

2016 U.S. pork exports show progress

At year-end 2016, U.S. pork exports showed impressive progress following a challenging 2015. In 2016, 5.1 billion pounds of pork and pork variety meats valued at \$5.94 billion dollars were exported, up 8 percent and 7 percent respectively from 2015, accord-

ing to the USDA.

"We saw a strong 2016 for U.S. pork exports, but we still face challenges with increased global competition and a stronger U.S. dollar," said Becca Nepple, vice president of international marketing for the Pork Checkoff. "The Checkoff

is committed to bolstering its partnership with international customers through additional funding of in-country promotions of U.S. pork with the U.S. Meat Export Federation."

On average, U.S. pork and pork variety meat exports accounted for 25.8 percent of

total pork production in 2016. Export value returned an average \$50.20 per head back to producers.

During 2016, more than 100 countries around the world imported U.S. pork.

The top five markets by volume were Mexico (1.61 billion pounds), China/Hong Kong (1.21 billion pounds), Japan (854.8 million pounds), Canada (452.2 million pounds) and Cen-

tral and South America (299.7 million pounds).

The top five markets by value were Japan (\$1.56 billion), Mexico (\$1.355 billion), China and Hong Kong (\$1.075 billion), Canada (\$798.5 million) and Korea (\$365.1 million).

With more pork available in the U.S., the National Pork Board recently approved an increase of 12.7 percent in

funding for 2017 export market activities. This financial commitment translates into tangible marketing activities that increase U.S. pork exports to emerging and developing markets.

According to Nepple, promotions and marketing activities will focus on displacing other proteins and global competitors and on promoting larger pork cuts.

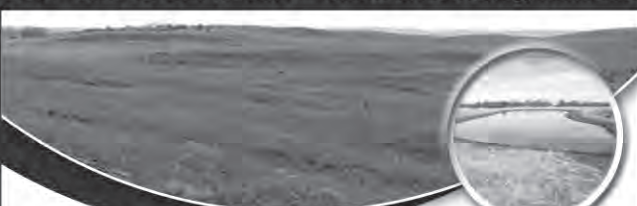

Bigger, better beef herds bring hope in tough times

A bigger beef cattle herd; a younger cow herd; in the face of declining cattle prices, these two facts can bring hope.

Had it not been for the drought early in this decade, Oklahoma State University ag economist Darrell Peel says the expansion would have come sooner.

"We continued to place heifers on feed" - no grass for them to join the herds - "but because of the drought, we were forced to liquidate cows off of the old end of the herd," he explains. When expansion finally began in 2015, it was with a large influx of heifers. "As a result, we made the herd very young."

That gives way to higher quality because of genetic progress.

"The 2015 cow culling rate was very low for as far back as I have data; 2016 is still below average," says Peel, who suggests 2017 will continue below average. "Eventually as you add more cows, you get back to normal culling for physical reasons, but I would imagine we are still a year away from that at this point."

The share of heifers in the USDA reported fed-cattle harvest is a good indicator of expansion trends, says Paul Dykstra, beef cattle specialist for the Certified Angus Beef brand.

"As we retain heifers to expand or replace the cows culled from drought, those heifers never show up in the fed cattle harvest tabulated weekly at USDA-inspected plants," Dykstra says. Historic data shows the share

of heifers in that mix has been more than 36% for 20 years, except for a slight dip in 2006.

"There's been a dramatic build-up in the past two years as heifers in the fed-cattle mix dipped to 32.5% in 2015 and 31.9% in 2016," Dykstra notes.

The most rapid years of expansion are behind us, he says, but Angus producers have made gains.

"Genetics have been up-

graded more rapidly with the higher rate of replacements from the drought," Dykstra says. "And some of those herds destocked in the south are restocking with primarily Angus genetics."

Simply based on supply and demand, a larger supply of beef means a softening cattle market. But for Angus producers, the steadily higher demand for quality beef despite its in-

creasing supply indicates a strong future.

"More cattle have been accepted into the CAB brand based on meeting the marbling parameter of our ten specifications," Dykstra says. "So as a result, we are looking at increased sales volumes."

The cattle cycle will

move ahead as expansion eventually levels off.

"Prices drive decisions to expand or cut back," he says. "If we are surprised with better-than-expected prices on these increased supplies, that could continue the heifer retention we've been seeing at the cow-calf level."

Dykstra says a heifer percentage of the fed-cattle harvest mix shifting to higher than 35% indicates cow herd expansion is slowing or reaching equilibrium. Read more of Dykstra's biweekly comments in the CAB Insider at <http://www.cabpartners.com/news/cab-insider/>.

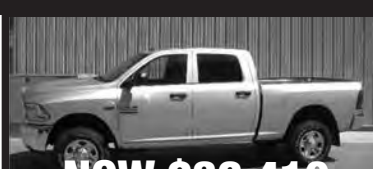

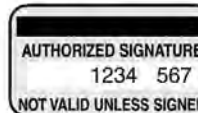

Monsanto Fund launches America's Farmers Grow Rural Education program

The number of jobs with an emphasis in science, technology, engineering and math (STEM) is expected to grow significantly over the next ten years, according to the National Science and Math Initiative. To help K-12 educators enhance their STEM curriculum, the America's Farmers Grow Rural Education program, sponsored by the Monsanto Fund, will once again provide farmers with the opportunity to nominate their public schools for opportunities to receive \$10,000 and \$25,000 grants.

Former grant-winning schools, such as Early County Elementary School in Blakely, Georgia, indicate the program stimulates school budgets for STEM education, as well as students'

level of interest in science and math.

In 2016, Early County Elementary School used the \$10,000 grant they received from the Grow Rural Education program to expand the school's science curriculum by building a hoop house, allowing students to apply classroom lessons about the ecosystem and plant lifecycles to the fruits and vegetables they harvest.

"The Grow Rural Education grant has had an impact throughout our entire school district. After our elementary school students harvest their crops, we provide the food to our high school culinary arts program," said Early County Elementary School teacher Tim Spooner. "This allows high school

students to learn their craft and then give a portion of that food to our area's most needy residents."

In 2017, the Grow Rural Education program will award approximately \$2.3 million to deserving schools. Since the program began in 2011, it has awarded more than \$11 million to schools in rural communities across the United States.

To qualify for a Grow Rural Education grant, farmers in eligible counties must nominate an eligible rural public school district to compete for a merit-based grant of either \$10,000 or \$25,000. Farmers can nominate their school district from January 1 to April 1, 2017.

After the school district

receives a nomination, the Monsanto Fund will notify the district and encourage administrators and teachers to design a grant that enhances STEM education in their district.

Nominated school districts have until April 15, 2017, to submit a grant application describing their project. An advisory council composed of farmer leaders then reviews finalist appli-

cations and selects the winning school districts.

"The Grow Rural Education program provides farmers with a way to give back and sets students up for success in their local communities," said Al Mitchell, Monsanto Fund president. "We have heard from many school districts that the projects they implement excite their students and, in many instances, have result-

ed in improved test scores."

To nominate a local school district for one of the Grow Rural Education grants, as well as a complete list of program rules and eligibility information, farmers can go to GrowRuralEducation.com. Additionally, more information about the program can be found at facebook.com/AmericasFarmers.

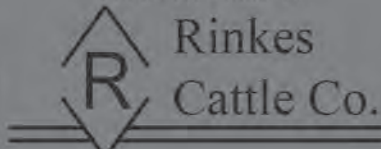
