Gunsmoke: A Classic Western

2010 is one of those round-number years. Any year ending in 10 makes it easy to do the math. Those years make it easy to calculate how many years have elapsed since some landmark (when we bought the sorrel mare, how old our kids are, etc.).

2010 also marks a landmark year in the history of television. Fall 2010 will be the 55th year since the debut of the show which would become the longest-running non-animated television show in American history. It was a classic western called Gunsmoke.

The show Gunsmoke actually predates television. Gunsmoke was a successful

radio program in the 1950s. As a kid, I can barely remember gathering around the radio with our family to listen to Gunsmoke.

Just as in modern times, the copycats in Hollywood try to make sequels or reuse ideas which have already been successful. So as television developed, CBS decided to make the radio program into a TV show. The radio show's lead character was Marshal Matt Dillon, played by William Conrad — yes, the same William Conrad who later played the detective Cannon on TV. His strong voice made him a great choice to portray the Marshal on radio, but his short, stocky build

didn't translate well to television.

So CBS went looking for a new actor to play Marshal Dillon. Eventually, they found him in James Arness.

Arness, by the way, is the brother of Peter Graves — yes, the same Peter Graves who starred on Mission Impossible.

Gunsmoke debuted on television in September 1955. Marshal Dillon's first deputy was a young fellow with a bad leg and an amusing manner. His name was Chester Goode, played by Dennis Weaver — yes, the same Dennis Weaver who later played McCloud and other roles in movies and television.

Chester was succeeded in later years as deputy by Festus Haggen, played by Ken Curtis — yes, the same Ken Curtis who had sung with the Sons of the Pioneers in the 1950s. His portrayal of Festus as a scruffy hillbilly was quite memorable. In 1952, Curtis had married Barbara Ford, the daughter of John Ford — yes, the same John Ford who directed John Wayne in his classic western movies.

The female lead in Gunsmoke was Amanda Blake

who portrayed Miss Kitty Russell, the proprietor of the Long Branch Saloon. She was a mainstay, having joined the show in its second season. Miss Kitty was a fiery redhead, although I didn't know it at first because we were watching the show on a black-and-white television!

The other mainstay of the show was Milburn Stone, who was actually a native Kansan. He was born in Bur-

ton, down near Hutchinson. Stone followed his uncle into vaudeville and then moved to Hollywood, where he was eventually cast as Doc — Dr. Galen Adams. He and Arness were the only ones to be on the show through its entire 20 year run.

By the way, according to legend, James Arness was not the first choice for the starring role in Gunsmoke. Reportedly, the studio's first

choice turned down the part. His name was John Wayne — yes, the same. . . Well, you know.

So 2010 is truly a landmark year, marking the 55th year since the debut of Gunsmoke. In 2005, the people of Dodge City hosted a seminar to celebrate the half-century since the debut of this wonderful show, and here is the poem I presented there. Gunsmoke is my favorite tv western.

Gunsmoke!

I can't believe it's been fifty years, Since the TV show Gunsmoke did first appear.

In September 1955, came a new series that would grow and thrive.

It featured a tall brave lawman played by James Arness. At capturing the bad guys, he was the best. You knew that we would get the villain, As he played the character, Marshal Matt Dillon.

At the Long Branch saloon, he had a friend who was pretty, But he never quite got hitched with his friend Miss Kitty.

In an office above the town boardwalk, was the town doctor who, of course, was called Doc.

Chester was Marshal Dillon's deputy. He walked with a limp for everyone to see.

Then Festus Haggen came on the show,

Along with Newly and Quint and others also.

Good acting, good writing and other reasons, Kept that show going for twenty seasons.

It was the longest running series in the history of our nation, And provided entertainment for young and old generations.

So I can't believe it began a half-century ago, But it brings back good memories of the Gunsmoke TV show.

P.S.

When I visited Dodge City, one thing made me frown: where were all those mountains the Marshal rode into whenever he rode out of town?

Schwieterman Market Outlook

A marketing commentary by Bret Crofts

Thursday is the June supply and demand report. There is the potential to see numerous changes in the corn, wheat, and soybean tables. Starting with the corn, the important number to watch is the corn yield. USDA is already above trend line with their yield estimate of 163.5 bu/ac due to the early planting, but it is possible that they increase the yield because the crop condition ratings are very good. Many traders are already talking about another record high yield and this is evident when you look at last week's market activity. Several important support levels failed in the December corn and now it looks like the market is headed back to the September low of \$3.52 ¼. To me it seems that it is a little early to be so confident in a record high yield, but when the outside markets are putting pressure on the market bearish talk seems to come from everywhere. There is a

little bit of talk about La Nina and adverse weather later this summer, but traders aren't going to be concerned about that unless the outside markets are supportive or some threatening weather actually materializes.

The wheat supply and demand tables are going to be bearish, it is just a matter of how bearish. I am very curious to see what USDA does with the old crop export estimate. We didn't sell, or ship, near enough wheat to meet the estimate, and I don't think donations have been large enough to fill the gap, so I think a sizeable cut is possible. All that really means though, is that extremely large ending stocks would become just a little bigger and that the piles of wheat on the ground at harvest should be expected to be just a little bit bigger. There is also the possibility that USDA increases the yield estimate. That is by no means a given since rust is-

sues are very wide spread, but overall crop condition ratings are good and one shouldn't be surprised to see higher production in this report.

The wheat market needs to see more demand and lower prices are the only way to attract demand at this point. My biggest fear right now is that the basis continues to erode. Basis has been very poor from time to time, but according to my records, it hasn't been this bad for this long. Since 1980 there have been several instances where basis has been -.90 to -.95, but I have no record of \$1.00 under. \$1.00 under is very common this year. Even the terminal elevators are .80 to .90 under right now. That would make it seem like it shouldn't be able to get any worse, but historically it is common for wheat basis to erode into late summer/early fall in years when we have plentiful wheat supplies. For the sake of hedgers, I hope we

don't see that happen, but I am not confident that it won't. In the short run, plan on the July KW moving down to \$4.50, and hope that the basis doesn't fall a like amount.

The soybean supply and demand numbers should be friendly for the old crop. It is likely that USDA increases the export estimate one more time, since old crop soybean sales are still running considerably over the needed pace. For the new crop I don't think there will be many changes. There probably isn't a need for adjustments to demand and it is too early to make changes to the yield.

The soybean market spent another week trading sideways. Both Thursday and Friday the July contract covered the entire range. There isn't enough conviction in either the bull or bear camp to push the market in either direction. That may not be the case for much longer in the new crop though. The outlook is already bearish and if the

weather in June is cooperative traders will be thinking about big soybean yields as well. A small increase in yield would have a big impact on new crop ending stocks, and with projections for record world ending stocks, supplies in the US could quickly become burdensome no matter how good the demand out of China is. The problem with the beans is that owning a put isn't practical without selling a call, so use rallies like we had on Thursday to sell call premium.

In the cattle market, we had some \$95 cash trade, which was higher for the week, but the August futures were lower. Blame the weak stock market for that. The cattle futures were on the verge of a break out to the upside, but Friday's financial uncertainty put an end to that. The boxed beef market was lower for the week, which didn't help matters either. This week's early trading action will be critical. The August LC will likely test the \$88.00 sup-

port, and if it fails, and the stock market is weak, plan on another leg lower. The cattle market just can't handle another leg lower in the stock market.

Prepare now for wheat storage

Now that Kansas wheat harvest has begun in southern portions of the state. If you haven't already, it's time for producers to get their bins ready for harvest, said Kansas State University entomologist Jeff Whitworth.

Whether storing seed wheat or the entire wheat crop, storage areas should be cleaned thoroughly and sprayed with an insecticide prior to filling with this year's harvest, said Whitworth, who is a specialist with K-State Research and Extension. "This needs to be done several days prior to harvest so that the insecticide has time to work before new grain is put into the

bin."

Growers should also make sure that any other grain stored on the farm is free from infestation prior to harvest to reduce the chance of insects from moving from one bin to another, he said. Any infested grain should be sold, disposed of or fumigated. Even small quantities of old grain can serve as the source of insects to infest this year's grain.

If the grain will be stored on the farm for more than a few weeks, producers will probably want to consider using a grain protectant to treat the grain as the bins are being filled, Whitworth said.

Trees lessen flooding

How well some Kansans get through this year's repeated, heavy rains could depend on how well they learned from the past.

Kansas Wayne Geyer completed the first real-life study of the roles trees can play during flooding. A forester for Kansas State University Research and Extension, Geyer examined aerial photographs of and scout reports from 35 miles of the Kansas River, both before and after the flood of 1993.

He found the areas of river with riparian forest buffers gained an average of 4 to 10 feet of soil, via the flood's sediment deposits. Areas with grassland buffers lost an average 78 feet in sediment. And, croplands bordering the river typically lost 150 feet of land.

Beyond that, while tearing away tons of soil from the treeless banks, the flood waters picked up a witch's brew of debris and ground-based pollutants.

Kansas Dairy groups work to promote industry

Kansas has two very active and effective dairy organizations in the state. Although different in how each is structured, they both have the same goal—helping the dairy industry.

The Kansas Dairy Commission (KDC) is funded by a 3/4 cent per hundred weight of milk assessment paid by all dairy producers. Education, research and promotion are the 3 major areas that the KDC focuses on.

Some of the things they are involved with include funding for research at K-State. They also team with the dairy staff at K-State to put on area informational meetings. These are known as KSU Dairy Days. About 150 dairymen and industry personal attend these each year.

Providing activities and opportunities for kids interested in dairy is a high priority for the KDC board. The Salina Chamber of Commerce teams with KDC to sponsor a state-wide dairy event in early July. Showing dairy cattle, judging dairy cattle and a highly

competitive dairy quiz bowl are all offered at this two-day event.

The State Fair provides an excellent opportunity for KDC to educate and promote the Kansas Dairy Industry. KDC teams with Midwest Dairy Association (MDA) and other Kansas Commodity groups to sponsor Agriland. This is a large display in the Pride of Kansas Building and gives kids (adults as well) an opportunity to learn about Kansas Agriculture. KDC also teams with MDA and Kansas Farm Bureau to educate fair goers about Kansas agriculture. One of the true highlights of the State Fair

is the live milking demonstrations given 5 times each day for all fair goers. The State Fair, Fort Hays State University and KDC work together on this activity.

The Kansas Dairy Commission is involved in many other activities as well. Whenever there is an opportunity to promote or to educate people on the dairy industry, KDC wants to be a part.

The Kansas Dairy Association (KDA) is a non-profit organization that can function or operate exactly like the Kansas Dairy Commission. The one distinct

difference is that KDA can be involved in state legislative activities. KDA is funded solely by associate members, donations and profits from the Dairy Bar at the Kansas State Fair. All dairymen who are KDC members in good standing are automatically members of KDA—no membership fees.

KDA focuses on three major areas. The first, of course, is to monitor legislative actions. While KDA does not consider itself a “pro-active” organization, they do closely watch for legislation that might cause

hardships or unnecessary laws. KDA tries to work with several other agriculture organizations when necessary.

Another major function of KDA is communication. A Dairy Dispatch is published four times a year and highlights dairy activities throughout the state, future activities and events, special awards, legislative updates as well as things happening in the dairy industry. This publication and a special email list of producers enables KDA to keep our producers informed.

KDA operates the Dairy Bar (under the Grandstands

at the State Fair. Ice cream is the featured dairy product, but milk shakes, sun-dae and milk are also offered. It is considered as one of the favorite eating spots on the fairgrounds, which make us proud.

The major challenge of both organizations is properly educating the consumer/public. Animal agriculture is being aggressive attacked by animal rights groups who have very large budgets.

Both KDA and KDC will be active in this battle and will join forces with other groups/organizations when necessary.





Maximize value of corn silage with harvest timing

Selecting the right time to harvest corn silage is critical to producing high-quality forage for best livestock performance. To do that, diligently monitor moisture content, say forage experts.

When plants begin to silk, record an expected harvest date on the calendar, experts suggest.

"Start walking fields and assess kernel milkline levels about four weeks after silking," says Bill Seglar, Pioneer nutritional sciences veterinarian. "Milkline levels provide a quick way to visually inspect the plant's maturity."

Seglar says when corn shows some dent on the ear,

it's time to walk fields and find samples to achieve ideal dry matter at harvest.

"To check milkline, first break an ear in half," Seglar says. "Use the outer half of the ear. Remove a kernel. Either bite into the tip of the kernel or poke a knife blade or pin into the bottom and push upward until the point meets resistance. The milkline is the area from the point of resistance to the crown. One-third milkline represents 68 to 72 percent while two-thirds milkline represents 63 to 68 percent moisture."

Although some research suggests milkline as a weak indicator to actual dry mat-

ter, it complements lab testing. Milkline also can be used as a signal to start sampling dry-matter content levels. Dry-matter lab tests may provide the most accurate results. Seglar suggests collecting a minimum of 10 plants per field location to sample.

"Comparing a chipper-shredder lab sample to a grower's own silage samples helps build the data needed to make informed harvesting decisions," says Bill Curran, Pioneer research scientist. "Any dry-matter test is better than guessing. It's worth the extra effort to make sure producers get the most out of their investments."

Knowing individual field conditions and hybrid matu-

rities also can help growers pick the appropriate harvest date. Experts recommend walking fields to examine crop maturity levels as harvest nears, helping determine if crops are on target for the expected harvest date. Under normal conditions, the tasseling date can serve as another way to check harvest timing.

"Harvest is typically six to 10 days away when the crop is about 3 to 5 percent wetter than optimal," Seglar says. "Yet, it's not a hard and fast rule. Outside factors such as weather and field location can affect the rate of maturity and ideal moisture levels for harvesting forage."

Curran says growers need to evaluate on-farm

storage capabilities, which can influence harvest-timing decisions, too.

If growers allow crops to reach 63 percent moisture in the field, they have the opportunity to maximize starch and tonnage yields. Harvesting below this moisture level can lower silage quality in terms of dairy performance.

Early-harvested corn silage will be lower in starch and higher in fiber content (neutral detergent fiber or NDF). Seglar says modern hybrids with strong late-season agronomics tend to retain fiber digestibility within the 63 to 70 percent moisture range.

Planting hybrids with a diversity of maturities is another way for operations with many acres to manage harvest timing.

"Staggering maturities can help hit targets for field, quality or dry matter on more of a grower's acres," Curran says. "Consider a five- to seven-day range between hybrids to allow for a shorter or wider harvest window." He says that although bigger machines allow producers to harvest in a more timely manner, there still can be limitations at the pit or storage facility, which could allow for a slip in quality at the very end.

Yard & Garden Tips

A Sweet Potato in Every Yard

It took me a long time to acquire a taste for sweet potatoes.

Deer seem to be born with a preference. I like them best cooked with a roast or cut up and baked like steak fries. Fresh leaves are the preference of deer. Bird netting discontinued the leaf eating.

Sweet potatoes are a warm-season crop that is planted now. They grow fine in the hot and sometimes dry days of summer. Plant your "slip" on a ridge of loose soil about 12 inches apart. This slip is mostly a bare root stem and will need time in the ground to get adjusted. It will look dead for about a week and then take off. A mature sweet potato vine will grow

six to eight feet. It makes for a good groundcover for a full sun location. At the end of the growing season (first frost) you will have something to eat. Soils that aren't too rich are best for sweet potato production.

There is seldom a need to fertilize sweet potatoes. Average soil has the nutrients it needs to grow. Since they don't need much water or nutrients, weeds are less of an issue.

Two issues may arise in growing them. Scurf is a superficial disease that will make black spots on the skin. Storage time is short with these but they are just fine to eat. A late season rainfall 3 to 4 weeks before harvest after being dry can cause the roots to crack.

These sweet potatoes won't be nice and smooth. If you cut them just right, you can make crinkly fries from the cracked ones.


Most common varieties are Puerto Rican types which are dark orange inside, moist, and sweet. Beauregard, Jewel and Centennial are proven varieties. Georgia Jet has a red skin and so does the variety

Travis. There are some white flesh varieties but they aren't as well adapted to growing here. The ornamental sweet potato vines do make fleshy roots. They

are not nearly as sweet and tasty for human consumption. Deer aren't as picky and will eat them. Besides eating them, I like that sweet potatoes are simple to grow and full of nutrition.

Research debunks myths of grass-fed health benefits

Ground beef from grain-fed cattle is actually healthier than grass-fed variety, according to a Texas AgriLife Research study funded by NCBA.

The research effort led by Dr. Stephen Smith, an AgriLife Research meat scientist, found that high monounsaturated fat ground beef from grain-fed cattle had beneficial impacts on HDL and LDL cholesterol and on insulin, which suggests that ground beef produced by intensive production practices provides "a healthful, high-quality source of protein." Meanwhile, the researchers found that, contrary to popular perception, ground beef from pasture-fed cattle had no beneficial effects on plasma lipids.

"We wanted to see from this study if product from pasture-fed and corn-fed cattle had different effects on LDL or HDL cholesterol," Smith said. "We looked at the scientific literature and could not find any justifications for the state-

ment that pasture-fed beef is better for you. All we found were rat studies in which they were fed omega-3 fatty acids, so we wanted to know if this applied to beef from grass-fed cattle."

The study used Angus cattle raised at the McGregor AgriLife Research Center. One group of cattle was fed a pasture diet with supplement hay. The steers were kept on pasture until 20 months of age. A second group of Angus steers was fed the same way a feedyard operator would and kept on a corn-based diet until 16 months of age, then reaching USDA Choice status. A third group of Angus steers was fed the corn-based diet the longest, until reaching USDA Prime. The fat in cattle that are high in marbling is low in saturated and trans-fats and higher in monounsaturated fats.

Beef cuts from the plate and flank taken from all three grades were made into a ground beef product, containing 24 percent fat. Next,

a group of 27 men completed a three-way crossover study. Each group rotated, consuming five 114-gram ground beef patties per week for six weeks from each of the three sets of cattle used in the study.

"There really were no negative effects of feeding ground beef from the pasture-fed cattle," Smith said. "We did see many positive effects in men that consumed ground beef from corn-fed cattle. The ground beef from the USDA Prime cattle increased HDL cholesterol and LDL particle diameter. Both effects are protective against cardiovascular disease. The Prime ground beef also decreased insulin, so it may have some protective effect against type II diabetes."

Smith said the study results surprised many. "As we talked to some user groups and told them that we had found pasture-fed beef is higher in saturated trans-fat, they were shocked." Smith presented the findings to the National

Cattlemen's Beef Association last year and is now sharing among consumers and producers.

Early on, Smith said he did receive some negative feedback from ranchers in the grass-fed beef business, but he isn't telling them that what they are doing is wrong. "I know that cattle are adapted to growing on high-roughage, pasture diets, but my focus is the beef product," he said. "A lot of producers are receptive. What I'm trying to show them is that the longer cattle are fed a corn or grain-based diet, the healthier the product will be."

"I realize cost is involved. Feeding corn is expensive. But if you want a healthier product, you need more marbling. Time on feed is a big factor."

The study team included Dr. Rosemary Walzem, AgriLife Research poultry scientist, and Dr. Stephen Crouse, researcher from Texas A&M University's health and kinesiology department.
