

Failure to communicate

“What we’ve got here is failure to communicate,” said the famous line in the 1967 movie *Cool Hand Luke*. I’ve thought of that line a lot – especially since someone named Siri came into my life.

Have you met Siri? I’ve never met her in person, but she is in touch with me daily. In fact, she’s been in contact with millions of people, but no one has ever seen her. That’s because Siri is an electronic person — a synthesized, virtual, computer-operat-

ed voice system which works with voice recognition software on electronic devices.

Did any of that last statement make sense? No, it didn’t to me either. But this electronic voice named Siri has become another member of our household, because she helps us operate our new cell phones.

I have grudgingly conceded that a cell phone is a handy thing to have while working on the ranch or out on horseback.

Obviously, a land line doesn’t reach the middle of the south pasture. But when a person tries to use the voice activation feature on their smart phones, Siri gets into the act.

My new phone has a microphone so I can just say what I need to say into a text, rather than trying to type it. I thought this was great until I started reading the messages. Siri was having major issues trying to decipher my words.

The same was happening in the voice texts that my wife and the hired man were trying to send. Either we are not speaking very clearly or Siri does not have any farm experience. Miscommunication leads to problems, as seen in the accompanying poem.

Siri’s efforts to translate our voices into texts have produced confusing messages. For example, when I get a message that says, “Prices on track,” that sounds encouraging. Then I found out that it was actually supposed to say, “Prairie hay’s on truck.” Rats.

Soybeans become “sizzle balloons.” Farrier becomes “fairy or.” Pasture becomes “pastor.” Hereford heifers become “her friend’s offers.” Sorrel gelding becomes “sorry old building.” (My horse would resent that remark!)

I get these perplexing messages. It’s like a game, trying to figure out the meaning. When the message says, “Free feeders log,” what the heck does that mean? Turns out the creep feeder’s clogged. “Since was loose” meant there was a loose cinch on the saddle. “Feliz up” meant the new foal is up.

How am I supposed to know that “barber friends” means barbed wire fence? Or that “bailing out sofa” means baling alfalfa? Or that “sweeping you drip” means that soybean yields are up?

Siri needs to take an ag class. Otherwise, what we’ve got here is... well, you know.

Survey indicates November drop in most crop prices

Preliminary prices received by farmers for winter wheat for November 2013 averaged \$6.84 per bushel, a decrease of 47 cents from the October price according to the USDA’s National Agricultural Statistics Service.

The preliminary November corn price, at \$4.32 per bushel, is down 42 cents from last month.

The preliminary Novem-

ber sorghum price averaged \$7.34 per cwt, a decrease of 6 cents from October.

The preliminary November soybean price, at \$12.50 per bushel, is up ten cents from last month.

The November alfalfa hay price, at \$199 per ton, is up from \$198 last month. The other hay price, at \$105 per ton, is down from \$109 last month.

The preliminary Novem-

ber sunflower price averaged \$24.20 per cwt, a decrease of \$1.60 from October

PED-positive submissions: another jump in positive case count

The total number of swine accessions and diagnostic case submissions testing positive for the Porcine Epidemic Diarrhoea (PED) virus is now 979, writes Jackie Linden. The rate of increase in positive results continues to rise each week and another state - the 19th - has reported its first case.

By farm class, this figure for the total number of positive laboratory swine accessions/diagnostic case submissions breaks down as follows between the weeks of 15 April and 27 October: suckling, 216 (+23); nursery, 150 (+16); grower/finisher, 325 (+28); sows/boars, 168 (+17) and 117 (+5) unknown. The total is up 85 from the previous week.

Maryland has reported its first positive result in the last week and so the total affected now stands at 19. Those states with ten or more positive tests are: Iowa, 266; Oklahoma, 211; North Carolina, 176; Kansas, 109; Minnesota, 62; Colorado, 29; Indiana, 28; Pennsylvania, 20; Ohio, 17 and Illinois, 10.

For the week of 20 to 27 October, Iowa leads the “league table” in the number of new positive results, accounting for 33 of the total of 85 new cases, with North Carolina and Oklahoma reporting 17 and 13, respectively. Across all the states, the new positive findings were mainly in the grower/finisher and suckling categories, with most of these new results in Iowa with 14 out of 28 and 10 out of 23 new cases in these two cate-

gories, respectively.

In mid-June, the reporting system was adjusted. For the weeks prior to 16 June, laboratories were able to provide diagnostic case submissions as well as the number of premises testing positive for PEDv. Since 16 June, the data refer only to diagnostic cases submissions (‘swine accession-’).

From the week of 16 June to week of 27 October, the total number of biological (swine) samples testing positive is 2,949, up from 2,620 the previous week (+329). The most-affected states are: North Carolina, 874; Oklahoma, 728; Kansas, 523; Iowa, 331; Minnesota, 145; Colorado, 82; Ohio, 72; Illinois, 51; Pennsylvania, 49 and Indiana, 30. Other states, where positive, reported 20 positives or fewer.

In the most recent week reported (week of 27 October), the following states reported one or more positive

results: Iowa (82), Illinois (23), Indiana (1), Kansas (6), Maryland (1), Minnesota (9), North Carolina (127), Iowa (1), Oklahoma (65), Pennsylvania (1), Tennessee (5), Texas (7) and Wisconsin (1).

The total number of environmental samples testing positive for PED has been reported weekly since the week of 16 June. The total has reached 582, which is 21 more than the previous week’s figure. The totals for each state are as follows (with the increase in brackets: Colorado, 14 (=); Iowa, 44 (+2); Kansas, 74 (+5); Minnesota, 186 (=); Missouri, 1 (=); North Carolina, 20 (=); Ohio, 16 (+5); Oklahoma 171 (+7); Pennsylvania, 4 (+2); South Dakota, 1 (=); Virginia, 2 (=); unknown, 49(=).

These data are collated by USDA APHIS VS NVSL National Animal Health Laboratory Network (NAHLN) and cited by the American Association of Swine Veterinarians.

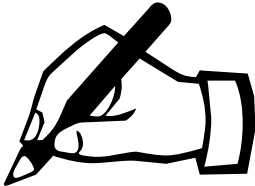

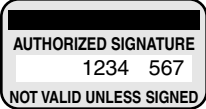

Study claims Congressional Budget Office may have overstated the cost of crop insurance

New data by agricultural economist Art Barnaby indicates that the Congressional Budget Office may have overstated the cost of federal crop insurance.

Barnaby concludes that price volatility, the amount of uncertainty or risk in the size of the changes of a security's value, drives premium cost more than market price. If implied volatility (estimated volatility) decreases then the resulting decrease in premiums will create lower premium support costs equaling lower taxpayer costs.

The Risk Management Agency's rating system uses the market implied volatility for estimating the price risk of insuring the crop. However, higher volatility does not always correspond with higher loss years. In 2012, corn had an implied volatility of 22 percent for the crop that had the largest historical underwriting loss and largest loss ratio since 1993.

In the last four years of winter wheat production the implied volatility has

decreased from 33 percent volatility in 2011 to 19 percent volatility for the 2014 crop. If the volatility for both corn and wheat remains about 20 percent, this will keep the premium prices lower indicating a lower federal cost for crop insurance. If CBO estimated crop insurance for an average 30 percent volatility rate then the budget could be vastly overstated. Barnaby's numbers are dependent on a reduction of implied volatility, and if true then the CBO estimated crop insurance costs will likely exceed the actual cost.

“My estimates are based on an assumption that we are going to 20 percent volatility. If that assumption is wrong than the CBO is probably right,” said Barnaby.

This numerical error could cause major issues in the farm bill debate. The conference committee works within a budget cap and if one of the programs costs less than budgeted, the money could be used for other programs.

“The committee has to

fit the farm bill under that magic budget number. If the CBO overestimates the cost and the committee doesn't spend that full amount then what they spent becomes the new baseline. It only impacts the current farm bill debate whether you can make current improvements through the commodity or crop insurance,” Barnaby said.

Ken Wood, a wheat farmer from Chapman, said he believes his premium will decrease this year but is unsure if the data will impact the farm bill debate.

Crop insurance is an important risk management tool for farmers. As the cost and risk of production agriculture is increasing, many farmers use crop insurance to protect their assets. “I hope that the public understands that crop insurance is used in a risk management program. Rarely does anyone get enough from a crop insurance claim to equal what they would get from the crop. It's not a get-rich-quick thing but it will keep you in business,” said Wood.

Implied volatility is just one of the factors that affect premium costs for farmers. While it is the most influential factor, premium cost is also based on market price, the rate set by the RMA and the individual farmer's actual production history.

“It comes down to what you assume for implied volatility. The last two years we've been in the 20 percent range, and in the es-

timations that I did, we are going to return to the 20 percent volatility,” said Barnaby. Does the CBO have a history of overstating farm programs costs? Barnaby said he believes so but has not done the research to back it up. As for crop insurance costing a significant amount for taxpayers, the current loss ratio is under one dollar, meaning that the government has paid out less than

it has taken in from premium payments. However, this does not account for the premium support that the government provides to assist the farmer.

Time will only tell if Barnaby's predictions prove to be true. The next announcement about crop insurance prices and premium costs for Kansas farmers will come with the corn and soybean price discovery periods in Feb. 2014.

Kansas feedlots, with capacities of 1,000 or more head, contained 2.05 million cattle on feed on November 1, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. This inventory was down 8 percent from last year.

Placements during October totaled 470,000 head, up 24 percent from 2012.

Fed cattle marketings for the month of October totaled 400,000 head, up 10 percent from last year.

Other disappearance during October totaled 20,000 head, down 5,000 head from last year.

U.S. senate committee proposes changing tax rules for agriculture

The U.S. Senate Committee on Finance today issued a proposed set of tax code changes that would negatively and significantly affect many agricultural producers, both crop and livestock. The proposed rule change would limit the number of agricultural businesses that can use cash accounting, requiring many to shift to the accrual method of accounting. This move is opposed by many agricultural groups including the American Farm Bureau Federation as well as the Farm Financial Standards Council.

"We are concerned that this change would force many agricultural businesses to pay a significant upfront tax payment and limit their ability to weather price volatility," says Brian Kuehl, director of federal affairs for Kennedy and Coe LLC. "Under this proposal, farmers could be required to pay taxes on products for which they have not yet received payment."

Kennedy and Coe, a national agricultural accounting and consulting firm, says the impact of the proposed rule could limit the growth and stability of some agricultural businesses and is actively opposing it.

"These changes could affect the economic viability of many operations," adds Jeff Wald, CEO of Kennedy and Coe. "Agriculture works very differently than other types of American business. We hope members of Congress remember that farmers, ranchers and feeders operate in a high-risk commodity environment unique to agriculture."

The proposal released by the majority staff from the Senate Finance Committee follows on the heels of a similar proposal released by the U.S. House Ways and Means Committee in March of 2013. Both proposals would require businesses with more than \$10 million in gross receipts to use accrual accounting. Both proposals would affect smaller operations by aggregating related businesses to determine whether the businesses collectively have more than \$10 million in gross receipts. If they do, then each

related business would be required to use accrual accounting.

According to data provided by Kennedy and Coe, this proposal could affect feed yards responsible for 73 percent of U.S. beef production and dairies producing approximately 30 percent of the U.S. milk supply.

"This proposal impacts many feed yards, hog farms, dairies, and row crop operations," says Kuehl. "Agriculture is a capital intensive business. Many companies have more than \$10 million in gross receipts but have very thin profit margins or even operate at a loss. Further, family businesses much smaller than \$10 million in gross receipts could be impacted since the proposal would group related businesses together."

Last month, the Farm Financial Standards Council issued a statement criticizing this proposed accounting change: "for income tax purposes, the Council believes that the cash method currently allowed for farmers and ranchers should be retained. Switching to the farm accrual method could subject agricultural producers to much larger swings in income due to dramatic market changes that might occur at year-end."

In August, Wald wrote to Representative Dave Camp (R-MI), the chairman of the House Ways and Means Committee. In his letter, Wald asked Camp to reconsider the proposal given the significant impact that it would have on U.S. agriculture. Producers who are concerned about whether this proposal would affect their operations are encouraged to contact their members of Congress.

the department faculty.

Weibert has served as president of the Kansas Livestock Association, president of Cattle-Fax and chairman of board for Kansas Agricultural and Rural Leadership (KARL).

Weibert grew up near Durham working on his family's farm and cattle feeding business.

“Cattle have been my life,” said Weibert, “I’ve always known feeding cattle is

what I wanted to do.”

Since 1977, Weibert and his wife, Carol, have operated Decatur County Feed Yard in northwest Kansas near Oberlin. Over the years it has grown from an 18,000 to 40,000 head capacity operation with 130 active ranch customers across the country.

Decatur County Feed Yard is a family business built on three principles:

1. Ranchers retaining ownership of cattle through the feed yard.
2. Managing and marketing cattle as individuals.
3. Providing comprehensive individual animal performance data to ranchers.

Weibert's goal is and always will be to work for the producer and to help cow-calf operations improve their long-term profitability

and gain more control over their cattle's performance. He said that it is strong communication that allows his feed yard to be efficient and successful, but the automation and electronics used in the feed yard are what really sets it apart from the rest.

Weibert believes in the meaning behind “you cannot manage what you do not measure.”

In 1994 they implemented the electronic cattle management system, which allows them to track each individual animal from the time it arrives at the feed yard and through the packing plant.

An electronic ear tag is attached to the animal at the time of arrival at the feed yard. This ear tag helps match data to the correct animal and documents it automatically in their system.

Each animal is also individually measured using ultrasound, video imaging and electronic scales to determine back fat, frame score, weight and projected feed efficiency.

When the cattle are ready for market, they are then sorted by the system according to their optimum finish dates.

Cattle are sorted into market groups where they are valued individually according to a value-based grid. This allows producers to be paid based on the value of their beef, not the commodity price set by the market.

After cattle are sold, individual animal reports are sent the producers. The data included in the report

reflects the merit of each animal, including the dollar value, feed efficiency, quality grade, and more, listed from highest to lowest net return. Producers can see exactly what characteristics, costs, and gains were attributed to every animal to better understand why certain animals were more profitable than others.

With this information, ranchers can improve their herd and begin genetic improvement to create a better control over their future revenues.
