Breeders may nominate sires for Angus Structured Sire Evaluation

The American Angus Association is expanding the Structured Sire Evaluation (SSE) program to include nominated sires from members.

“The Structured Sire Evaluation increases accuracies on carcass traits, which grows prediction accuracies of genomic evaluations and builds a stronger database,” says Esther McCabe, American Angus Association director of performance programs. “As this program grows, we want to give members the opportunity to prove sires of their choice.”

Members who are interested in having a sire included in the SSE should complete the nomination form and submit the initial fee for test sires by Jan. 28.

The SSE was reestablished in 2016 to collect carcass data on progeny generated from widely used Angus sires to strengthen the database. Since 2016, there have been more than 150 Angus test sires included in this program. Through collection of carcass data, along with genomic testing and ultrasound scanning of progeny in seedstock herds, Angus bulls can have higher accuracy expected progeny differences (EPDs) for carcass traits at younger ages.

Don't buy a fat bull; sale-season nutrition should prepare bull for work instead of beauty

Traditionally, young bulls offered for sale are often too fat, especially the ones that have gone through maximum-gain performance tests to measure rate of gain and feed efficiency. We now know that this can be detrimental to their fertility and longevity, but many young bulls are still too fat at sale time. John Kastelic, department head and professor of production animal health at the University of Calgary, has done a lot of research on nutrition in bulls.

Historically, people focused on nutrition after weaning, especially since the 1970s.

"Back then, seedstock producers fed young bulls practically a feedlot ration to achieve gains up to four pounds per day to see how fast they gained. There is good evidence to show that if you feed bulls high-energy diets after weaning, you get very rapid weight gain, but you also create a lot of problems with excessive fat in the scrotum, reduction in semen quality, more risk for laminitis/founder, liver abscesses, rumenitis, joint and skeletal problems, etc. Feeding young bulls this much is counterproductive," he warns.

Even though buyers know that a bull should be fit, not fat, they tend to think there is something wrong with a bull that's not carrying extra weight at sale time. Bulls are likely to be too fat unless the breeder feeds just a growing ration — and some of the "growing rations" people claim to be feeding still contain too much energy.

Producers are recognizing this and realize that a bull should be fed for a long life of breeding rather than being fed like a steer destined for slaughter.

A bull needs to be athletic, not fat.

"It is very detrimental to feed bulls high-energy rations postweaning for rapid gains, resulting in overconditioned bulls," Kastelic says. "The thinking used to be that if a bull is not fat, he must be a hard-keeper and poor-doer. Sale bulls were always fat, but producers thought they could just take them home and put them on a diet before they went out with cows, and then they would be in breeding shape. Unfortunately, some of the damage in the overfat young bull can be permanent."

Even though most seed-

stock producers now realize this, many bulls are still fed to be a little too fat. Fat is beautiful and covers up a lot of conformation faults, Kastelic says. Even though buyers know that a bull should be fit, not fat, they tend to think there is something wrong with a bull that's not carrying extra weight at sale time. Bulls are likely to be too fat unless the breeder feeds just a growing ration — and some of the "growing rations" people claim to be feeding still contain too much energy.

When fed a mostly forage diet postweaning, the bulls with genetic poten-

tial for rapid and efficient gain will still gain the fastest, he says. The difference between the top and bottom performers will just be smaller.

"You can still do a feed test, but on a forage-based ration with a modest amount of grain, and still identify the top-performing bulls," Kastelic says. "Thus, there is no reason to push them with a feedlot ration, because you can do permanent damage. It is detrimental, and a waste of feed resources, so that's the first thing seedstock producers need to know, and bull buyers need to beware of."

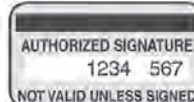

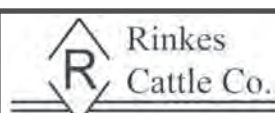

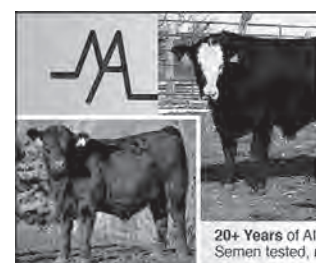

Schwieterman Market Outlook

A marketing commentary by Bret Crofts

Grain markets had a very volatile week. At times we saw heavy selling pressure in the wheat, but we also saw some new contract highs in corn, soybeans, and soybean oil. Not to mention the new contract highs in crude oil and the Dollar Index, which added to the big swings in the ag markets.

The March corn made new multi-month highs on Monday, Tuesday, and Friday, and nearly reached the contract high of \$6.40½ set back in May. The December contract made new contract highs Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday. Although we are seeing the new crop make contract highs and the old crop not quite making it there, bull spreading has been a prominent feature of the market. The March-July spread reached the highest level of the year and the March-December spread reached the highest level since September. This is a definite sign of up-front demand and a very bullish aspect of the market.

Export sales have been improving the past couple of weeks, and the recent pace will have traders wondering if USDA's current export estimate is too low. With the Chinese Yuan recently making multi-year highs versus the U.S. dollar, there is a good chance we see more Chinese buying, and if something happens over in Ukraine that slows exports from there, we could see a great deal of demand this spring.

Wheat futures exploded higher to start the week, thanks in part to the tensions with Russia and Ukraine. The March KW stalled out at trend line resistance Tuesday, so Wednesday and Thursday saw heavy selling pressure and the market gave up the early week gains.

Thursday's export sales report was great, showing nearly 25 million bushels of sales, which was the best in a very long time. The biggest problem with seeing strength in the wheat market because of problems in Eastern Europe, was that we had not seen it result in new business for us. If we can see a few consecutive weeks of good sales, then we can talk about USDA potentially reversing the trend of lower export estimates and higher ending stocks estimates. If we start seeing lower ending stocks estimates, crop condition

ratings will matter more, and we will have a shot at returning to the contract highs.

March soybeans made new contract highs last week, but Monday was pretty rough on the bean market. Stabilization in the weather and production estimates in South America put the beans under pressure, but eventually the new all-time highs in Palm Oil provided enough support to the U.S. bean oil market that the whole US complex moved higher.

The \$14.80 level may be strong resistance for the March soybean contract, since that is the 62% retracement of the last move down on the monthly continuation chart. Also, we need to continue to see strong export sales, since the U.S. ending stocks estimate if far from tight. Demand is the key for the soybean going forward. Problems in S. America have to translate to big sales numbers for us in order for this bull market to keep going.

Livestock markets were not immune to the recent volatility last week. The live cattle started the week under heavy pressure thanks in part to the Cattle on Feed Report, and the free fall in the Stock Market. By the end of the week, however, the April live cattle were back above the 50-day moving average and higher for the week. Optimism for the cash cattle market is growing a bit since our slaughter numbers seem to be getting back to normal. With normal demand for cattle, this market has some very good upside potential.

The feeder cattle market did not fare as well as the live cattle. The feeder auctions have been steady to lower for a while now, and since the futures were already at a premium to the index, there was just no incentive for the March contract to be that high. March, however, is at a \$20 discount to August, so there is a great deal of optimism built into the feeder market. We just have to get through spring. The front months of the feeder market really need a reason for some optimism and we just aren't getting it.

RMA extends crop insurance flexibilities to June due to COVID-19

Because of the ongoing impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic, the U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) is extending program flexibilities to Approved Insurance Providers (AIPs) and agricultural producers until June 30, 2022 or later. Originally, these flexibilities were expiring in January.

"Our priority is to keep our producers and partners as safe as possible, while at the same time continuing to provide the best service we can," said Marcia Bunger, administrator of USDA's Risk Management Agency (RMA). "These unique times call for everyone to be cautious and as flexible as possible, and these added flexibilities will help us achieve those goals."

Extended flexibilities include:

Allowing notifications to be sent electronically, including policy related information over the phone or other electronic methods to select policy elections by sales closing, acreage reporting and production reporting dates, including options, endorsements and their forms. Producers may sign electronically or within 60 calendar days.

Allowing producers to submit a request for a written agreement after the sales closing date.

Allowing producers with inability to physically sign a written agreement because of COVID-19 to do so after the expiration date.

Providing additional time for AIPs to accept Regional Office Determined Yield, Master Yield, and Irrigated Determined

Yield requests for Category B (annual) crops.

Allowing AIPs to request a 30-day extension to submit Determined Yield requests for Category C (perennial) crops.

Waiving the witness signature requirement for approval of Assignments of Indemnity.

Additional Pandemic Assistance

These flexibilities are part of USDA's broader response to the COVID-19 pandemic. In 2021, RMA recently provided \$59.5 million in premium support for producers who planted cover crops on 12.2 million acres through the new Pandemic Cover Crop Program. Also, USDA's Pandemic Assistance for Producers has provided additional support for producers by improving and retargeting existing programs and creating new efforts, like PCCP, to reach a broader set of pro-

ducers. USDA is currently accepting applications for two new pandemic assistance programs: the Organic and Transitional Education and Certification Program by Feb. 4, 2022 and the Spot Market Hog Pandemic Program by Feb. 25, 2022.

RMA staff are working with AIPs and other customers by phone, mail and electronically to continue supporting crop insurance coverage for producers. Farmers with crop insurance questions or needs should continue to contact their insurance agents about conducting business remotely (by telephone or email).
