Late maturing soybean face damage from early killing frost and need special attention for harvest and storage, says University of Missouri Extension soybean specialist Bill Wie-

Harvest frost-damaged soybean based on seed moisture content rather than how plants look after frost, says

Delaying harvest after damaging frost results in grain shatter and subsequent yield loss. Soybean breeders select for shattering tolerance and normally the seam of the soybean pods holds together. However, the halves rupture if left in the field too long after maturity or damage.

Ice crystals form inside plant cells when temperatures quickly drop below freezing. Freezing water expands and tears plant cells and membranes. This causes cell contents leak outside the cells and plants die quickly.

When harvesting, adjust combine settings to allow for plants with wetter than normal stems and leaves, says Wiebold. Seeds also will shrink to smaller than normal size and seed will be more oblong in shape than normal. Frost-damaged soybean should store almost as easily as normal soybean, Wiebold says. He also recommends aeration when

When soybean plants die before maturity, seeds on those plants do not mature normally. Plants quit producing chlorophyll when they reach physi-

storing.

ological maturity. Seeds from immature plants contain chlorophyll and remain green.

Intensity of the pigment depends on how mature the soybean plant was prior to frost. The seed coat stays green if death occurs late in seed filling. If this is the case, the color may bleach from sunlight or natural metabolism or lessen during storage.

If plant death occurs earlier in the life cycle, the inner part of the seed may remain green. even after long-term storage. Immature beans also may require longer drying times.

Nearly all USA soybean grain is classified and sold as yellow soybeans, according to the "Official U.S. Standards for Grain." "Seeds with green seed coats should be classified as yellow soybeans and not docked. However, seeds in which less than 90% of the cross-section is yellow will likely be classified as "soybeans of other color." If the grain lot has more than 10% seeds of other color it may be graded as "standard" and may receive substantial dockage, says Wiebold.

Below-freezing temperatures will not affect plants that showed signs of maturing, such as yellow leaves and leaf drop, before freezing.

However, many producers likely will see damaged slow-maturing soybean after recent frosts. Because of the large number of delayed planting acres this year, recent frosts will affect more soybean than usual

Damage can occur even when temperatures are too warm for ice to form, says Wiebold, because cool temperatures can damage the plant's enzymes.

"Killing freeze" usually means a temperature as low as 28 degrees Farenheit for four hours. However, the freezing point of water within leaves is less than 32 degrees Farenheit. This makes leaves most susceptible to freeze damage. Ice crystals form inside plant cells when temperatures drop quickly below freezing. Freezing water expands and tears plant cells and membranes. This causes cell contents to leak outside the cells.

Damaged leaves or parts of the leaves die and do not change color. If temperatures drop enough, the entire plant

Wiebold says damage may not be uniform through the field. Cold air is heavy and drains down slopes to pool in lower parts of the field. Even small dips can catch and hold cold air and put plants at risk of freezing.

Soils lose heat more slowly than air, so damage varies in different areas of the canopy. Leaves, stems and pods near the top of the plant are most vulnerable while those closer to the warmer ground may receive less damage.

now can enroll in the Agriculture Risk Coverage (ARC) and Price Loss Coverage (PLC) programs - two U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) safety net programs - for the 2020 crop year. Meanwhile, producers who enrolled farms for the 2018 crop year have started receiving more than \$1.5 billion for covered commodities for which payments were triggered under such pro-

"These two programs pro-

vide income support to help producers manage the ups and downs in revenues and prices," said Richard Fordyce, administrator of USDA's Farm Service Agency (FSA). "USDA is here to support the economic stability of American agricultural producers by helping them maintain their competitive edge in times of economic stress. We encourage producers to consider enrolling in one of these programs."

ARC provides income support payments on historical base acres when actual crop revenue declines below a specified guaranteed level. PLC provides income support payments on historical base acres when the effective price for a covered commodity falls below its reference price. The 2018 Farm Bill reauthorized and updated both programs.

Signup for the 2020 crop

year closes June 30, 2020, while signup for the 2019 crop year closes March 15, 2020. Producers who have not yet enrolled for 2019 can enroll for both 2019 and 2020 during the same visit to an FSA coun-

ARC and PLC have options for the farm operator who is actively farming the land as well as the owner of the land. Farm owners also have a one-time opportunity to update PLC payment yields beginning with crop year 2020. If the farm owner and producer visit the FSA county office together, FSA can also update yield

information during that visit. Covered commodities include barley, canola, large and small chickpeas, corn, crambe, flaxseed, grain sorghum, lentils, mustard seed, oats, peanuts, dry peas, rapeseed, long grain rice, medium and short grain rice, safflower seed, seed cotton, sesame, soybeans, sunflower seed and wheat.

2018 Crop Year ARC and PLC Payments

FSA began processing payments for 2018 ARC-County (ARC-CO) and PLC on covered commodities that met payment triggers on enrolled farms in the 2018 crop year. In addition to the \$1.5 billion now in process, FSA anticipates it will issue another \$1 billion in November once USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service publishes additional commodity prices for the 2018 crop.

Producers who had 2018 covered commodities enrolled in ARC-CO can visit www. fsa.usda.gov/arc-plc for payment rates applicable to their county and each covered commodity. For farms and covered commodities enrolled in 2018 PLC, the following crops met payment triggers: barley, canola, corn, dry peas, grain sorghum, lentils, peanuts, and

rence Tribune was not known to have health problems, although his wife, Kitty, regularly consulted the family physician, Dr. Medicott, for an undisclosed chronic ailment. Isaac met Kitty in St. Louis

after the death of his first wife. Kitty was in an unhappy marriage to Seymore Voullaire. They soon divorced. The first time Voullaire saw

Kitty with Isaac Ruth, both men pulled pistols and fired. Voullaire was seriously injured. Kitty tended to him until he had sufficiently healed, and then promptly married Mr. Ruth. The couple moved to Lawrence in 1868. That same year Dr. John

J. Medlicott and his wife, Sarah, moved to Lawrence. Mrs. Medicott was a widow and used her fortune from the previous marriage to establish Dr. Medicott's office in their Lawrence home. The doctor developed a respectable practice and Mrs. Medicott, "many years his senior," was loved by all who knew her. Imagine

the morning of December 15, 1870. Dr. Medicott called in other physicians but nothing could be done to resuscitate her. The attending physicians noticed signs of poison but Dr. Medicott insisted she had died of a stroke. She was buried the very next day.

the shock of finding her dead

Four short months later Isaac Ruth lay dead behind a mysteriously locked door in his own home. Dr. Medicott had been playing chess with him the evening before. Most damning for the doctor was a note left by Mr. Ruth for his wife. Ruth wrote that Dr. Medicott had given him medicine that was making him feel numb and blind. "I write this so that if I never see you again, you may have my body examined and see what the trouble is. Good-bye and ever remember my last thoughts were of

Dr. Medicott was immediately arrested. On his person were found a photograph of Kitty Ruth and two love poems written in her hand. Rumors had persisted for some time that the doctor and Mrs. Ruth had been carrying on in an unseemly way. Now, the question of Mrs. Medicott's poisoning was revisited.

The trial was set to convene in October with a change of venue fifty miles south of Lawrence at Garnett. The newspapers were convicting Dr. Medlicott and his "lover" with each edition. The Lawrence Standard published photographs of Dr. Medlicott and Kitty Ruth taken when they visited at a photo gallery together. Kitty's love poems to Medlicott were also printed and picked up by other news-

papers. The trial began on October 10, 1871. Dr. Medlicott's cell mate, Henry Johnson, testified that the doctor had concocted an elaborate escape attempt. Johnson said that he passed coded letters out of the jail for Medlicott. Kitty was appalled that the prosecution would rely on Johnson, a convicted felon for truthful testimony. In a newspaper interview she said that she and her husband were deeply in love, and Mr. Ruth had never been jealous of Dr. Medlicott. She did not believe that the doctor could have murdered her husband. She kept her medication in the room in which her husband died and believed he may have

taken something by mistake. Other "witnesses" offered sordid details of the affair between Dr. Medlicott and Isaac Ruth's wife. A maid told of Dr. Medlicott visiting twice a day after his wife had died in December. Mr. Ruth was always away at the newspaper office. The two often went behind a locked door for up to an hour in Mrs. Ruth's room. A neighbor of Medlicott testified that Mrs. Ruth had visited the doctor's home several times after Mrs. Medlicott had died. The body of Mrs. Medlicott was exhumed. Morphine was found in her stomach; the

same for Mr. Ruth. The jury was out for about eleven hours from Wednesday to Thursday morning, October 26, 1871. At 8:30 a.m. the jury rendered the verdict; guilty of murder in the first degree. He was sentenced to be hanged. An appeal was referred to the

Kansas Supreme Court. Mrs. Ruth was arrested Sunday, October 29, 1871, as "an accessory before the fact" in the murder of her husband. The "pretty, pretty baby" was summarily found guilty, but all was not lost. On the very day scheduled for Medlicott's hanging, January 26, 1872, the Kansas Supreme Court announced a stay of execution to

review the case.

The March 14, 1872, Saline County Journal announced that the Supreme Court had reversed the judgement, citing several legal exceptions relating to the proceedings. Mrs. Ruth was released, but Dr. Medlicott languished in jail while Douglas County determined whether to retry the case. Medlicott was finally released in September after seventeen months in jail. When asked if he knew the whereabouts of Mrs. Ruth "he responded heartily, 'God knows,

The way in which the entire episode ended did not convince many of the innocence of Dr. Medlicott and Mrs. Ruth. Was it murder? Did Isaac Ruth take the medication by accident or did he commit suicide to revenge the lover of his unfaithful wife? Only eternity can unveil the mystery of entangled love and death on The Way West.





and manure. The skin is an amazing barrier that blocks pathogens from entering the body. However, an injury to the skin, specifically the skin in-between the toes, is necessary for the infection to take hold. These injuries can be caused walking in rocky areas, punctures from hard stubble or frozen/dried mud can all be the culprit. Once the bacteria break through the skin barrier, they release a toxin that

causes destruction of the cells and leads to inflammation and swelling. Obvious lameness can be observed. Early in the disease process, swelling may be located on the backside of the foot under the dewclaws. Foot rot also has a terrible smell.

Foot rot occurs in wet conditions, and managing the external environment can be extremely difficult. Commonly visited areas of the pasture usulocations could be wet, muddy areas around water sources, shaded or resting areas, or mineral feeding areas. They will have increased amounts of environmental contamination, particularly from manure. Moving mineral and supplement sites, and monitoring water tanks for leaks can be helpful in limiting these conditions. Controlling access to watering sites in a pond can also reduce the threat.

It has been indicated that supplementing with proper levels of zinc and iodine may help reduce overall occurrence. There is a foot rot vaccine available but there are mixed reports on overall ef-

Work with your local veterinarian to choose the proper treatment regimen. The treatment typically consists of an injectable antimicrobial. Foot rot is a painful condition. There is also a new topical flunixin product available to control the pain associated with this condition. Early treatment in the disease process is typically very rewarding. To find these cases, be sure to check mobility of all animals in the herd while checking and monitoring your pastures. Because as the disease progresses, deeper structures of the foot can be involved, making treatment difficult. If left untreated the infection can spread up the leg causing systemic issues or






