Kansas Hay Market Report

Compared to the last report, the hay market was a bit calmer this past week, meaning we didn't see the huge upward changes that we have seen in recent weeks. Folks are busy in the fields either harvesting, planting wheat, or baling whatever they can find left to bale. Several hay fires were reported last week which stings even more when every bale is needed. According to the U.S. Drought Monitor for September 27th, more than 70% of the topsoil moisture was short or very short in Kansas, Nebraska, South Dakota, and Wyoming, according to USDA statistics. Abnormally dry conditions in Kansas (D0) decreased to 16%, moderate drought (D1) increased to 15.5%, severe drought (D2) remained at 14%, extreme drought (D3) decreased to near 28%, and exceptional drought (D4) increased to 25%. This leaves only 1.5% of the state's area without abnormally dry or drought con-

American Farmland Trust leads group in effort to transition U.S. beef supply to carbon neutral

Trust and partner organizations are being awarded \$30-million grant from the USDA Partnerships for Climate-Smart Commodities to spearhead an effort to transition the U.S. beef supply chain to carbon neutral. The eight-state project will amplify production of climate-smart beef by expanding market drivers, grassroots support networks and early adopter mentors, while also providing technical assistance for the adoption of climate-smart grazing practices to substantially reduce agricultural greenhouse gas emissions and increase carbon seques-

tration.
"This effort is critical in transitioning the country's U.S. beef supply chain to one that is more environ-mentally friendly," said Beth Sauerhaft, AFT vice president of programs. "Beyond this, we will support farmers in protecting their land through permanent easements to help ensure that the soil health and climate benefits from those practices continue

far into the future The project will help produce climate-smart beef for all market levels - from direct sales through local farmers' markets to regional distribution channels to national and global consumer-facing food companies. The project team will engage and train more than 50 producer mentors, transition more than 750 beef producers, map and permanently protect at least 3,000-4,500 acres of threatened farmland.

'We are excited about the level of impact we will be able to achieve with this project," said Bianca Moebius-Clune, AFT climate initiative director and principal investigator. 'We anticipate being able to sequester at least one to five million tons of CO2e during the five-year project, but more importantly we project self-sustaining and accelerating expansion of climate smart system adoption and stable broadly available verified climate smart marketing opportunities beyond the



The KFB Legal Foundation board selects up to three recipients each year from law students in the fall semester before

their anticipated graduation date. The selection process favors applicants who demonstrate a strong desire to live and work in rural Kansas, understand the legal issues farmers and ranchers commonly face, have high academic achievements and show a financial need. Rural Kansas is defined as anywhere outside Douglas, Johnson, Sedgwick, Shawnee or Wyandotte counties.

Recipients receive the grant money in three installments, with the first \$5,500 paid after passing the bar examination and starting practice in rural Kansas. The remaining installments will be paid after a recipient's continued practice in rural Kansas for one and two years, respectively.

KFB's Legal Foundation is accepting applications for the next round of grants through Nov. 1. Applicants must complete the application and submit it with a résumé, transcript and letter of recommendation. 



National Institute for Animal Agriculture Partners with CDC

NIAA invited animal with CDC professionals at agriculture leaders from across the country engage

their home office in Atlanta, Georgia.

In August, The National Institute for Animal Agriculture (NIAA) hosted a group of ten farmers, ranchers, and veterinarians on a tour and engagement visit with the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC).

Each vear the Cattlemen's Beef Board designates Beef Checkoff funding to programming that includes research, foreign marketing, industry information, consumer information and safety. NIAA's project was approved in 2021 with a plan to connect farmers and ranchers and industry professionals to CDC and other public health professionals to learn and engage on the importance of responsible antibiotic use in animal agriculture.

"The responsible use of antibiotics in animal agriculture is one of the most misunderstood topics in today's food system," said J.J. Jones, executive director of NIAA. "Farmers, ranchers and veterinarians face an ever-changing landscape of consumer demands without much needed constructive discussion or feedback."

NIAA believes the future of animal antibiotic use will be shaped by consistent, effective communication and collaboration between the animal agriculture sector and its allies to combat antimicrobial resistance (AMR) through a One Health approach.

Megin Nichols, DVM, MPH. DACVPM, CDC Deputy Division Director, Division of Foodborne, Waterborne, and Environmental Diseases and co-chair of the NIAA antibiotics council, sees the mutual benefits to be gained from collaborative in-person sessions "The opportunity to meet in-person and share ideas through the NIAA engagement with livestock producers regarding the intersection of human health and animal health was invaluable to our team. It opened the door to dialogue and innovation on topics of mutual interest," said Nichols. Dr. Nichols is a veterinarian employed by CDC and understands the lapse in knowledge with her public health colleagues.

Andy Bishop, a rancher from Kentucky, appreciated the opportunity to connect with leaders outside of the industry. "The CDC visit was a great opportunity to bring a multi-faceted group of individuals together in a collaborative effort to protect animal agriculture and the American population," said Bishop. 
