

Kansas ozone levels rise after Flint Hills pasture burning

(AP) — The Kansas Department of Health and Environment says grassland burning in the Flint Hills sent ozone levels above national pollution standards in several areas this month.

KDHE says readings showed the excessive ozone Tuesday in

Shawnee County and April 6 in Linn and Sedgwick counties. Higher-than-normal levels of particulate matter also were recorded.

Tom Gross, of the department's air bureau, says the readings are disappointing. But Gross also says the agency believes a smoke manage-

ment plan approved in December will cut down on such incidents in the future.

The plan allows ranchers to continue spring burning but restricts other burning in 12 counties in the Flint Hills and four near Kansas City and Wichita.

Beef Cattle and Forage Crops Field Day planned for southeast Kansas

K-State Research and Extension's Southeast Agricultural Research Center will host its Beef Cattle and Forage Crops Field Day at the Mound Valley Unit on Thursday, May 5. The unit is located 2-1/2 miles west of Mound Valley on U.S. 160 Highway (formerly K-96), then 1/4 mile south on Elk Road.

The day begins with registration from 8:30 to 9 a.m., plus coffee and donuts, compliments of Parsons Livestock Market. The program includes:

- Nitrogen Management for Crabgrass Production — Joe Moyer, K-State forage agronomist;
- Utilization of Poultry Litter to Fertilize Pastures — Doug Shoup, K-State crops and soils specialist;
- Forage Systems for Grazing Stocker Cattle — Lyle Lomas, K-State animal scientist and head of the Southeast Agricultural Research Center;
- Kansas Flint Hills Smoke Management Plan — Tom Gross, chief of air monitoring and planning section, Kansas Department of Health and Environment; and
- Plants Toxic to Cattle — Larry Hollis, K-State extension veterinarian.

In addition, numerous companies will have displays at the field day and will sponsor a complimentary lunch.

The field day will be held rain or shine. More information is available by contacting the K-State Southeast Agricultural Research Center at 620-421-4826.

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Vermillion Creek site for Kansas Agroforestry Field Day May 4

Ken Melvin decided 15 years ago that he had watched too many floods carry valuable soil away from crop fields and stream banks in northeast Pottawatomie County. So, he planted trees — lots of them — mostly along Vermillion Creek.

Those attending the 2011 Kansas Agroforestry Field Day Wednesday, May 4, will see his results. Beside the part of the creek that crosses today's Melvin Tree Farm are a small forest of 20- to 35-foot-tall bur oak and black walnut trees.

"They've made a real difference in the quality of the Vermillion's water," said Bob Atchison, rural forestry coordinator for the Kansas Forest Service.

The field day will actually begin nearby in the small town of Corning. Registration will open at 8 a.m. in the Corning Community Center at 5th and Main.

The featured speaker for the morning's indoor sessions will be Dusty Walter, specialist with the Center of Agroforestry at the University of Missouri-Columbia. Walter will provide an update on such trends as:

- Woody biomass plantings, for use as a renewable energy source.
- Silvopasture — i.e., managing timber production and livestock pasture as an integrated system.
- Windbreaks for confined livestock-feeding operations, to ameliorate odors and provide screening.

Rounding out the morning will be discussions on Kansas' common tree health issues, results of a recent assessment of the riparian forests along waterways that feed into Lake Perry and techniques to improve water quality on farms and ranches.

Ken Melvin will host the afternoon's outdoor sessions at his tree farm. He'll also describe the challenges he faced when

planting and establishing his 15-year-old tree stand on Vermillion Creek. Plus, Kansas Forest Service pros will provide hands-on instructions on pruning properly, thinning tree plantings, and controlling competing weeds and grass in new tree plantations. Charles Barden, forester with Kansas State University Research and Extension, will suggest how to design riparian forest buffers.

Registration for the field day is \$10, which will include morning refreshments and a hot lunch. To aid in planning, the Kansas Forest Service is asking that participants express their intent to attend as soon as possible by calling 785-532-3300. For more information, a brochure is available on-line at www.kansasforests.org (click on "Calendar of Events").

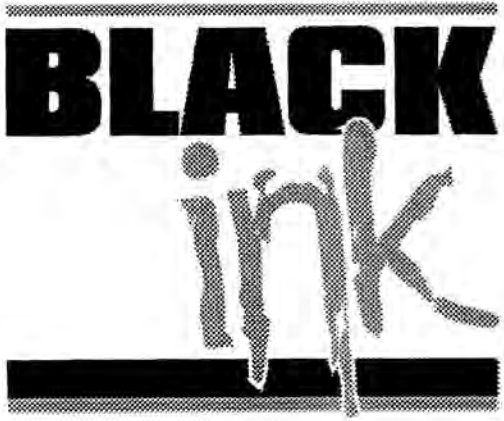

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Quality Always Wins

The commodity markets were up and up, and mostly up as spring arrived. History says there is a kind of gravity that will bring prices at least partway back down. That'd be fine if input costs would fall back in tandem, but history also says we may not be that lucky.

As demand outpaced supply for any form of bovinity, you could still find cheap cows here and there, filling orders for less than \$1,000. Sometimes that would even buy calved-out pairs. Better cows were selling for twice that. Weaned calves were bringing from \$600 to more than \$900 at similar weights.

You might wonder which cattle were the better bar-

gain. All of them are eating more expensive feed and forage now, but the brood cows on the low end of the price scale will not produce calves that can cover costs, let alone top the market. The grade bull with unknown breeding values bought by the pound and under budget won't help build better genetics that can compete in this higher risk economy. You could use a better bull, but by the time you upgrade "junk" cows, this market may be a lost opportunity.

If you bought the cheapest calves in any weight range to graze or finish, you may pay more than you bargained for because of sickness, death loss, poor performance and low beef quality grades. Even if they

stay healthy, the lower price up front was likely tied to some negative market information, like poor feed efficiency or inability to put on marbling.

You still get what you pay for, and that cuts especially deep when you have to pay a lot for anything in the category. Now more than ever, the smart money is on cattle of known genetics, feedlot performance and carcass merit. When low-potential cattle go on feed, the clock is ticking as every day they consume expensive feed, and they must rush to market the first time any packer will have them, just to cut losses. Meanwhile, premium quality cattle continue to gain weight and value on the quality grids as they can be sorted to optimum finish.

Consumers face similar choices in the meat case and on the menu. The financial impact is much smaller for each individual, but the effect on the beef industry is magnified when multiplied by millions. Do they want to pay half again or twice as much as other proteins for average quality beef, or buy save a buck with dependably bland fare? Any beef they buy is going to cost significantly more than the alternatives. Some people may seek out cheaper, lower quality cuts and plan to use more high-

moisture, slow cooking methods. Others may not realize that there are big differences in beef steaks that costs \$4 versus \$8 for their spring grilling party, only to be disappointed and have to apologize for the poor results later.

Many times, they find the best value proposition in paying a little more to buy a proven brand or quality grade that always satisfies.

Retailers and restaurateurs sometimes limit quality options, assuming their customers can't afford the best. Imagine if an auction market manager turned away cows from an award-winning herd's dispersal because the quality would be too high for the locals. Perhaps more plausibly, a feedlot could decline partnering with an award-winning ranch to finish cattle

with a track record of near ideal gain and grade, if they lack confidence. But most likely, several feedyard would jump at the chance to feed such cattle and own a percentage, because they know the quality is there.

Beef Checkoff issues social responsibility report

Called "The Cattlemen's Stewardship Review: Connecting Our Vision and Values," the social responsibility report recently released by the Beef Checkoff Program is a first-of-its-kind inside look at cattlemen's influence on the nation's communities, the economy, public health and the environment.

Built on a statement of seven fundamental principles adopted by U.S. cattle farmer and rancher leaders at the 2011 Cattle Industry Convention in February, the review details cattlemen's commitment to preserving the environment, raising healthy cattle, providing quality food, enhancing food safety, investing in communities, embracing innovation and creating a sustainable future for generations to come.

The review is broken into five sections, which showcase key accomplishments of U.S. cattle farmers and ranchers, including:

U.S. cattlemen provide 20% of the world's beef with only 7% of the world's cattle, meaning that they are helping provide valuable nutrients to a growing population both in the United States and abroad.

Since 1993, cattlemen have invested \$30 million

of their beef checkoff dollars in safety improvements. Collaborative beef industry efforts have helped reduce the incidence of food-borne illnesses, including E. coli O157:H7, which now affects less than one in 100,000 people.

More than 90% of feedyard cattle raised in the U.S. today are influenced by Beef Quality Assurance (BQA) programs that set guidelines for animal care and handling.

Between 1977 and 2007, the "carbon footprint" of beef shrank 18% as farmers and ranchers raised 13% more beef with 13% fewer cattle. When compared to 1977, each pound of beef raised in 2007 used 20% less feed, 30% less land, 14% less water and 9% less fossil-fuel energy.

Environmental efforts by cattle farmers and ranchers help manage and protect more than 500 million acres of permanent grassland and a variety of wildlife and endangered species.

Nearly half of cattle farmers and ranchers volunteer with youth organizations, and more than one-third donate their time to other civic organizations, compared to a national average of 7% of all Americans.

Through EQIP, NRCS provides financial and technical assistance on eligible conservation prac-

tices. Beginning, limited resource, and socially disadvantaged producers may be eligible for additional financial assistance.

Producers interested in applying for EQIP Organic Initiative funding must submit applications through their local NRCS Service Center, which can be located through the website at <http://offices.sc.egov.usda.gov/locator/app?agency=nrcs>.

Schwieterman Market Outlook

A marketing commentary by Bret Crotts

The U.S. Dollar Index fell to the lowest level since December 2009. The dollar market is oversold on the daily and the longer term charts, but there is little indication that the Dollar is about to turn up. Meanwhile both the gold and silver made new all time highs. These markets make short term corrections, but for the most part the gains are relentless and there is little indication they are about to end. The money supply keeps growing and the money has to go somewhere. The scary thing is that the gains will accelerate if interest rates ever go up or the economy improves. Rampant inflation won't occur until those things happen.

July corn was down 24 1/2 cents for the week, while the December fell 1 1/4 cents, so that makes it very apparent that the bull spreads struggled this week. Liquidation and fear of liquidation in the front months put pressure on the old crop corn, while the December was supported by the unwinding of the spreads and by the threat of planting delays.

Most of the weakness came on Tuesday and could be attributed to widespread commodity weakness that stemmed from Goldman Sachs talking about liquidating some commodity positions. All the liquidation talk seemed to weigh most heavily on the grains, because the metals ended up shooting higher after Tuesday's break, but the corn in particular really struggled. There was also talk through the week about wheat being a bigger part of the feed mix and offsetting some corn de-

mand. May corn closed higher than May Chicago wheat for the first time ever, so obviously the market is telling us to feed wheat, and maybe that will cut into corn demand. However, the point to be taken from all this is that the demand for feed grain is so strong that some end users will be forced to use substitutes and eventually that becomes bullish for all grains. I don't think that I would actually count on feed wheat hurting corn demand, right now I think that the world will feed wheat in addition to feeding all the corn it possibly can.

Export sales were very good 848,000 MT of old crop sales. We can't handle sales at this level for an extended period of time. A little bit of trivia I read this week suggested that we will export the equivalent of 1.25 billion bushels of corn in the form of DDG's. Combining that with corn exports would imply that our "real" corn exports are over 3 billion bushels, which would be a record.

The charts suggest that the July corn is headed down to the open chart gap at \$7.31. \$7.28 is the 50% retracement, which is also a viable downside target in the same vicinity. If the market can avoid a crash on Monday, then perhaps the correction is over and we will avoid the drop to \$7.31. I am cautiously optimistic about corn finding support early next week and then moving higher, but regardless of the size of the break, we still have to view any break as a long term buying opportunity.

Bull spread the corn. Buy

July and sell December. July could move to \$2.00 over December if exports stay good and if there aren't terrible planting problems.

Garden City had about half an inch of rain, which is far from a drought buster. I have a serious case of backyarditis, because all I can think about is our declining production prospects. I realize that stocks are more than adequate, because that has been a problem for the wheat market for quite some time. However, our stocks situation could be much, much different a year from now, but apparently no one is too concerned about that now.

The charts are ugly. The July KW is trying to hold at the 50% retracement of the last move up, but it is looking more and more likely that we will see a test of \$8.50. Friday's close was okay, and if we can avoid a new low for the move on Monday, then I think the correction is over, but for now there is still danger of further weakness.

The July soybeans lost 60 1/2 cents this week. Bear spreading was rampant as we started the week due to ideas that demand would be shifting so S. America and that U.S. acreage might be a little higher than previously thought. By the end of the week that news had run its course and the spreads corrected and the market found support.

Like the wheat and corn, the action early next week will be very critical. The old crop soybeans are set for a run higher if we can avoid a sell-off at the beginning of the week. The market has consolidated around the 62% retracement and we will see technical indicators generate buy signals if we see just a little bit of strength. Export sales were a little light at 130,200 MT. We don't need to see much, but it needs to be a little bit

better than that. This week's pressure will likely attract end user demand next week, so look for the sales figures to improve in the near future.

Cash cattle traded at \$119, which was down considerably from last week, the boxed beef market was down, and the futures were down. Basically, we had a corrective week across the board. On the charts the June live cattle fell to the 62% retracement last Tuesday and that support area held through the week. This week's low of \$114.87 will be watched very closely by traders. If that low doesn't hold, that will indicate the market will likely head down to the March low of \$110.65. My opinion, however, is that the support holds and the market begins another leg higher. The fundamentals of the beef and pork markets are still quite bullish and further gains are quite possible.

It is interesting to note that the U.S. is becoming a net exporter of beef. We had been a net importer since the 1950s, but that is changing. We are being outbid on the world market for beef, so we are importing less and exporting more. It is a fascinating turn of events.

Options offered for declining brome grass

By David G. Hallauer, District Extension Agent, Crops & Soils/Horticulture

Last fall, armyworm infestations, heat/drought, declining fertility, or some combination thereof resulted in brome grass stands under some pretty severe stress. In the case of armyworms, catching them early and treating was a huge benefit. If not, or if the stress was weather or fertility related, it didn't seem like much helped.

Fast forward to this spring. Even at this late date, many stands have not recovered or responded to fertility treatments. What's your next option?

Seeding brome this spring is pretty well out. We're well past the optimum seeding date for brome. Another window will open in the fall for overseeding if forage production is your focus. In the interim, give consideration to either keeping the stand clean and preparing

for seeding next fall, or seeding another forage this summer. Summer annual forages would be one option. Others exist as well, depending on your future focus of the stand. Be considerate of the fact that weed pressure will be severe due to the increase in open space, so weed control efforts may need to be increased. Erosion potential on steep slopes is also a concern that may require some seeding this summer to hold soils in place. No matter what the situation, soil test soon if you will be seeding something this fall, or later this summer if you will be re-seeding in the fall.

USDA accepting REAP fund applications for blender pump installations

The U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) is now accepting applications for federal REAP funds to help gasoline retailers install blender pumps designed to give consumers flexibility and choice in the ethanol blends they use. Originally announced last spring, Agriculture Secretary Tom Vilsack announced on April 8, 2011 that USDA was moving forward with plans to install 10,000 blender pumps over the next five years. That announcement and opening of the application process is welcome news to The Blend Your Own (BYO) Ethanol campaign, a joint educational effort by the American Coalition for Ethanol (ACE) and the Renewable Fuels Association (RFA).

“More blender pumps means more consumers will finally have the choice and flexibility they deserve to pick the ethanol blends that work for them based on their vehicle, their beliefs, and their budget,” said RFA director of market devel-

opment Robert White. “Through the BYO ethanol campaign, we have the ability to assist retailers in applying for these funds and help USDA and the Obama administration achieve the renewable fuel goals they have put forward.”

“One way to break the stranglehold oil has over America’s economy and energy future is to give consumers the option to choose something other than petroleum,” said ACE VP & Director of Market Development Ron Lamberty. “Ethanol is the only viable renewable alternative to gasoline today. A critical challenge the industry faces is getting this fuel in front of more consumers. This announcement together with the efforts of the BYO ethanol campaign will go a long way to overcoming that challenge.”

The BYO Ethanol campaign is designed to inform gasoline marketers and retailers about the opportunities blender pumps offer. Blender

pump technologies allow retailers and consumer to choose the blend of ethanol they want from no ethanol content to 85 percent ethanol by volume. Increasing the number of blender pumps in operation in conjunction with expanding the size of the America’s flex-fuel vehicle (FFV) fleet capable of using high level ethanol blends is critical to achieving our nation’s energy goals, including commercializing advanced ethanol technologies.

According to information released by USDA, this is part of their REAP Program, which is designed to help spur rural

development. It has an announced budget of \$70 million for FY11. In this program there will be funding for grants, and loan guarantees, but certain restrictions will apply on the size of the local communities and the businesses applying for the funds. Applications will be due in June.
