



Schwieterman Market Outlook

A marketing commentary by Bret Crofts

We had an interesting week in the cattle market. Cash cattle shot up to the \$137 area in many locations and some areas in Nebraska were higher than that. Choice boxed beef is trending higher, the Choice - Select spread is setting new highs, and the Cutter Cow Cutout value is the highest in two years. Generally speaking, when the Choice - Select spread is widening, the cattle market is rising, and that is the case right

now. However, we have seen times when that spread is very narrow and cutter cows are more valuable because the bottom end of the market is the driving force in the market place. Right now we are in a situation where we have great demand for choice beef, but we may be on the cusp of a huge surge in demand at the bottom end of the market as well. If India, the largest exporter of beef in the world, successfully bans the slaughter

of cows, the world may have a hard time coming up with grinding meat, low end cuts, and leather. It will be an interesting situation to monitor in the coming months.

On the charts, the trends are pointing up, but we haven't made any new contract highs in the front months of the live cattle, yet. With the current cash price, it looks very likely that we see new contract highs in the front months soon. The contracts from October forward have

already made new contract highs and further gains in those contracts will push the feeder cattle to new contract highs as well. If the spread between June and October were closer to normal, we would have to feeders \$20 than they are now already.

Friday the 9th is a full moon and the June supply and demand report. There may not be a lot of adjustments to the numbers this go round, but we do have to potential to see both corn and soybean acreage and yields adjusted. Most likely any changes to acreage will come in the June Planted Acreage report at the end of the month, and yields most likely won't be tweaked until the July supply and demand report. The fact that crop condition ratings came well below last year at 65% Good to Excellent, will have some analysts believing that a yield cut is necessary, but USDA probably won't act on that until more data is available.

Another thing that we won't have is the wheat class by class break down for the new crop. A lot of traders are interested in how tight new crop Hard Red Spring wheat supplies might get. Minneapolis

wheat is well above Kansas City and Chicago partly due to the demand for high protein wheat, and partly due to fears of falling supplies. Hopefully the strength in Minneapolis will finally spill over into the Kansas City contracts.

On the charts, we are seeing a whole lot of sideways trade in the corn and wheat. Hopefully there is something in the supply and demand report that breaks the market out of the range, either bullish or bearish. As for the soybeans, it is hard to have much hope for that market. Demand is great, but it will never be enough to absorb another large crop. The best hope for the bean bulls is a weather disaster.

Other things that are happening in the markets include the Dow Jones making new all-time highs, the U.S. Dollar Index making a new low for the year, and the U.S. 30-year bond futures making new contract highs. It seems that the stock market is going up forever, but there is still enough demand for bonds to keep yields down. Apparently bond traders don't really fear interest rate hikes at this time. It is hard to make sense of the movement in

the financial markets, but I hope that the weakness in the dollar spurs demand for U.S. wheat, because that is what we need more than anything.



Kansas' Flint Hills Nature Trail open for bikers and hikers

(AP) - After 16 years of planning, the Flint Hills Nature Trail is open to hikers and bikers, although they might encounter a few rough stretches on a trail that winds through native grasses, wildflowers, trees, bridges and even a section of hardwood forest.

The trail, which runs along abandoned Missouri Pacific Railroad lines, is 90 miles long and could expand to nearly 120 miles from Osawatomie to Herington in the future.

Linda Craghead, assistant secretary for the Kansas Department of Wildlife, Parks and Tourism, says the trail is already being used by people who stay overnight in nearby state parks, private campgrounds or motels, *The Wichita Eagle* reported.

"Most people don't realize the interest Kansans have in trails these days, said Craghead, who runs the state's tourism department. "People want to get out, and get away from the cities and towns. It's a huge, huge desire."

Work on the trail began when some residents living along the abandoned line

formed the Kanza Rail-Trails Conservancy in 2001.

"When I first got involved, so many people told me I was crazy," said Scott Allen, of Council Grove, the group's vice president. "The only idea crazier was not building this trail. It's too much of a natural resource to let it go to waste."

Volunteers spent the first few years cutting back trees and brush from the railroad bed, battling erosion damage and removing thousands of railroad ties. Some volunteers even bought needed equipment with their own money, Allen said. Eventually the conservancy received money from private foundations.

Craghead said about 80 percent of the money used to improve the trail has come from federal transportation funds earmarked for alternative transportation. The Wildlife and Parks department also had helped raise money and offered expertise.

Trent McCown, manager of the department's 53-mile Prairie Spirit Trail, said finely crushed limestone has been added to parts of the trail and most of the

original railroad bridges have been upgraded or replaced.

While the entire Flint Hills Nature Trail is "traversable," improvements continue in some areas. McCown said a 15-mile stretch of trail, roughly from Quenemo to Ottawa, is largely complete but other areas

need more attention. The 15.5 miles from Osage City to Admire have an unfinished surface and in some places, the trail detours onto country roads for a mile or two.

Allen, McCown and Craghead think the trail will be finished within the next few years. Some access points could one day offer

camping, large parking lots, bathrooms and interpretive kiosks.

Another section of the old railroad trail between Council Grove and Herington could be added to the trail, which would stretch it to 117 miles.

Despite some unfinished parts, the trail is already

popular.

"It's not uncommon to see cars from other counties, and even other states, like Missouri, Iowa and New York," Allen said of the trailhead in Council Grove. "On a Saturday or Sunday it's not uncommon to see ten to twelve horse trailers at the trailhead at Rantoul."

Located in Abilene, Kansas, the inaugural Trails, Rails and Tale's symbolizes the end of the Chisholm Trail. 

Song Fight

It wasn't exactly the Shootout at the OK Corral or a quick draw in Abilene or Dodge City, but it was a western dispute which had to be resolved. The question was the authorship of the famous song, *Home on the Range*.

Most Kansans know that *Home on the Range* is the Kansas state song, and no doubt one of the most famous of any state songs. It is sometimes called the Anthem of the American West. But people may not know that the authorship of this historic song was highly disputed in the 1930s.

Ken Spurgeon of non-profit Lone Chimney Films in Wichita came across this story and has produced a docudrama about the creation and conflict surrounding *Home on the Range*. Ken credits El Dean Holthus with giving him the idea. El Dean is also credited for saving the Home on the Range cabin itself on its original site in Smith County. By the 2000s, the cabin was suffering in disrepair from the toll of time. El Dean led the effort to save the old cabin and was supported by Michael Martin Murphey, Wichita radio personality Orin Friesen and many others. With their help, the cabin was restored to its original form in 2013.

When El Dean shared the history of the song with Wichita filmmaker Ken Spurgeon, Ken became increasingly intrigued. He and Orin Friesen connect-

ed with Smith County writer Sharon Black, and ultimately it became the topic of a new docudrama called *Home on the Range*.

The film tells the story of how an Arizona couple filed suit in 1934, claiming they were the authors and rightful owners of the song. At the time, the song was quite popular, having been recorded by artists such as Bing Crosby. A New York lawyer was dispatched to find the true ownership, and his pursuit led him to Smith County, Kansas. A retired Smith County sheriff named Trube Reese explained to him that Dr. Brewster Higley

had first written the words about Higley's cabin in Kansas. A neighbor named Dan Kelly put the words to music, and the Harlan family performed it. The *Smith County Pioneer* newspaper published the poem in the 1870s, ultimately proving that Higley had written it before the couple in Arizona. The movie ends with *Home on the Range* being performed by Michael Martin Murphey and then by the rock group Kansas.

This movie is terrific. It

was entirely filmed in Kansas. Trube Reese is played by Buck Taylor who played Newly on *Gunsmoke*. Judge Harlan is played by Michael Martin Murphey, and his son Cal Harlan is played by Rance Howard. Howard is the father of Hollywood director Ron Howard, who played Opie on the *Andy Griffith Show*. The radio announcer is played by Voice of the Chiefs Mitch Holthus - yep, the son of El Dean.

In January 2017, the movie debuted in Wichita, Kansas City, and Smith County. In April, it showed

A Kansas family that has stabilized miles of stream-bank on the Little Blue River by planting trees and implementing other conservation techniques will be featured during the Agroforestry Field Day on Thursday, June 8.

Jim Downard, along with his siblings Karen Haley and Ed Downard, are recipients of the 2017 Kansas Agroforestry Award. The family has improved the quality and health of their woodlands by removing lower quality

trees from their property, giving more valuable oak and walnut trees the opportunity to grow strong.



Kansas State University Department of Animal Sciences and Industry graduate students Jared Johnson and Esther McCabe were recognized Tuesday, May 23 as recipients of Larry Corah Outstanding Graduate Student Awards.

Johnson received the Outstanding Ph.D Student Award which includes a

\$1,500 scholarship. He is a graduate research assistant pursuing a doctoral degree in ruminant nutrition. Johnson's research involves developing a sorghum berry processing score for sorghum silage to help the industry address a starch availability issue with unprocessed sorghum berries. He has worked with a commercial laboratory to develop a procedure to evaluate sorghum silages from commercial farms. The

last step in the process will be to determine if the berry scoring procedure will accurately predict starch availability in those samples.

He has served as a teaching assistant (TA) in various courses including dairy cattle management and coaching the Dairy Challenge Team. The team represented K-State at Midwest and national contests placing second at the national contest.

Johnson, originally from

Kerkhoven, Minn., was nominated by his advisor, Michael Brouk. "Jared is the best student that I have had the opportunity to direct," he wrote. "He has done great with academics, time management, research, presentations and teaching. I could not have asked more of him, and he has always done an excellent and professional job at whatever has been asked."

McCabe was awarded the Outstanding Masters Student Award, which includes a \$1,000 scholarship. She is a graduate teaching assistant pursuing a master's degree in animal science. Esther's research efforts include investigating trends over time and factors influencing value of beef calves marketed through video auction.

She has actively pursued and taken opportunities to grow in her teaching skills during her graduate program. She has served as a teaching assistant for Animal Sciences Career Preparations, Farm Animal Reproduction, Bovine Reproductive Technologies, Embryo Techniques, Bovine AI, and Farm Animal Reproduction Laboratory. She is currently a TA for one section of Animal Science & Industry Lab while taking primary responsibility for teaching a separate section of the same class.

McCabe, originally from Elk City, was nominated for the award by her advisor, Karol Fike. "She has also been highly instrumental the past two years in organization for the local Animal Sciences Academic Quadrathlon competition," Fike wrote in her nomination letter. "She has also taken sole responsibility for organization of the beef cattle station of the Midwestern Section Animal Sciences Academic Quadrathlon. Among the graduate students I've worked with over the years, I've found her to be one of the mostly highly organized students who takes significant initiative in regards to her teaching and research roles. She not only gets work done but also does so in a high-quality fashion the first time."

Both the Ph.D and Master's awards are presented in honor of Larry Corah, who served for 25 years as a K-State Animal Science and Industry Department beef Extension and research specialist. After retiring from K-State, he went on to work for the National Cattlemen's Beef Association as director of production systems and then served 17 years as the Certified Angus Beef (CAB) LLC Vice President of Supply. The scholarships are supported from the Larry Corah Graduate Student Enhancement Fund.

The award winners are selected based on scholastic achievement, research activity and success, teaching activities, faculty evaluation, and overall contributions to the mission of the department.

Senator Thune introduces ARC legislation

Sen. John Thune (R-SD) has introduced legislation intended to improve the Agriculture Risk Coverage (ARC) Program. In an attempt to fix the county disparity issue present in ARC, Thune is proposing that all ARC county payments be

calculated using the payment rate for the county in which the land is physically located. Currently, ARC participants with farms in multiple counties may choose to receive the payment rate for the county in which the land is physically located or the

payment rate of the administrative county.

Thune's proposal would also require a mandatory base reallocation determined by planted and considered planted acres on a farm for the years 2014-

2017. Past efforts to force a mandatory base update have been rejected as an assault on the planting flexibility that was first created under the 1996 Farm Bill and maintained ever since.

One-quarter of Kansas wheat in poor, very poor condition

(AP) - The latest government update shows a quarter of the winter wheat crop in Kansas is in poor to very poor condition.

The National Agricultural Statistics Service reported that 30 percent of the state's wheat is rated in fair condition. About 38 percent is in good and 7 percent in excellent condition.

Wheat coloring is at 39 percent.

The agency says that hail in northwestern Kansas has damaged some wheat and recently planted spring crops. The southern half of the state was mostly dry last week while areas in the north got up to two inches of rain.

About 82 percent of the state's corn crop has now been planted statewide. Soybean planting is at the 41 percent mark. Sorghum seeding is 11 percent complete.



Are your grow/finish barns summer ready?

Whoever coined the phrase "the lazy days of summer" clearly wasn't a pig farmer. Hot, humid summer weather demands extra vigilance to keep pigs comfortable. It can be particularly challenging to support optimal performance in finishing barns when pigs are approaching market weight.

Pigs nearing market weight are pushing stocking densities and generating maximum body heat. "When your finishing pigs reach market weight during the heat of summer, they could have a greater risk for heat stress and reduced performance than during other seasons," says Dan McManus, DVM, Purina Animal Nutrition swine specialist. "You can help minimize the risk with a few changes to your finishing barn routine during summer months."

Understand your ventilation system

"A common mistake I see in wean-to-finish operations is a lack of understanding of the ventilation system and how it works," McManus said. "You're not saving time or helping your bottom line if you skip reading the

manual and try to learn as you go."

The goal of pig barn ventilation is to move as much air as possible without creating a draft or causing stress to the pigs. The set points you choose to start your ventilation should be based on managing air quality, including humidity.

Lower your set point to 62 degrees F by the time a group reaches 100 pounds. Remember, the set point is not the temperature you want in your barn. It's the temperature at which you want your controller to operate.

The optimal temperature for pigs entering the nursery in summer is 82 degrees F. By the time those pigs reach 70 days post-weaning, the optimal temperature is 64 degrees F.

Ideal humidity in a wean-to-finish facility is between 60 and 70 percent.

If your controller stage differential is usually set at 2 degrees F, set it to 1.5 degrees F in the summer. This will help combat the added summertime heat.

Adjust your sprinklers
Research has shown on/off

sprinklers can support better grow/finish pig performance than continuous foggers. This is because the drying phase of evaporative cooling is what cools your pigs - not the wetting action.

Have your sprinklers set to come on at 18-20 degrees above your set point once the barn reaches an average of about 100 pounds of body weight.

Set your "on" time for two minutes, which should be enough time to wet down 60 percent of the pen. Set your "off" time at 20 minutes in summer, and turn it down to 15 minutes on the warmest days.

It's easier to see water on the barn floor than on the pigs themselves, but the drying time is the same. Watch your slats, and you

will know when your pigs are dry.

Minimize feed outages

Outages are common in summer because increased humidity can cause feed to bridge in bins and feeders. A good practice is to check your barns twice per day to minimize the chance of a 24-hour feed outage.

In your twice-daily walk-through, check feeders and augers for bridging, and confirm you have 50 percent pan coverage for optimal intake.

In the heat of summer, pigs are more likely to eat at night. If you check your feeders a second time in the evening, you increase the likelihood your pigs will have feed overnight when they're hungry.

Check your waterers, too. Pigs will drink one gal-

lon of water per 100 pounds of bodyweight per day when they are comfortable. In hot weather, that can increase by as much as 50 to 70 percent per day.

Modifying your management protocol in summer may help your pigs perform

to their genetic potential, even in the heat. Taking extra care to understand and use ventilation systems correctly, using on/off sprinklers and minimizing feed outages can help maintain an optimal environment in your grow/finish barn.

Interns to assist with written biosecurity plans

The KDA animal health and dairy programs have hired student interns to

assist producers seeking to complete biosecurity plans. Interns will complete most of the work off-site, but they will need to spend at least one day on the premises, gathering information. Biosecurity is important in the event of an Foreign Animal Disease outbreak, and the Kansas Department of Animal Health hopes to assist producers become more biosecure. Largest Chinese animal vaccine company to add labs, offices in Manhattan

The largest animal vaccine company in China announced May 31 that it will open a research lab and offices in the Kansas State University Office Park, which is on the north side of the Manhattan campus.

Officials for Jinyu Bio-technology Co. Ltd. said that this is the first time that the company has established facilities in the United States. The company will focus on the research and design of vaccines for swine and cattle, as well as developing educational materials for Chinese companies and veterinarians.

"When university-focused companies like Jinyu Bio-technology locate adjacent to K-State's campus, partnerships develop with faculty expertise and research to promote real-world application and discovery," said Greg Willems, Kansas State University Foundation president and chief executive officer. "The K-State Office Park advances opportunity for these current and future collaborations to boldly move K-State and the needs of a global community forward."

Jinyu plans to employ

four to six scientists. The company has researched the Manhattan location for nearly two years and was drawn to its connection with the Kansas City Animal Health Corridor, which stretches from Manhattan to Columbia, Missouri. It is home to more than 300 animal health companies, which account for more than half of the sales generated annually by the global animal health industry.

"The Kansas City Animal Health Corridor's international reputation is a strategic advantage for more and more animal health companies," said Kimberly Young, corridor president. "We are thrilled to welcome Jinyu to our corridor community and look forward to the company's leadership and effort."

Chongyu Zhang, Jinyu chairman, said the company's decision was based on a belief that Manhattan and Kansas State University are in the forefront of animal health research that is relevant to Chinese animal agriculture and the world.

"Manhattan is the home to many world renowned scientists in the Kansas State University College of

Veterinary Medicine, Bioscience Research Institute and the future National Bio and Agro-defense Facility," Zhang said.

He added that Jinyu is growing quickly internationally and is looking forward to developing long-term, mutually beneficial relationships with partners in the region. The company may add manufacturing facilities in the future.

"The addition of Jinyu Bio-technology to the Kansas City Animal Health Corridor is truly a partnership of innovation and expertise," said Antonio Soave, secretary of the Kansas Department of Commerce. "We, as a state, must continue to engage excellent biotech companies like Jinyu, as Kansas continues to become one of the leading locations for bioscience in the nation."

Many organizations played a key role in attracting Jinyu to the region, including the state of Kansas and the Kansas Department of Commerce; city of Manhattan and Manhattan Area Chamber of Commerce; Kansas State University, Kansas State University Institute for Commercial-

ization, KSU Foundation, College of Veterinary Medicine and the university's U.S.-China Center for Animal Health; the Kansas City Area Development Council; and the Kansas City Animal Health Corridor.

"Jinyu has state-of-the-art pilot production and manufacturing facilities, strong financial support for research and development, and great market penetration in China," said Jishu Shi, director of the U.S.-China Center for Animal Health. "This partnership is the first for K-State with a Chinese animal health company. It will accelerate the commercialization of novel discovery and development ideas generated by K-State scientists."

Tammy Beckham, dean of the College of Veterinary Medicine, said the agreement supports the university's interest in research and development of biopharmaceuticals.

"In addition, Jinyu's expansion to Manhattan will help support economic development through the addition of jobs and partnerships," she said. "I am absolutely thrilled to welcome Jinyu to the state of Kansas

and look forward to a long and robust partnership."

Peter Dorhout, Kansas State University's vice president for research, said the university's strength in animal health research helps attract large companies to the region and contributes to the economic impact in Riley, Geary and Pottawatomie counties, which amounted to \$882 million in fiscal year 2015.

"Partnerships in animal health in particular help university and industry researchers inhabit the cutting edge," Dorhout said. "Protecting animal health requires adapting to changing global circumstances, and we want to ensure that our researchers and students are prepared to contribute and to help industry address urgent needs."

Dorhout added that the partnership further advances the university's goal to become a Top 50 public research university by 2025.

"K-State's 2025 strategic plan encourages us not only to create a culture of excellence that results in increased research activities, but also to fully engage with people and build necessary infrastructure," he said. "We are working to ensure that K-State innovations are applied to improve global food security, bio-agro defense, animal and human health, and more."

"Engagement is part of our land-grant heritage, so

our attention to this area isn't new, but 2025 infused new energy into these efforts," Dorhout said. "Industry partnerships also enhance the opportunities we can offer to our students through involving undergraduate and graduate students in individual research projects as well as internships and full-time employment opportunities."

Lyle Butler, president of the Manhattan Area Chamber of Commerce, hailed Jinyu's announcement as another success story for the city of Manhattan and the Kansas City Animal Health Corridor.

"Our partnerships with the university family, the state of Kansas and the Kansas City Animal Health Corridor were critical in attracting Jinyu to the state," Butler said. "Jinyu's decision to locate in Manhattan is yet another example of the successes that can come from our shared university/community economic development strategy to attract high-pay, knowledge-based jobs and grow the regional economy through the leverage of Kansas State University's research and talent."

Jinyu's Manhattan operations will be located in Phase II of the Kansas State University Office Park, which is scheduled to break ground in July. The company will begin operations in 2018.
