

KDA announces State Drought Assistance Initiative

The Division of Conservation at the Kansas Department of Agriculture is pleased to announce the availability of funds to assist landowners with their efforts to mitigate

the impact of drought. The Livestock Water Supply Financial Assistance Initiative will provide financial assistance for livestock water supply wells, pipeline and tanks installed

after June 1, 2018, and before the announcement of the Environmental Quality Incentives Program (EQIP) Drought Initiative by NRCS on July 24, 2018.

The State Conservation

Commission took action on July 31, 2018, to approve the initiative for these qualifying drought mitigation efforts that took place prior to the NRCS EQIP Drought Initiative. Eligible areas

will be the same as for the federal initiative.

Kansas, Colorado reach agreement on Republican River water usage

On Friday the governors and attorneys general of Kansas and Colorado announced that they have reached a settlement of claims regarding Colorado's past use of water under the Republican River Compact. The Compact allocates the waters of the basins between the states of Colorado, Nebraska and Kansas.

"This settlement is an investment in the basin to ensure a better future for Kansas water users," said Kansas governor Jeff Colyer. "Kansas and Colorado are committed to continuing to make the Compact work for the ben-

efit of the citizens of our states, and this settlement recognizes the ties that bind our states together and is an important step for the economic development of the region."

Kansas Attorney General Derek Schmidt also expressed his approval. "The Kansas water team at the Department of Agriculture and our legal team at the Attorney General's office have done an outstanding job of resolving years of past disputes without litigation," Schmidt said. "This settlement going forward promises a more cooperative approach to what

really matters — the best possible management of the water resources in the basin's South Fork on both sides of the state line."

Colorado governor John Hickenlooper agreed that "This settlement provides funds that could be used in the Republican River Basin within Kansas and Colorado and creates additional opportunities for cooperative water management between the states."

Colorado attorney general Cynthia H. Coffman also expressed her approval, saying the agreement "avoids the costs and uncertainty of litigation and furthers the principles of the Compact, including removing controversy and fostering interstate cooperation."

The agreement resolves the existing controversies between the two states regarding Col-

orado's past use of water under the Republican River Compact and allows them to continue to work collaboratively through

the compact as part of an overall ongoing effort which also involves the state of Nebraska.

The settlement was

signed by the governors and attorneys general of both states. A copy of the settlement is available at agriculture.ks.gov/RRCA.

Kansas Hay Market Report

Hay market trade activity is light to moderate. Prices mostly steady with undertones of strength. Demand remains very good for all hay types. Third cutting of alfalfa is well under way or near completion and the grass hay baling is all but over. Fields of corn in eastern Kansas are being chopped due to the drought, keeping the silage crews busy. Spotty rain continued last week for the western half of the state, but neglected most of the eastern half. According to the U.S. Drought Monitor, drought has worsened, especially where precipitation deficits have grown. Year-to-date precipitation percentages are 25 to 50 percent below normal across

parts of east central Kansas. The abnormally dry (D0) category is at 18.5 pct, moderate drought (D1) is at 27 pct, severe drought (D2) is at 18.5 pct, and extreme drought (D3) is at 7 pct and exceptional drought (D4) is at 1 pct. Farmers team with Kansas Water Office and K-State to present Water Technology Field Days

Technology keeps evolving to help crop producers make every drop of water count on the fields. To demonstrate the latest in crop irrigation technology, farmers in numerous counties are teaming with the Kansas Water Office and Kansas State University to present Water Technology Field Days in several locations in August.

"I'm pleased to see the growing interest in Water Technology Farms across the state," said Kansas Water Office director Tracy Streeter. "We continue to see outcomes from these farms suggesting that water use reductions, coupled with irrigation technology adoption and water management improvements, are leading to positive effects on the aquifer as well as the producer's bottom line."

The field days are designed for producers to see how the newest research and technology is being applied in real-life settings in different areas of the state. Three more Water Technology Farm projects were implemented in 2018 with a total of ten Water Technology Farm projects, on more than 35 fields overlying the High Plains Aquifer.

* Aug. 30 - Scott County - Circle C Farms - 10 a.m.

For the second year Northwest Kansas Technical College is also participating by providing learning and workforce development training for its students. Northwest Kansas Technical College's Precision Agriculture department and landowners in

the surrounding counties have partnered to develop ten Water Technology Farm projects. In these projects, the students and landowners receive in-field training and hands-on experience implementing water efficiency technologies. With supplier partnerships, students will be exposed to multiple types of soil moisture probes, pivot controls, irrigation scheduling systems and other water management tools.

KWO provides financial assistance to Kansas State University's efforts to give technical support to each technology farm. K-State is deeply involved in establishing and monitoring the farms to help answer the producers' specific questions and concerns about the new technology.

"K-State is working with partners to help address questions and concerns about the new irrigation technologies so in the future, farmers will fully embrace the technology appropriate for their

operation and situation," said Jonathan Aguilar, water resource engineer with K-State Research and Extension, based in Garden City. "Each farm is set up slightly different, depending on the primary concern the producer has. For example, one farm has three adjacent spans with different modes of application for comparison purposes. In most fields, soil moisture sensors are installed and tested for accuracy as feedback or for its performance in the different soil types."

Remington Ranch to host KLA/K-State Ranch Field Day in Gove County

Tyler and Kassie Remington will host the August 13 Kansas Livestock Association (KLA)/Kansas State University Ranch Management Field Day at their ranch near Quinter. The Remingtons own and operate a diversified farming and cow-calf enterprise. They grow wheat, corn and forage for their cowherd on irrigated and dryland acreage. Cover crops and annual forages are used for grazing and harvested for silage.

Utilizing cover crops and annual forages to boost grazing opportunities will highlight the

field day program. K-State Agronomist John Holman and a panel of western Kansas producers, including Tyler Remington, Larry Manhart of Quinter and Charlie Kraus from Hays, will share their experiences with incorporating these forages into their grazing programs. Holman has conducted ten years of research on the viability and advisability of planting annual cover crops or forages in conjunction with conventional dryland cropping systems in western Kansas. He will discuss his findings during the presentation.

Also on the field day program will be Jami Seirer, northwest district forester with the Kansas Forest Service in Hays. Seirer will explain the process of renovating old and/or environmentally stressed windbreaks, planning and establishing new windbreaks and plant selection. She also will provide tips on managing wind and snow distribution. Options for financial assistance through federal and state cost-share programs will be discussed, including the Conservation Stewardship Program and Environmental Quality Incen-

tives Program, which the Remingtons utilized to establish and renovate several windbreaks at their ranch headquarters.

Agra View's Amy Roeder and Steve Vollrath will share timely information about programs provided to livestock producers through the USDA Risk Management Agency. Insurance plans to be discussed will include the Livestock Risk Protection Program, Livestock Gross Margin Program and Rainfall Index Program, which protects against the loss of precipitation in key months of pasture, range-

land and forage growth.

KLA Chief Executive Officer Matt Teagarden will provide an overview of the new cattle traceability pilot project. KLA, K-State and the Kansas Department of Agriculture launched CattleTrace June 30. The project will involve an end-to-end disease traceability system beginning with cow-calf producers and ending at the beef processing plant. The goal is to develop a system that can operate at the speed of commerce.

Inaugural auctioneering contest held at National Junior Angus Show

The first Auctioneering Contest is a huge hit with competitors and viewers alike.

The art of the auction, the practice of selling with live bids, with an auctioneer that stimulates the crowd into a frenzy of bidding and buying, has arrived at the National Junior Angus Show (NJAS). This year, the first-ever Auctioneering Contest was held to encourage juniors toward a new profession and a new appreciation for the art of selling to the highest bidder.

The Auctioneering Contest was divided into three different levels of competition, Junior Division (ages 8-13), Intermediate Division (ages 14-17) and Senior Division (ages 18-21). These different brackets had different items to be auctioned off to the planted members of the audience who were ready to bid. The junior division sold two lots, intermediate sold three and the senior division sold five. These different lots can range from bred heifers, semen packages, video sale lots and other varieties. The juniors participating were given two weeks to prepare, conducting any research they felt

would be necessary to coax a bid out of a buyer.

A winner was announced in each category; in the Junior Division, Connor Cook stole the show. The Intermediate Division had Weston Svoboda collecting the win, and in the Senior Division, Cale Hinrichsen was announced the champion auctioneer. The American Angus Association® events and education department is considering inserting an Auctioneering Contest Overall Auctioneer winner for the upcoming year.

Brian Curless, Dan Naughton and Paul Handsaker were honored as well as excited to be the judges of the very first NJAS Auctioneering Contest. All of them have a background in Angus cattle and auctioneering. Curless, currently the reigning 2017 World Livestock Auctioneering Champion, also raises Angus cattle; Naughton, an auctioneer who also raises Angus cattle and hogs in central Illinois; and Handsaker, a 30-year veteran Angus cattle producer and auctioneer.

"The quality of the kids was fantastic; every one of those kids was sharp as a tack and just absolutely attacked the contest," Curless said. "I was extremely impressed. I hope there are other kids out there who will see what went on here today, and they are just as excited. Hopefully, we will get twice as many kids in it next year."

Handsaker commented about the importance of these contests because it encourages juniors who do not have cattle, to continue to participate at the show.

"A lot of these contests you can come, enjoy, make great friendships and not have to have cattle to participate," Handsaker said. "This is what makes contests like these so special because having cattle to show is not a prerequisite to taking advantage of the opportunities allowed to these juniors."

This contest is making an impact, even in its infancy, in the youth of the Angus breed and cattle industry as a whole.

"The auction business is as popular today around the world as it has ever been, and there is nothing that will help our auction business any more than getting youth involved in it," Curless said.

Even at the 50th anniversary of the NJAS, the NJAA board and NJAA members are looking for ways to improve the juniors' experience and benefits they gain from these different contests. On this golden anniversary, the Auctioneering Contest has left its mark, and will continue throughout the upcoming years, on the legacy of the NJAS.

LaCygne ranch site of KLA/K-State Field Day

Options for controlling invasive trees and plants on grazing lands will highlight the educational program at the August 16 Kansas Livestock Association (KLA)/Kansas State University Ranch Management Field Day in Linn County. Loma Land & Cattle, located near LaCygne and owned by the Robert Thayer family, will host the event. The third-generation ranch includes a cow-calf operation and backgrounding business.

The Thayers, like many other eastern Kanas producers, maintain their cowherd on fescue and native grass pastures year-round, making management of invasive plant species extremely important. A panel will discuss what makes controlling these plants a challenge and provide options to lessen the burden. Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS) rangeland management specialist Dane Varney will give tips on the best way to control invasive trees and explain NRCS cost-share programs available to producers. K-State range management specialist Walt Fick, who has conducted extensive research on herbicides for controlling invasive plants in grasslands, including sericea lespedeza and old world bluestem, will discuss his findings. Rancher Greg Christiansen from Parker will round out the panel by sharing his experiences with the intensive grazing of goats as an economical means for controlling unwanted plants in fescue and native grass.

Recent media coverage of developing technology to produce lab-grown meat has raised concern in the beef industry about the future of "fake meat."

National Cattlemen's Beef

Association Director of Government Affairs Danielle Beck will talk about the politics of this issue and the battle over which federal agency should regulate fake meat products.

Agra View's Amy Roeder and Steve Vollrath will share timely information about programs available to livestock producers through the USDA Risk Management Agency. Options discussed will include the Livestock Risk Protection Program, Livestock Gross Margin Program and Rainfall Index Program, which protects against the loss of precipitation in key months of pasture, rangeland and forage growth.

KLA chief executive officer Matt Teagarden will provide an overview of the state's new cattle traceability pilot project. KLA, K-State and the Kansas Department of Agriculture launched CattleTrace June 30. The project will involve an end-to-end disease traceability system beginning with cow-calf producers and ending at the beef processing plant. The goal is to develop a system that can operate at the speed of commerce.

In addition, K-State Extension livestock specialist Jaymelynn Farney will be on hand to discuss options for cover crops and summer annuals for livestock forage. She will display numerous samples of cover crops used by Kansas ranchers to provide feed for their cattle on an annual basis.

The August 16 field day will begin with registration at 3:00 p.m. and conclude with a free beef dinner at 6:45 p.m. All livestock producers and others involved in the business are invited to attend.

Loma Land & Cattle is

located south of LaCygne in northeastern Linn County. From Highway 7, go east on Highway 152 6 1/2 miles to 1095 Road (Highway 152 will jog one mile to the north). Go South 3 1/2 miles on 1095 Road to 1850 Road. Turn east on 1850 Road and travel 1 1/2 miles to Quarterman Road. If traveling from Highway 69, go west through LaCygne on Highway 152 6.3 miles to 1095 Road, then follow the directions listed above. Directional signs will be

posted.

Russell and C.J. Blew will host the August 6 KLA/K-State ranch field day near Medicine Lodge. Remington Ranch at Quinter will be the site for the August 13 field day.
