### Governor signs Executive Order easing motor carrier regulations to assist with flood relief grateful for the work of our

To expedite emergency relief and restoration efforts associated with recent flooding in Kansas and neighboring states, Governor Laura Kelly has issued an executive order temporarily exempting commercial motor carriers and operators from Parts 390 through 399 of the Federal Motor Carriers Safety Regulations while traveling in Kansas and directly participating in disaster operations.

"Yesterday, I signed an executive order waiving fees and easing regulation on motor carriers to assist with transporting relief to flood affected areas," Kelly said. "I'm emergency management team and the Kansas National Guard during this critical time. It's important communities in both states receive the aid they need immediately." The regulation exemptions

include licensing, certification and permitting; fuel tax permits, and other rules that will allow motor carriers to more quickly bring in necessary supplies and equipment to aid in relief efforts. Heavy rains and spring

snow melts are causing moderate flood conditions along the Missouri River in several states, including Kansas, and is expected to increase to major flooding in the next few days. Doniphan, Marshall and Jefferson counties have issued local disaster declarations and Gov. Kelly signed a state declaration for Doniphan County on March 15. Currently, potential flooding in the state would primarily affect farmland and not residential areas.

The State Emergency Operations Center in Topeka has been activated to a 24/7 level to monitor weather conditions and support local emergency management operations. The governor toured the area impacted by flooding with the Kansas National Guard, the Kansas Department of Emergency Management, and the Kansas Water Office.





abundant moisture early in the winter and bitter cold late was tough on cows and their calves.

"One of the reports we're hearing a lot of people talk about is that our cows are a little thinner than we typically would be coming into calving," Waggoner said. "A lot of that we can attribute to mud and cold temperatures; both of those increase the energy requirements of the cows."

Waggoner notes that it takes extra energy for cows to get up from muddy pens to move to the feed bunk. "Cold basically has the same effect," he said. "When those temperatures drop below 18 degrees, we can see a pretty dramatic increase in energy requirements."

"If we didn't make adjustments for that in our supplementation or feeding program throughout the winter, we tend to draw body condition reserves off the cow. That kind of explains the situation we are in. We are seeing some cows where their condition might be lacking right now."

Waggoner said the best strategy for moving forward is to maintain whatever condition the cow is in right now, rather than to let her slip further. He is working with producers to help them understand their herd's energy requirements and what their current feeding strategy is providing. "We need to pay attention

to both the protein and the energy need," Waggoner said. "A lot of times we do a good job of covering our protein need; that's really what most of our supplementation protocols are geared toward. But we don't always do a good job thinking about energy." He suggests providing high

quality hay, if available, as well as concentrated forms of protein and energy, such as corn blends, dried distillers grains or a commercial range "We need to be looking for supplements that are going to

Jan 8th - Feb 7th provide energy in the form of a high fiber source," Waggoner said. "If that isn't necessarily an option, we can go to concentrates like corn, or even some by-products can work well in that situation." He is encouraging producers to provide dry areas for

cows, which may require using a box blade to clean up wet "We really start to see a performance impact in the feedlot when cattle don't have

a dry place to lie down," Waggoner said. "The same thing is true of cow-calf type systems. There are immense benefits to creating a dry place, either by spreading cattle out or giving them access to a new area where they have a dry place to get out of the mud."





Food Integrity (CFI). "Not only are they bombarded with confusing labels, but with conflicting viewpoints and science, and frequent peer pressure to 'eat this - not

that." said CFI's Roxi Beck. "What they'd really love are honest answers from credible sources so they can make confident decisions about the food they choose to eat."

What consumers want is authentic transparency, CFI research shows. "Most of all, they want proof," said Beck.

"We want to see proof" During a recent CFI con-

were asked how the food industry can alleviate fears about GMOs, one woman said she doesn't want food companies simply saying they're doing something: "We want to see proof" that they're actually doing it.

She specifically mentioned videos that show how food is produced or that give the other side of trending anti-food industry documentaries or videos. Food Evolution is an excellent example, said Beck. Described by its producers as

"Not pro-GMO, but simply pro-science," the film shows all sides of the story of genetic modification.

A similar sentiment was echoed in the CFI Street Talk series when consumers were asked how food companies can be more transparent. "I've seen programs where

"There are many options to show what you do and we encourage you to consider enhancing your engagement," said Beck. "In any relationship actions do speak louder than words."
