Kansas Hay Market Report

The hay trade seemed to pick up slightly again, primarily for grinding alfalfa, with prices remaining fairly steady for all classes of hay.

The exception is for grinding hay in the southwest and north central-northeast regions, which has increased. It seems most folks have been very busy moving hay. Drought conditions were unchanged for a second straight week. The abnormally dry (D0) category remained at 64.91 pct, moderate drought (D1) remained at 26.02 pct and the severe drought (D2) category remained at 6.68 pct. 

Construction originally was scheduled to be completed last year but was delayed. The lab is now on track to be fully operational in December 2022.

Martha Vanier, of the Department of Homeland Security says \$266 million in construction has been completed so far.

She says about 200 workers are currently working on the construction but that number will grow to as many as 1,000.

2017 KSU Chemical Weed Control Guide now available


By David G. Hallauer, District Extension Agent, Crops & Soils/Horticulture

A seven-year Weed Science Society of America study indicated that if weeds were left to grow without implementation of any control measures, we would lose almost half our yield. K-State weed scientist Anita Dille was part of the study and says: 'What we saw in corn is that we'd lose over half of our yield if we didn't manage those weeds - a 52 percent yield loss, and in soybeans, almost the same - 49.5 percent total yield loss on average.' Kansas alone would potentially have lost 52.6 percent of soybeans at an average financial cost of \$666,435,000 per year over the seven years of the study (2007-2013) if weeds had been left to grow unchecked!

We certainly don't see many losses like that in our weed control programs, but there's no doubt challenges do exist when it comes to keeping weed pressure at bay. That's why one of our most popular publications is the annual Chemical Weed Control Guide. It is now available at all three of our District Office and other K-State Research & Extension Offices across the state as well as online at: <http://www.bookstore.ksre.ksu.edu/pubs/chemweedguide.pdf>.

Between now and February 20th, KARTA members (and prospective members) are encouraged to submit funding applications for on-farm research. "It is getting harder and harder to maintain a viable farming operation with rising input costs," says KARTA board president Tyler Rider. "On-farm research is so important for testing new products and new methods - and sharing that information with the other producers at our annual conference is always an attendee favorite. It's not about your theory being right, it's about being more in-the-know when the data comes in."

Research grants are available in several amounts. KARTA members who submit new research project receive a grant in the amount of \$500 per person. Members who submit applications for continuing projects from previous years receive \$400 per person. Group studies are also encouraged, and grants are available at \$300 per group member involved with the research project. New group projects are being facilitated this year, with more information being announced to those who apply to participate.

"Grant funding is designed to encourage producers to answer the questions they might have on their own farms," says KARTA research coordinator Brent Rendel. "The first time you take on a research project it can be challenging, but it gets easier the more you practice. We can help new researchers get started tracking their results, and can try to walk them through the process to make it as simple as possible."

Grant recipients are expected to track their project's results in a scientific manner that produces comparable data. The funds will be awarded in the spring of 2017, and the recipient will be expected to report their results to the KARTA membership at next year's conference in January 2018. Anyone interested in learning more about the research funding or reading previous research projects should visit the KARTA website at www.kartaonline.org. From there, they can also fill out the convenient online application to request funding for their proposed project. Deadline to apply is February 20th.

In addition to the winter conference, KARTA also hosts a number of workshops and educational events throughout the year including a workshop on Yield Editor coming up March 2nd and 3rd at two locations in western Kansas. Instances of improper crop insurance payments well below government averages

The acting administrator of the USDA's Risk Management Agency recently said that crop insurance's improper payment rate — a closely watched standardized measure of waste and efficiency for all major federal spending programs — fell again in 2016.

The 2016 rate of 2.02 percent marked the second year in a row it declined, falling from 2015's 2.2 percent. Both are significantly lower than the 5.58 percent catalogued in 2014.

The announcement, made by Heather Manzano at the crop insurance industry's annual meeting, was great news considering crop insurance's results were far better than other government programs. The government-wide improper payment rate was 4.67 percent in 2016 and 4.39 percent in 2015.

An improper payment occurs when funds go to the wrong recipient; when the correct recipient receives too little or too much; or when the recipient uses funds in an improper manner. Many errors are simply rooted in data entry and reporting mistakes.

Tom Zacharias, the president of National Crop Insurance Services, which sponsored the meetings, said the news shows how well the current crop insurance infrastructure operates.

"Crop insurers and our partners at the USDA work closely together, and we are dedicated to being good stewards of taxpayer dollars by constantly improving efficiency," he said. "The private sector spends millions every year on new research and technologies, as well as monitoring, training, and education programs."


Reducing improper payments has been a long-term goal for crop insurance providers and the USDA. Zacharias said the new data is proof that the hard work is paying off, and he believes it will be key to defending the farm safety net in political circles.

"It proves how efficient the current system is, and it proves that crop insurance is a well-run public-private partnership," he concluded. "It's a great story, and it's one we will tell over and over again as perennial critics of farm policy look to weaken farmers' risk management tools."

market. The export value is the highest it has been since July 2013. According to NCBA's Beltway Beef report, 2016's export numbers (with December not yet reported) have already surpassed 2015's numbers with a total of \$929.3 million, a

25 percent increase over 2015's total of \$847.4 million. Once December's numbers are calculated, South Korea will join Japan, Hong Kong, Canada and Mexico as nations to import more than \$1 billion of U.S. beef in a single year.
