

Schwieterman Market Outlook

A marketing commentary by Bret Crotts

The US Dollar Index fell to fresh multi-year lows this week, which seemed to put some life into the grain markets. The March corn traded above \$3.55 for the first time since early December and the market is headed for the next resistance level, which comes at the December high of $\$3.60 \ \frac{1}{2}$. The March KW made a complete recovery of the post report losses and traded at the highest level since mid-November. The next objective for that contract is the \$4.50 area.

The soybeans were a bit more volatile than the corn and wheat and ended up finishing the week in the middle of a 25 cent trading range. The market traded above \$10.00 briefly, but ran into a great deal of selling pressure. Traders are still concerned about the weather in S. America, which is why the beans were able to make the run up from \$9.50. The weather pattern is still less than ideal so after this corrective break the March beans should have a great shot at moving up to the \$10.30 level.

American The S. weather is also having an impact on the corn as well. Condition ratings in Argentina are very bothersome and may result in better exports for the US. At this point in the year, the only thing that can really help the corn market is better demand, so hopefully the combination of the weak Dollar and less competition from Argentina will shave some of the bushels off of our ending stocks.

As for the wheat, we need to see better demand over there as well. Export sales in the last report were much better than the prior two weeks, but far from good enough to get speculators excited. We have to sell at least 14 million bushels per week to meet the USDA estimate, but we need to sell over 20 million a week to put a noticeable dent in the ending stocks.

weak Dollar should help with that and the Drought Monitor continues to look worse nearly every week. Not only is the HRW Belt being impacted, but a large portion of the Spring Wheat country is abnormally dry and much of the SRW Belt is dry as well. It is a long time until harvest, so for the most part no one is too bothered by the dry weather, but it will be interesting to see how traders react if the Drought Monitor contin-

The central and southern Plains, including much of Texas, Oklahoma and Kansas have a higher than usual potential of wildland fire through April, according to Kansas State University scientists and a government organization that assesses such risks.

In its latest report, the National Interagency Coordination Center shows an elevated risk because of dry conditions in several states. The center is comprised of representatives from the Bureau of Land Management, Bureau of Indian Affairs, National Park Service, Forest Service, U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service, Federal Emergency Management Administration, and the National Association of

fire managers in making decisions that will improve protection of life, property and natural resources. increase firefighter safety and effectiveness, and reduce firefighting costs.

For the months of February through April in Kansas, the outlook highlights all but the northeast part of the state as having above-normal significant large fire potential that would require the mobilization of resources beyond the typical local response.

"Some parts of Kansas, especially the south central and southwest areas, saw above-normal moisture during the growing season, with many reports of large to significant fuel loads as a result," said Chip Redmond, meteorologist with the K-State Mesonet and an incident meteorologist. "Areas west of U.S. 81 have seen considerable drying the previous months with many locations exceeding 90 rain. This, combined with persistent dry air masses, sunny skies, and breezy winds, are rapidly depleting any remnant moisture."

While that's not unusual for this time of year, he said, any deficit developed will be difficult to overcome without a period of above-normal moisture between now and March.

"With recent forecasts of mid-to-long range dryness continuing, we are setting the stage for some large fires in Kansas with heavy fuel loading and flash-type drought," Redmond said.

Precipitation received during the crop growing season, April to September, is a determining factor for the upcoming fire season. In 2015 and 2016, above-normal precipitation was received which encouraged plant growth which then contributed to large fires the following winters. Despite a margin-

ally drier period in 2017, the timing of above-normal moisture received in April and May was critical for supplying ample grass and fuel growth.

"This increased fuel load (plant growth) is a large concern for the next few months which are tvpically the driest period of the year for Kansas. With any strong system, the potential exists for large fires similar to what we have seen the last two years,' said Jason Hartman, the statewide Fire Protection Specialist with the Kansas

Forest Service.

Much of Kansas began to dry out this past September. Areas of western Kansas haven't received 0.1 inch of rain in more than 90 days. Above-normal temperatures in November and early December combined with gusty winds dried the soil surface. As a result, drought conditions are expanding across much of Kansas. According to the Drought Monitor at www.droughtmonitor.unl.edu, the condition of the entire state ranges from abnormally dry to severe drought.

Long-term forecasts suggest the dry period will continue through January, especially in western Kansas. Conditions may be aided somewhat by slightly below normal temperatures the rest of the month.

Beyond January, trends are more difficult to discern, said assistant climatologist, Mary Knapp. The February through March period is typically very dry in Kansas, averaging only 3.1 inches of total precipitation statewide. Any precipitation that does occur will only have short-term impacts on the dried out fuels until the arrival of spring rains.

"The biggest concern during the next few months," said Knapp, "will be the occurrence of very warm days. These are typically associated with very dry air and high winds in advance of a strong storm system. Kansas' largest wildfires are usually dependent on the shifting winds and the lack of moisture associated with these systems. Normally, Kansas will see several of these systems before one can eventually tap into the Gulf moisture and provide

much-needed rainfall." Finally, the influence of precipitation type on wildland fires is important, she said. Snowfall can knock down or flatten standing grasses, which removes the vertical fuel load and can significantly decrease fire behavior. Despite some recent snows, a lack of heavy snowfall through January will continue to make grasses available and lead to suppression difficulties until a significant snowfall occurs.

Kansas Hay Market Report

Hay market activity moderate; demand moderate to Hay market activity moderate; demand moderate to good for all classes; Offerings were light to moderate and prices steady for all classes. Hay usage slowed slightly as we came out of the deep freeze. USDA released the 2017 Production Summary, where most notably Kansas alfalfa hay production totaled 2.05 million tons, down 32 pct from 2016. Area harvested for dry hay was 570,000 acres, down 19 pct, and average yield was 3.60 tons per

acre, down .70 tons per acre from 2016. Even though a good portion of the state saw some precipitation the past week, the U.S. Drought Monitor reports that dryness in southern Kansas and eastern Colorado continued to expand to the west, incorporating all of southwestern Kansas and extreme southeastern Colorado. Extreme drought conditions were also pushed more to the west in southern Kansas. The abnormally dry (D0) category is at 100 pct, moderate drought (D1) is at 52 pct, severe drought (D2) is at 19 pct and extreme drought (D3) is at 4 pct. 





Immunization is probably the most important part of having a healthy beef cattle herd. However it is important to use vaccines as they are intended and when they should be given. Calves should get their first round of shots at branding time or at two to three months of age. Another round of shots should also be given three to four weeks prior to weaning.

Remember a calf's health is additive, as you use a vaccination protocol you are improving the calf's health and adding value. Vaccines are not a magic potion in a bottle; we must handle cattle in a low stress method, handle the vaccines correctly. and reduce stressors like weaning, transportation, commingling, and weather changes near vaccination time to increase our suc-

Hard-working farm families across the country accessed nearly \$6 billion in new credit, either directly or guaranteed through commercial lenders in 2017. At year end, FSA was assisting more than 120,000 family farmers with loans totaling just

"FSA loan funds have been in high demand the last few years," said Dr. Robert Johansson, acting deputy under secretary for the Farm Production and Conservation mission area. "We provide opportunities to qualified small, beginning and underserved farmers who are unable to obtain commercial credit, to help them get started, gain access to land and grow their operations. Family farmers across America also come to us for credit when they face challenges to stay in business. We're proud to support rural prosperity by providing credit to those who need it most."

FSA provides a variety of loan assistance, including direct and guaranteed farm ownership loans, operating loans and even direct Microloans up to \$50,000 and EZ Guarantees up to \$100,000 with streamlined application

More than 25,000 direct and guaranteed FSA loans went to beginning or underserved farmers and ranchers. Over 4,200 beginning farmers received direct farm ownership loans from FSA to make their first land purchase. And of the approximately 6,500 Microloans made in the last fiscal year, three-quarters (almost 4,900) went to beginning farmers, 1.000 went to women and 400 to

FSA's direct farm loans are unique in that the agency provides technical assistance in addition to credit. Consistent with efforts to continually improve technical assistance, FSA announced the publication of two booklets that will serve as important informational tools and resources for existing and prospective farm loan
