Urbino, due to open in January 2009 in an up-and-coming neighborhood known as Dogpatch. At 6,000 square feet, Urbino is large enough to include a commissary where Appleman will hand-cut his own meat from whole animals.

On this day Appleman is one of five chefs from trend-setting restaurants around the country who have paid their own way to see how the heritage-breed hogs they serve for dinner live — and die.

Watching a hog slaughter

is not for the squeamish. But for a growing number of top chefs, putting richer-tasting pork on the plate means learning more about how the hogs are raised.

Heritage pork starts on the farm with genetically superior breeds, such as Berkshire, Red Wattle, Tamworth and Duroc, and ends with custom butchering, an art fewer meat-cutters are mastering in the Age of McRib.

The two-day Newman University agri-culinary tour is the brainchild of Patrick Martins, the co-founder of Heritage Foods USA. Since 2002 the company has promoted independent family farms, biodiversity, humane production and traceability in the food supply. Last year the company sold \$5 million worth of heritage-breed pork, turkey, chicken, beef, bison, lamb and goat.

Visiting chefs include Mark Ladner, executive chef/partner of Del Posto, the pinnacle of fine dining in the New York-based Lidia Bastianich/Mario Batali empire; Colin Alevras, chef/owner of the Tasting Room in New York City; Anna Klinger of Al di La, an American chef who runs the popular restaurant in Brooklyn with her Italian-born husband; and Zach Allen, executive chef of Carnevino in Las Vegas, another outpost in the far-flung Batali restaurant group.

The day before the trip to the meat locker in Trimble, 25 miles north of Kansas City, the chefs had visited Mark and Rita Newman's hog farm in Myrtle, Mo. The last stop on the tour was a heritage pork dinner at Justus Drugstore: A Restaurant in Smithville, prepared by chef/owner Jonathan Justus.

Although there are pockets of heritage producers in other parts of the country, 80 percent of the Heritage Foods-branded pork comes from small family farms in Kansas and Missouri, a region Martins refers to as the

epicenter of a larger heritage foods movement.

While commercial hog producers may butcher thousands of animals a day, Mark Newman delivers only 100 Berkshire hogs each week for processing and shipping from Paradise Locker Meats.

"We're a very small producer in today's world," he says.

Chefs are willing to pay a premium for heritage pork because the animals spend their whole lives in a pasture, growing to market weight more slowly. As a result, they produce meat that is richer tasting, darker in color and more heavily marbled.

Although the pork is also available to the home cook, it is more expensive than supermarket brands — four slabs of St. Louis-style ribs cost \$135 plus shipping.

"The thing is," Appleman says, "in a blind taste-test setting, the better pork always wins. In a supermarket setting, the inferior pork always wins. (Consumers) have heard pork is lean and the other white meat," so they go for the palest, whitest meat."

Charlotte Fulkerson calls herself a picky eater — she likes her meat off the bone and without any visible fat.

A regular at Justus Drugstore, she was persuaded one night to give the pork shank a try. When it arrived at the table, she was shaken to see her \$25 entrée included a substantial bone. But just one taste of the fork-tender meat, with its "delectable" pockets of fat, and she was a convert.

"It's really difficult to buy at (the supermarket) after you've had heritage pork," says Fulkerson, who lives in Trimble and is a teacher in the Liberty school district.

If you ask a farmer like Newman, the flavor Fulkerson tasted is from the intramuscular fat on the hog. A chef like Dan Swinney refers to the same fat as marbling, a trait that has

been bred out of pork in recent decades to cater to fat-phobic consumers.

"I'm not sure where I first tasted heritage pork, but I remember it kind of brought back a flavor memory I'd tasted as a kid," says Swinney, the executive chef at Lidia's Kansas City.

About five years ago Swinney was ordering pork from other suppliers. But when he found out the same quality product was being raised and processed in his own backyard, he became the first local chef to buy from Heritage Foods.

Soon the other Bastianich/Batali chefs followed Swinney's lead.

Lidia's Kansas City uses many lesser cuts, while prime cuts are shipped to Del Posto, where the check average is two to three times higher.

Swinney's menu features chops and shanks, as well as pork bellies used to make pancetta and pork shoulder to make Luganega sausage that flavors the restaurant's popular "Sunday Sauce."

Meanwhile, Mario Fantasma, who owns Paradise Locker Meats in Trimble, knows that to supply chefs across the country with Missouri-raised heritage pork, he needs to understand what they do with the raw ingredients.

"You just can't put two and two together if you don't go and eat at the restaurant," Fantasma says. "We've been to New York, and I probably gained 50 pounds, but we got to taste all these products from a chef's perspective."

And yes, Mario has actually met Mario.

"He's a great guy," Fantasma says of Batali. "He let us even go in his kitchen as a matter of fact he said, 'Are you going to do any work tonight, or not?' I said, 'Give me a knife and let's get going!'"

Ladner, the soft-spoken, introspective chef of Del Posto, admits he wasn't sure what to expect when he signed on to watch

the slaughter of his dinner.

"It's an important part of the process to witness," he says. "I've certainly watched films and the sensationalized videos and all this stuff, but it was very, very civilized. It was very calm. It was really clean. Everybody there seemed like they were very focused and well-trained and actually interested in what they were doing."

But here he is ordering from the menu at Justus Drugstore, which features a choice of Berkshire pork shank with wild arugula pesto, hominy, Berkshire bacon, creamy polenta, arugula salad and fresh apple vinaigrette for \$23 or a Berkshire pork ribeye with caramelized shallots, Maytag blue cheese and fig sauce atop housemade pasta with green beans for \$25.

"Most of the stories you hear are that (small farms are) dying and that we're on the cusp of a global food crisis," Ladner says as the chefs, farmers and butchers tablehop late into the night. "And these guys are — through many different measures — trying to reverse these trends. They're really positive, ethical, ecological. Anything we can do to embrace that, we'll try to do. It's undeniably our future."

Mark Newman, the farmer, agrees. "We've always taken it for granted that if we produce it, they will buy it. And that's not the case. As things change, we need to supply consumers with the best eating experience they can have."

But in a time of rising food prices, are consumers willing to pay more for premium pork?

Martins sees heritage foods as something that could one day become as popular as organic food at Wal-Mart. "It's not our job to change the world, but maybe it is our job to set the standard that other people could strive to achieve," he says.
