State's largest livestock show draws youth entries from 91 counties

Youth from across the state have entered 1,456 head of animals for the 79th annual Kansas Junior Livestock Show (KJLS). A total of 713 4-H and FFA members from 91 counties will show 109 market steers, 318 breeding heifers, 323 market hogs, 273 market lambs, 52 purebred ewes, 168 commercial ewes and 213 meat goats. The competition will take place September 23-26 at the Kansas Pavilions in Wichita

Marion County is sending 31 exhibitors to the show, the most of any county in the state. Johnson County youth have entered nine steers, 20 market lambs, 12 commercial ewes and 69 total head of livestock, the most of any county in the state in these four categories. The largest number of heifers, 30, was entered by Pottawatomie County. The market hog category is led by Washington County, with 21 entries. The largest number of purebred

ewes entered, eight head, is a tie between Greeley and Lyon counties. Exhibitors from Labette County entered the most meat goats with 16 head.

When the competition is complete, grand and reserve steers, hogs, lambs and goats will sell during the KJLS Auction of Champions, September 26 at 7:00 p.m. The public is welcome and encouraged to support the event by bidding on livestock in the live auction. In many cases, exhibitors of the winning animals use the money earned from the auction to help fund their college educations and buy next year's livestock projects.

Prior to the auction, KJLS will present a number of scholarships ranging from \$750 to \$2,500 to exhibitors who have excelled academically, in communitv service and in 4-H/FFA. A total of \$283,600 in scholarships has been presented to 232 KJLS exhibitors

since the program's inception in 1993. Last year, a total of \$18,900 was awarded to 11 exhibitors. The scholarship program is funded primarily through private contributions and income generated by the Beefeater Barbecue held in the Sam Fulco Pavilion prior to the premium sale. Tickets to the barbecue. which will begin at 5:30 p.m., are \$60 and can be purchased at the door that evening or in advance by calling Cheryl Smith at (316) 390-0285.


"This traditional event for Kansas youth has a large number of faithful and very generous supporters," said KJLS president Ed Frey of Wichita. "It is a great way for businesses and individuals to reward young people for their hard work and help them meet their educational goals."

Separate from the selection of species champions, a showmanship contest will be held. The top showman

in both the junior and senior divisions of each species will receive a silver belt buckle. Prizes also will be awarded for second through fifth place in each division.

The Kansas Junior Livestock Association (KJLA) will sponsor a club calf show and sale during KJLS. Steer and heifer prospects from some of the top club calf producers in the Midwest will be consigned. The event will take place September 24. Sale proceeds will go toward KJLA/Kansas Livestock Foundation Youth in Agriculture scholarships. Since its inception 30 years ago, this program has awarded more than \$40,000 in scholarships to Kansas youth.

KJLS is sponsored by KLA, Kansas State University and the Agri-Business Council of Wichita. In addition to these groups, hundreds of volunteers from across the state help organize and put on the show.

The much anticipated September supply and demand report contained some pretty bullish information, but the reaction to the report was certainly far from positive. The most bullish figure from the report was the corn yield estimate, which USDA cut from 153 bpa, to 148.1. Unfortunately, despite the large cut in production, the ending stocks estimate was not cut as much as expected, coming in at 672 million. The larger than expected yield cut combined with the smaller than expected ending stocks cut meant that USDA is quite sure it won't be a problem to slow down demand and keep stocks at a comfortable level. So far it appears that traders in general believe that because the December corn lost 44 1/2 cents for the week.

On the chart, the \$6.92 area, which was Friday's low, is the last level of support before \$6.70. The market is oversold, but the momentum is clearly down. The market could see a corrective bounce at any time, but until traders either believe that we will see further cuts in production or that USDA is wrong about demand dropping off, the corn will probably have a weaker bias.

The wheat numbers were very bearish. Ending stocks came in much higher than expected at 761 million. That stocks level is more than adequate and there is really no reason for wheat to move higher with stocks like that and nobody seems too concerned about the planting conditions of the Hard Red Winter Wheat crop. Several weeks ago it seemed that the corn was supporting the wheat due to moving more wheat into the feed mix and potentially drawing down supplies, it now seems that the threat of more feed wheat is pressuring the corn.

Thursday's technical action in the December KW looked encouraging. The move down toward the \$7.70 support followed by the positive close could be an indication of a change in trend. Friday's action wasn't very encouraging, but Thursday's low is still intact. If the wheat can avoided further pressure on Monday, we will be in for a turnaround. After more than a dollar's worth of weakness in less than a month, the wheat is due for a bounce.

The soybean numbers were mostly negative last week. Traders were looking for a small yield cut and we got a small yield increase up to 41.8 bpa. The jump in the yield subsequently increased the ending stocks estimate to 165 million, which is comfortable. The soybeans didn't even manage to get any support from possible freeze damage in some areas of the Corn Belt. Some analysts insist that there was some significant damage in some areas, but traders obviously didn't care because the November contract lost over 70 cents for the week.

On the chart, there is some reason for optimism. Friday's low completed a 62% retracement of the last move up and the market is oversold. \$13.50 should be good support early next week and the bottom of the new trading channel is at \$13.35 if the \$13.50 level fails. The soybeans are in prime position for a turnaround if traders can just get the downward momentum to slow.

The cattle market was

flat for the week. The cash cattle market was basically unchanged and the October live cattle picked up about 70 cents. The October feeder cattle gained about \$2.75, a lot of which could be attributed to the falling price of grain.

The chart outlook is pretty encouraging for the feeder cattle now that the front months are back above the 50-day moving average. There should be very good support in the October FC at the \$136.50-\$137.50 area. The live cattle look like they will see some corrective weakness to start the week. The reversal lower on Thursday was negative and the follow through lower on Friday confirmed the start of a correction. There should be good buying interest in the October live cattle at the \$117.00 area.



Page 19 Kansas drought continues, production losses reach \$1.7 billi

Drought continues in Kansas with nearly threefourths of the state abnormally to exceptionally dry. The estimated value loss of wheat, corn, sorghum and soybeans in Kansas in 2011 is more than 1.77 billion dollars, based on a comparison of current U.S. Department of Agriculture production estimates and average historic production.

The Kansas Department of Agriculture is offering emergency drought term permits to additional counties as conditions worsen. Additionally, certain motor carrier regulations remain suspended to allow hay to be moved to drought-stricken areas faster.

We want to be flexible and do our part to help Kansas farmers and ranchers deal with this severe drought," Kansas Secretary of Agriculture Dale Rodman said. "We have learned as a new administration that there are ways we can work with the USDA and other agencies to ease the burden on producers. Our goal is to take what we've learned to respond swiftly to address producers concerns now and in the future."

In response to Gov. Brownback's recent request for federal assisfor additional tance drought-stricken counties, the Department of Agriculture has extended the Drought Emergency Term Permit option to water right holders in Allen, Anderson, Bourbon, Chase, Chautauqua, Cherokee, Coffey, Crawford, Elk, Ellsworth, Greenwood, Labette, Linn, Lyon, Montgomery, Neosho, Wilson, and Woodson counties.

The one-time, droughtfocused term permit allows holders of existing water rights the flexibility to borrow a portion of next year's authorized quantity in order to complete the 2011 growing season.

Additional information about the drought emergency term permit, including application forms, can be found on the 2011 Drought Options webpage. Program enrollment ends on December 31, 2011 and water right holders must apply for this program prior to exceeding the quantity of water authorized by their water right(s). There have been 903 drought emergency

term permit applications as of September 14.

significantly limited forage options for livestock producers. On July 28, Brownback signed Executive Order 11-25 temporarily suspending certain motor carrier rules and regulations in order to expedite efforts to transport hay to livestock in droughtstricken areas.

Jerry Moran's legislation to remove a trade barrier with Cuba, by allowing direct cash payments from Cuban buyers to U.S. financial institutions during the 2012 fiscal year (FY), was adopted by the U.S. Senate Committee on Appropriations as an amendment to the FY2012 Financial Services and General Government Appropriations Bill. on a level playing field. "Current U.S. trade policies hurt American farmers and ranchers by making it more expensive for Cuba to purchase agriculture products from the United States," Moran said. "This means Cuba is buying more of its food from countries such as Vietnam and China. The change is an important step to increase American export sales and support thousands of American jobs without increasing the debt."

In 2000, the passage of the Trade Sanctions Re-

form and Export Enhancement Act allowed for the cash sale - including sales by direct cash transfer - of U.S. agricultural commodities and medicine to Cuba for the first time in 38 years. In 2005, however, the Treasury Department administratively banned direct cash transfers. This resulted in payments having to be routed through a third party in a foreign country, driving up transaction costs and making American products less competitive.

In addition to Moran's

amendment, the FY2012 Financial Services and General Government Appropriations Bill includes a provision making cash payments due when a Cuban buyer receives their goods, which is standard trading practice. Without the provision to fix the definition of "payment of cash in advance." which has been included in appropriations bills for the last three years, payments would be due before ships leave U.S. ports. This bill was voted out of committee and will now move to the full

Senate for a vote.

According to a Texas A&M University report, giving relief from the current regulatory prohibitions on direct cash transfers could increase annual agricultural exports to Cuba by over \$270 million and support nearly 4,500 United States jobs per year.

In February 2010, then-Congressman Moran introduced - and the House

Committee Agriculture passed - H.R. 4645, legislation to expand agricultural trade with Cuba. Nearly 150 U.S. organizations have voiced their strong support for doing so, including the U.S. Chamber of Commerce, the American Farm Bureau Federation, the National Association of Wheat Growers and the National Farmers Union.

ment than the American farmer and rancher, who know firsthand that clean air and water and healthy soil go hand-in-hand with a healthy economy. Our producers deserve respect and appreciation from the EPA, not costly and redundant regulation."

The bill, S. 1328, the Farm Dust Regulation Prevention Act, would stop the EPA from regulating dust in rural America by preventing it from imposing more stringent dust standards for one year. It would also allow state and localities the flexibility to address any rural dust issues before the federal government would have the authority to do so.

For the EPA to retain regulatory

authority, the bill would require them to identify scientific evidence of substantial adverse health effects of farm dust, as well as demonstrate that the benefits of the regulation outweigh the economic costs to affected communities.

The bill was recently introduced in the Senate by Sens. Mike Johanns (R-Neb.) and Chuck Grassley (R-Iowa).

Roberts is the author of legislation to require a review of federal regulations to identify those regulations that harm the nation's economic recovery. It has 47 cosponsors. Roberts is the ranking member of the Senate Agriculture Committee.




