# USDA and FDA announce formal agreement to regulate cell-cultured food products from cell lines of livestock and poultry

The U.S. Department of Agriculture's (USDA) Food Safety and Inspection Service (FSIS) and the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services' (HHS) Food and Drug Administration (FDA) have announced a formal agreement to jointly oversee the production of human food products derived from the cells of livestock and poultry.

FSIS and FDA released a formal agreement to address the regulatory oversight of human food produced using this new technology. The formal agreement describes the oversight roles and responsibilities for both agencies and how the agencies will collaborate to regulate the development and entry of these

products into commerce. This shared regulatory approach will ensure that cell-cultured products derived from the cell lines of livestock and poultry are produced safely and are accurately labeled.

"Consumers trust the USDA mark of inspection to ensure safe, wholesome and accurately labeled products," said USDA deputy under secretary for Food Safety Mindy Brashears. "We look forward to continued collaboration with FDA and our stakeholders to safely regulate these new products and ensure parity in labeling."

"We recognize that our stakeholders want clarity

on how we will move forward with a regulatory regime to ensure the safety and proper labeling of these cell-cultured human food products while continuing to encourage innovation," said Frank Yiannas, FDA deputy commissioner for Food Policy and Response. "Collaboration between USDA and FDA will allow us to draw upon the unique expertise of each agency in addressing the many important technical and regulatory considerations that can arise with the development of animal cell-cultured food products for human consumption."


Under the formal agreement, the agencies

agree upon a joint regulatory framework wherein FDA oversees cell collection, cell banks, and cell growth and differentiation. A transition from FDA to FSIS oversight will occur during the cell harvest stage. FSIS will over-

see the production and labeling of human food products derived from the cells of livestock and poultry.

On Oct. 23-24, 2018, FSIS and FDA held a joint public meeting to discuss the use of cell culture technology

to develop products derived from livestock and poultry. The public meeting focused on the potential hazards, oversight considerations, and labeling of cell cultured food products derived from livestock and poultry.

# Big jump seen in beef export and forward sales

While parts of the Midwest continue to be hit with snow, affecting both cattle and hog slaughter, retailers know that warm weather is just around the corner. The seasonal shift brings merchandising opportunities, and one of the key goals is to build on the revenue targets from the year prior. That goal be-

comes much more difficult to achieve if you don't sell the same amount of beef, which has a much higher price point than alternatives. The total supply of cattle on feed as of Jan. 1 was 1.7% higher than the previous year but the supply of +150 day cattle at the start of the year was estimated to be 31% high-

er than the previous year. Lower placements during Sep-Dec (down 380,000 head) should help ease this front end supply going into the spring months. What is always a big wild

card, and the reason why we mentioned the seasonal shift in demand, is how aggressive retailers and foodservice operators will be in trying to sell beef this year. Some initial data
