

USDA announces Farm Service Agency cooperative agreements

The U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) has announced cooperative agreements with 46 partners to educate producers, including those who have been historically underserved by USDA programs, about

Farm Service Agency (FSA) programs that provide financial, disaster or technical support. Nearly \$2.5 million will go to nonprofits and universities that will provide training and access to FSA programs, financial

resources and other information. "We're always innovating to find new ways for our programs to reach more producers and create more jobs in agriculture," said FSA Administrator Val Dolcini.

"The organizations selected as part of this effort share USDA's priority of helping more Americans build successful farms and ranches." Cooperative agreements totaling nearly \$2.5 million and encompassing 24 states,

will range from \$25,000 to \$99,999 each. This additional investment builds on the \$2.5 million in cooperative agreements awarded in 2016. A list of awardees can be found at www.fsa.usda.gov/cooperativeagreements.

Kansas officials urge federal agency to find listing of Lesser Prairie Chicken not warranted

Kansas Gov. Sam Brownback, Kansas attorney general Derek Schmidt and Kansas Department of Agriculture secretary Jackie McClaskey are urging the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Services (USFWS) to determine that the Lesser Prairie Chicken population in Kansas is being protected by the state's voluntary efforts and

that re-listing it as threatened or endangered is not warranted.

In a comment letter sent to the USFWS, the officials point out that re-listing the Lesser Prairie-Chicken as threatened or endangered would have a substantial negative impact on the state's economy and agricultural industry, and would

unduly impinge the state's sovereign interest in controlling how the land within its borders is used.

"The previous listing of the Lesser Prairie Chicken did nothing to enhance the species or its habitat, but it threatened the energy and agriculture economies of western Kansas. I urge the federal government not

to reinstate this unnecessary and harmful listing," Brownback said.

In July 2016, the Lesser Prairie Chicken was removed from the Endangered Species Act List of Endangered and Threatened Wildlife following a September 2015 court order from the U.S. District Court for the Western District of Texas,

which vacated the USFWS's 2014 listing rule. However, in September 2016, in response to a new listing petition from three environmental groups, the USFWS began a re-assessment of the biological status of the species. That assessment is expected to be completed in the summer of 2017.

"The courts rejected the last attempt to list the Lesser Prairie Chicken as a threatened or endangered species," Schmidt said. "It would be wise of the federal agency to reconsider its decision to press ahead and instead focus on working cooperatively with Kansas and with affected landowners to achieve the common purpose of sustaining the species' population."

"This renewed effort to list the Lesser Prairie Chicken as a threatened or endangered species ignores the dramatic increase in the occupied range of the species since the mid-1990s,

which is a direct result of improved weather conditions and the voluntary conservation measures of Kansas farmers and ranchers," McClaskey said. "This recent action by USFWS does not recognize the significant and successful stewardship of our agricultural community."

The letter urges the USFWS to determine that the renewed effort to have the Lesser Prairie Chicken listed as threatened or endangered is not warranted under the facts or the law, and asks the USFWS to give proper weight to the sweeping economic impact of the rule, the state's sovereign interests, and the long-term trend showing that the states' conservation efforts have been effective in re-establishing the population of the species in all eco-regions where it is found.

Kansas cattle on feed up 4 percent

Kansas feedlots, with capacities of 1,000 or more head, contained 2.17 million cattle on feed on January 1, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. This inventory was up 4 percent from last year. Placements during December totaled 395,000 head, up 18 percent from 2015. Fed cattle marketings for the month of December totaled 430,000 head, up 16 percent from last year. Other disappearance during December totaled 15,000 head, unchanged from last year.

The conference provided young ag producers between the ages of 18-35 with agricultural education, moti-

ational speakers and opportunities to connect with industry resources and network with peers.

Newly elected Kansas congressman Roger Marshall addressed the ag producers at the networking luncheon Jan. 28.

State committee members from each of the ten Kansas Farm Bureau districts planned and hosted the Live to Farm... Farm to Live-themed conference that included workshops, speakers, tours and compe-

titions during the weekend event. The YF&R state committee played an integral part in making this year's conference a success.

Wichita County farmer and rancher Amy France, who chairs the YF&R committee, said the leadership conference was intended to, "Prepare for the uncertainty coming down the pike. We'll be dealing with a new administration in Washing-

ton and the downturn in our farm and ranch economy continues."

France stressed the importance of grassroots involvement and speaking on behalf of farmers and ranchers throughout Kansas.

"Because we come together and speak as one, unified voice, we resonate on the county, state and national levels," France said. "Speaking as the voice of ag-

Major research development to help honey bees

A new honey bee testing service will allow beekeepers to more effectively identify and address diseases plaguing bee colonies, according to the National Agricultural Genotyping Center (NAGC).

NAGC conducted the research and developed the testing panel with the support of the National Corn Growers Association and the North Dakota Department of Agriculture. The testing service, called "Bee Care," will launch in February 2017.

"It's the first time we have a panel of the most common honey bee diseases in North America all in one test," said Pete Snyder, president and CEO of the NAGC. "So we can diagnose problems, get results in 30 days and allow beekeepers to pursue the right treatment."

NAGC has begun contacting beekeeper groups nationwide with information on the BeeCare testing service and how to submit samples for testing.

"Supporting this research work at the NAGC is just part of Corn Growers' overall effort to assure healthy

bee populations. BeeCare is an important tool that will allow beekeepers to evaluate and address health issues in a timely manner," said Carson Klosterman, a farmer from Wyndmere, North Dakota and member of NC-GA's Stewardship Action Team. "We are also actively engaged in the Honey Bee Health Coalition (HBHC) which has the goal of reversing recent declines in honey bee health and ensuring the long-term health of honey bees and other pollinators."

HBHC, comprised of beekeepers, researchers, government agencies, agribusinesses, growers, conservation groups, manufacturers and consumer brands, seeks to improve and sustain honey bee health at all levels of beekeeping, identifying and implementing novel and proven solutions to major honey bee health challenges, enhancing effective communications, and collaboration among diverse private and public sector stakeholders with interests related to beekeeping, pollination, and agriculture production.

"American agriculture re-

lies upon healthy pollinators. Recent problems like Colony Collapse Disorder are very complex and have a multitude of possible causes. Unfortunately, some groups are quick to blame row crop farmers and immediately attack crop protection products," Snyder said.

Cowboy Chatter

Buck, Kick and Run

That's not all horses do. Bite is missing from the title but that's something a horse can do very well, whether biting another horse or maybe even a person. If you're on the wrong end of a bite or kick, it can ruin your whole day. It may even cost you a trip to town to visit the doctor.

However, if you're on top of one that's become unhappy about something or somebody and goes to bucking, you may have your hands full for a short time. When the fun is over and your heart rate goes down, you'll probably have some dark thoughts concerning your steed.

Have you ever wondered why horses sometimes do things that we as humans would consider bad behavior? It's the way they're put together. Their brains are programmed to those reactions when they feel threatened or in danger. As big as they are, horses are still prey animals.

Prey animals are animals caught, killed, and eaten by another animal as food. It's hard to believe that horses are preyed upon but that's the way it has happened since the first horses roamed the planet. Our horses don't have too much of a problem in the modern world but they still have the instincts of the prey animal.

Think back to the old days when horses roamed free and had to be continually on guard to protect themselves, their offspring and others of their band from wolves, lions, bears and an assortment of other

creatures that had a liking for horsemeat. Don't forget humans, because from what I hear horsemeat will sustain life.

I answered a knock on the door years ago to find a man selling a hindquarter of a horse that broke a leg. He had to put him down and said it would be a shame to waste the meat. I declined but it got me to thinking about the plight of the horse.

Domesticated horses are at our mercy. They have to do our bidding and depend on us to provide care and nourishment and attend to their ailments. It wasn't always that way. Horses had to provide those comforts for themselves and with all the prowling predators, it wasn't easy to survive. To get to the point, that is why they buck, kick, run and bite when they feel threatened.

A horse bucks because he wants to get something off his back that threatens him. He bucks to rid something aggravating him like a slipped rear girth or a bite from another horse or a sting by a bee or hornet.

It's a natural trait that developed in the wild for protection from feline predators like mountain lions and cougars that would attack horses from above by jumping on their backs to kill them. They bucked to throw the predator loose. Sometimes they buck to rid themselves of the rider on their back. If they get away with it, they may develop the habit of bucking a rider off since they have learned they can do it and, consequently, won't have to work as hard.

Sometimes they buck when they're happy like when you move them into a gallop and they are enjoying themselves. We all know a fresh horse, one not warmed up enough, or young horses are all prone to showing off with a few wild movements.

Horses learned to kick when they were cornered by packs of wolves or other predators. If they couldn't run or bite, they kicked and that just might be their most dangerous weapon. Imagine what it was like for them to be surrounded by a pack of wolves. Their only defense was to kick or bite the predators. If you've ever been kicked, you'll have to admit their aim is pretty good. You might even call them sharpshooters with their legs.

Their front legs are dangerous too. They can cow-kick with a front leg that will stagger you. They can rear up and strike with both front legs that can be deadly and those powerful hind legs can deliver a killing blow from both barrels.

A horse's best line of defense is to run, to flee from the danger or remove themselves from an uncomfortable situation. Their speed can carry them far from the danger zone and most predators simply can't catch them.

Knowledge of horses' instincts of survival can be put to use in our relationship with them. We know they kick, bite, run and buck for protection. We can safely move around them on the ground and ride them if we use our understanding of why they do these dangerous things.

We can take precautions to prevent bucking if we understand why they buck. Loose rigging or worn-out cinch hobbles that could break and cause the rear cinch to slide back and surprise the horse are a blow-up waiting to happen. Regularly inspect your rigging to eliminate any tack failures.

Prepare the colts you start on the ground. Get them used to saddles, rear cinches, cruppers and other rigging before you step in the stirrup.

Keep your eyes peeled when leading a horse known to bite. If you feed treats, be careful how you offer them. If the horse is pushy, stop feeding those horse cookies. Be on your toes when you administer worm medicine or give shots. Remember the horse's survival instincts and try to reason ahead of time how he may react to something you are about to do to him.

If you have to do something that will be uncomfortable to the horse, position yourself away from the trajectory of his legs in case he kicks. When you're on the ground, don't chase the horse from behind to catch him. If he doesn't want to be caught, you won't have a chance of catching him.

He may use his instinct to kick, bite or run if you corner him or have too many people standing on both sides brushing, doctoring or saddling him. His escape route has been blocked by the people surrounding him and he will feel threatened. A good vet will always ask you to stand on the same side he is working to make the horse feel more secure and not threatened by blocked escape routes. The same goes for holding a horse for the farrier, stand on the same side he is working on.

Using your knowledge of their survival instincts can save a lot of trouble and sometimes pain by eliminating the conditions that make them buck, kick and bite.

Hazardous Occupation Training to be held for 14 and 15-year-olds in May

This law does not apply to youth who work on a farm owned or operated by immediate family members, nor does it apply to youth who are 16 years of age. The K-State Research and Extension - Central Kansas Extension District Office will conduct the only session this year, Tuesday, May 30, 2017, 300 W. Ash, Room 109, Salina. The training will begin at 8:30 a.m. and concluding at approximately 4:00 p.m. Each student will be required to complete an assignment from course materials prior to the class.

Interested youth can enroll at their respective Ex-

tension office. The Central Kansas Extension District Offices are located in the City-County Building, Room 111, 300 W. Ash, Salina and Courthouse, Minneapolis.

Materials for the course cost \$15.00 and must be picked up by May 12th. The following information is

Kansas cattle inventory up 2 percent

All cattle and calves in Kansas as of January 1, 2017 totaled 6.4 million head, up 2 percent from January 1, 2016, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. All cows and heifers that had calved totaled 1.72

million head, up 6 percent from last year. Beef cows totaled 1.57 million head, up 6 percent from last year. Milk cows totaled 150,000 head, up 6 percent from January 1, 2016. All heifers 500 pounds and over totaled 1.84 million head, up 1 percent from last

year. Steers weighing 500 pounds and over totaled 2.05 million head, up 2 percent from last year. Bulls weighing 500 pounds and over totaled 95,000 head, up 6 percent from last year. Calves under 500 pounds totaled 695,000 head, up 1 percent

from January 1, 2016. All cattle on feed fed for slaughter in Kansas feedlots totaled 2.3 million head, up 3 percent from the previous year. The 2016 calf crop totaled 1.48 million head, up 11 percent from 2015.

We just need to think not only about our marketing environments today but also think about the beef industry for the future."

The leading beef export markets (by value) in 2016 were Japan, Mexico, South Korea, Canada, Hong Kong and Taiwan. Additional promising markets are located in the Middle East, Southeast Asia, Central and South America, and Africa.

Sheep, lamb and goat numbers up from last year

All sheep and lamb inventory in Kansas on January 1, 2017 totaled 68 thousand head, up 3,000 head from last year, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service.

Breeding sheep inventory totaled 45,000, up 1,000 from last year. Ewes one year and older totaled 36,000 head, unchanged from the previous year. Rams one year and older

remained unchanged from last year's 2,000 head. Total replacement lambs totaled 7,000 head, up 1,000 from last year.

Market sheep and lambs totaled 23,000 head, up 2,000 head from last year. A total of 2,000 head were mature sheep (one year and older) while the remaining 21,000 were under one year. Market lamb weight groups were estimated as follows:

8,500 lambs were under 65 pounds; 2,000 were 65-84 pounds; 1,500 were 85-105 pounds; 9,000 were over 105 pounds.

The 2016 lamb crop totaled 44 thousand head, up 1,000 from 2015. The 2016 lambing rate was 122 per 100 ewes one year and older, compared with 119 per 100 ewes in 2015.

Shorn wool production during 2016 was 285,000

pounds, up 10 thousand pounds from 2015. Sheep and lambs shorn totaled 43,000 head, up 1,000 head from 2015. The average price paid for wool sold in 2016 was \$0.89 per pound, compared with \$0.87 in 2015. The total value of wool produced in Kansas was 254 thousand dollars in 2016.

All meat and other goat and kid inventory in Kan-

sas on January 1, 2016, totaled 46,000 head, up from last year's 43,000 head. Milk

goat inventory totaled 4,700 head, up 500 from last year.

Farm Credit Services report touts crop insurance

Crop insurance saved nearly 21,000 jobs in four states during one of the worst droughts in two decades, according to a report from Farm Credit Services of America.

The 20-page paper breaks down the history of the crop insurance program from the start in 1930s, with the Great Depression and Dust Bowl, to expansions in the 1980s and 1990s after a string of unbudgeted disaster relief bills strained federal coffers.

The paper says farmers have plenty of "skin in the game" when it comes to crop insurance, and their participation helps minimize risk exposure for taxpayers.

FCS provides a step-by-step guide to the public-private partnership that makes the crop insurance program efficient when it comes to covering losses. It also highlights key points including the fact that private companies sell the insurance products and that farmers, like all other insurance customers, pay deductibles and premiums.

But the story of the drought of 2012 is where the paper really shines in showing just how important crop insurance is to keeping America's food, clothing and fuel supplies secure.

The drought was a devastating hit in a year that was supposed to be favorable for planting. Corn, soybean and hay production declined throughout that summer as the drought intensified.

Corn production was down more than 29 percent and soybeans fell 6 percent. The low yields were coming on a year that started with low beginning stocks, the report notes, and tight U.S. and global supplies.

Projected prices rose in anticipation of short supplies. Farmers faced low yields and ended up facing big expenses to buy crops at higher prices to fulfill forward marketing obligations and to feed on-farm livestock.

Crop insurance helped cover the shortfall and saved 20,900 jobs across Iowa, Nebraska, South Dakota and Wyoming, with an annual labor income of \$721.2 million, according to the report.

That's money that ended up in Main Street shops and restaurants. Money that allowed farmers to continue to pay the bills and get ready for the next season even after a disaster like the drought of 2012.

And best of all, farmers didn't have to go to Congress for an ad-hoc relief bill - just like Congress designed.

"Crop insurance kept me farming," Iowa farmer Denny Marzen said in the report. "It's a business tool I use with my marketing program and to help me deal with Mother Nature."

Would you give to this charity scam?

HumaneWatch.org, a project of the nonprofit Center for Consumer Freedom, announced a national commercial targeting the Humane Society of the United States (HSUS). The ad, titled "Would You?" airs on the Fox News Channel and asks viewers whether they would give to a "humane society" that runs zero pet shelters or that paid millions of their donors' contributions to settle a racketeering lawsuit. View the commercial online. The HSUS is not affiliated with local humane societies that care for homeless pets. In fact, HSUS does not run a single pet shelter. In 2014, HSUS settled a racketeering lawsuit for nearly \$11 million after it was caught paying a witness who lied in federal court. HSUS was also the subject of a "consumer alert" and civil investigative demands issued by Oklahoma attorney general Scott Pruitt that year.

Junior Livestock Auction sets all-time record

The 2017 Auction of the Junior Livestock Champions set a National Western Stock Show (NWSS) record with the top eight champion animals posting total sales of \$442,500. The standing-room-only crowd hollered as the Grand Champion Steer set a record selling for \$135,000. The auction start-

ed with a bang when the Reserve Grand Champion Lamb sold for \$34,000, exceeding last year's bid by \$6,000. The Reserve Grand Champion Steer sold for a record-breaking \$107,500, exceeding last year's bid of \$70,000. The money invested supports the junior exhibitors that raised the animal as

they plan for their agricultural future and college educations. In addition, a portion of the proceeds support the National Western Scholarship Trust, which funds scholarships in agriculture and rural medicine at colleges throughout Colorado and Wyoming. This year 80 students received funds to aid their education.
