Letter to the Editor

Growing up in a northeast Kansas town, I never thought much about health care. We had two doctors in town, and hospitals that were 15-25 miles away. Of course, that was years ago, and many things have changed in Kansas, including changes in the medical care field. I'm retired now. but as a working RN, I continued to upgrade my skills and education. Even now, I am observing how the medical field is constantly improving in the ways that they provide care using new techniques, technologies, and staff education and training.

Change can be difficult for most people. It seems that there are those who don't want to acknowledge that lots of medical delivery methods have changed and will continue to change; that there are still systems in place that are no longer needed to provide the services they once did; and are not self-sustaining. But I also see that there are many Kansans who believe that it's time to start talking about potential solutions to these changes, including rural super health telemedicine, clinics, nurse practitioners practicing independently, and using Federally Qualified Health Centers to provide

primary care. HB 2066 is a bill that is waiting to be voted on in the Kansas legislature. The purpose of this bill is to update certain requirements relating to Ad-

vanced Registered Nurse Practitioners. When this bill is passed, these nurses will be authorized to practice independently without the direct overseeing of a physician. Nurse Practitioners are highly skilled, experienced, and educated in the Nursing profession. When the bill is passed, they can provide care and work independently in communities without a doctor, or if it's difficult to get to one. Some may even visit you in your home. You might consider sponsoring an interested person in your community. to train to become a nurse practitioner for your community. This would be ben-

eficial for everyone. Each Kansas District Representative has one vote. You would be able to widen your access to medical care providers, by letting your District Rep know that you want him/ her to vote to approve this bill. If you need to find out who your representative is, please visit the website www.OpenStates.org. This website will request your address in order to be able to provide the information

you're requesting. When contacting your representative, please let them know your name, address, and phone number. This is so they'll know that they are representing you in their district when they cast their vote in favor of

USDA mark of inspection to ensure safe, wholesome and accurately labeled products," said USDA deputy under secretary for Food Safety Mindy Brashears. "We look forward to continued collaboration with FDA and our stakeholders to safely regulate these new products and ensure parity in labeling."

"We recognize that our stakeholders want clari-

forward with a regulatory regime to ensure the safety and proper labeling of these cell-cultured human food products while continuing to encourage innovation," said Frank Yiannas, FDA deputy commissioner for Food Policy and Response. "Collaboration between USDA and FDA will allow us to draw upon the unique expertise of each agency in addressing the many important technical and regulatory considerations that can arise with the development of animal cell-cultured food products for human consumption."

# Are killed vaccines a good fit for your beef operation?

You can't always know the pregnancy status of every animal or have the time to separate pregnant cows from the herd. But with killed vaccines, you can usually vaccinate any animal - regardless of age or production stage — with confidence. Killed vs. modified-live-

#### virus vaccines Vaccines generally fall

into two categories: modified-live virus (MLV) and killed virus. Both types of vaccines contain a form of the viruses that help "prime" the immune system, so the next time the animal comes in contact with those organisms, it will recognize them and mount an immune response.

MLV vaccines contain live viruses that have been attenuated, or weakened, so they usually can't cause disease in the animal. However, in rare cases, an animal might develop disease. Some MLV vaccines, if administered to pregnant cows, can lead to abortion.

Killed vaccines, on the other hand, contain viruses that have been killed. or chemically inactivated. While they cannot cause disease or abortion in an animal, they do require adjuvants or special vaccine additives that help enhance the immune response. Any age, any stage

The biggest advantage of using a killed vaccine is it can generally be administered to animals of any age at any stage of production — even pregnant and immuno-compromised animals.

"If you purchased a cow, and you're not sure if she's pregnant or not, or you don't know her vaccine history, killed vaccines are very safe," asserted Peggy Thompson, DVM, Boehringer Ingelheim.

"They're also a good choice when you're not sure which vaccines your own cattle have had in the past," she added. With killed vaccines, you have the flexibility to vaccinate an entire herd without

separating out the pregnant animals. **Boosting calf immunity** 

Vaccinating a pregnant cow also helps to protect her future calf and to make antibodies to pass onto the calf. "When we vaccinate a pregnant cow, we're really trying to enhance the colostrum that she's going to make for that calf," said Dr. Thompson. Fitting killed vaccines into

# your protocol

It's important to work with your veterinarian to develop the best vaccine protocol tailored to your operation. At the same time, it's essential to read and follow label directions. "Three to four weeks after killed vaccines are first administered to an animal, a booster vaccine is usually required," noted Thompson. "That booster is necessary if producers want optimum immune protection for their ani-

#### Choosing the right killed vaccine

mals."

"Producers should look for a vaccine that's easy to use," Thompson advised. "Vaccines that can be administered subcutaneously in low doses in the neck can help support Beef Quality Assurance standards." Good vaccines also have research and data to support their efficacy.

"In the industry today, there's been a lot more interest in killed vaccines as they relate to animal safety," Dr. Thompson concluded. "We're learning they have more of a place in operations than what we may have thought in the past."

year prior. That goal be-

comes much more difficult to achieve if you don't sell the same amount of beef, which has a much higher price point than alternatives. The total supply of cattle on feed as of Jan. 1 was 1.7% higher than the previous year but the supply of +150 day cattle at the start of the year was estimated to be 31% high-

er than the previous year. Lower placements during Sep-Dec (down 380,000 head) should help ease this front end supply going into the spring months. What is always a big wild card, and the reason why we mentioned the seasonal shift in demand, is how aggressive retailers and foodservice operators will be in trying to sell beef this year. Some initial data







# **USDA** strengthens partnerships and protections to keep African swine fever out of the country

Department of Agriculture (USDA) recently announced additional steps to keep African swine fever (ASF) from entering the United States, even as the disease spreads internationally. These steps strengthen the protections announced last fall after the deadly swine disease reached China. The goal remains to protect our nation's swine industry from this disease. ASF does not affect people, nor is it a food safety issue.

In coordination with the pork industry, USDA's Undersecretary for Marketing and Regulatory Programs, Greg Ibach, has stated the following enhanced activities to intensify multi-agency efforts toward the prevention of ASF's entry into the United States: Work with Customs and

Border Patrol (CBP) to





These cover different aspects - from trade implications to policy discussions to the boots-on-the-ground realities of a response. These will help everyone involved ensure their response plans are ready and identify any preparedness gaps that must be ad-

dressed. ASF is a highly contagious and deadly viral disease affecting both domestic and feral (wild) pigs in all age groups. It is spread by contact with the body fluids of infected animals. The ability to use a prescribed burn as part of our forage management is dictated to a large degree by weather. Do we have enough wind to carry a fire, but not so much that its dangerous? Has grass started greening up yet so that it's ready to burn? What about moisture levels? This year, our moisture levels – and the continued presence of snow may hinder our ability to carry a fire the way we'd like to.

In all likelihood, everything will 'break loose' at one time. The snow will melt. Temperatures will rise. Grass will start to grow – and we'll all want to be burning at the same time. For that burn to be safe and successful,

pared.

The key to keeping a prescribed burn from becoming a wildfire comes in that preparation. That means that right now you should be thinking about what equipment you'll need and preparing the site for a burn that may occur in as little as a few weeks from now on our cool season pastures. Make sure all pumps, hoses, and tanks on firefighting equipment are in good working order. Is your pump properly sized for the flow needed for putting out a fire? Some ATV sprayers may not be. Do pump engines work correctly? Are hoses in good working order? A prescribed burn needs to occur in our very short window of opportunity. Safety should not be com-

essential when conducting equipment isn't ready.

> Ask yourself as you plan - why am I burning? What benefit is this fire going to do for my forage stand or wildlife habitat? Cool season grasses don't tend to respond to fire like warm season prairie grasses do. In fact, if burned too frequently or at the wrong time, stands can be harmed. Further, if you are trying to take out brush or taller cedar trees, do you have enough fuel, and will it be flammable during the appropriate time? If ample fuel loads are not available to burn up small cedar trees, or if burns are being conducted prior to the beginning of regrowth on our brush species (as is often the case with our cool season grasses), control will not be as effective as you'd like. At that

options may better help you achieve your desired objective.

Last, but not least have you given appropriate attention to safety? Have you obtained the proper permits required by local authorities to conduct the burn? Do you have proper clothing, equipment, and tools to safely spread and quickly put out fires? Do you have

or laid out other methods to prevent fire spreading to places you don't want it to? A formal burn plan with efforts coordinated by a burn boss is key to making sure that the burn achieves its desired objective in a manner safe to man, machine, and structure. Much of that effort can be undertaken now so that when it's time to start the prescribed burn, you

Need a burn plan? Your local NRCS office or wildlife biologist can likely help. Our District Extension offices have numerous resource publications available to help you plan, as well as a video available for checkout if you want to learn some techniques. "So, you can put more hay in front of them to eat, but if the quality isn't good, it's not going to help," Grimes said.

Significant shifts in temperature from, say, a high of 50° F to a high of  $20^{\circ}$  F put further stress on a cow's body to adjust to the changes, Grimes said.

A pregnant cow at the time she gives birth typically weighs 1,200 to 1,400 pounds. Much of that weight is gained in the last 30-45 days before the calf is born. The cow should be gaining one pound per day in the last month or so


